Health Services Recommendations for Interregional and Intraregional Transfers by Land (to be reviewed as required)

The purpose of this document is to clarify Health Services' recommendations for the staff and inmates involved in the Interregional and Intraregional Transfers by land, which may not be covered in the Risk Management Framework.



Prior to leaving the site

- Each site to provide medical/ procedural mask and face shields for all staff/inmates

Testing

STAFF	INMATE
Staff who are transferring inmates, including the driver, are to be rapid tested by CSC Health Services at their respective site within 24 hours prior to departure. A negative test result is required to participate in the transfer.	Inmates who are transferring will be offered a rapid test by CSC Health Services within 24 hours prior to departure to the airport. Inmates who refuse to be tested will be transferred. Inmates whose test results are positive will not be transferred.

Health Check

STAFF	INMATE
Active screening before leaving and upon return to the institution will be conducted.	Inmate who will be transferred are to be pre screened via the Health Check document the day of transfer at the site by CSC Health Services.

Wearing of Masks and Face Shields

STAFF	INMATE
Staff to wear medical/ procedural mask and face shields:	Inmates to wear medical/ procedural mask and face shields:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medical/ procedural masks must be worn by escorting officers, including the driver, during transportation. • Face shields are expected to be worn by escorting officers during transportation. Drivers are not expected to wear face shields. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At all times within the mode of transportation to/from the airport.

**Hand hygiene and physical distancing where possible remain critical.

If overnight stay is required (for escorts)

- Staff to ensure social distancing
 1. Not to congregate with other staff (no going out for food, social gathering).
 2. No visiting in hotel rooms.
 3. Meals to be obtained and eaten alone in individual hotel rooms. (This requirement will be reviewed prior to each interregional/intraregional transfer operation)
