ATIP request A2020-00357 – Revocations and suspensions

Request:

“Access to Information and Privacy Division (ATIP) has received an Access to Information Act request for;
Timeframe: 1 March 2020 to 30 August 2020
Suspensions and Revocations - I am requesting statistical overviews tracking the number of suspensions and revocations of parole and other forms of community release from your parole offices.”

Response:

-Revocation Admissions: These data include admissions between March 1, 2020 and August 30, 2020 with an actual admission type of revocation (with offence, without offence, and with outstanding charge). Note that there is a delay in the entry of these data into the Offender Management System (OMS) therefore caution should be used when interpreting these numbers. As time progresses, more admissions will be entered and the numbers will go up.

-Suspensions - These data include all supervision warrants that were issued between March 1, 2020 and August 30, 2020. Note that one offender may have more than one supervision warrant issued in the specified timeframe. Warrants that were for recommitment on revocation or withdrawn were excluded.

As the issuance of a supervision warrant does not automatically lead to a revocation admission, caution should be applied with the interpretation of the below figures.
