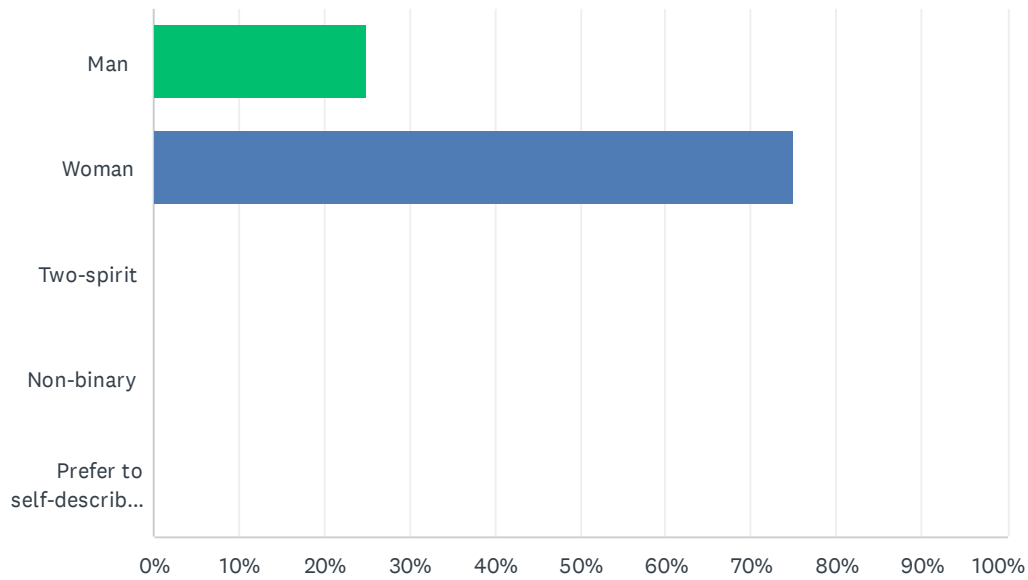

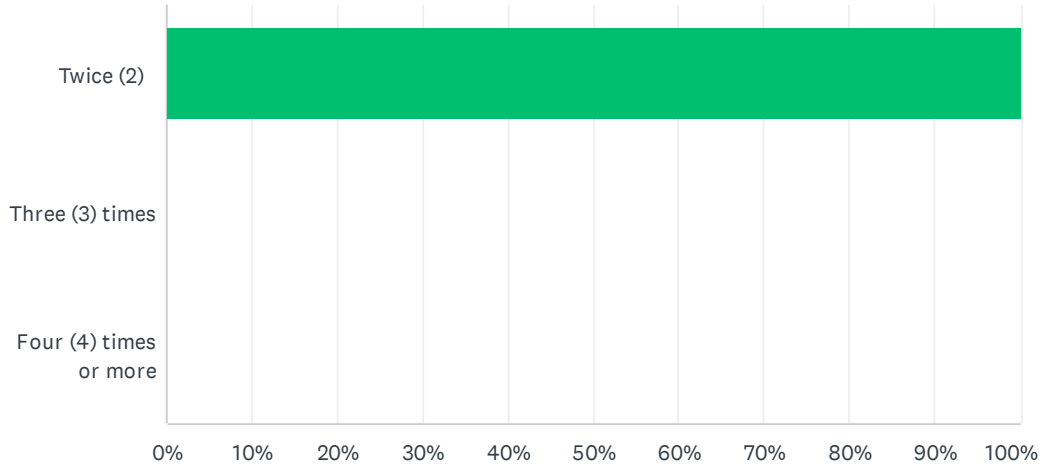

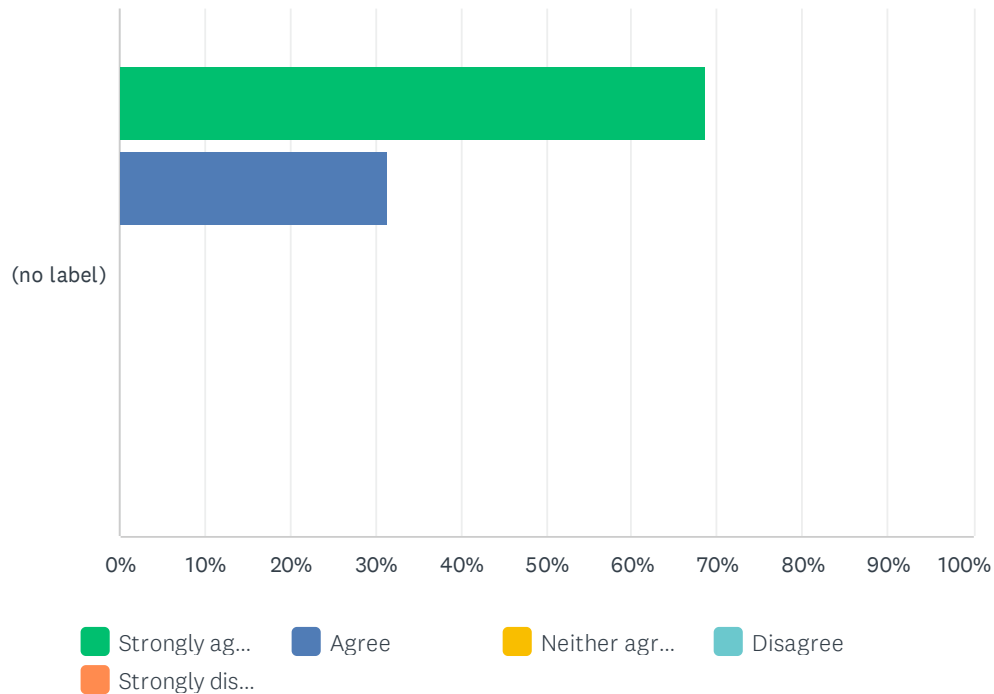

