

**Strategies for Managing Government Microblogs:  
A Critical Study of 29 Provincial Weibos in China**

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## Abstract

It is becoming widely believed that social network is posing an insurmountable threat to authoritarian rule, as the role tweeter played in the Arab Spring. However, Chinese government is benefiting from the proper use of Weibo (the Chinese name for microblog) instead of just regarding it as a danger. Chinese government is using Weibo to build a more responsive government and meanwhile avoiding the potential for collective movement. Although numerous scholars have studied astroturfing<sup>1</sup> and censorship in weibo, there's no systematic study of how both activities work in the government weibo. In this critical study, we found provincial governments use weibos for responding to the demand from various social actors and applying different strategies to manage comments in weibo. Furthermore, we found there's a regional difference in the above strategies.

## I. Introduction

Since “tweeter” is not accessible in China considering the potential chaos they might bring, weibo becomes the substitute for tweeter in China and now enjoys a high popularity among netizens. There are about 200 million monthly active users in Sina weibo<sup>2</sup>, according to Sina’s 2015 weibo report<sup>3</sup>. There’s no doubt that weibo has been an important part of people’s “internet life”.

For the Chinese government, the rise of weibo is a chance to make itself more responsive. Social media platforms are increasingly being used by governments to foster user interaction. Until the end of 2015, there are 152390 government affairs weibos, including 114706 weibos of government agencies and 37684 weibos of government servants. This number is still increasing rapidly. The newspaper press number (482.4 billion) is only one third of the aggregate reading number of government weibos (Ma et al, 2005).

There is a reason for the flourish of government weibos which is part of the electronic government project. Through e-government, China’s leaders expect to boost administrative reforms by transforming government functions, streamlining procedures, and enhancing administrative transparency (Ma et al, 2005). Chinese government needs weibo as “home court” to deal with public emergency, guide public agenda, strike the rumors, promote “positive power” (正能量) and provide some online public services.

Correspondingly, Chinese netizens seem to be passionate to participate in the political discourse on the Internet platform. In an empirical investigation of 31 Informational World Cities (Mainka et al 2014) , Chinese citizens showed a relatively strong will to use electronic services for citizens and get involved in policy decisions on social media platform (figure 1.1).

However, many would argue that media can pose threats to non-democratic regime. In the earlier times, the important role of television in the “demonstration effect” or “snowballing” in Eastern European transitions have been illuminated (Shanthi, and Taylor, 2001). Recent years, as ICTs (Information Communication Technology) develop, it is becoming widely believed that the Internet poses an insurmountable threat to authoritarian rule. Arab Spring is a recent example strengthening this belief. The Arab uprisings were spontaneous process of mobilization that emerged from calls from the Internet and wireless communication networks (Howard, 2011). To sum up, the diffusion and use of ICTs favor democratization, strengthen democracy and increase civic awareness.

Collective action in the form of protests is often thought to be the death knell of authoritarian regimes. Protests in East Germany, Eastern Europe, and most recently the Middle East have all preceded regime change (Ash 2002; Lohmann 1994; Przeworski et al. 2000). In the “internet

age”, the authoritarian state is faced more challenges of maintaining stability since the widespread use of internet among the people. “The Chinese government now meets the real opponent— Internet. “ (Nicolas, 2005). According to the survey conducted by “People’s Forum<sup>4</sup>”, 70% of the interviewed officials suffered from “cyberphobia”. Indeed, For them “collective movements” could be their nightmares for their careers: First, a serious collective movement can remove them from office (figure 1.2). Second, collective movements can stop them from promotion. As scholars found in the 17 indexes that can “veto” the promotion of local leaders, social security and stability is the only one applied nationwide (Shang and Li 2011). So when an online protest gain its momentum and potentially develop into a street protest, it’s a vital signal for the local leaders to stop it. No one wants to become the victims of the internet.

However, we argue that the story of “Arab Spring” won’t repeat itself in China because the Chinese authority applies effective control over social media. Unlike those uprising Arab states, Chinese authority uses weibo as a way to build “harmonious society” (和谐社会), trying to

eliminate the sensitive and seditious information and propagandize policies as well ideology. The most famous activity is “censorship” which is aimed to eliminate sensitive speech online. The Chinese regime also conducts “astroturfing”, or what we might call “reverse censorship,” surreptitiously posting large numbers of fabricated social media comments, as if they were the genuine opinions of ordinary Chinese people ( King, Pan and Roberts, 2016). Emails leaked from the Internet Propaganda Office of Zhongnanhai give explicit details of the work of numerous 50c accounts in this district (Henochowicz, 2014). However, Chinese authority has no intention to stop people from criticizing certain policies. Their tolerance to the criticism is from the rationale that these criticisms have no potential of collective movement and can be used as feedbacks to their policies(Lorentzen, 2013).

We argue that no matter it’s “astroturfing” “censorship” or “tolerance”, they are ways of government’s response to different social actors in a manipulative way. Each way represent an attitude toward certain issues related to certain demands. From this study, we will identify numerous such activities by collecting and analyzing data from 29 provincial units. Finally we will try to induce some patterns behind these activities.

## **II.Literature Review**

We argue that the government weibo is an undertaking to increase government responsiveness. With more response, the authoritarian regime can gain more legitimacy and advocacy. This ultimately will make the regime more resilient. We did literature review in the following order: authoritarian resilience→responsive government→ how Chinese government is using weibo now.

### **2.1. Authoritarian resilience**

Regime theory holds that authoritarian systems are inherently fragile because of weak legitimacy, overreliance on coercion, overcentralization of decision making, and the predominance of personal power over institutional norms (Nathan, Andrew J,2007). China's authoritarian system, however has proven resilient. When authoritarian rule is legitimate, the ruled accept commands because they originate in an authoritative source such as traditions, leaders, or because the ruled accept the reasons provided by rulers (He et Mark, 2011). In Mao's Era, the charisma of the leader and the communist belief can persuade people into believing the legitimacy of the states. While the Cultural Revolution seriously impaired this kind of legitimacy, scholars point out China's present authoritarian resilience comes from the following sources:

- Most people's living standards have risen during two decades of economic growth.
- The Party has coopted elites by offering Party membership to able persons from all walks of life and by granting the informal protection of property rights to private entrepreneurs.
- Thanks to the success of political repression, there is no organized alternative to the regime.
- Coercive repression—in 1989 and after—may itself have generated legitimacy by persuading the public that the regime's grip on power is unshakeable.

In short, the recipe for the stamina of the Chinese regime contains three ingredients: capitalism, nationalism, and legal rights(Dimitrov, 2008). There are studies arguing that authoritarian can "borrow" some legitimacy from democracy especially the deliberation mode (He, 2001) .

Scholars refer to this paradoxical phenomenon as authoritarian deliberation. Oriented by democratic theory, He Baogang argues that authoritarian deliberation is theoretically possible (He, 2001). Andrew develops another similar explanation, more directly related to institutionalization: The regime has developed a series of input institutions (that is, institutions

that people can use to apprise the state of their concerns) that allow Chinese to believe that they have some influence on policy decisions and personnel choices at the local level (Andrew, 2003). Similarly, according to Shi, Chinese participate in the local and work-unit levels in a variety of ways. These include voting, assisting candidates in local-level elections, and lobbying unit leaders (Tianjin, 1996). To sum up, the “transplant” from certain democracy mechanisms is actually to increase the responsiveness which is often evaluated by citizens under authoritarian regime (M, Stephen, 1992).

## **2.2. Responsiveness**

In democracies, responsive government is a reaction to pressure from below, either pressure exerted directly by citizens through political action (Cleary 2007; Hirschman 1970; Putnam 1993) or indirectly through the incentives created by electoral institutions (Besley and Case 1995; Canon 1999; Powell 2000).

In authoritarian regimes, responsiveness could also be a reaction to pressure from below, for example, collective action can precipitate government response. Using an online field experiment to directly measure the responsiveness of subnational officials to citizen requests, scholars found that threatening collective action causes a 10 percentage point increase in the overall response rate and almost one-third of county governments in China are responsive to citizen requests related to social welfare (Chen, Jennifer, Xu, 2015).

