

60+ Days on October 31, 2020

On October 31, 2020 there were 128 clients in custody who have spent 60+ aggregate days in segregation between October 31, 2019 and October 31, 2020. Of those 128 clients in custody on October 31, 2020, 48 (37.5%) were in segregation.

Mental Health Alerts

Of the 48 clients who have spent 60+ aggregate days in segregation since October 31, 2019 and were in segregation on October 31, 2020, 62.5% (30) have a mental health alert(s).

 - o For example, an individual who had a placement from December 5, 2019 to January 12, 2019, will have the December 5, 2019 date defaulted to December 30, 2019.

- The "Number of Placements" column reflects the total number of segregation placements the offender had that made up the 60+ aggregate segregation days.

- The number of placements will be collapsed if the segregation placement consecutively spanned into the next day:
 - o As an example, an individual who had one placement from 2019-01-01 12:00 am to 2019-01-24 11:59 p.m., and then a second placement from 2019-01-24 12:00 a.m. to 2019-01-31 11:59 p.m. - would have these two placements collapsed into one placement.

- "Consecutive Placement Length" as of December 31 2020:
 - o Data in this column will reflect individuals who were in segregation on December 31, 2020, and the consecutive number of days they have spent in segregation at that point.
 - o Breaks in segregation are defined as 24 hours or greater (within a midnight to midnight timeframe). This logic will be applied to placements beginning November 1, 2019.
 - o Prior to November 1, 2019, any break in segregation, regardless of length, is considered a break.

- The "Primary Reason for Placement" column will reflect the inmate's most recent segregation placement reason within their placement details captured.

- The presence of a mental health alert does not necessarily reflect a diagnosis.