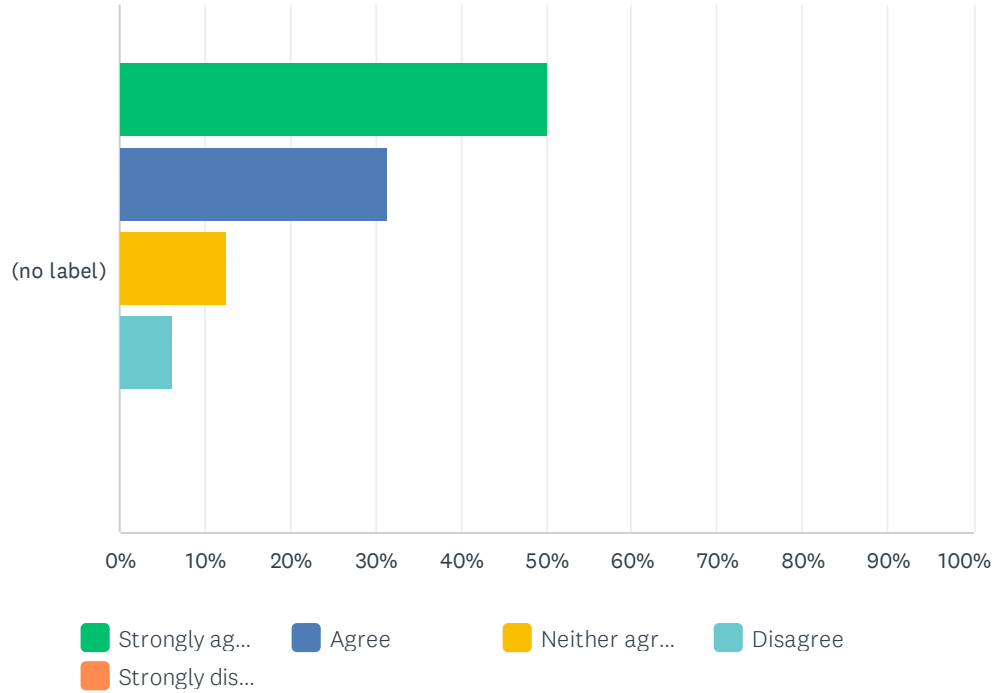

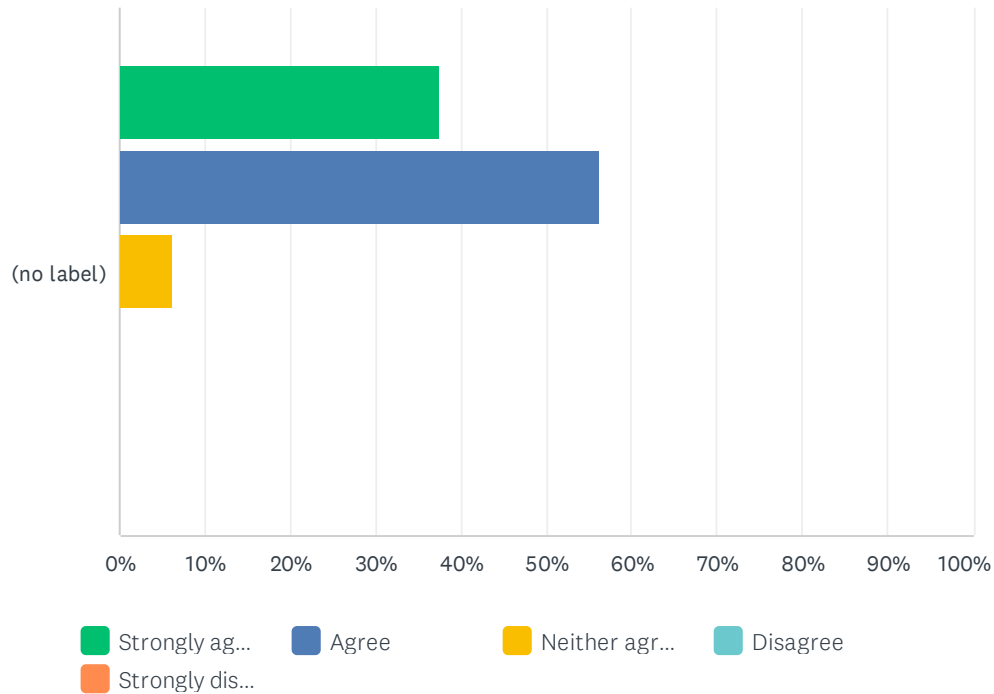

