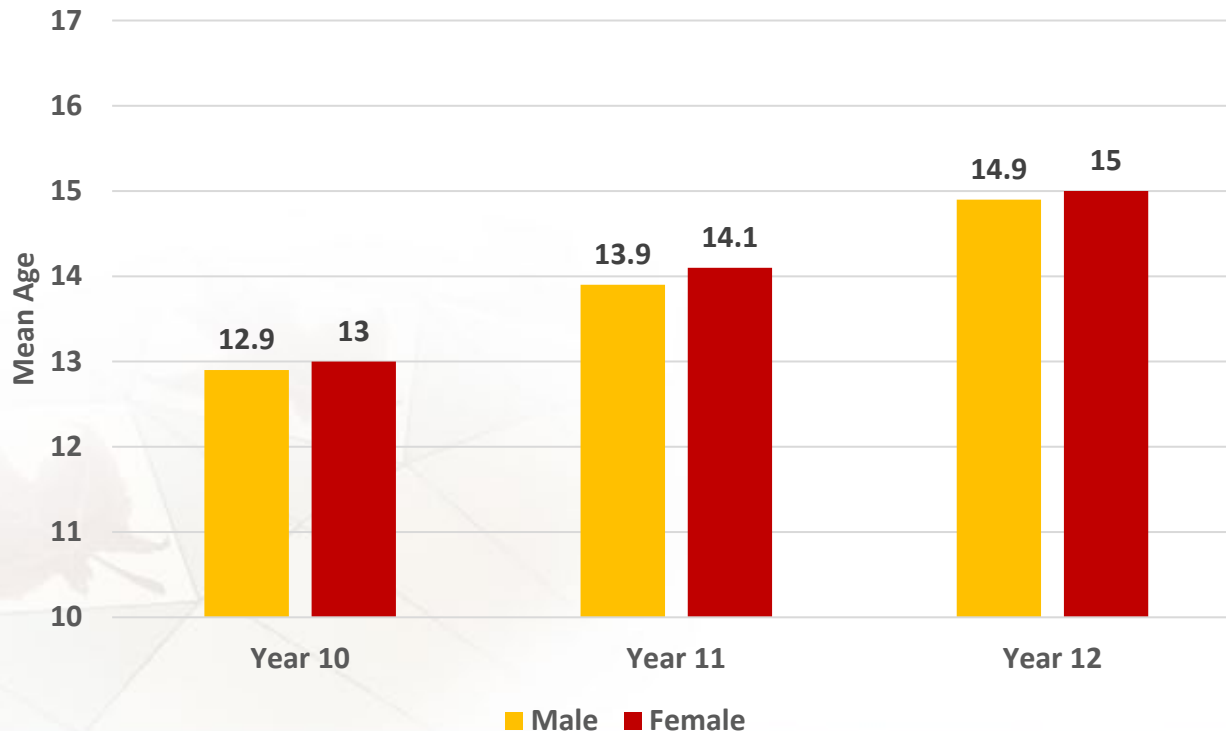

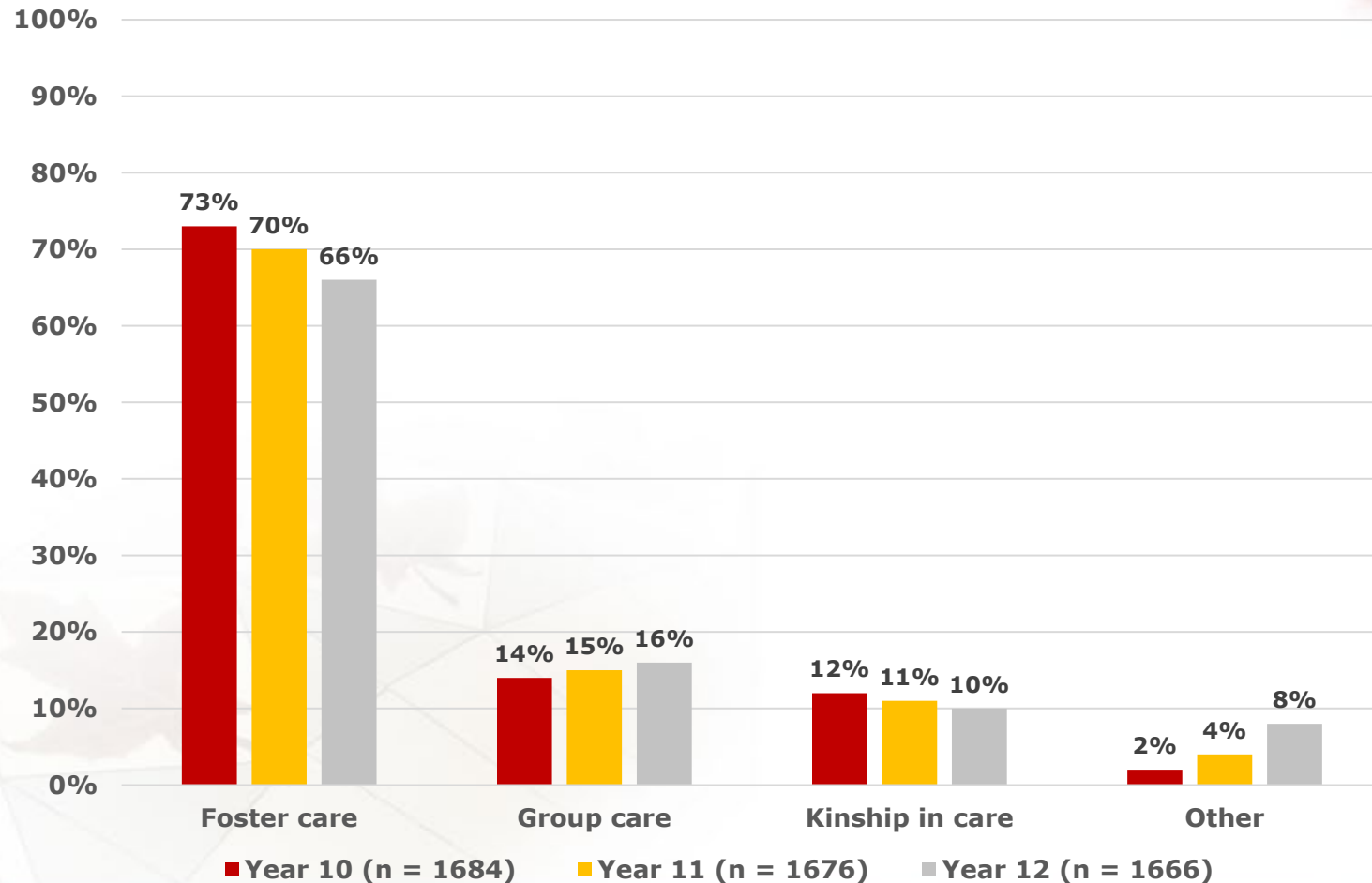

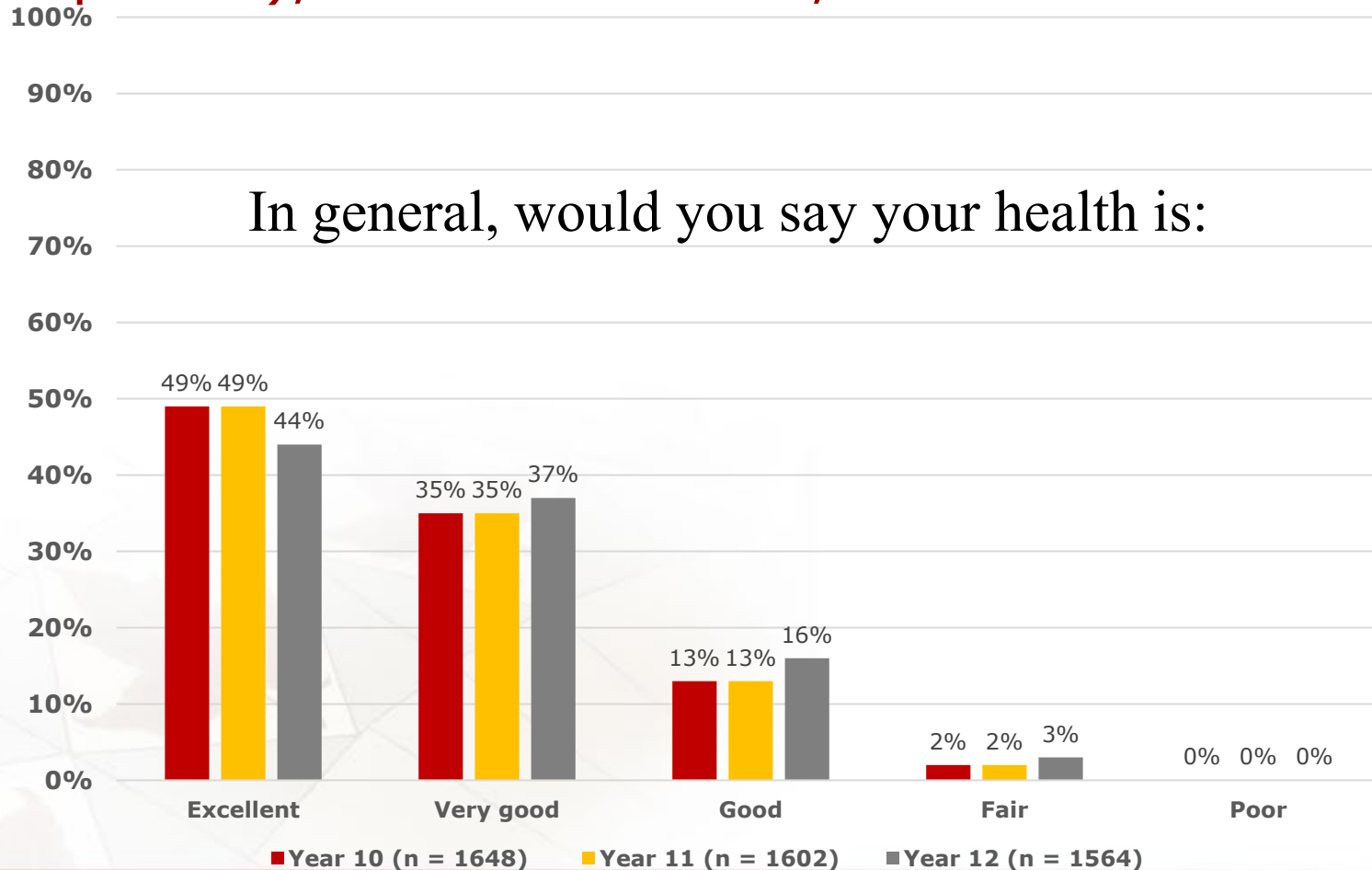

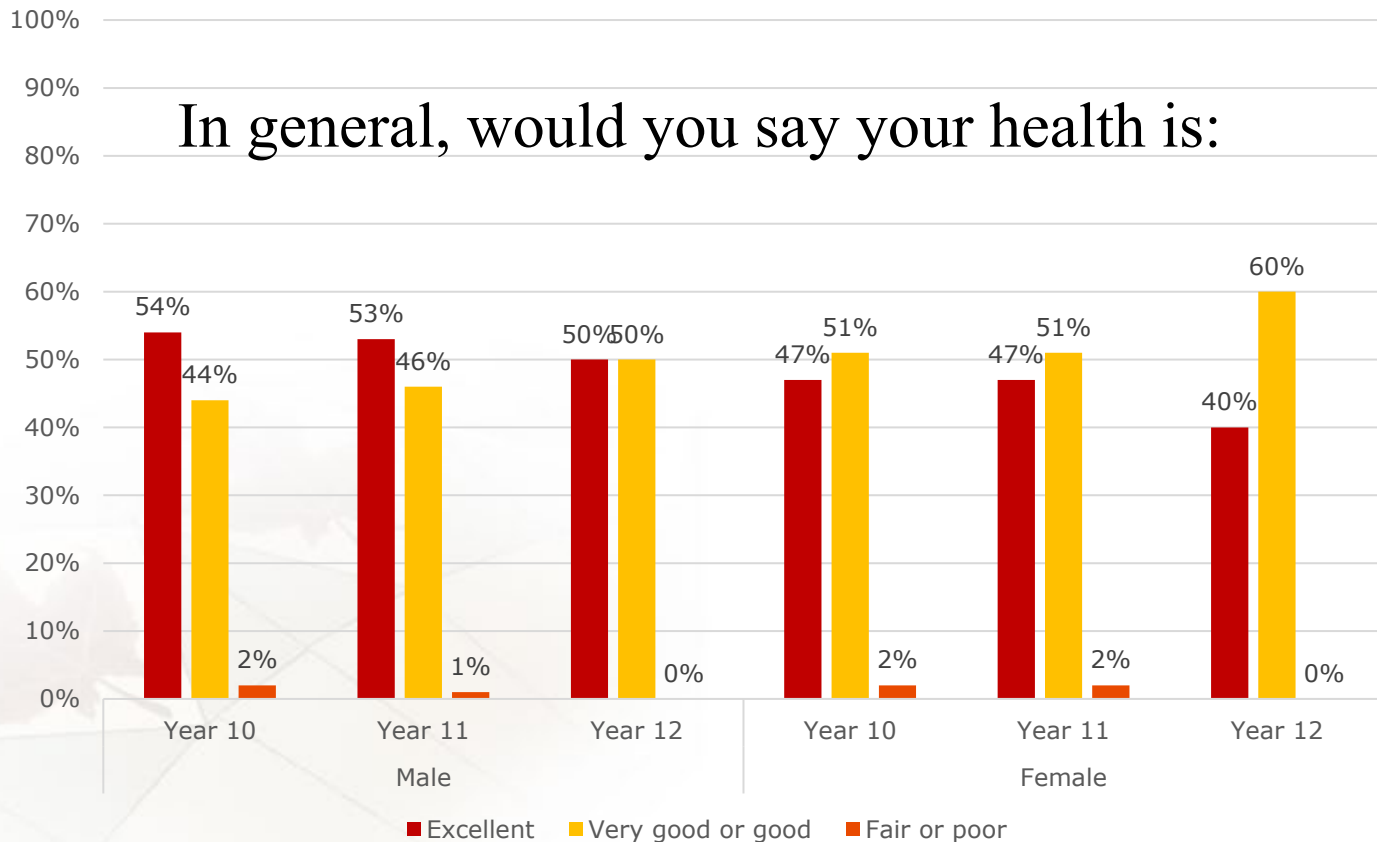
Placement settings for young people in care, OnLAC Years 10, 11 & 12