Yet literature related to responsiveness of Chinese government is still insufficient due to the difficulty to conduct political field studies in China. However, with the help of social media, studying how the government respond to the demand of different social actors online can be a good approach. Run by Sina, representing the government, seen by everyone and commented

by anyone—these characteristics make the government weibo an ideal channel for demand- and complaint-making. The government weibo itself can be seen as a way to enhance legitimacy by creating more responsiveness with the help of social network.

Scholars also found that criticism and protests in certain degree and areas can be used to benefit the authoritarian regime itself. The authoritarian regime's characteristic lack of accurate information about citizen preferences and resulting widespread discontent is precisely what can lead small-scale protests to spread like a "prairie fire" (Kuran, 1991). Authoritarian elites must find a way to resolve this problem if they are to hold power for the long term. Lorentzen uses a formal model and a close examination of the Chinese case to show that the informal toleration and even encouragement of small-scale, narrowly economic protests can be an effective information gathering tool, mitigating these informational problems. Furthermore, he named the tolerated protest as "loyalist protests" and any protests out of the boundaries of "Loyalist protests" can be treated harshly (Lorentzen, 2013). What's more, during the reform period, the communist party has been mindful of the need to extend certain rights and liberties to the people after all, this makes it easier to rule, because individuals are more likely to comply with government policies if they feel they have a say (Dimitrov, 2008). To conclude, instead of muting the public and pretending deaf, the authoritarian government could let go and even make use of certain criticism and protests.

### ***2.3 Existing weibo studies***

There are many studies focusing on China's experience in controlling social network. Current pieces can be categorized into the following two fields: China's internet censorship and astroturfing.

Many scholars have observed that those sensitive and seditious words are most likely to be censored. Authoritarian states will likely respond to the challenges from social network with a

variety of reactive measures: restricting Internet access, filtering content, monitoring online behavior, or even prohibiting Internet use entirely.(Shanthi, and Taylor, 2001). Scholars also found that the online censorship apparatus allows criticism of the regime, its officials, and their policies but stops discussions that can generate collective action on the ground (King, Pan and Roberts, 2013, 2014).

Astroturfing is the other most studied suspicious activity. Academics have indicated that between 250,000 and 300,000 paid 50c party members write pseudonymous posts as directed by the Chinese government (Freedom House, 2009; Barr, 2012; Greitens, 2013). In King's newest study, cheerleading in directed 50c bursts is one way the government distracts the public, although this activity can be also be used to distract from other events, general negativity, specific grievances, etc (King, Pan and Roberts, 2016). There are also numerous studies showing the good of astrouturfing in terms of distracting people. Distraction had the advantage of reducing anger compared to ruminating on the same issue( Denson, Moulds and Grisham, 2012). Since censorship alone seems to anger people (Roberts, 2015), the 50c astroturfing program has the additional advantage of enabling the government to actively control opinion without having to censor as much as they might otherwise (King, Pan and Roberts, 2016).

In general, their studies focus on the two major means in manipulating social media: censorship and astroturfing. However, the subject who is using these two strategies remain to be clarified. Every province, city and even county could apply these means to control public opinions related to their regions. From province to province, their emphasis on the content of censorship and astroturfing can be various. The "50 cents party" and censorship apparatuses they depict are mostly speaking for China as a whole and central CCP. However, what are they like in a more

micro-level, such as provincial level? This paper will explore this question and try to fill the gap in this field.

### **III. Method and Theory**

We select Sina Weibo because it is the most widely used social media site and we are able to obtain access in the manner we need. There are also other microblogs in China such as Tencent and Renmin which are relatively new and have less users compared with Sina microblog. In addition, 86% of government microblogs in China were registered in Sina Weibo (Qinghua, 2014).

For further study, we select provincial weibos as study objects. The provincial weibo is the connecting link between the central government weibo and the city weibo. On the one hand, it needs to deliver the commands, orders, or instructions of its superior. On the other hand, it needs to interact with its lower tiers of governments and even the grass roots. The other practical reason is that municipal weibos (more than 300 accounts) and county weibo (more than 2000 accounts) are too many to study considering the time and means we have. For now the provincial weibo is the only practicable gateway for us to study how local government weibos run.

With the help of “web crawler”, we use the “user ID” from 29 provincial weibos to draw the content of post, the date of the post, the content of comment and the numbers of comments from their newest 5000 weibos. By looking at the number of “comments” and the content of comments, we can tell how the post is discussed among netizens or if it is astroturfed. We will

find the most commented posts (top 10) in every provinces and then make an joint analysis of the posts and comments.

So why do we choose to study the comment? Not everyone has the patience or time to post a new microblog and sometimes they would rather simply comment under the government post to show their attitude. The comment itself can actually be seen as an quasi-post for expressing netizens ideas. In observing the comment, we can gather the opinions and feelings of the mass on a particular issue. Furthermore, hig- comment number can indicate the post attracts a great attention and concern—network crowding (网络围观). Some “Network crowding” can cause pressure and threat to the government since it has the potential to cultivate collective movement. If so, the government may close the comment system or delete comments. However, it’s too simple to say so. Sometimes the government allows network crowding as long as the matter is not serious; sometimes they even hire large number of “fifty cents” to fake network crowding.

As the foundation of this study, this very fact should be noted: How many comments a post can have, what kind of comment can be reserved and what kind of comment will be deleted or banned are all at government’s disposal. The manipulation of the comment can be done by astroturfing, deleting comments and forbidding to comment. Knowing this can help us to explain why some posts get giant number of comments whereas some get a little or even 0. Hence we can furthermore analyze government’s rationality behind “low comment number” and “high comment numbers”.

The reason of high-comment number can be complex. Some of them are spontaneous, i.e. netizens want to participate in the discourse. There is an additional prerequisite for this kind of

spontaneous comments: 1. the government posts related issue which are naturally attractive for the netizens to comment 2. the government allows people to comment 3. the government won't delete comments in large scale. That's the conditions for the spontaneous "high comment number" to exist. The other situation of "high comment number" is astroturfing which is a manipulative activity to build up the momentum for some purpose.

***What we expect to find from this study***

Responsiveness refers to the extent to which officials in the regime adhere to the demands of societal actors. Here, we expect to find the modes of responsiveness to various social various and different demands.

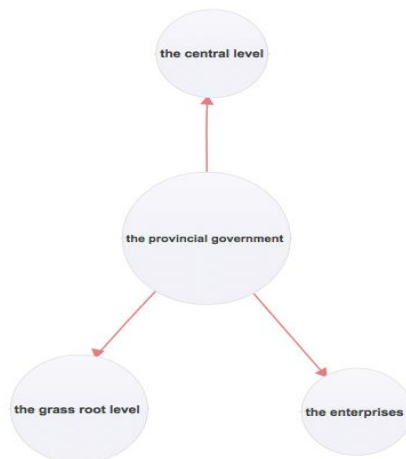


figure 3.1 the responding objects of provincial weibo

There are various demands from different social actors. However, there are not always response to every demand. As a provincial government, it should respond to both upper level—the central government, to show its loyalty ; it should respond to the grassroots people—to clear their doubt and appease their anger; it also responds to the local enterprises' need—help them gain a better development (figure 3.1). The attitude of response can be different depending on whose demand, what kind of demand and how urgent the demand is.

Furthermore, here's the mechanism for the responsiveness in weibo:

**Demand → Responses → Comment → Responses**

**1                    2                    3                    4**

1. The government discovers demand from various social actors
2. The government responds to various demands (or fail to respond sometimes)
3. Social actors give their comments (including suggestions, criticism or praise and so on)
4. Based on the comment, the government responds again and may tinker the policy more or less.

