I won't distribute these products further at this time – until we determine if we want to send any to Parole Office's, RHQ's etc.

Emily – there are 2 types of KN95's listed on the Depot list that failed the testing – any idea which of them are these referenced masks?

Mask KN95 (0007) (did not pass test)  
Supplier: Fastenal – there are 100 cases of a 1000 masks/case

Mask KN95 - Non compliant (0062)  
Supplier: PHAC – there are 3104 cases of a 1000 masks/case
