Hi folks,

Just a quick update on our status at PAYR:

We have had our discussion with Public Health on our current situation. PH has taken it back to MHO, Dr. Chokani, who has deemed us a "SUSPECT OUTBREAK" at this time. Although he is aware of the initial positive case, who has since been released, he has indicated that we only have the one current positive case and will be on a "standby" pending further monitoring, testing, assessments etc. With this direction, we have not yet entered the red zone of PH's outbreak status or the Ministry's.

PH is very happy with our current response and processes we have in place. At this point, we have been given a recommendation that the one positive youth will be isolated for 10 days which exceeds the Ministry guidelines of a "non outbreak" 5 days isolation. If we are to have anymore positive cases, Dr. Chokani indicated our status will change and we will be in the Outbreak red zone for both PH and the Ministry along with new mitigation guidelines for our unit.

We will continue working with PH, monitoring our situation and send updates on any changes to our status.

Subject: PAYR Update - Moving into Outbreak Status

Good day folks,

This morning we had another youth, from our Secure/Remand Unit, test POSITIVE for COVID. POCTs were completed on the remaining 5 youth producing a NEGATIVE result for each. Unfortunately, due to 2 youth testing positive within days of each other, we have now moved into **OUTBREAK STATUS**. We are working within the Ministry's COVID Protocols regarding the Isolation and Quarantine statuses of our youth on the Unit. We are also waiting to hear back from Public Health to have our initial discussion. PH's direction will be followed, therefore, we are prepared for further updates and communication for the facility. The Sign has been posted on our Secure/Remand Unit and we will begin moving through the Ministry's Outbreak Status and De-Escalation Measures Matrix and Public Health's direction.

Important to note - Initial youth who tested positive has been with us for a while, however, had a professional visit in the facility as well as attended an appointment in the community. The second youth, who has tested positive today, also had a professional visit with the same stakeholder as the initial youth on the same day.