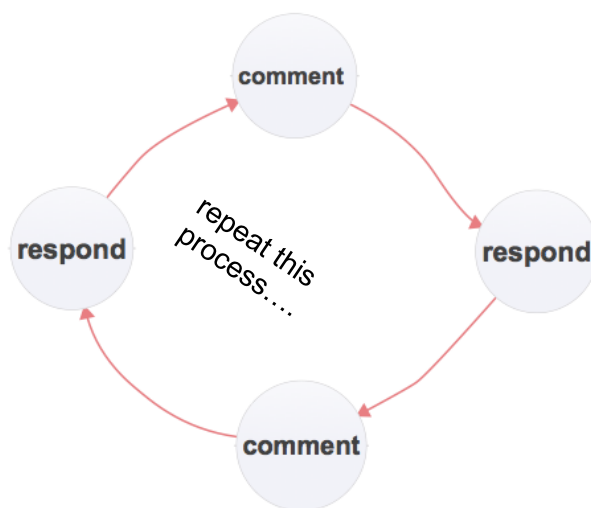

A healthy mode can be seen as above: the government allows netizens to speak and meanwhile the government replies. This ongoing and circulating process can allow the exchange of ideas and negotiation, which is fundamental for democratic deliberation.

Nevertheless we don't expect such healthy mode will completely exist in China for the following two reasons :

First, it's noteworthy that the stage 2, 3 and 4 don't necessarily always exist. When the government fails to respond to the needs initially (or doesn't want to), stage 2,3 and 4 won't exist. When the related social actor doesn't comment, stage 3 and 4 won't exist. When the government doesn't response again to the comment (implying the government has no intention to change the policy), stage 4 doesn't exist.

Overall, the prerequisite for the healthy process of deliberation is to let people speak out their ideas first. Yet we speculate that when the provincial government found the comments become dangerous—potentially elicit collective movement or severely damage the image of the government, it will delete the comments or simply forbid to comment. We will try to identify the dangerous comment in the following study.

Second, the government can also fake a sugar-coating interaction—astroturf in the comment. These comments are not the reflection of public opinion but what the government wants to show its people and superior. We expect to find what information the government wants to astroturf and who's implementing the astroturf.

### ***how we conduct this study***

First, we will make a chart of high-commented posts. Second, by looking at the comments of these posts, we identify various comments—criticism, praise or astroturf or others. Thirdly, we analyze each category of comments and try to find the theoretical implication of them. Last, we will summarize our findings and give a typology of strategies for administering governmental weibos.

This study is faced with two major technical problems. First, we need to find a way to distinguish genuine netizens and “50 cents” by analyzing the content of comments.

From our observation, there’s a pattern for fifty cents party to give comments which can expose their identity : Fifty cents often give repeated comments (figure 3.31, the user repeated replies the same content). Those comments often praise the government in very short sentences, words like as “cheers” or “xx is beautiful” , or just micro-expressions like “flowers” “applaud” or “thumb” (figure 3.32). In addition, the “blue V” can be another source of fifty cents. As government organizations, it’s quite natural to help their peers or superiors look good on weibo. (figure 3.33). However, as genuine netizens won’t comment in such a predictable way: their comments usually are not just simple praising but reasoning; their attitudes are can be various instead of uniformly praising. Comments from real netizens can be long sentences or analysis based on the issue. Sometimes real netizens inquire more information about the posted issue and sometimes they criticize. In a word, the 50 cents only produce “big number” of positive comments but the real netizens care about the issue and express their feelings.

In such a way, we can tell whether the posts are mostly commented by real netizens or “50 cents”. If there are too many “50 cents” users, it means that the post is astroturfed. We speculate that there will be a pattern in the “comment numbers” over similar content posts in

different provinces. There maybe also a provincial difference in different regions in China since their governing policies vary. In the following study, we will try to answer these assumptions.

Second technical problem is how to find out the deleted comments, if there are any. We argue that there's no point only deleting some of the criticisms and leaving the rest of them. The strategy should be either deleting entirely or "zero" deletion of the comments. That's to say, if there are high volume of criticisms, it's very likely that the government doesn't apply deletion to the comments for that post.

Furthermore, we think that forbidding comments is a better way than just simply deleting the negative comments. Since once an incident goes viral on internet, there will be endless negative coming out every few hours or even every few minutes. Forbidding to comment is better way than simple deletion since the government can't easily finish deleting once it starts. It's like what an old Chinese poetry says "the grass cannot be burned out by a prairie fire but grows again with the spring breeze" (野火吹不尽, 吹风吹又生). What's more, deleting comments can also cause "reverse psychology" among netizens since netizens may think the authority must be diffident or else it won't be so eager to eliminate the negative comments. Then these netizens will come back to comment on the post and taunt the authority on the suppression over public opinion. In reality, there are indeed many weibo accounts simply forbidding people to comment due to the above rationale. In the following study, we will further prove this point.

***Limits and difficulties of the study:***

When the government deletes the comments, currently we have no means to find back the comments given our technical limits. This might influence the accuracy of the study. However, as we argued, once the government deletes the post, people will find it more suspicious and

come back to taunt the government on other posts. So simply closing the comments seems to be a more efficient way.

In this case study, we met some problems due to the internet block for accessing weibo out of China. The mass information extraction from weibo can be noticed by Sina and hence the access will be banned. This largely limits our volume of extraction from weibo because the more information extraction, the more risk of banning access. So we are unable to extract all the posts from every provincial account. Even though, we gathered 5000 posts from every provincial weibo account. This should be sufficient for the analysis.

## IV. Findings and analysis

Based the high-commented posts from 29 provincial weibos, we make this content-rich table below (figure 4.1). By observing comments of each post, we colored the cells into four colors.

- 1.Green: positive comment but it's actually astroturfing
- 2.Red: negative comment and it's netizens' genuine comment
- 3.White color: no obvious political attitude towards the government.
- 4.Yellow color: positive comment and it's netizens' genuine comment.

One thing to note is that the above colors means the comments are dominantly astroturfing, criticism, praise or no political attitude. The aggregate comments are usually mixture of several above categories in practice. For perceptual intuition and the convenience of the study, we only use single color to depict the post.

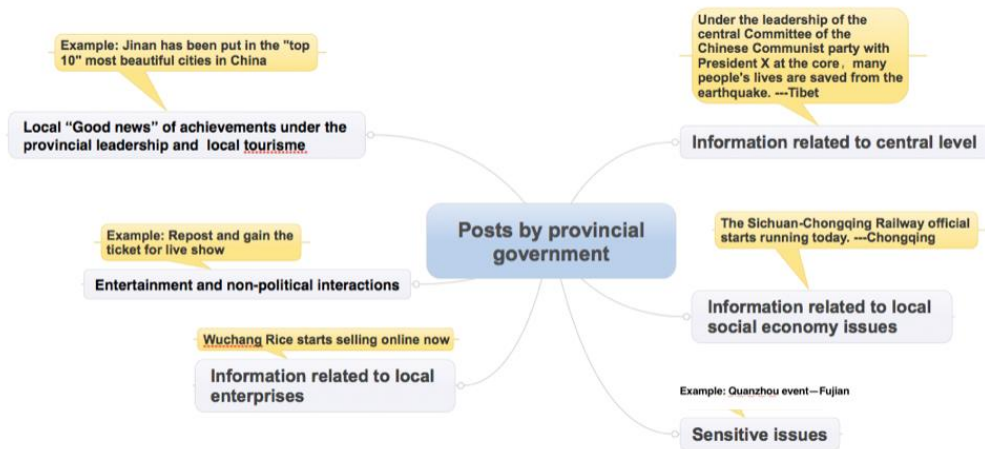


figure 4.2 topic tree of posts by provincial government

### ***analysis of strategies***

By collecting the high-commented posts and analyzing the comments, we made the table 4.1.

The green and yellow zones represent that positive comments are dominating but the green zones are the products of astroturfing activities. The red zones represent criticisms. The white zones represent non-political attitudes in the comments. In the following parts, we will give a detailed description and analysis of each colored zone.

#### **A. green zones—astroturf**

81 astroturf activities (total number is 290) are found in this study. Since weibo is seen as a tool to respond to the demands of various social actors, we categorized them into 3 subtypes: 1. to the central government 2. to the enterprises 3. to the provincial government itself. To each subject, the provincial government applies astroturf out of diverse motives.

