Based on the direction from Dr. Henry and the discussions at the BC Immunization Committee with our health authority partners, this is the planned sequencing for BC, based on vaccine availability:

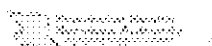
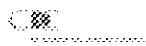
Sequencing in federal and provincial correctional facilities

Federal corrections inmates (vaccine provided from federal allocation):

- January: >70 & those 65-69 with comorbidities
- April: remainder of inmates

Federal HCWs/ staff and Provincial inmates/ HCWs/staff (vaccine provided from BC/ regional allocation):

- Late March: inmates aged 65+, and HCWs
- April or later: inmates <65 years, staff including corrections officers