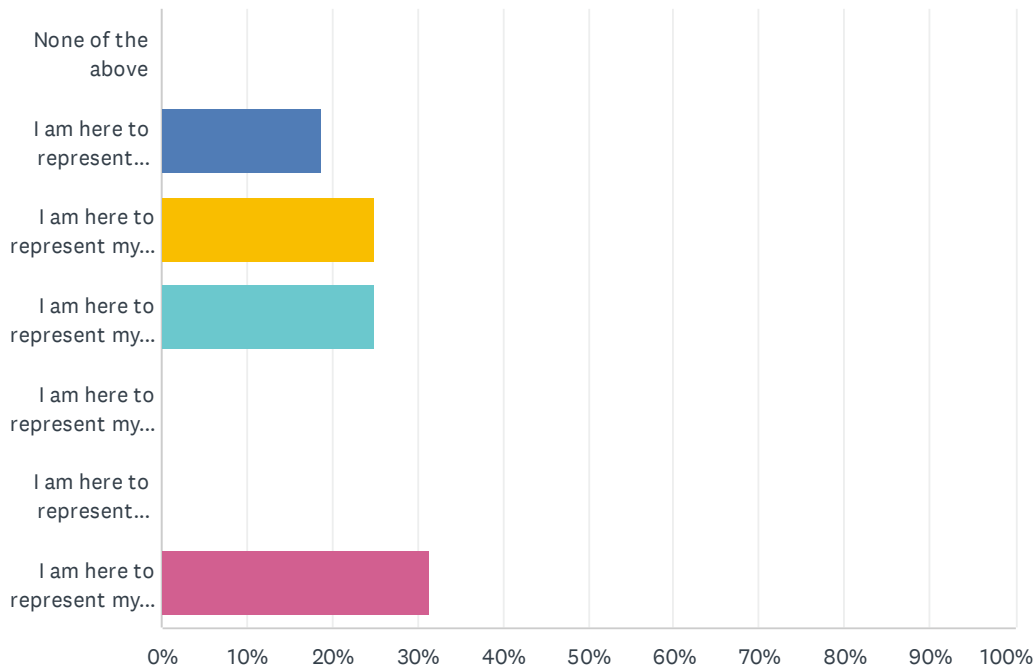

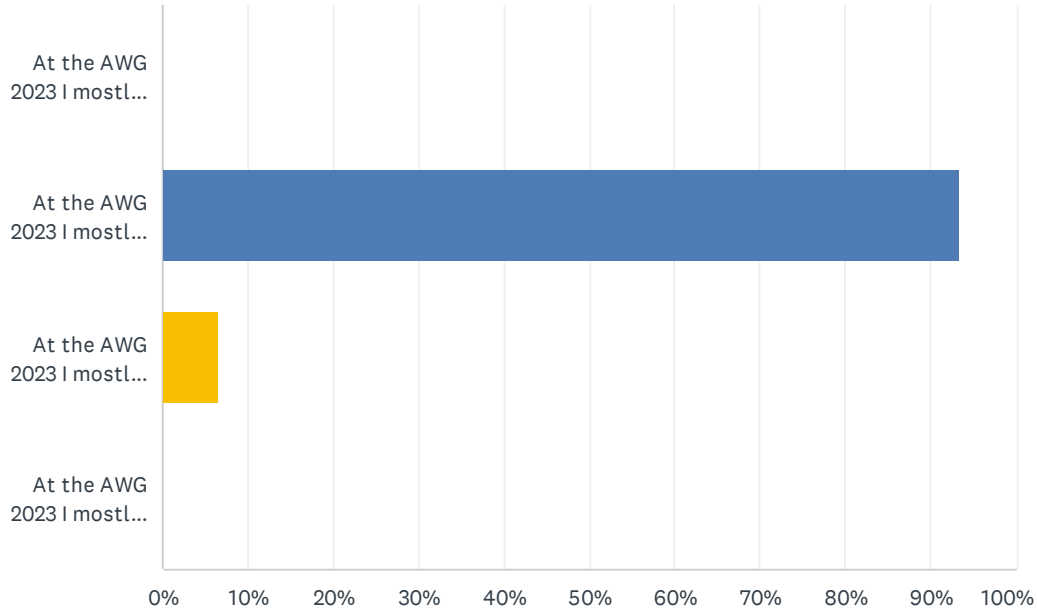

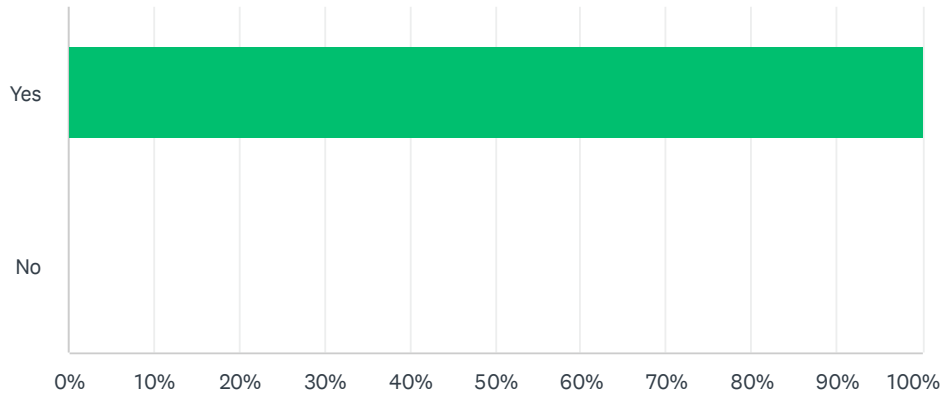

