RE: RCC Update- Offender Population

The total number of positive cases in the offender population is 17.

The units currently on regular programming are: Units 1A, 1B3, 1C, 2C, 2D3, 3, 4, 5A, 8, and Dorm 1. All other units still remain on either quarantine or isolation status.

SHA will be in the facility next week completing 7 and 14 day swabs on some units. They will also be here on Wednesday, May 19th to vaccinate inmates aged 30+ (with the possibility of this changing to all inmates 18+).

Vaccines help protect yourselves and your families. They are the best way to stop the spread of COVID-19, make our communities safer, and can help us start to resume our normal lives and end the pandemic. Make a wise decision when it is your turn. If you are unsure, the nursing clinic will be able to provide you with more information.

Although our numbers are decreasing, we must ensure that all current cleaning, sanitizing, and safety protocols remain in place on units. Continue to be diligent when it comes to washing your hands, wearing your masks, cleaning/disinfecting high touch point areas, socially distancing, and not eating or drinking together. Although the number of positive cases are looking better, there are still other variants that we have not experienced yet and this is not the time to ease off the health and safety protocols put in place.
