Hi Gord,

Another update for you:

The youth who was on Admission/Assessment quarantine moved to isolation status last week, April 7, as he was exhibiting symptoms (previous email update) {He was in contact with (+) staff member on the Monday he was admitted prior to the staff member testing (+)}. Due to symptoms, a PCR was completed and it came back Sunday, April 10 as (-). His symptoms subsided, however, complained of a sore throat today, therefore, a POCT was completed and it returned (+). PH was consulted and his Isolation date starts today. This will push our outbreak status further into the future.

A PFT staff member who was on shift today wanted to do a test after the youth's test returned (+) and the staff member's test returned (+) as well. This staff member has been working in the Remand Unit throughout. The DD directed the staff member to leave immediately and his 5 day isolation period would start today. The (+) Staff member and other staff members working the secure unit indicated masking has been donned at all times and full PPE has been worn while working with all the youth. PH was consulted on this case as well and staff are to monitor symptoms, recommending daily testing and report to management if there is a change in health.

To date since the outbreak status has been in place:

- 4 youth (+)
- 4 staff (+) (1 staff member unlikely linked to this case)

**Subject:** PAYR Outbreak - Update

Hey Gord,

I am sending you an update on our situation at PAYR as there were a few more positives which Tricia and I have discussed early this morning and reporting back to PH.

- 1 more youth has tested positive by a POCT yesterday. He has been isolating since Friday

when he complained of a sore throat. A PCR was done then and we are still awaiting results.

- 1 staff member reported to PAYR on Saturday that he tested positive. No symptoms while working. He is a PFT staff on the Secure Unit who works the evening shift. He was working all week which was prior to the 2 positives where masking was in place and after where the youth were isolated and full PPE was required. This one will be linked and there will be 1 day WCB once the Form 101 and W1 process is completed.
- 1 staff member called in yesterday to indicate they tested positive on Saturday as well. No symptoms while working during the week. He is a PFT staff member who works the Open Custody Unit, however, was redeployed on Thursday to the Remand Unit to work. Full PPE was in effect and youth all isolating. He indicated that his wife has been sick all week (did not disclose whether she was positive or not). He is due back Thursday with 3 days missed but unsure at this time whether he will do a Form 101 or not. He did not mention this to the DD. This one is very debatable but if he does do a Form 101 it will be linked because it will be too hard to challenge otherwise in my opinion.

With the above youth testing positive yesterday, this will move our youth who are isolating and are currently negative to a later date than the initial 10 days and will essentially move our outbreak status to a later date. The 2 youth who tested positive initially will be done their 10 day isolation period on Friday.

Again, this is all subject to Public Health direction after they receive our updated line list spreadsheet for our Outbreak this morning.
