

Visiting an inmate at a CSC institution during COVID-19



PLANNING FOR A VISIT



- Visits must be booked at least 48 hours in advance by contacting the institution.

- You will be screened at the time of booking.



- Monitor your health and know the symptoms of COVID-19.

- You must be registered on their authorized visitors' list.



- A maximum of three visitors are permitted at a time, which can include up to two children.

- Only one visit per week per visitor.



- Masks are mandatory. You can bring your own or one will be provided.

- You cannot bring food, beverages, or personal belongings into the institution.



- Visits will be limited to 1.5 hours.

DURING YOUR VISIT



- All visitors will be screened upon arrival.

- All visitors will have their temperature taken by a contactless thermometer. If you have symptoms, you will not be permitted to enter.



- Visitors will be required to wash their hands and wear a mask.

- No physical contact is permitted between visitors and inmates.

- Vending machines will not be available.

- Play areas will be closed and toys will not be permitted.

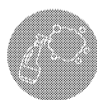


- Inmates and visitors will be 2 meters apart and physical distancing applies throughout the site.

AFTER YOUR VISIT



Each visitor table will be provided with disinfecting wipes.



Locations where visiting occurs are disinfected before and after each visit, including visitor washrooms.



Remember to wash or disinfect your hands.