Health status of young people in care (youth-reported), OnLAC Years 10, 11 & 12

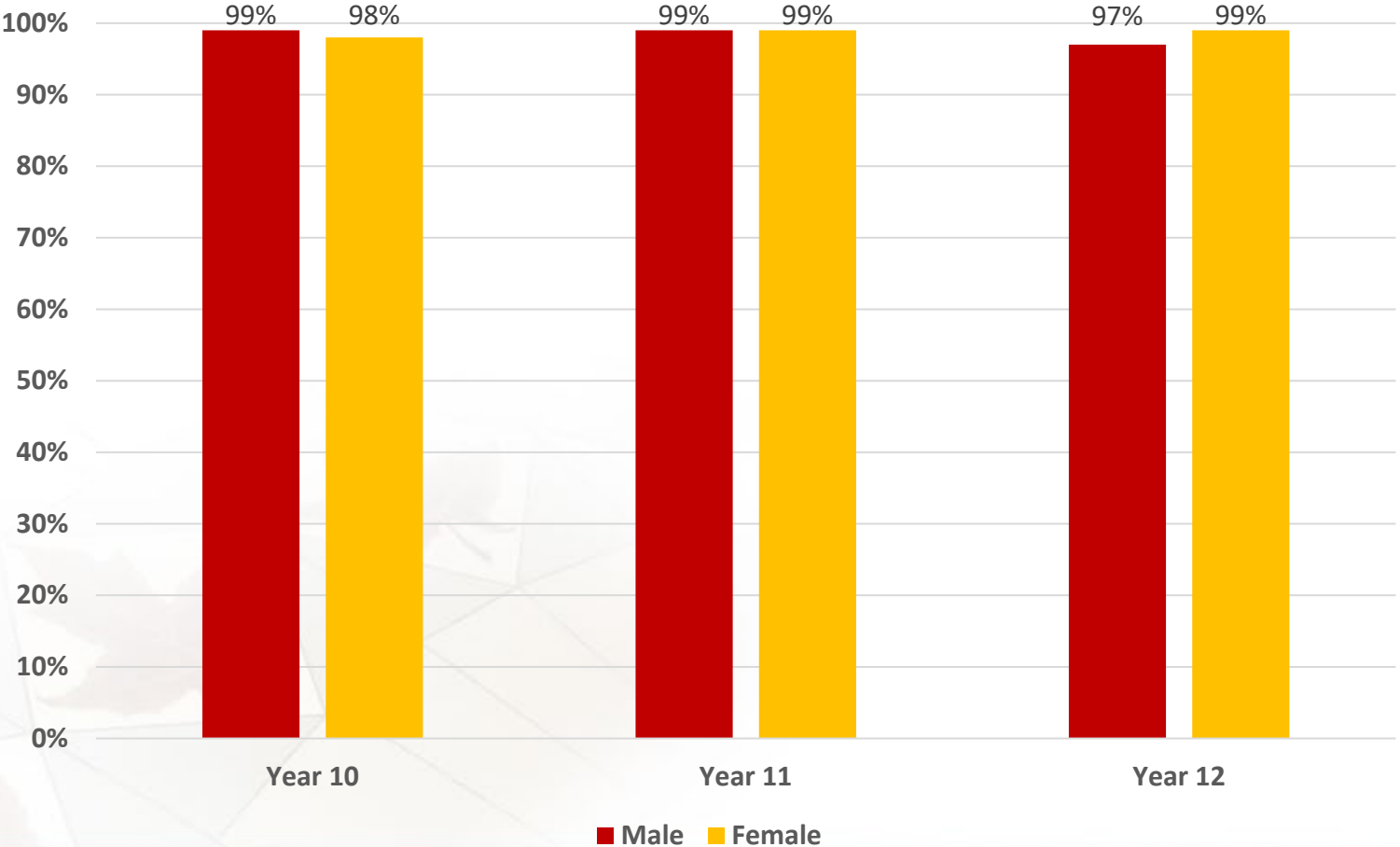


Health status of young people in care (youth-reported), for male ($n = 822$) & female ($n = 605$) youths, OnLAC Years 10, 11 & 12

