

Additional details (JPS/35/2021):

In addition to the Safe Work Practices, Adult corrections implemented the following procedures in various institutions:

Labrador Corrections Centre:

- Mental health care provision for offenders included transition to video and telehealth counselling service through Mental Health and Addictions, Nunatsiavut, SIFN and MIFN.
- Group programming was limited to 6 offenders for social distance measures.
- Facilitator was required to complete COVID-19 questionnaire prior to session.
- Facilitator was required to wear mask for duration of session.
- One on one counselling services was provided through visiting room with glass partition.
- Family visitation was transitioned through video services.
- Admin staff were transitioned to work from home. Upon return to work place phone provision for offender contact was established.

Her Majesty's Penitentiary, NL Correctional Centre for Women:

- Visits were conducted by video.
- all facilitators were not permitted in the building for a period of March to July.
- Classification Officers were removed from the main building and worked from an outside trailer (they were on a rotational schedule).
- When facilitators reentered the building, programs were offered at a reduced capacity.

West Coast Correctional Centre, Bishop's Falls Correctional Centre:

- Visits were conducted by video.
- All in-person programs were stopped.
- All mental health sessions that were with Doorways were conducted by phone.