##### **1. astroturf for the central government**

We found some patterns from table 4.1: if the name of Xi Jinping (the general secretary of CCP) is mentioned in the post, it's very likely that post will be astroturfed. The top leader of CCP in every generation has his own theory —Deng Xiaoping's "seek truth from facts", Jiang Zemin's "three represents theory" and Hu Jintao's "scientific development concept". Xi Jinping is developing his systematic "China dream" theory. These theories can be seen as the "bible" of the party in the respective stage. Although the provincial weibos' propaganda of China dream can be interpreted as flattery to some degree, we argue that more importantly these posts and astroturfings can have significance in politics. Groveling serves as a useful technology through which followers can credibly signal their loyalty to their patron, and the patron can gain useful knowledge of his or her support base even before a serious challenge (Shih, Victor, 2008). Especially Xi now is firmly in power after ruling out some political enemies, this kind of "groveling and flattery" signal seem to be more imperative, since no one wants to be like in the other team. By speaking highly of Xi's words and deeds, the provincial leaders show their loyalty to Xi.

In policy areas, the provincial should be conscientiously in line with the central CCP as well. The policy in China is delivered from top to bottom: the central level gives policy instructions to every

provinces, then the provinces study the policy, combine it with the provincial realities and then apply the policies. The provincial government can't go against the spirit of the central government. A common example is that every provincial TV channel broadcasts CCTV (China Central Television) News every day at 7:00. This a traditional and tacit routine kept in China since the day CCTV was founded, except when Chen Liangyu was the party secretary of Shanghai. It's said that Chen's disloyalty to the central government led him into prison in the end.

So it's necessary to propagate what the central government says and implement what the central government instructs. In the top commented posts, we found many of them specifically states: according to Xi Jinping's instructions or according to the instruction of Party Central Committee.... As for comments, the comments are full of astroturfings without surprise.

When the provincial government astroturfs for ethnic harmony and national unity, we argue this kind of astroturfing is also a signal to the central government that the provincial leaders have the ability to keep their turf stable and well-administered. In ancient times, the emperors send senior general to safeguard the frontier and ethnical unity. Those who can accomplish this mission well can be appreciated by the emperor. Although as time goes by, there's no emperor in China

anymore, but the centralized bureaucratic system hasn't changed. The central government has the same expectation of the provincial leaders, especially Xinjiang and Tibet, which are both frontier and ethnic minority autonomous provinces.

China has 5 provincial autonomous regions established for minorities: Tibet autonomous region, Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region, Inner Mongolian Autonomous Region, Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region, Ningxia Hui Autonomous Region. We are unable to collect the data of Guangxi since it doesn't have one. In the rest of 4 autonomous regions, we found Tibet and Xinjiang are mostly “green areas” (astroturfing) in the chart, intensely astroturfing for patriotism and ethnical unity as its outstanding feature. Notably Tibet and Xinjiang has no “red zones” (criticism) in the high commented posts. This is very suspiciously sugar-coating harmony since both provinces have relatively rampant ethnic separatism. The truth might not be as beautiful as those comments present—either singing praises for the central government or the ethnical unity.

Although Inner Mongolia has 10 “green zones”, its emphasis of astroturfing is mainly on local concerns—local economy and tourism. However, as an even shaper contrast, Ningxia has 6 red zones out of 10 most-commented posts, mainly because of the extra-mark policy. This policy allows Hui students to have bonus marks in the college entrance examination which caused dissatisfaction among Han<sup>5</sup> people. Again, this doesn't mean that the conflict between Hui and Han are more serious than that in Tibet and Xinjiang. We argue it's precisely because Ningxia has less ethnical conflicts and less worry of split that the Ningxia government can tolerate the following extremely disrespectful comments (figure 4.33).

9. Extra mark should have good reason, such as a low IQ.

Although Hui is seen as a minority, it had already been sinicized to a great extent. Hui has almost the same appearance with Han. The majority of Hui speak Mandarin and have very similar life styles with Han except that they keep some Muslim traditions. Second, Ningxia is not a frontier province either. These two conditions which Xinjiang and Tibet lack, together make ethnic conflicts and split less a concern in Ningxia. So even extreme comments can be left there because of very little potential danger.

## 2 astroturfing for the provincial government itself

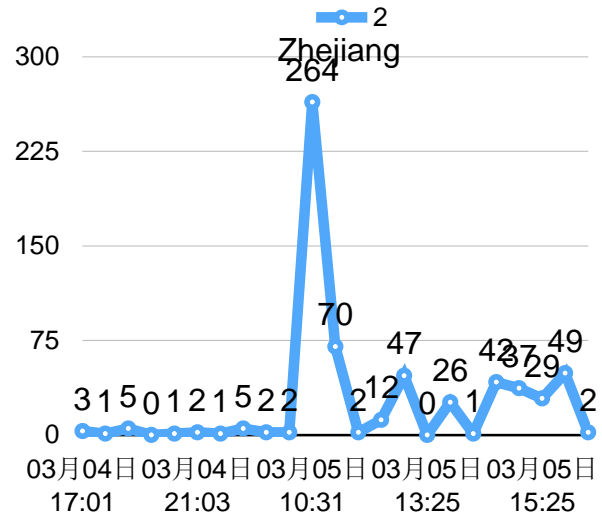
We found such a pattern in the chart: when the theme of the post are related to “economic project” “ environmental project” and “provincial meeting”, the post is very likely to be

astroturfed. Here we use Zhejiang’s top-astroturfed post as a case to study the rationale behind this.

The Five River Project is the key project of Zhejiang. It's people's beloved benevolent project. It's a project pushing the industry to upgrade. According to the statistics, more than 96 of Zhejiang people support this project. Many people say: our beautiful and clean hometown is coming back.

From this line chart, we found the corresponding high-commented posts (in the above chart, 264, 70, 49, 47 can be seen as high number of comments) have three characteristics:

1. They are all astroturfed.
2. Their content is all about the success of provincial environmental project.
3. The time of these high-commented posts is around March 5th, which is the exact date when national “two meetings<sup>6</sup>” started.

We found the following news can provide a possible explanation for the above characteristics:

“Before the opening of national two meetings, Zhejiang government praised the “advanced typical examples” in “Five River” environment-friendly project. The government also comes up

with new planning and requirement for the project. The project is opening a new chapter<sup>7</sup>. The national “two meeting” is a venue for every province to summarize the achievement and for provincial leaders to show their governing ability to the top CCP leaders. This chance shouldn't be spoiled by any “negative event” (like Liaoning Flag Issue as well in the later session) and should be lightened up by some great achievements. Hence, we argue the provincial weibo can astroturf for the its own achievements because the government wants to claim credit for its governance. This kind of self-boasting activity can also be seen everywhere on provincial newspapers and TV as well. It's also possible that even though it's not the provincial leaders intention to apply such explicit astroturfing, the provincial propaganda office uses such flattering move to show its loyalty, the same logic with why the provincial government astroturfs for the central level.

### 3. astroturfing and advertising for the local enterprises

China's Wuchang rice is extremely popular due to its fragrant smell and good taste. With the demand for Wuchang rice so high, some companies start to exploit the opportunity and create

fake rice using the brand of Wuchang while they sell for the same high price. This was reported by CCTV and became a sensational news at the point. As a result, the sales volume of real “Wuchang” goes down and those real “Wuchang” branded rice companies can’t survive.

The number of registered wuchang rice companies is 292 which can create thousands of jobs and a considerable contribution to local economy. It’s necessary to keep them prosper for local employment, stability and government tax revenues. When these enterprises are dying for help, the government responds and supports them by posting advertisement and astroturf for them on weibo. Even though these astroturfings are full of flaws (lots of “copy and paste” comments), it’s still an effort to help local enterprises.

As the direct administer of provincial weibo, the internet propaganda office is faced with some financial challenges. Except for the funds allocated by government, how to increase the founds of the propaganda in other channel? Officers there may also want to increase their “grey income” as well. Astroturfing for the enterprises can be a solution to these problems. As some insiders disclose, a weibo account with 100 thousands followers can earn 200-500 yuan by posting an advertisement and can earn at least a thousand yuan if it has a million followers<sup>8</sup>. Normally a provincial weibo can have millions of followers and this can bring them thousands of yuan by posting an advertisement. Increasing revenue provides a possible explanation for provincial weibos’ engagement in astroturfing for enterprises.