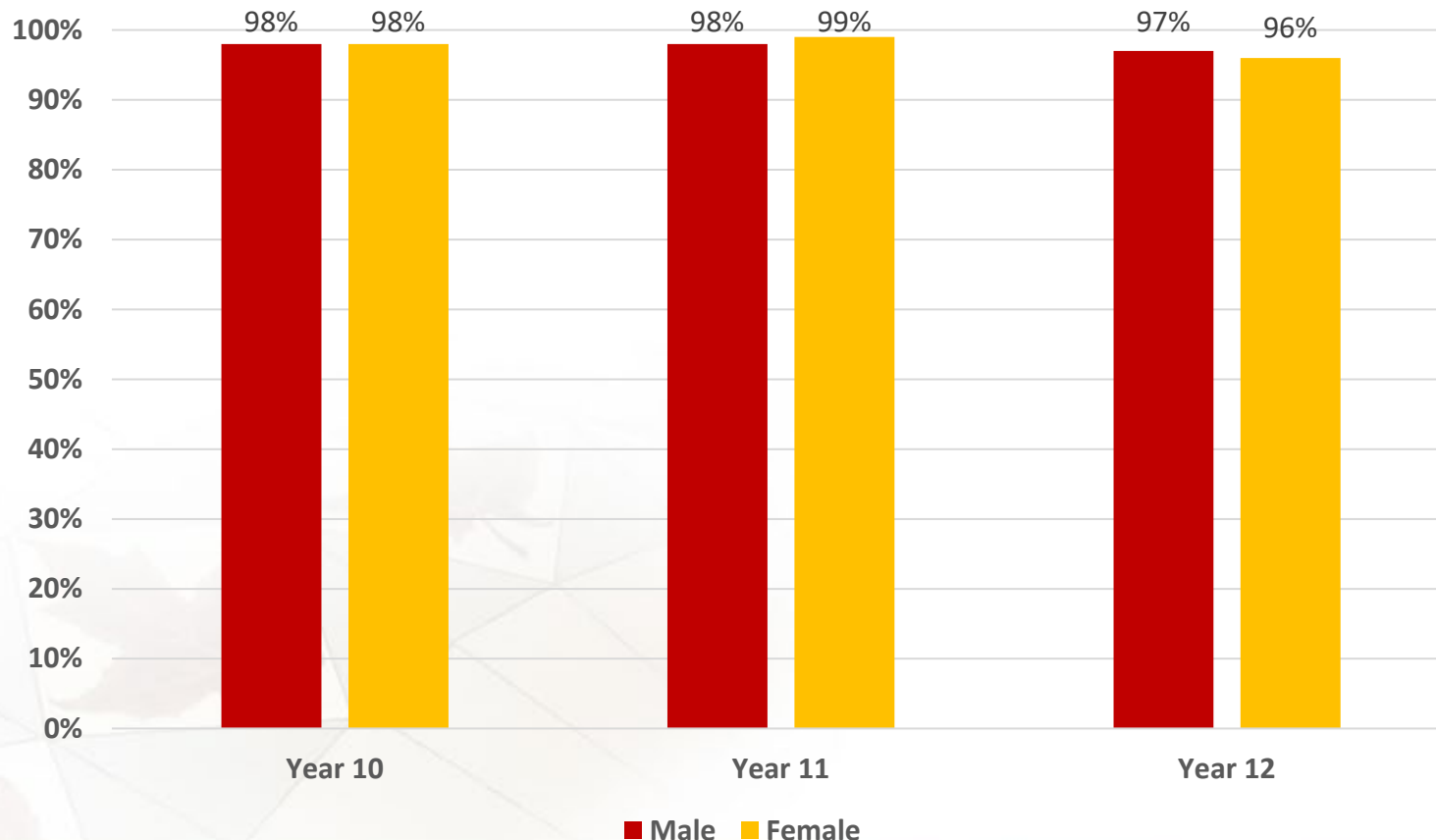




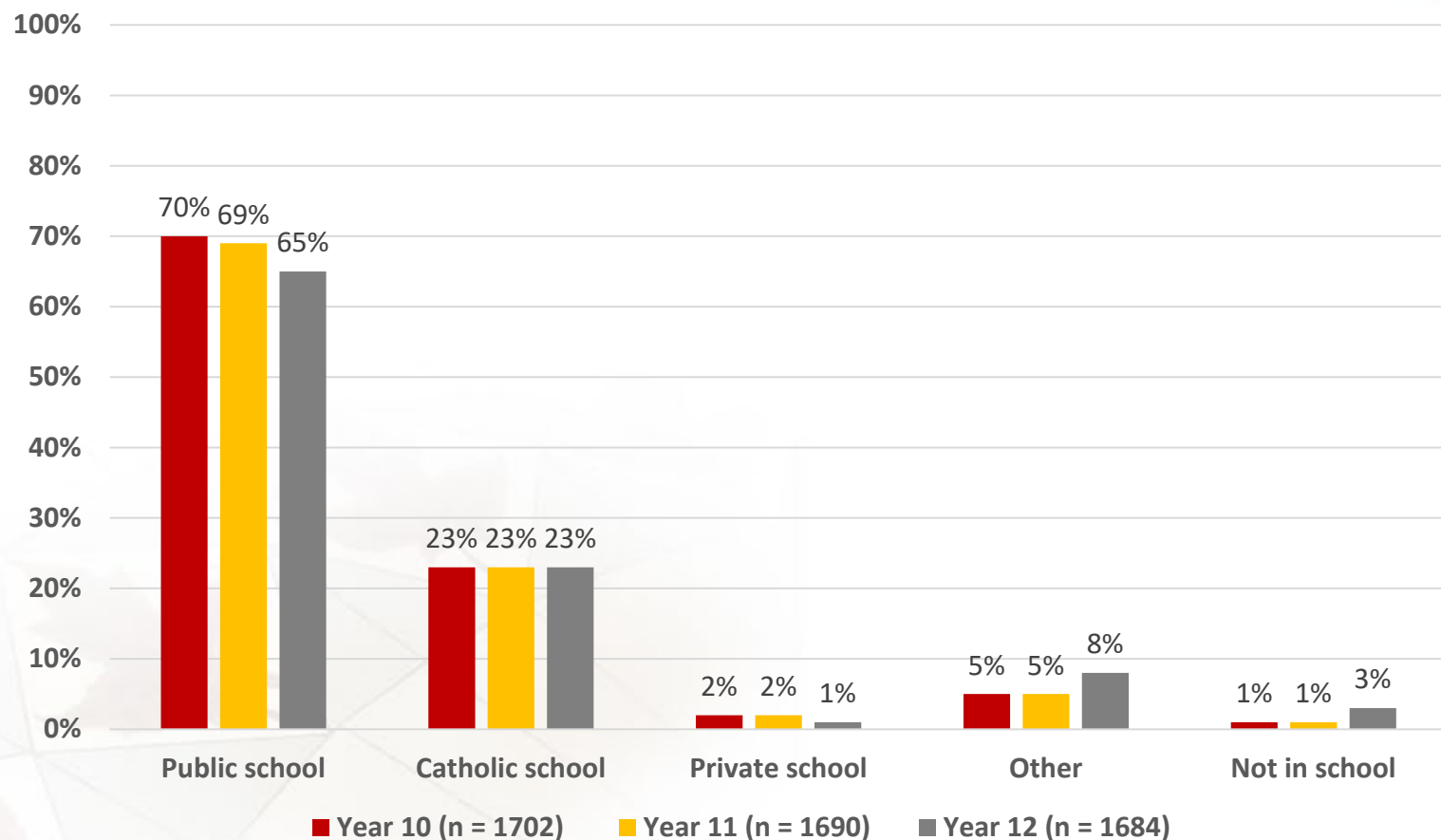
Young people in care who have had a dental exam within the last year (as reported by worker), OnLAC Years 10, 11 & 12



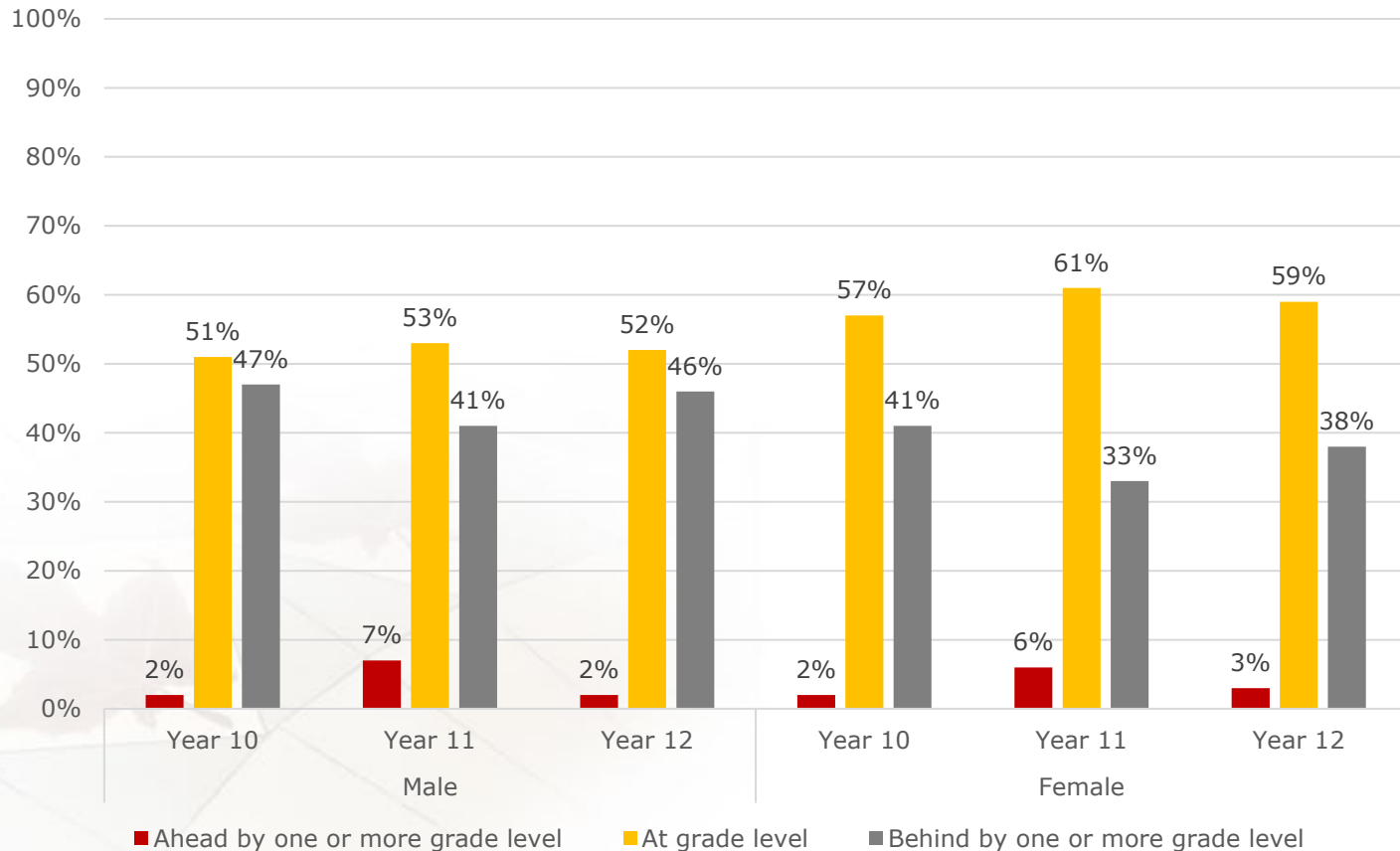
Young people in care who have had a medical exam within the last year (as reported by worker), OnLAC Years 10, 11 & 12



