Good Afternoon,

As per our facility Nurse Jaimie who spoke with Jordan at Public Health our outbreak status is **over as of right now** and we do not have to wait until 2359 tonight.

Due to our Outbreak status being lifted, effective today we will follow the 11.1 Guidelines for PPE. Some information below is outlined to help you with this transition.

Youth may return to eating in the common area.

**Masks will only be strongly recommended for clients and visitors-** We can no longer mandate our youth to wear masks when not in outbreak status.

**MASKS STILL MANDATORY FOR STAFF** – We follow Section 11.1 of the OH&S PPE Guidelines as we have been designated as an area within these guidelines. Mandatory masking does not change for us at this time.

Although, we are considered an area that is designated and falls under 11.1, where staff have to continually mask, there are other areas across the province that will not, therefore, this matrix allows flexibility for the facilities/offices to reduce continuous masking if not in an outbreak. This also allows for recognition of one facility who may not be in an outbreak status while another one would be and the steps/processes to follow.

Youth <b>must don a surgical/procedural mask whenever out of their cell.</b> (Exception for hygiene and eating.) If a quarantined unit happens to be a dorm, youth must always don a surgical/procedural mask (exception for hygiene, eating and sleeping)
<b>Transports</b>	Youth with or without suspected COVID-19	Youth must don a surgical/procedural mask on all external escorts.
<b>Open Custody Youth</b>	Open Custody Facilities will limit community outings to activities that ensure youth/employees avoid contact with members of the broader community.	Youth must don a surgical/procedural mask prior to leaving the facility and replace it with a clean surgical/procedural mask once they have returned. All Youth leaving the home non-designated unit for work detail, programming, or other internal facility movement must don a surgical/procedural mask for duration of the activity.
<b>Nurses Clinic</b>	Any	Youth must don a surgical/procedural mask during entire admission process and movement until placed in cell
	Youth with respiratory symptoms or from Quarantine / Isolation/ Assessment and Admission unit	Immediately move the client to an isolation room or separate area away from others; if this is not feasible, ensure spatial distance of at least 2 metres from other clients.