### ***Who astroturf for the provincial weibos:***

Based on the comments we collect in the astroturfing posts, we are able to find out who's the "astroturfers", or the so called "fifty cents" for provincial weibo. We still use "Zhejiang's Five River" case as a sample for analysis.

In the finding, most comments of astroturf are made by the "blue V" like this  (figure 4.36). Blue V is a symbol only authorized to governmental and public institutions. Basically governmental departments, public institutions, the Communist Youth Leagues in municipal level, county level and subdistrict level have participated in astroturfing the post. In this way, hundreds of comments are produced without extra expenses on hiring "50 cents" army. And for these sub-provincial governmental department or quasi-subordinates such as school and museum, it's part of their duty to comply with the provincial government's order to popularize this post. Meanwhile, they repost as well which makes the original post spread in a wider range. This is consistent with Gary King's finding: although the scholarly literature describes 50c party members as ordinary citizens hired for very low wages, we found instead that almost all in our sample are government employees (King, Pan and Roberts, 2016).

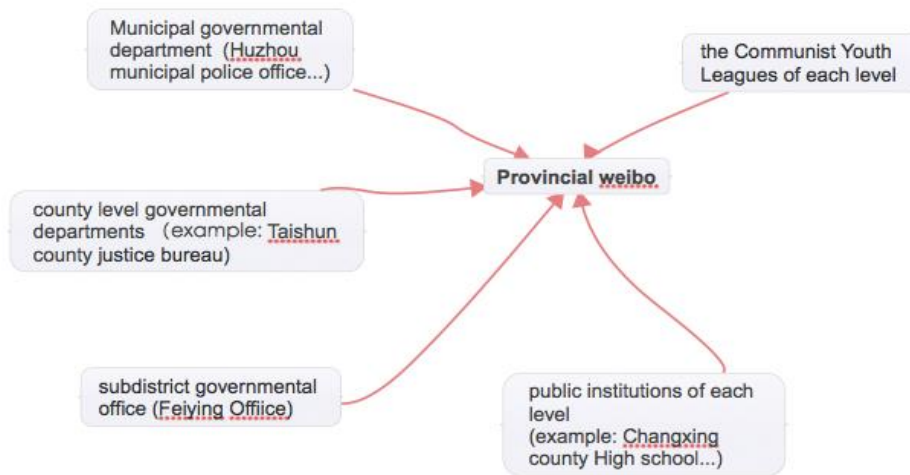


figure 4.37 : who astroturfs for provincial weibo in the case of Zhejiang’s “Five River” environment-friendly project

However ,these “cameo appearances” are usually very poor work. These voluntary commentators have no incentive to do a good job. All they want to do is to finish the astroturf quota distributed by their superior. As a result, netizens can easily tell these comments are astroturfing, since it’s just “copy and paste” “multiple comments by the same user” or all commented by “blue V”. Instead of being popular online, the content of astroturf might end up with being detested by netizens.

While the provincial weibo represents the image of provincial government, as the direct administrator, the internet propaganda office has its own interests and realities as well: how to finish the task without spending too much considering the budget limit? Having these “voluntary” astroturfers to do the job can save a considerable amount of money. According to

the insider's saying, in the "astroturfing market", in the "astroturfing market", each comment can charge 1 yuan. That's to say, according to our data, usually the government wants to have hundreds of comment or even more for astroturf, which cost hundreds of yuan or more<sup>9</sup>. From this point of view, using government employees as astroturfers is a economically rational choice.

### ***Red areas***

The red areas represent where comments are mostly criticisms and protests. Then some readers may ask such a question: in authoritarian state like China, is the government so open-minded and confident to take all the criticism and what the government will do when online protestants can threaten the regime?

To answer the question, usually people will observe whether the comment is censored—if the authority found the comment very improper or threatening, it will remove the comment.

However, we argue this is not the usual way used in provincial weibos. Usually they just close the comment system when they find certain content is too sensitive to comment. As for the already-existed criticisms, they just leave them there. The new posts will soon cover the old ones in people's eyesight. Unless netizens go back to the previous highly-criticized posts in the long ago, they won't find anything embarrassing the government at the homepage of provincial weibo. After the comment system is closed, the comment number is often very low. It could often be 0, or other low number (2 or 3, for example). Sometimes astroturfers can help to

improve the comment number. This thought is inspired by the scandal of Chinese Red Cross<sup>10</sup>. When the scandal is revealed, a single post of Chinese Red Cross attracts more than 200 thousands comments in a short period. However, after a while, the comment number of the following posts become 0 or low number since Chinese Red Cross very likely forbids the comment system.

Yet the 200 thousands comments are not deleted, which are mostly harsh criticisms. The reasons are two fold: First, as we talked above, deletion of posts can only make the netizens more resentful. Second, the central government criticizes the deletion of comments. People's Daily reprimanded the Ministry of Culture for deleting netizens' comments<sup>11</sup>. We argue that the comment is a information channel for the central government to know the opinions of grassroots and the performance of its subordinates. We will further explain this later.

At the point we gathering the data, we found that Liaoning, Chongqing, Fujian and Zhejiang forbade to comment. But now Chongqing weibo is open to comment again. That is to say, in practice provincial weibos could temporarily forbid to comment for certain reasons.