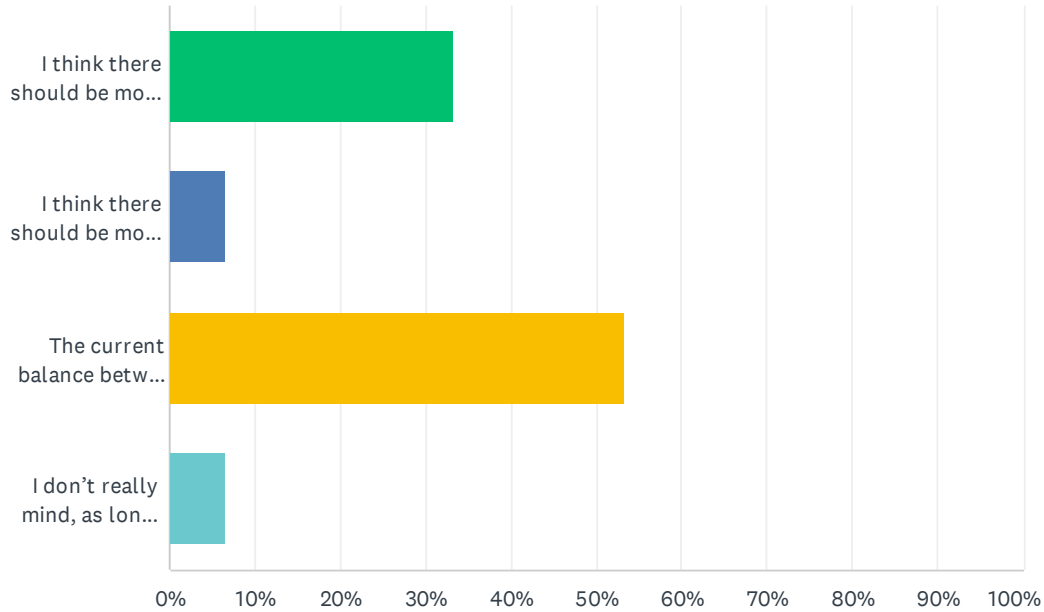

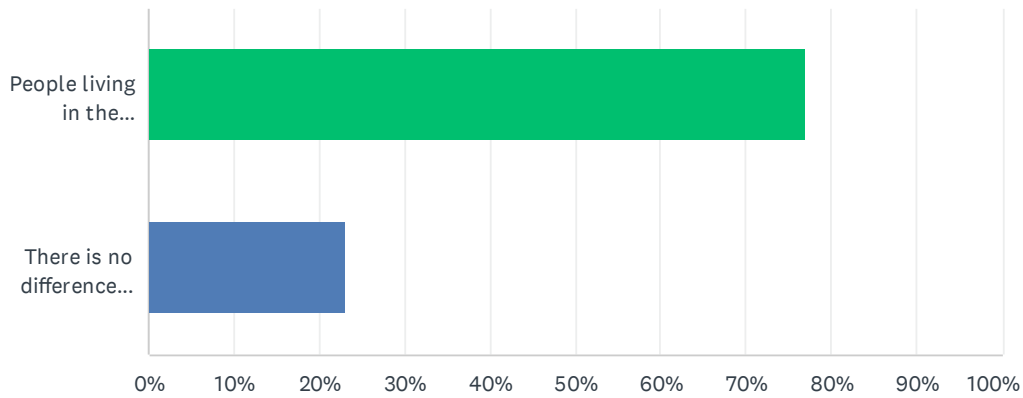

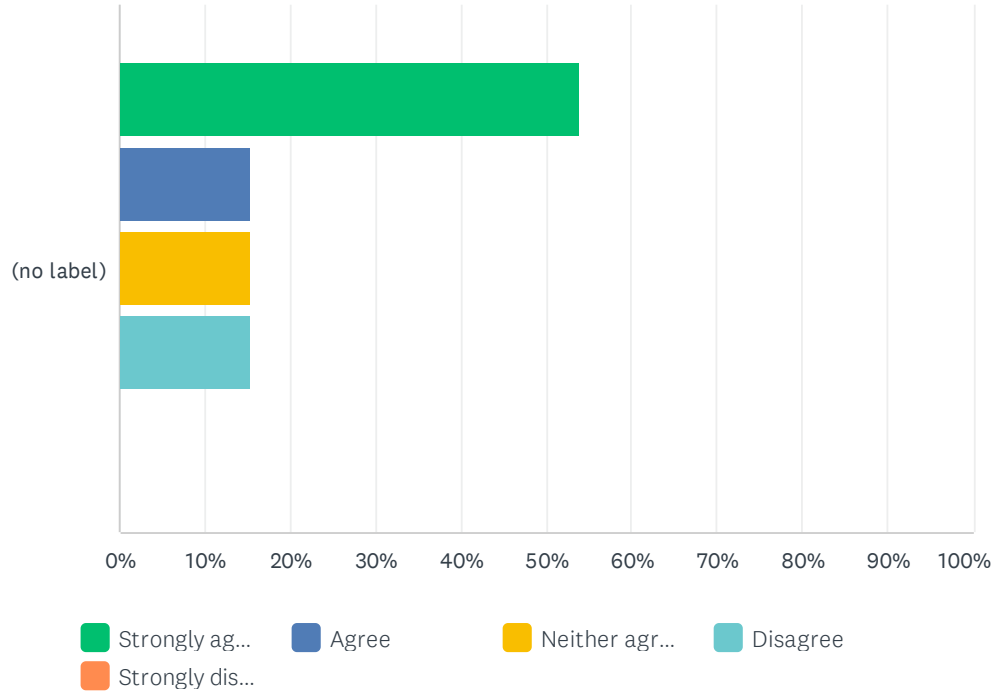