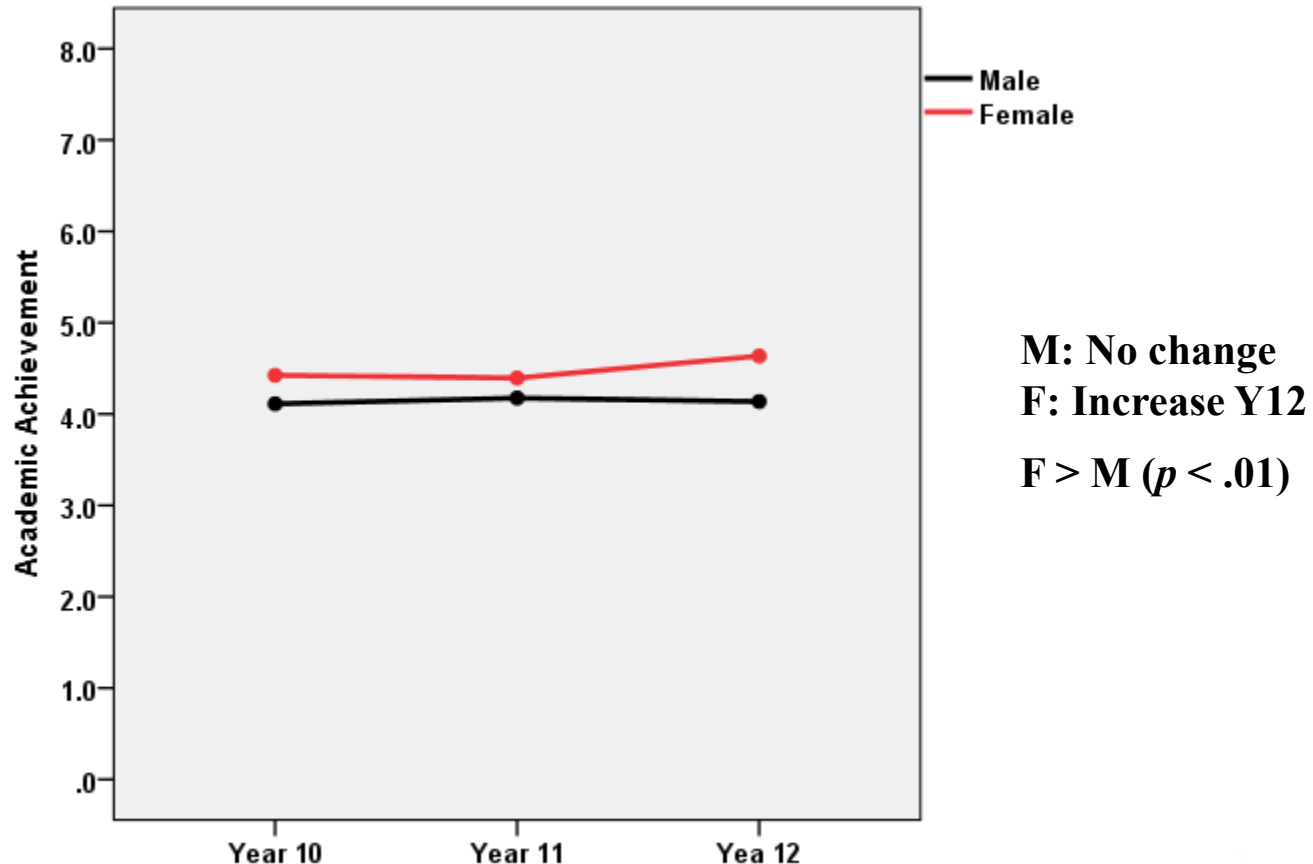
Types of school attended by young people in care (as reported by worker), OnLAC Years 10, 11 & 12