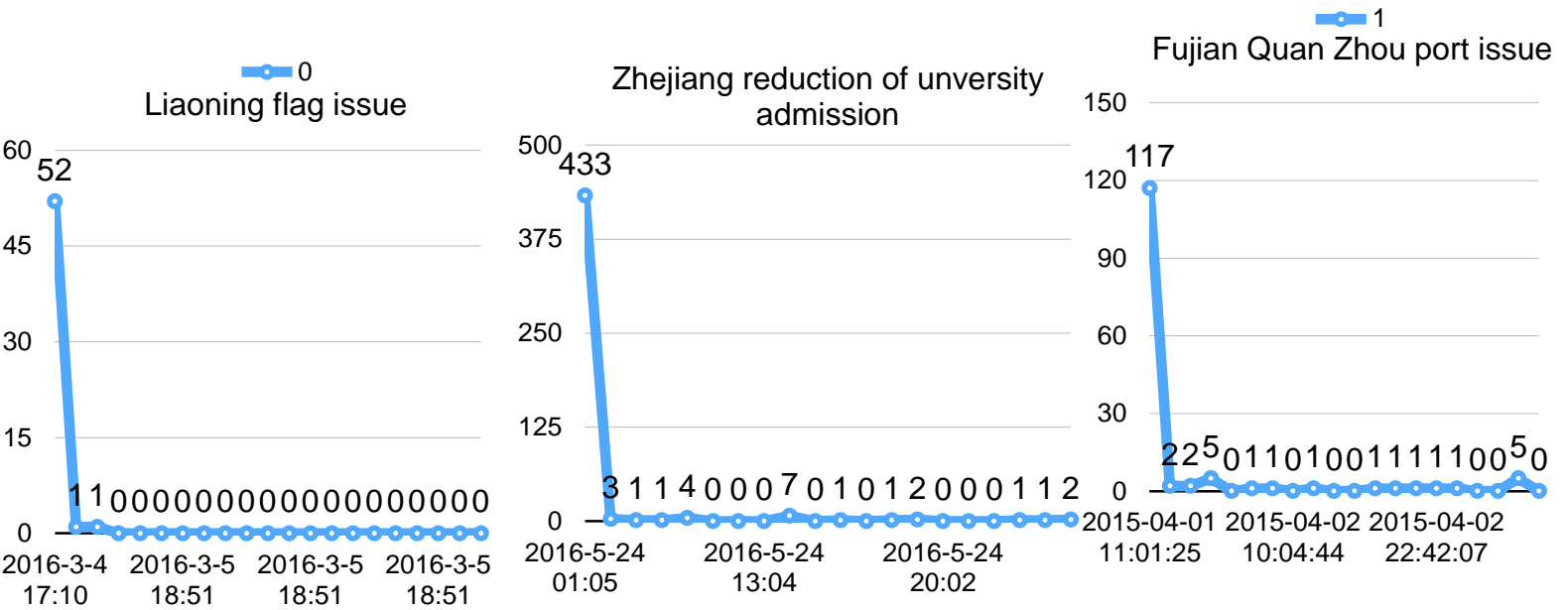

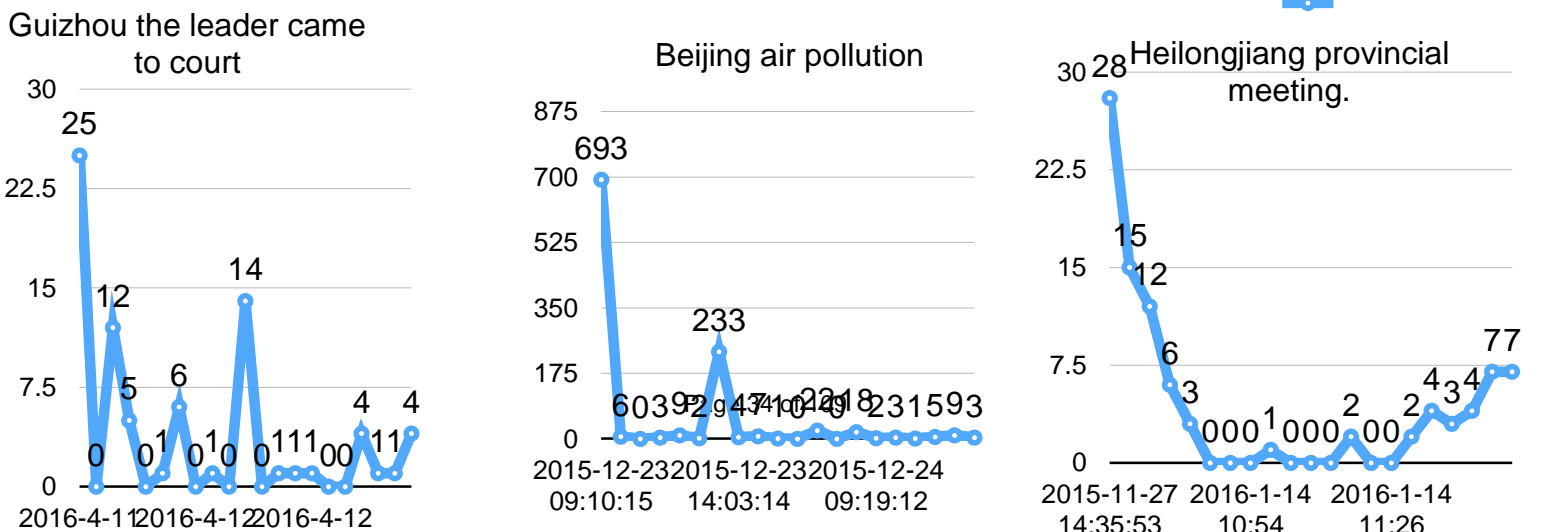
### type A and type B in comment numbers

By identifying the time of “highest commented posts” of red zone, we made line charts of the most recent twenty posts’ comment numbers in the aftermath of the highest-commented post (X axis shows the timeline, Y axis shows the comment numbers) In this way, we found two types of event:

1. 3 type A events, with a sudden drop in comment numbers
2. 26 type B events, with fluctuations in comment numbers (see Appendix B for more charts)

We think that the government will take measures when it thinks necessary to prevent collective movement possibly brought about by weibo. To under this is kind of tricky: a sudden drop of “comment numbers” in the aftermath of the “high commented” events is exactly the symbol of control over the comment.

We argue that it’s abnormal to have such “sudden drops” in the comment numbers:

1. Usually people’s attention can be attracted by the “hot issue” for quite a while. Their passion to discuss, criticize and inquire shouldn’t disappear all of sudden. Hence, it’s normal to see a transitional decay of the comment number
2. Usually a provincial weibo has more than millions of followers, which means “0, 1 or 2 comments” (as what type A looks like) for continuously twenty posts is unusual while normally there should be ups and downs in the line charts of “comment number” (just like type B)

## **1. nationalism against Taiwan flag in Liaoning**

The first type A issue is Taiwan flag issue. In the beginning of March, 2016, Taiwan’s “national flag” beside the South Korea’s national flag on the banner in Liaoning goes viral online (figure 4.43). This infuriates netizens and they harshly criticizes Liaoning government (figure 4.44).

In this event, nationalism can become a dangerous actor. First, nationalist activity not controlled by the regime can backfire and turn into anti-regime protests and thus undermine government legitimacy rather than bolster it. second, while externally oriented nationalism can be the glue that keeps people together and ensures greater regime support (Dimitrov, 2008), it can easily degenerate into anti-Taiwan nationalism, which finally does no good to the cause of peaceful reunification.

As a very similar case in recent years, there are frequent protests against Japan breaking out in major cities like Xi’an, Chengdu, Chongqing, Wuhan and so on. However, these protests are all finally stopped by local authorities. In these protests, irrational people boycott Japanese products, burn Japanese flag, break Japanese-brand cars like Toyota and break in restaurants with Japanese names such as Ajisen Ramen and Yoshinoya. These activities will cause adverse impacts on local economy and people’s property.

In addition, these protests could potentially damage CCP’s legitimate foundation, one of which is nationalism. The protesters want the government to take a more aggressive stance against

Japan which goes far beyond CCP's diplomatic maneuvers. In the eyes of these angry and aggressive people, being soft could mean CCP's incompetence as the ruling party.

Taiwan Issue is in the same situation. In general, cross-straits relations tend to be easing these years. The central government doesn't push Taiwan hard on returning back. Both sides admit the ambiguous words "one China" but don't clarify who's going to rule China. This kind of ambiguity is seen as best alternative for now, because clarification of such words could harm the feeling of either side which is bad for consensus. The flag issue could make netizens desperately claim mainland's sovereignty to Taiwan. This will eventually break this subtle balance, infuriating and pushing away Taiwanese. Hence, this issue needs to be controlled for the sake of big picture.

Meanwhile, it's also noteworthy that the "two meetings" were being held at the same time. The provincial "two meeting" is under the spotlight of media and both the grassroots level and central level are watching closely. At this point, any mistakes could be amplified and therefore threaten the political career of provincial leaders.

We also found that weibo of Liaoning intensely posts unrelated microblogs. The intention is very likely to distract people's attention from the hot issue. Liaoning weibo posts more than 200 microblogs in the day of flag event broke out—2016.3.5, which is much more frequent than usual.

## **2. fight against injustice of education in Zhejiang**

The second type A post is the Zhejiang education department's reply to Zhejiang parents' and students' concern on the reduction in admission quota (quota event, in short). In 2015.4.25, the

ministry of education of China issued a document: <plans for admissions in higher education>. According to this document, Zhejiang, Jiang Su and Hubei will send out 1600 thousands quota of high education admission to western provinces<sup>12</sup>. Under the new scheme, leading universities across the country must admit a greater number of non-local students, which the parents fear will make it more difficult for their children to find a place at schools close to home<sup>13</sup>. Fear of collective movement is the reason for forbidding comment in the aftermath of quota event. In other provinces related to the event, collective movements have already broken out. Thousands of parents staged demonstrations in the capital cities of Hubei and Jiangsu provinces, protesting over the same issue. Given this lesson, Zhejiang government should take harsh measures on the online comment which are very inflammatory. In a later part of this section, we will analyze the potential effect of these comments in detail.

### **3. collective anger of Quanzhou in Fujian**

The third type A event is Quanzhou event. Disputes broke among Chinese netizens due to a governmental decision to change the name of Quanzhou port, a world famous seaport located in Fujian province, southeastern China, Xinhua reports<sup>14</sup>. Netizens from Quanzhou blame the government for not respecting the history and trying to be partial to Meizhou. These netizens also think that the corruption in provincial government is incurable, which is a shame for Fujian.

This controversy gradually became a nationwide concern: influential newspaper and magazines report this issue and they clearly support Quanzhou people; Netizens in weibo and other social media also speak for Quanzhou as well. However, netizens soon found the criticisms on the mainstream social-networking site was deleted. The insiders said Quanzhou government ordered a ban on discussion of Quanzhou event to the public sectors. Then after that, the provincial government blocked the themes related to Quanzhou event. The intention is to stop this online issue from escalating into a street protest.

