To all staff,

This notification is to inform you that the outbreak of COVID-19 at the Saskatoon Correctional Centre has been declared over by the Medical Health Officer.

Please post this in an area for all of your inmates to see. For inmates in medium, high and on segregation, please provide them with a copy.

This moves SCC into Phase 1 of the de-escalation of COVID-19 measures matrix which indicates a Moderate Risk: outbreak is declared over and for the next three weeks. For the next three weeks, nothing much will change from how we have been operating since the outbreak was declared (including continuous masking).

As we get closer to phase 2 (low risk, at least three weeks after outbreak declared over), further information will be sent out.

If it is an emergency requiring urgent attention, call 911.

We strongly recommend that everyone who is eligible, gets all doses of the COVID-19 vaccine which they are eligible to receive.