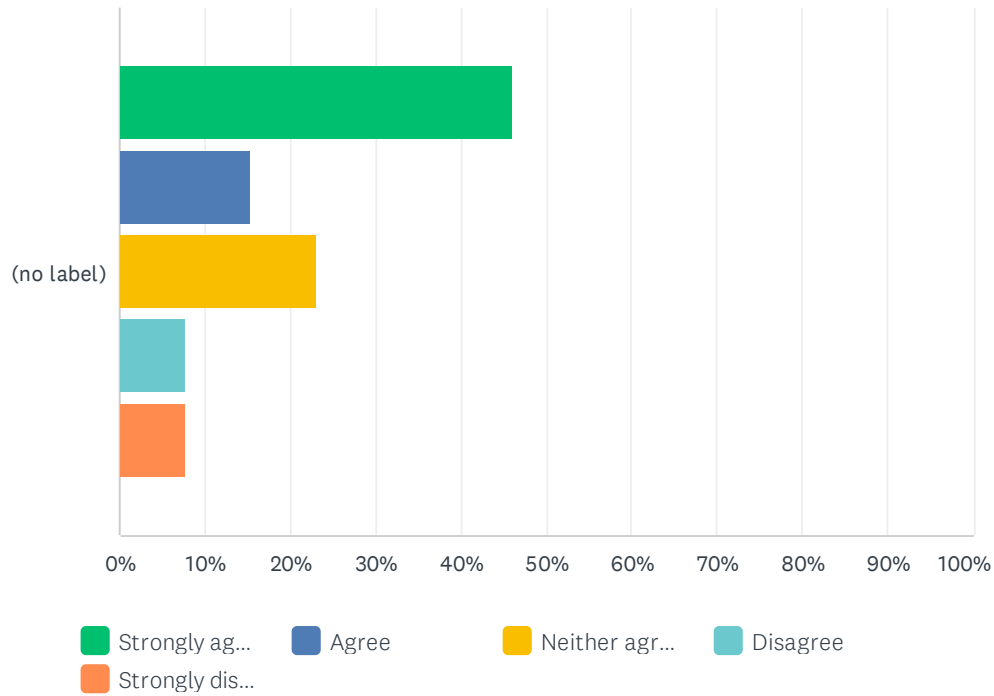

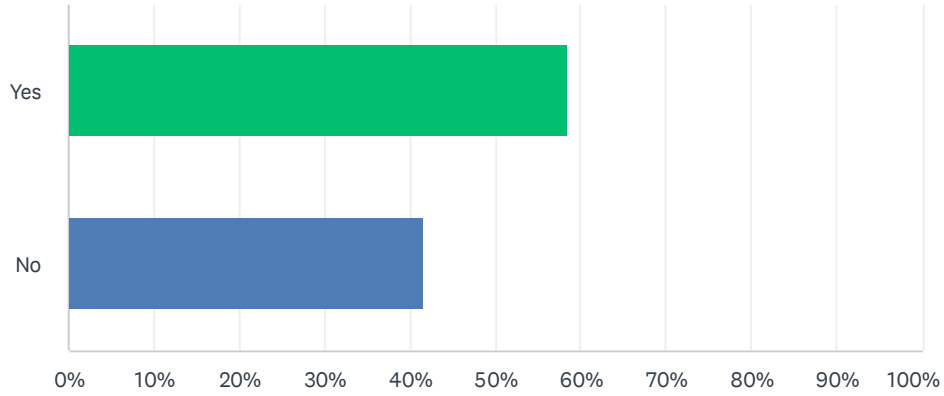

## Q42 Do you think