The content of the original post is not related to Quanzhou issue, but the posted time is April 1st which the issue is under heat discussion. This is different from what we speculate in the beginning: when the government doesn't respond to hot issue, it will cut off the the following procedure of 2,3 and 4. Even though Fujian government didn't show any attitude on weibo about the Quanzhou event, it was still denounced under the unrelated post. Then again, when the comment number is rising rapidly under this post, the provincial weibo decides to forbid comment, as we observed in the line chart in figure 4.1.

#### 4. analysis of the comments in Type A

The typical comments in Type A can be described as extremely harsh, insulting and instigating. The image of the government is being harmed indeed but a more serious danger is these comments can encourage netizens to take extreme actions in real life. This can be explained by **informational cascade** and **group polarization**.

An **informational cascade** occurs when a person observes the actions of others and then – despite possible contradictions in his/her own private information signals – engages in the same acts. A cascade develops, then, when people "abandon their own information in favor of inferences based on earlier people's actions" (Easley, David, 2010). Based on this theory, netizens can change their judgement based on previous comments by other netizens. When most comments a netizen read are condemning the government, the netizen is very likely to reach the conclusion: the government is useless, corrupt and evil.

In social psychology, **group polarization** refers to the tendency for a group to make decisions that are more extreme than the initial inclination of its members. These more extreme decisions are towards greater risk if individuals' initial tendencies are to be risky. The internet is not only a media tool but also a locale for people to share emotions. When only a few netizens think extremely, they may not dare to act extremely. However, if they see there are lots of people thinking the same with them, they can take bold actions more easily since they have a collective appeal and collective identity against the government. When the netizens have the collective identity "we" against "they"—the government officials, it makes them think they are not fighting alone and they have allies to back up each other. There's an idiom in China: "no punishment if everybody does it" (法不责众). In the collective movement, people also think "I'm only one of thousands of people who protest. They can't easily arrest thousands of people. I should be safe too." Having seen the previous anti-government comments, people can think it's OK to speak and act extremely beforehand since he's not the only one doing it.

To sum up, the "comment system" amplifies the risk of collective movement. Extreme comments could influence the neutral netizens and make them anti-government. It also gives people signal that they are not alone so people dare to take bold actions. Therefore, the government needs to close the comment before more netizens are getting extreme.

## Type B issue

The government has tolerance to certain issues and let people comment as they want, even sometimes the critics are harsh, irrational and disgraceful. The government will keep the criticism there even they overwhelm the positive comments. Government policies sometimes look as bad, and leaders can be as embarrassed, as is often the case with elected politicians in democratic countries, but, as they seem to recognize, looking bad does not threaten their hold on power so long as they manage to eliminate discussions associated with events that have collective action potential(King, Pan and Roberts, 2013).

## the utility of criticism

“Chongqing Railway opens” is one of the Type B issues. This post sounds like good news for those who travel a lot from Sichuan to Chongqing. However, the comments are overwhelmingly negative. Some critics complain that the ticket is too expensive considering it only saves two hours. Some complain there are so few stops that the train doesn’t stop by their destination at all.

These comments are all tolerated by the Chongqing government. It’s noteworthy that these complaints and criticisms are neither politically sensitive nor inflammatory for people to start

collective movement. As scholars summarized, citizens criticize the regime without collective action on the ground in many ways, including even via (unsubstantiated) threats of protest and viral bursts of online-only activity — all which do not have collective action potential by this definition and so are ignored by the government. (King, Pan and Roberts, 2013).

In addition, these criticisms have two utilities: First, although these comments blame the government for its unsatisfying performance, they also provide valuable feedbacks for the government to improve its work. Second, these feedbacks are useful for the higher-level government in judging the performance of (as well as keeping or replacing) local leaders and ameliorating other information problems faced by higher-level authorities (Dimitrov, 2014a,b,c; Wintrobe, 1998). As such, avoiding any artificial change in that balance — such as from astroturf or censorship — can be valuable.

### online petition in the comments

Online petition is also observed, as the Heilongjiang's case shows. Under the post of “two meeting of Heilongjiang”, we found lots of netizens came to report local corruption (in municipal level, county level and even town level). In China, there's a tradition of “skip-level petition”. When people found their interests is hurt by the local government, they sometimes can't get an ideal compensation or even an apology. After failure of negotiation with basic-level government, the grass-root citizens will go to the higher level— provincial government (or sometimes the central level, if the provincial government fails them) to complain their sufferings, wishing the provincial government could uphold justice for them.

For CCP as a whole, instead of regarding this activity as dangerous, the provincial CCP should even be happy about these skip-level petitions. Although people lose hope on the basic level, they still trust the provincial government. They don't negate CCP's overall legitimacy but place the hope of justice on the high-level government.

What's more, in an authoritarian regime, high level government usually lacks of accurate information about citizens' preferences and complaints. This will result in a widespread discontent which precisely can escalate small-scale protests into spread like a "prairie fire". While the basic level government can cover their problems very well by detaining the petitioners in real life, it's very hard to do so online. Hence there's a saying "reporting on the internet is better than petition in person" (上访不如上网). Weibo solved the information asymmetry to some degree. For the above reasons, the provincial government have no needs to delete or prohibit such online "whistle-blowing". On the contrary, they should be happy to see it.

#### **some criticisms reflect the loss of public trust**

In the type B issue, we found even when the government make some progress can incur negative comments as well. For example, it can be seen as a progress of "rule of law" that the

incumbent vice governor of Guizhou province came to the court to answer the query from the public, however, the comments are overwhelmingly negative (figure 4.53). No matter it's a posture or a genuine respect of judicial system, it has the positive significance which should be affirmed. However, in the comments, we only found one-sided criticisms. Almost no one talk about its positive side of this event. Similar cases are everywhere<sup>15</sup>. When the government tries to clarify matters of the vaccine issue<sup>16</sup>, people don't buy it and suspect the government is hiding something, even though the government is telling the truth. When cities win some honors, such as the "cleanest city"—Jinan, netizens laugh about the "gold content" of the honor<sup>17</sup>. When the government issues a new policy to benefit the pregnant, netizens only talk about the bad effects it might bring but ignore the overall good of the policy<sup>18</sup>. No matter what the government does and says, people think it's not good. This is exactly the so called "tacitus trap" —when the government loses public trust, no matter it does good things or bad things, people will deem the government is lying or doing the wrong things.

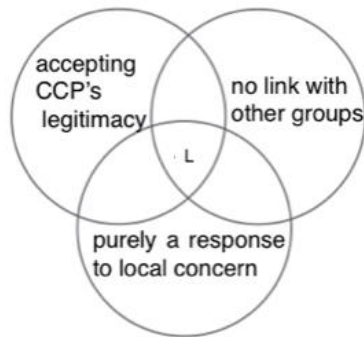

**join analysis of A and B**

In certain ranges, protests and criticism can be tolerated. In Lorentzen’s term, this is called “loyalist protests” which follow strict rules in their demands, their rhetoric, and their actions (Lorentzen, 2013). He found three conditions the loyalist protests usually follow: 1. They use the rhetorical strategy that O’Brien has characterized as “rightful resistance” (O’Brien, 1996),

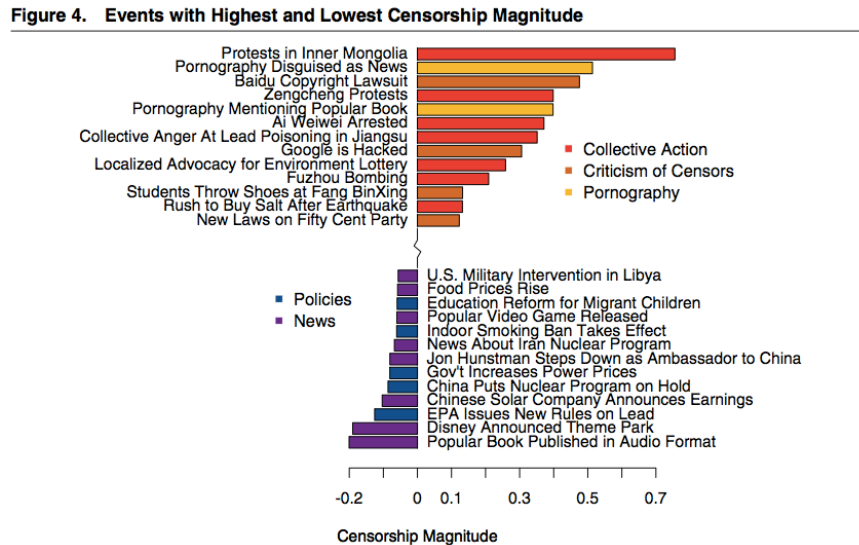

The three events under type A don't fit in areas L and hence were banned to comment after the comments escalated into a more threatening style. The flag issue could potentially harm CCP's legitimacy. The quota event could possibly cause a co-movement with Jiangsu and Hunan, which is not a local issue any more. Anger and outrage pervade Quanzhou. It's not just a matter of a group people anymore but a nationwide concern online. Hence, none of the above events can fall in area L.