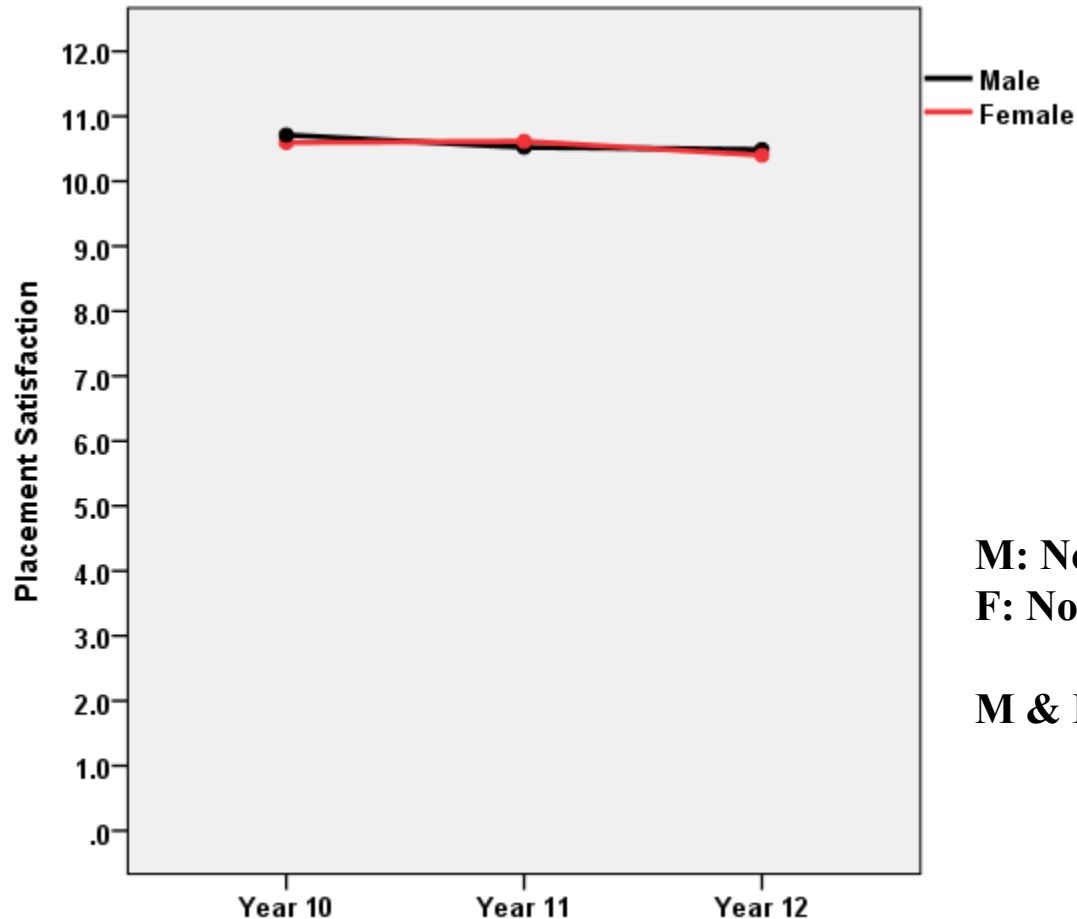

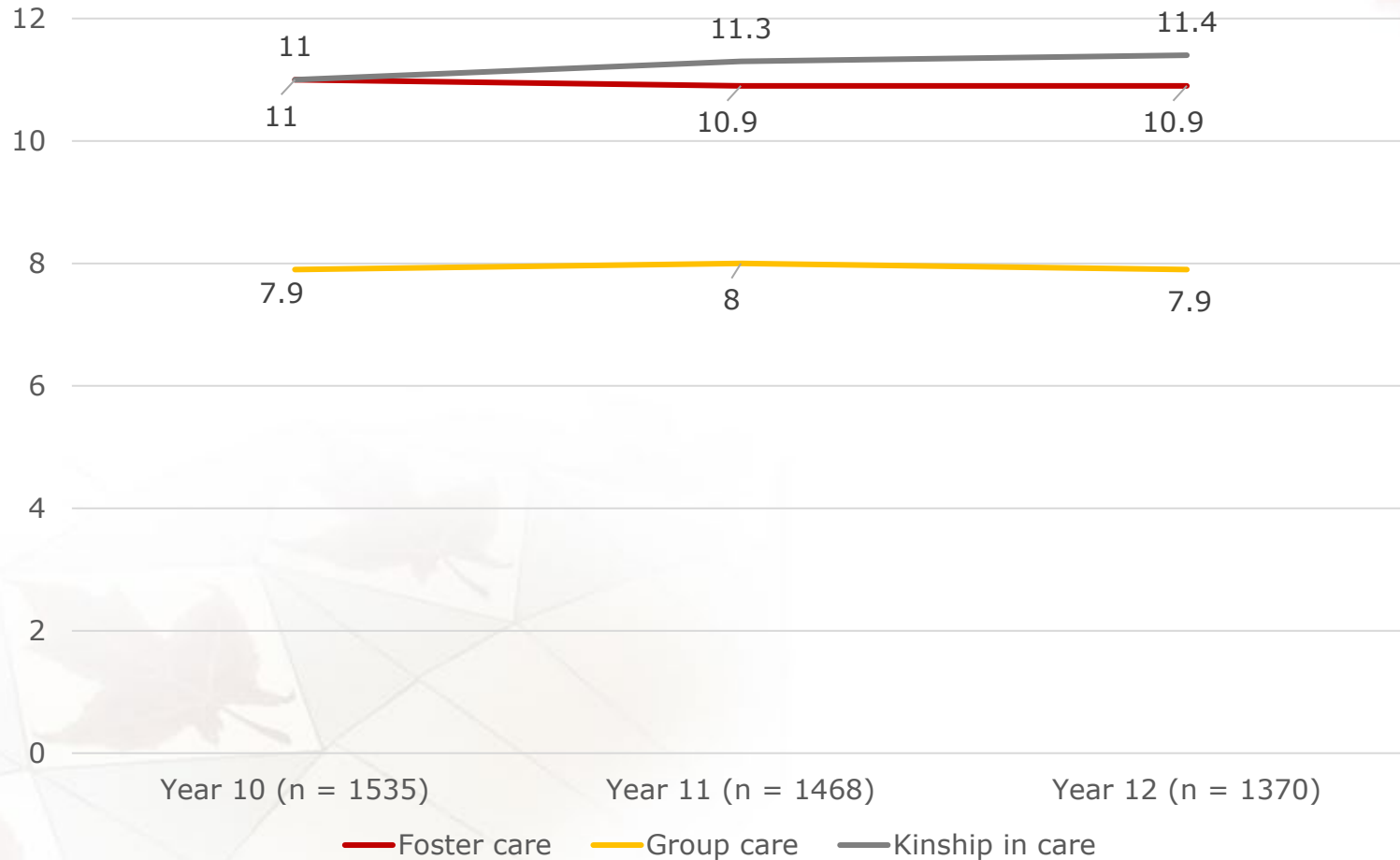

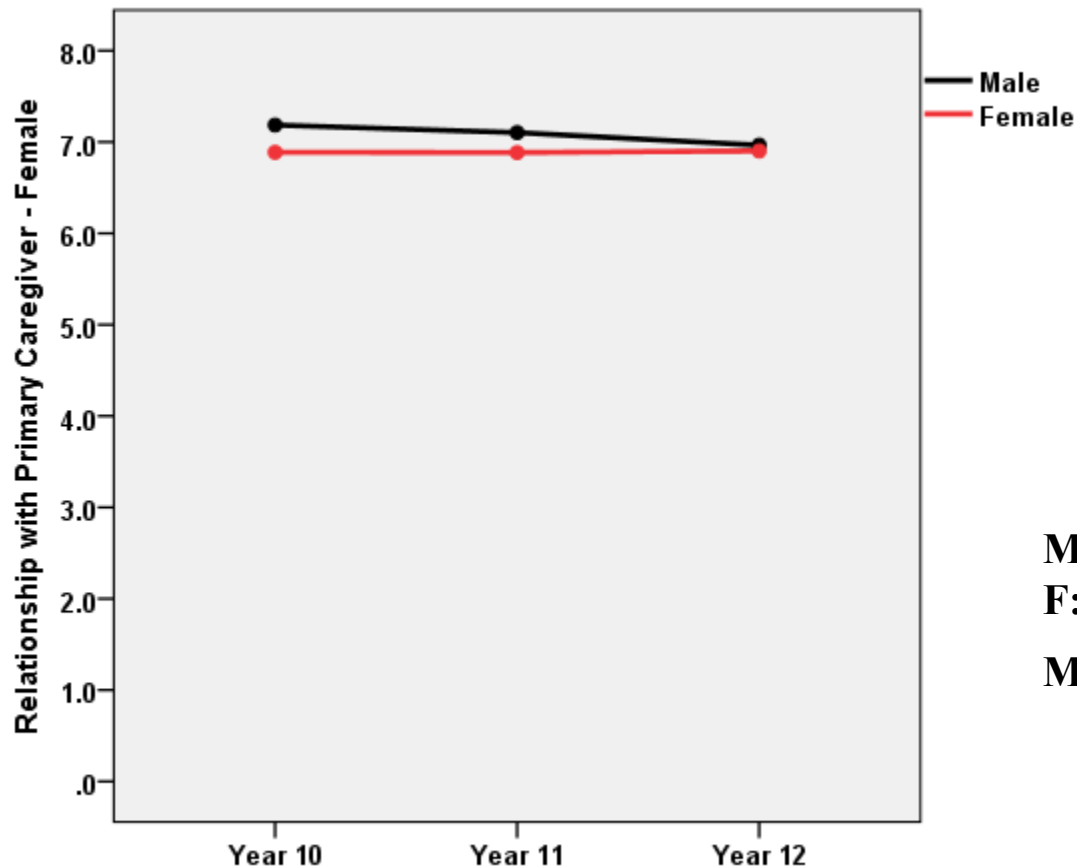

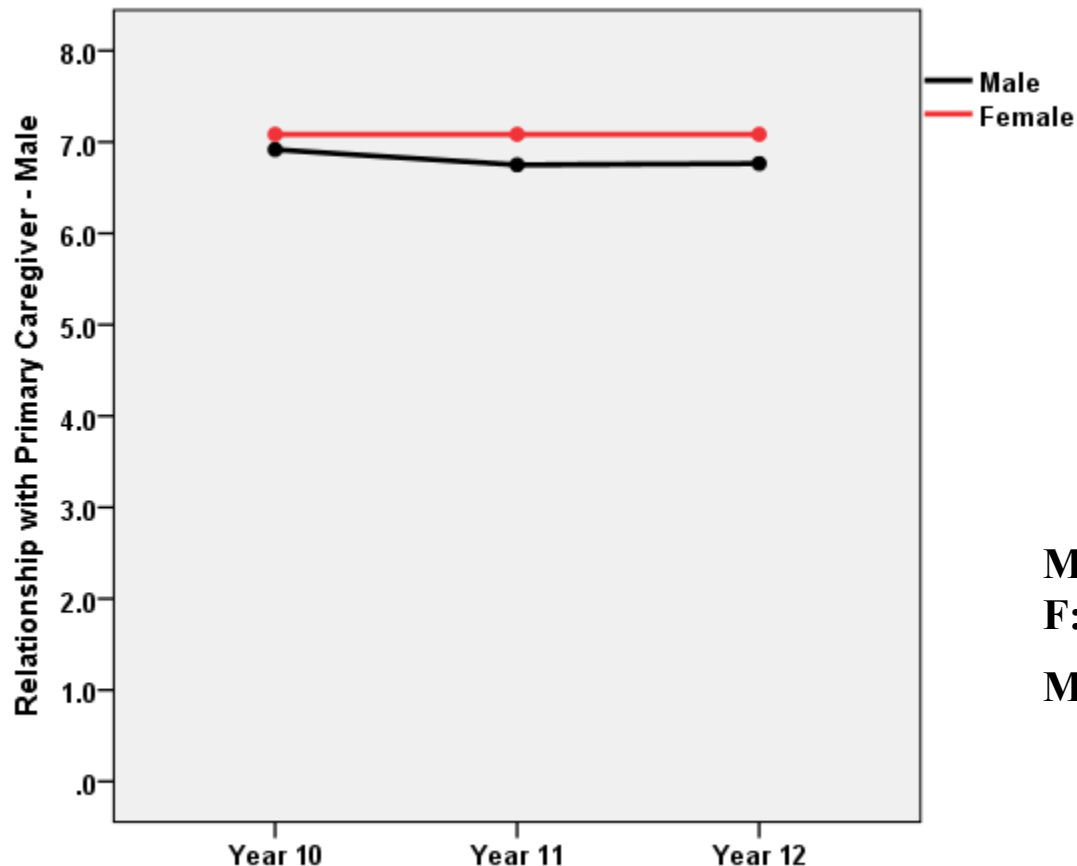

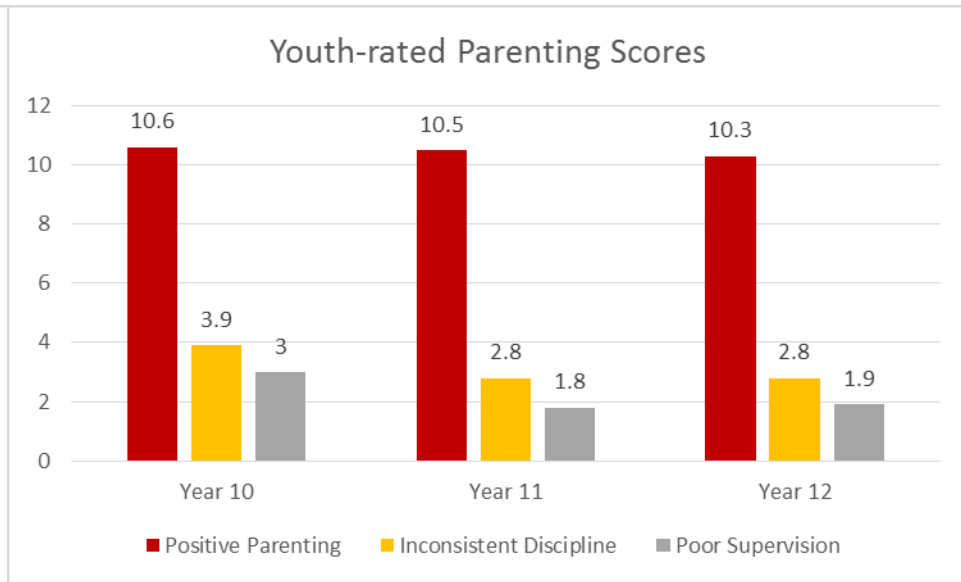
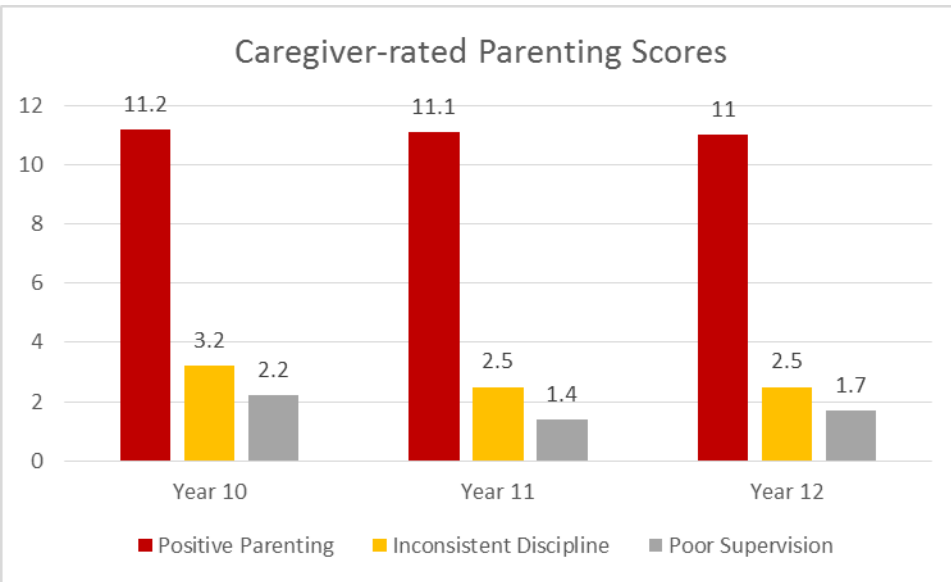

