Your request is for access to statistical overviews on the number of lockdowns and length in correctional institutions for the time period covering October 1, 2020 to December 20, 2020. Please be advised that total access is granted to the available statistics. Please note that Operational Support (OS) have confirmed that due to inconsistencies with institutions reporting, the ministry does not track the length of lockdowns.