the AWG 2023 are a sustainable event that protects the environment?

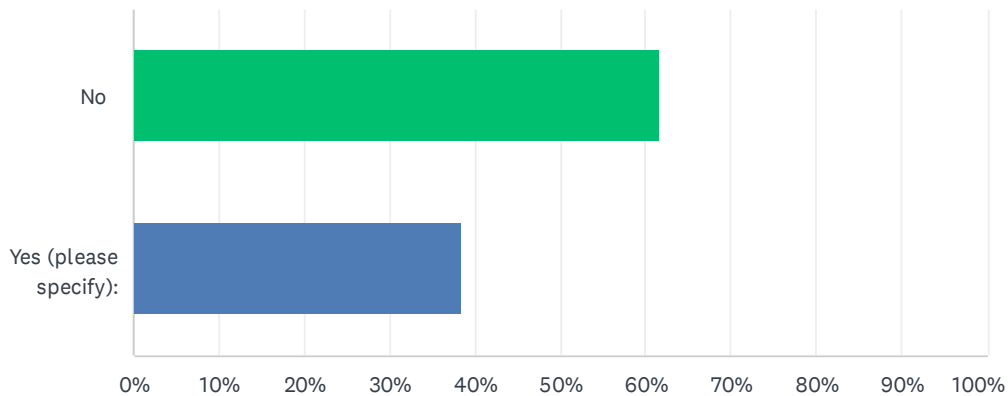