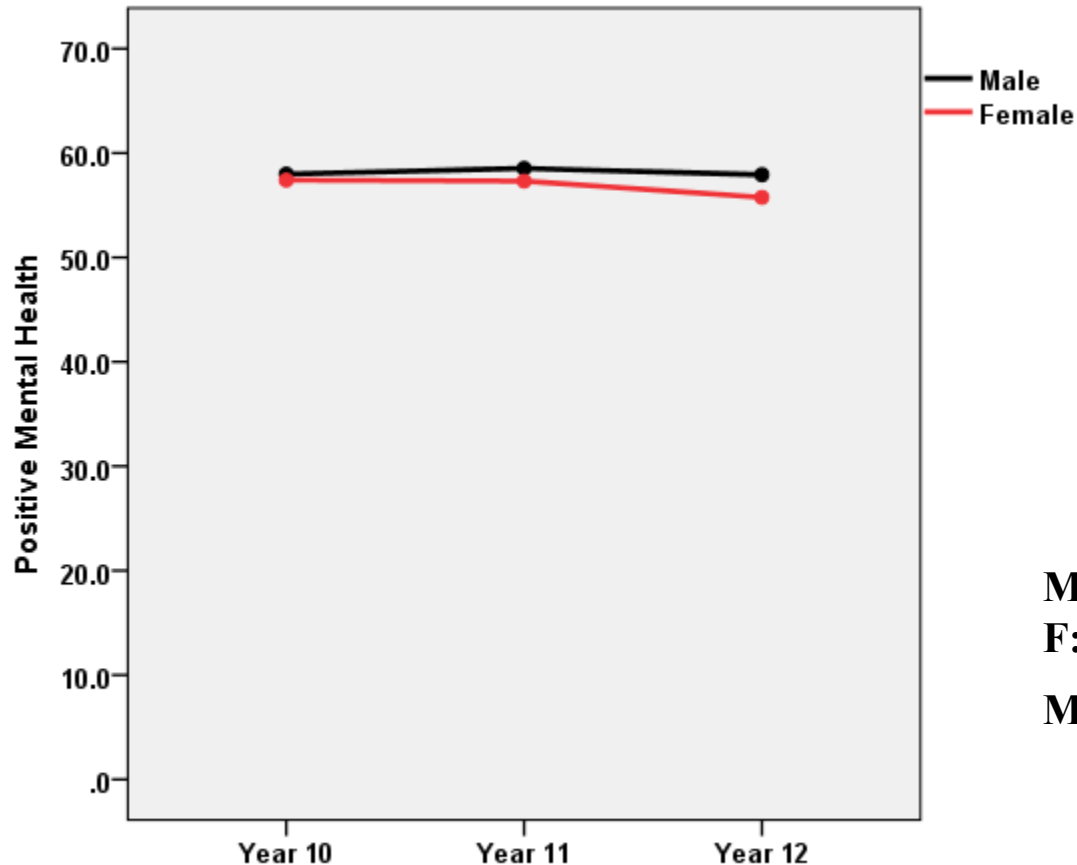

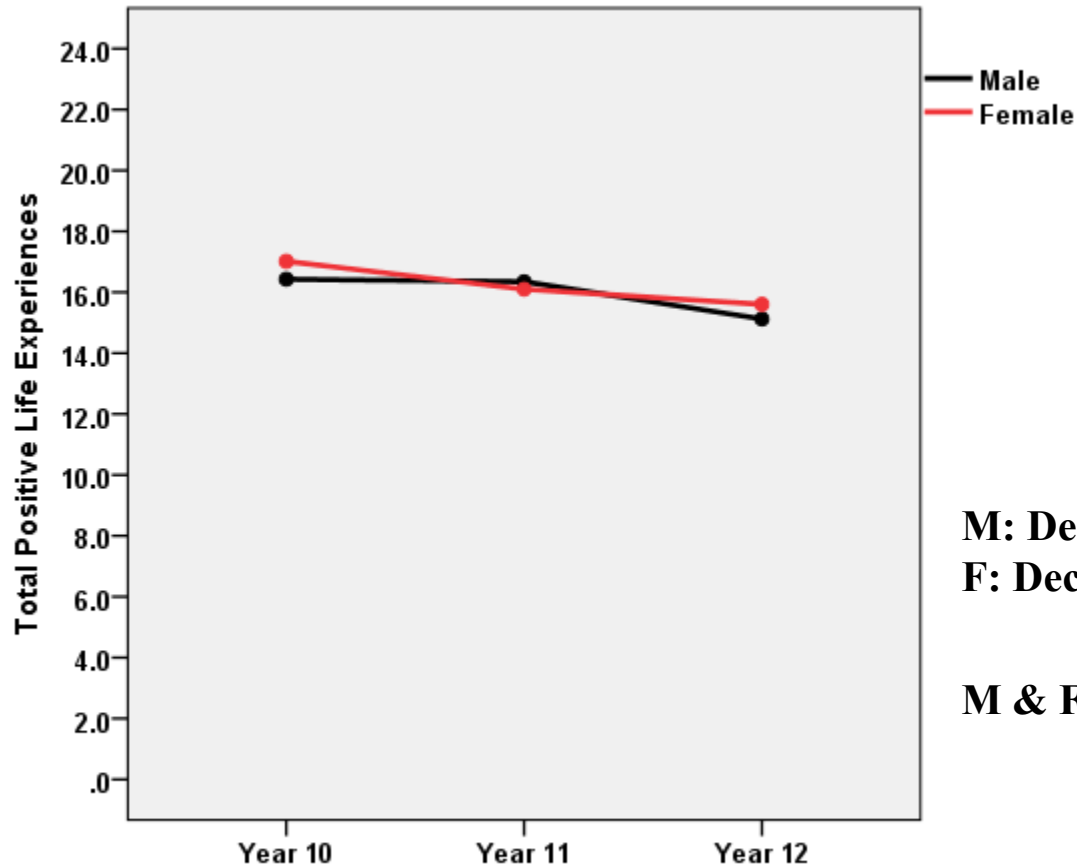

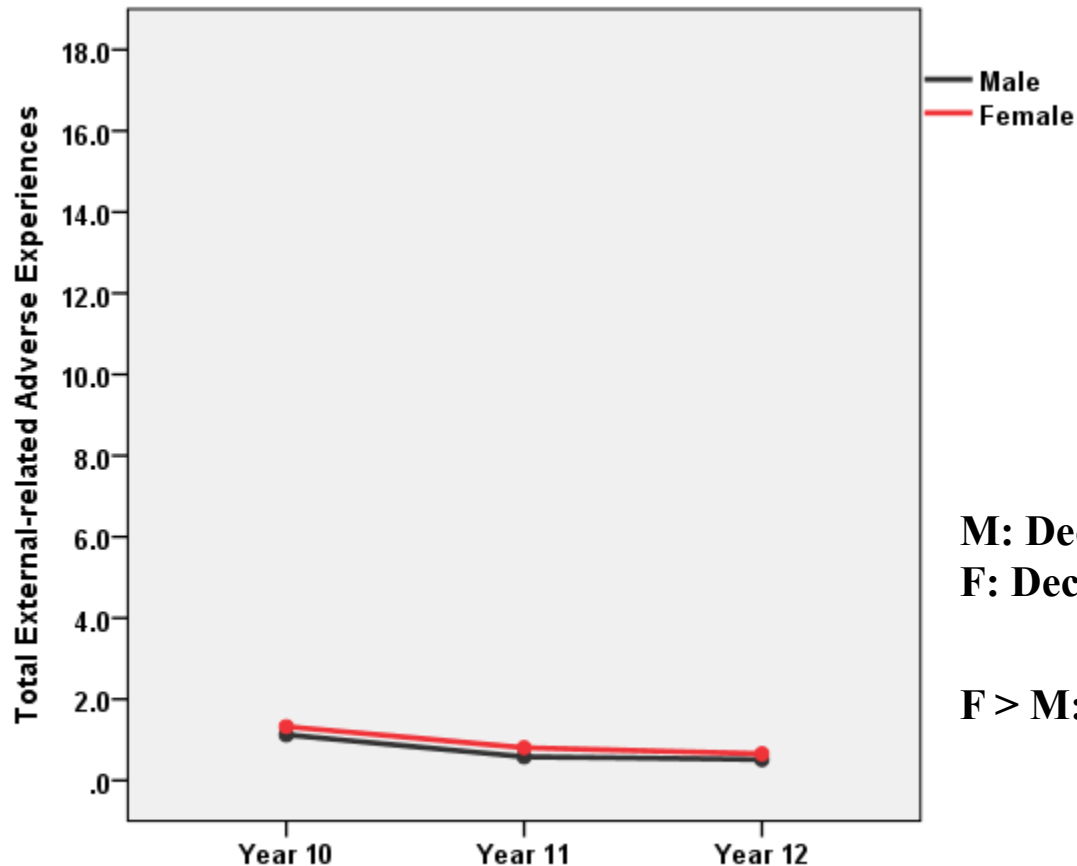

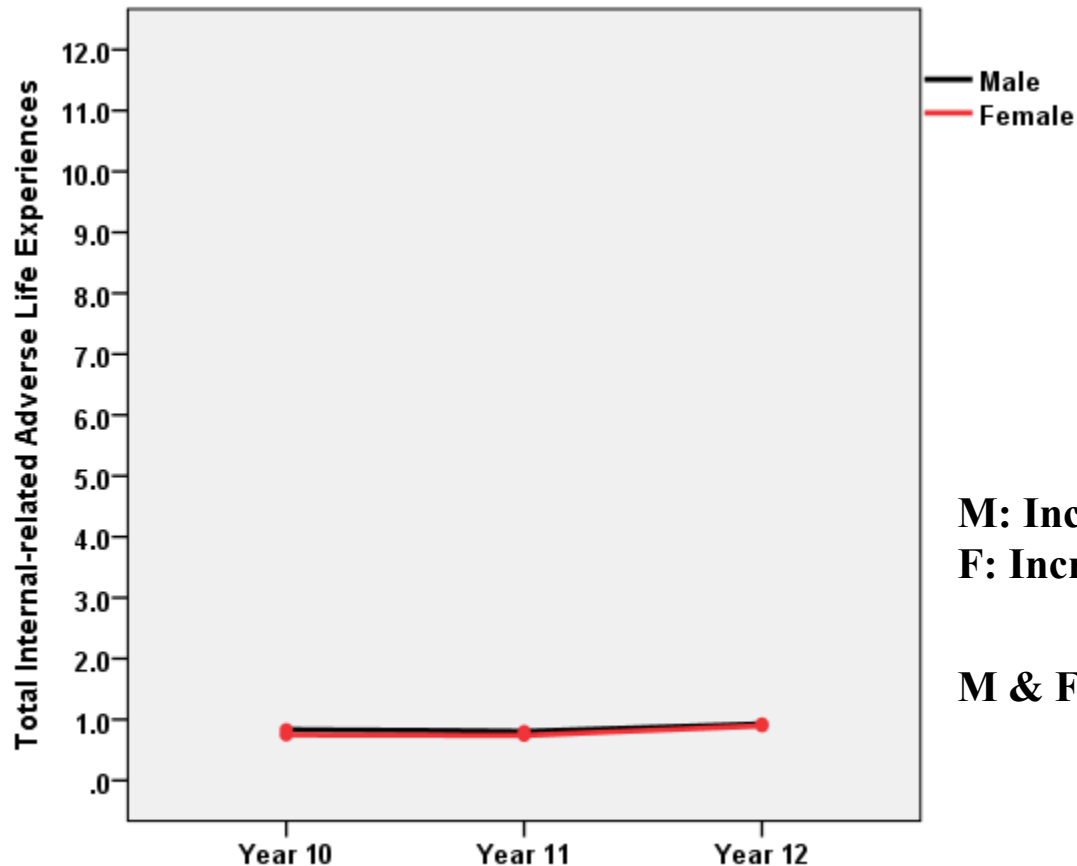