When the criticism and protests are type B (or in area L), the government can tolerate them and even make use of the criticisms and online petitions for policy-making and anti-corruption campaign. We argue that type B and type A are not in the same magnitude in terms of severity. Some scholars have founded a similar pattern: censorship magnitude (King, Pan and Roberts,



2013).

In the above censorship magnitude , we found some similar events with our high-commented posts which means the censor magnitude correlates well with our finding. In the high-commented “type B” events, for example, “Disney Park rail station opens ”, “ Government raises oil price” can find their correspondences in the above figure. In our finding, these events have received a heated discussion in its comments below and lots of them are criticisms to the government. This implies a lower censorship magnitude of type B issues. Meantime, type A events like “Quanzhou collective anger at changing name” “collective anger at the reduction in admission quota” and “Netizens’s anger Taiwan flag in Liaoning” are restricted to comment, which are very similar with the above high-censorship magnitude events as well. Both the

magnitude and this paper reveal the pattern: the more danger of collective action, the more likely to be treated harshly; In turn, the less danger of collective action, the more tolerance.

### C. please and entertain netizens

Not all the comments are related with political attitude. People play weibo also for some entertaining purposes as well (Chan et al, 2012). Sometimes netizens spontaneously comment the post because it's interesting or entertaining, or attracting. Based on figure 4.1, we summarize that the following three types of information attract non-political comments most:

#### 1. online awarding event:

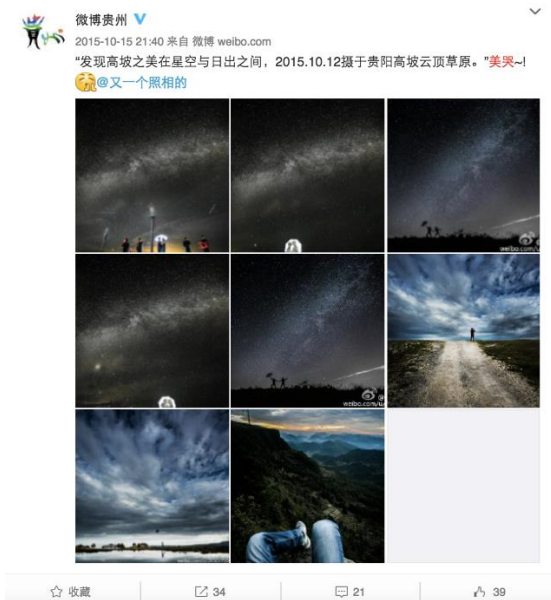

The common good of such posts is that they make the grassroots feel closer to the government, making the government more like a good friend rather than a serious authority. In other words, this kind of “entertaining” posts can help the government please the netizens and hence attract more followers and gain more support. Although not any of these information are related to politics, we argue that it’s exactly non-political nature of such information helps the government reduce some criticisms and protests. In the “red zone” posts, we found the content is often informational—telling people about the political, social and economical news. As a result, informational news can often attract netizens to express their opinions towards the government, since they think it’s the government’s job to inform the people, listen to the people and response to the people in political, social and economical areas. However, when the nature of the posts is entertaining—winning a reward, beautiful tourist attractions and interesting interactions, netizens also show passion to participate in commenting such posts. This kind of passion will squeeze people’s attention on focusing and commenting on the politics-related issues and hence reduce the government’s risk of being exposed under harsh criticism. In general, informational uses of media result is positively related to politically relevant variables, such as social capital and discussion of politics. (Shah D, McLeod JM, Yoon, 2001; Eveland et al, 2005) On the other hand, entertainment uses lead to lower levels of political efficacy, political knowledge, and political participation (Scheufele, 2002; Leung, 2009). In China, there’s an idiom—When one is

having such a good time that he forgets to go home(乐不思蜀. It's the same thing that too much entertaining information could make people forget to participate in political discussion.

## VII. Conclusion

This study is based on the data collected from provincial weibos. By analyzing the most-commented posts, we found these posts and comments are managed in various strategies.

There are four strategies: astroturfing, tolerance to criticism, ban on comments and entertaining the netizens. Each strategy corresponds with a demand from various social actors. Our finding can be concluded in three parts: 1. a typology of responsiveness 2. an overall view of provincial weibo strategies 3. regional characteristics.

### 1 . A typology of responsiveness

Every post can be seen as a response to a demand of a certain social actor. To put these various responses together, we made the following table:

Situations are different from province to province, provinces have their own respective features in their weibo posts and comments. In eastern provincial weibos, the high-comment posts reflect certain post-modern values of citizens. The government response to environmental issues and netizens actively participate in the discussion. The environmental awareness usually emerges when a society has reached a high stage of economic development. The new middle class is the beneficiaries of the economic boom in China. Therefore their demands are primarily about the quality of life (Tong, 2012). For example, Beijing weibo posts “PM 2.5 alert” and Shanghai weibo posts “Disneyland is going to open”. These posts attracts tons of comments. In Guangdong, although it has more astroturfing posts but many of them are mainly astroturfing for local high-tech enterprises which also reflects a higher stage of economic development.

However, in the underdeveloped provinces like Gansu, poverty alleviation is usually a focus of propaganda and astroturfing topic as well. This reflects in these provinces, the society still rests in a lower stage where economy development is still the focus of policy. In provinces which are both frontier and minority-condensed, like Xinjiang, Tibet and Inner Mongolia, “patriotism and ethnical” unity are commonly astroturfed topics. These provincial governments shoulder the responsibility of fighting against the so called three vices: separatism , terrorism, and extremism.

In summary, each province has its own realities which generate different degrees of responding to various demands from citizens, from the central government, from itself and from the enterprises. A issue is more of a concern in this province may not be a problem for another.

Overall ,the number of “red zones” is very close to “green zones” which can serve as the evidence that provincial CCP doesn’t try to manipulate weibo comment completely. Provincial CCP also gives the space for criticism and protests for spurring them to make policy improvements and collecting information as well.

However, the number of “yellow zones” is 8, a poor number compared with that of “red zones”. This reflects that the provincial government overall is not very satisfying to the public. Some posts show the efforts to improve the governance and the achievements provincial governments have made. However, they didn’t get much praise for that. Instead they received taunt and suspect which can be seen as “Tacitus Trap”. To some degree, it exposes public's insufficient trust to the government. The number of “white zones” are almost half of total, implying provincial governments are paying good-sized efforts to make provincial government weibos more friendly. However, we also argue this is a strategy to divert people’s attention from dissatisfaction with government.

### **3. Regional characteristics**

Since most posts in “red zones” are type B (only 3 posts are type A), “red” can be seen as more tolerance to criticism and protests. Similarly, “green zones” reflect the truth the provincial government wants to manipulate the comments for its own good by astroturfing. Hence, more “green” can be seen as more manipulation. ( figure 6.31)

Then we found in general, the eastern China provinces are relatively open to criticism and the western China provinces are more manipulative in weibo administration. For example, in Beijing ,local leaders even directly interact with netizens and listen to their complaints and suggestion for governance; However, in Xinjiang we couldn't see such a broad mind to tolerate or even actively ask for criticisms and suggestion from the public. This analysis concludes that the regional difference of weibo administration is a result of different economic stage, location and ethnic composition.