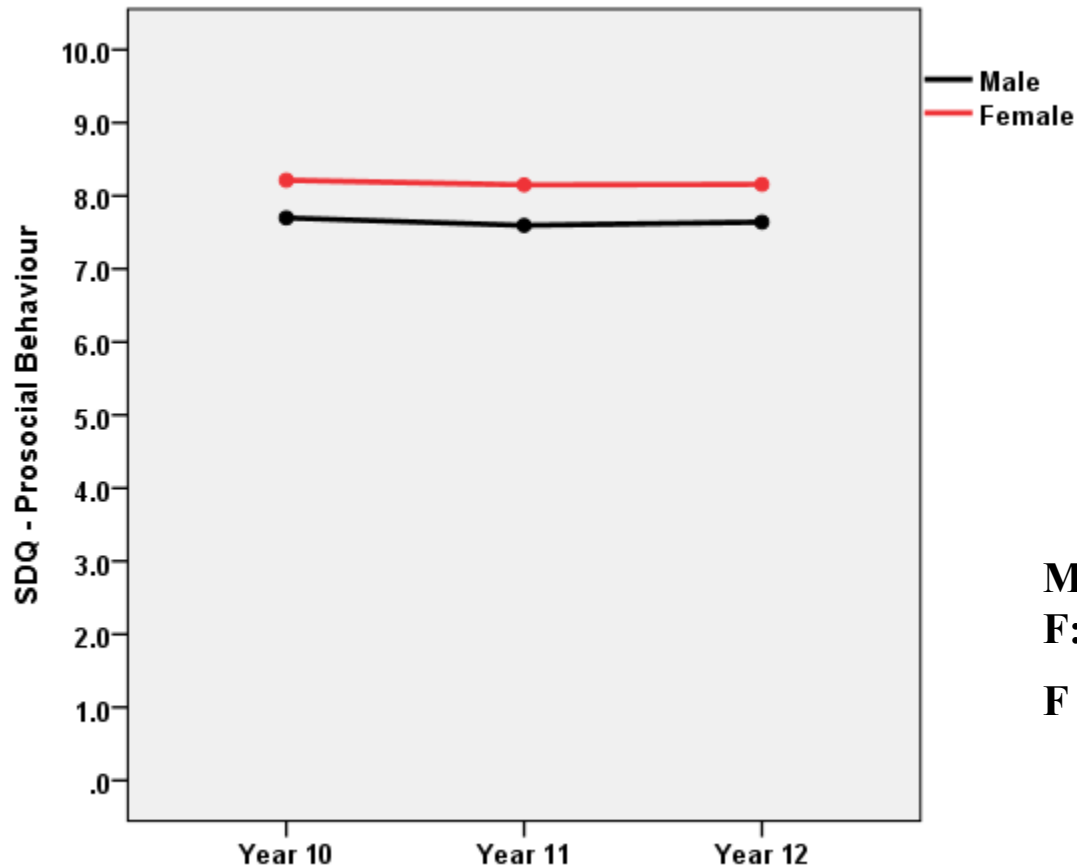

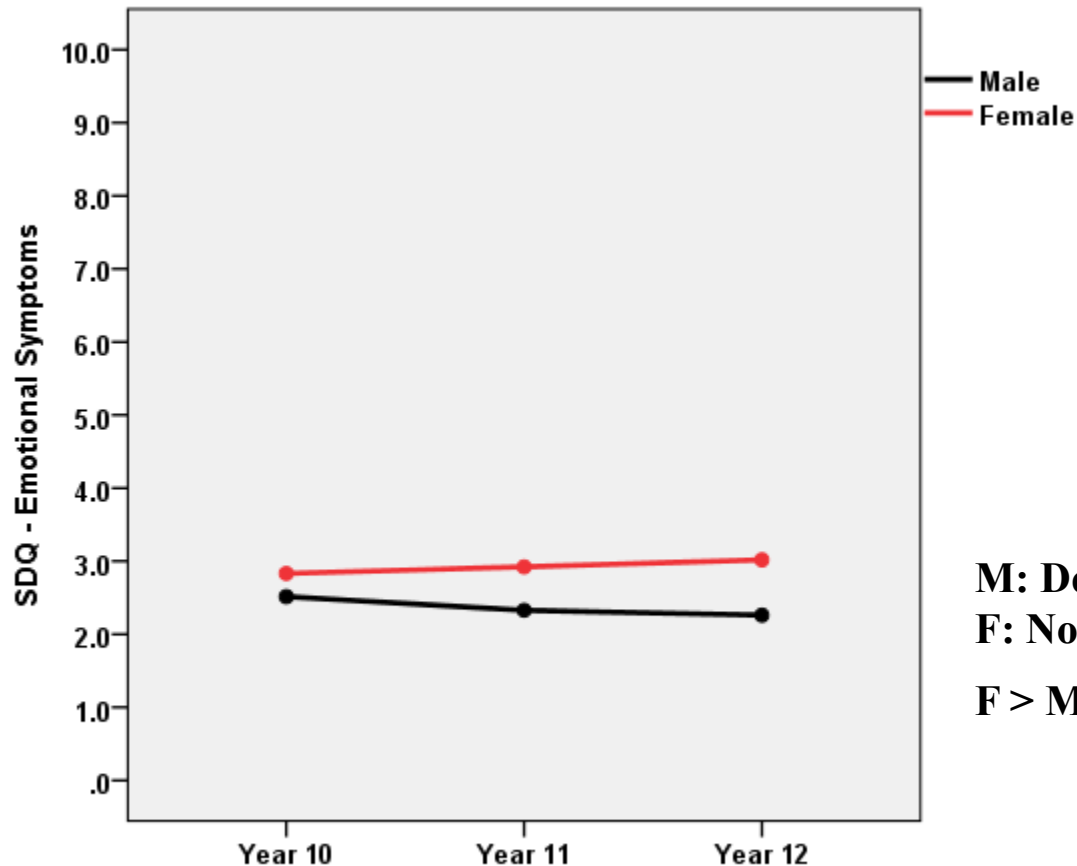

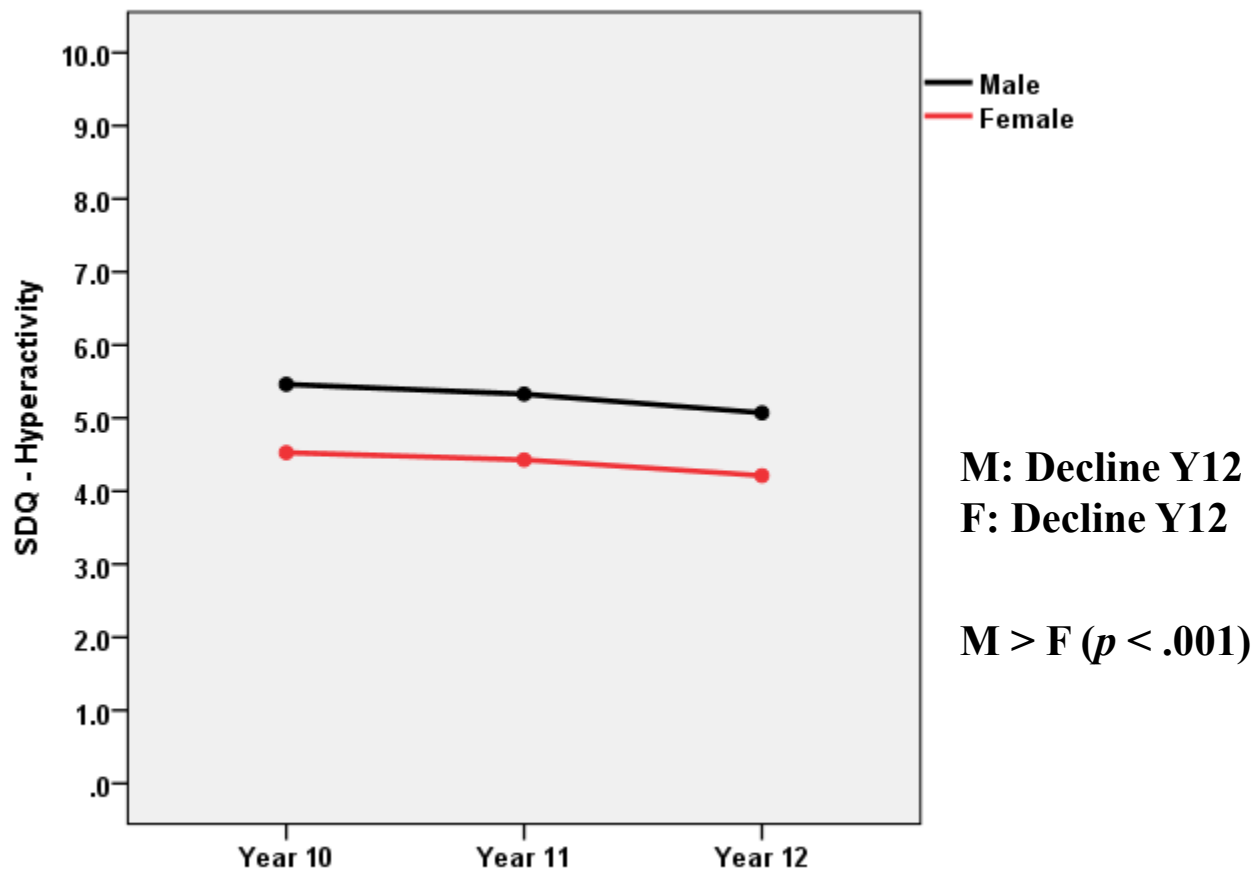

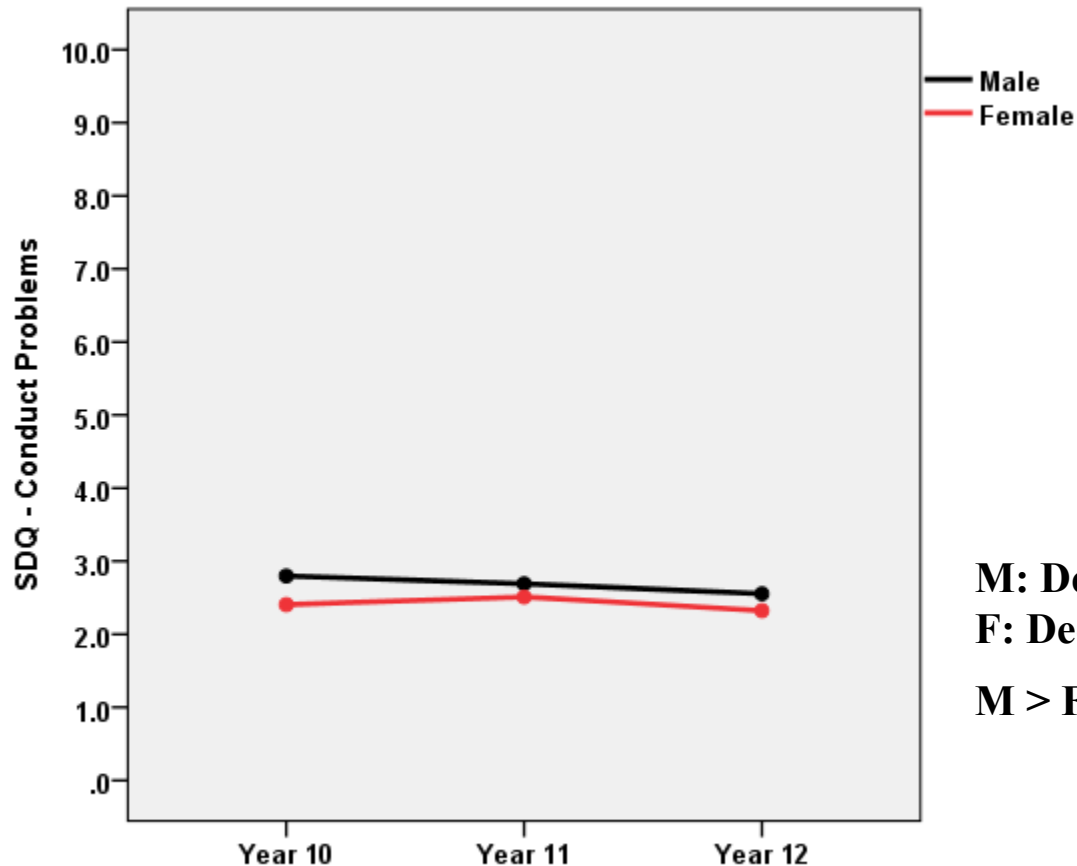

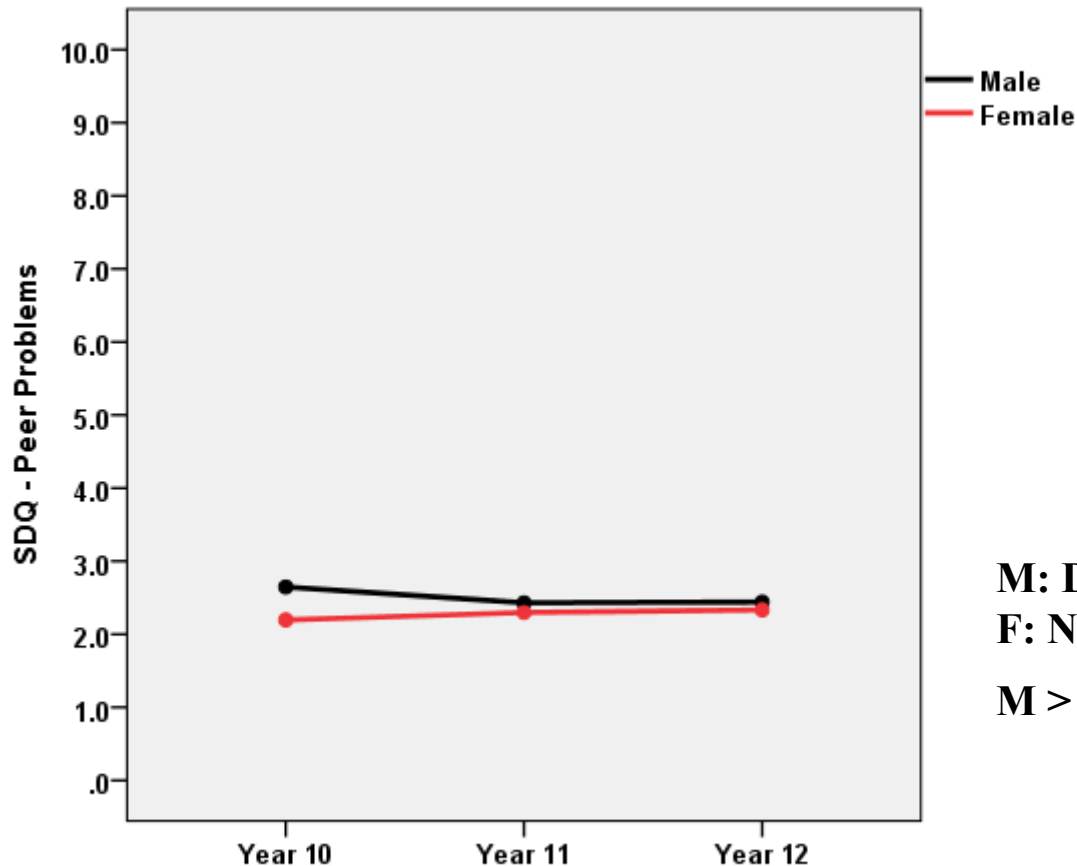

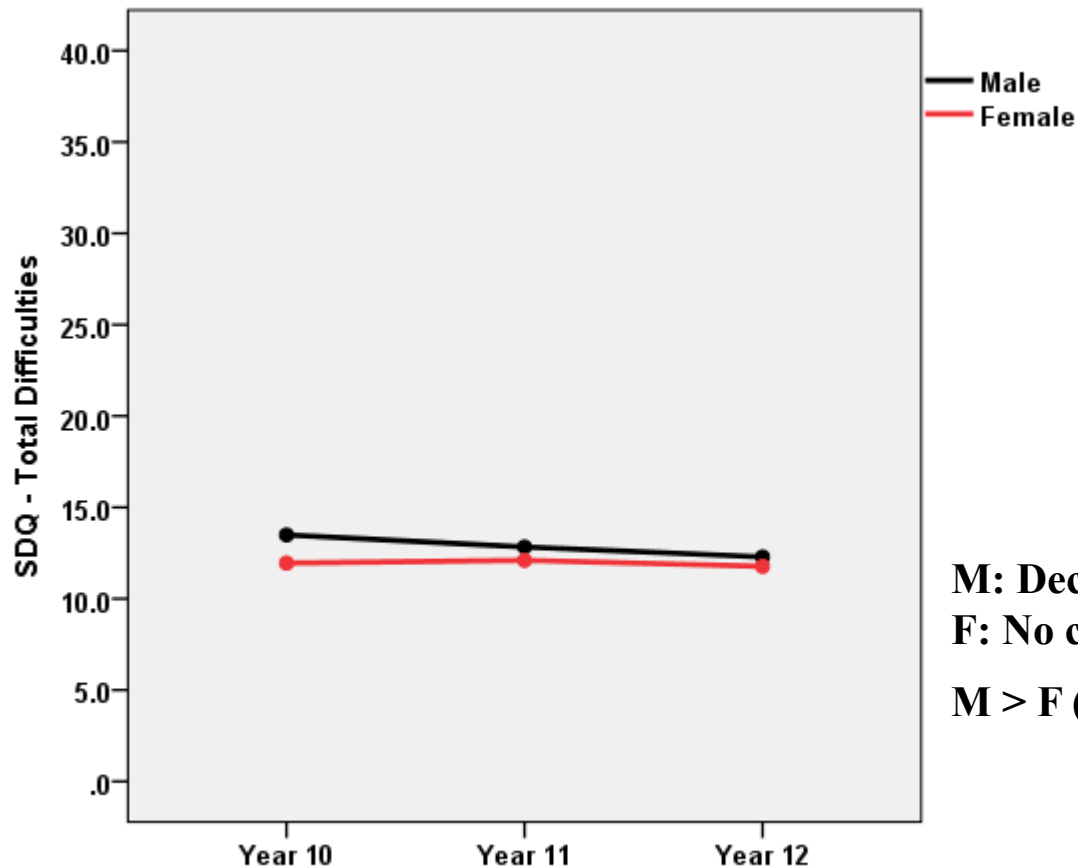

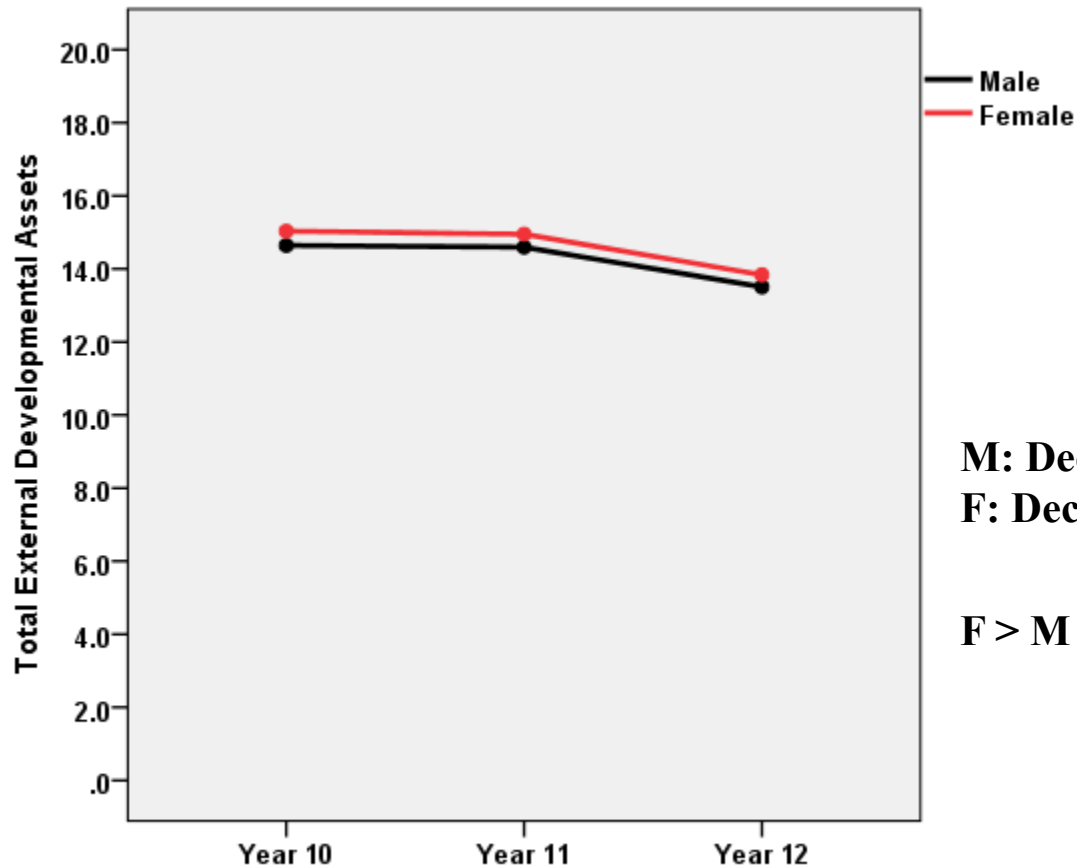

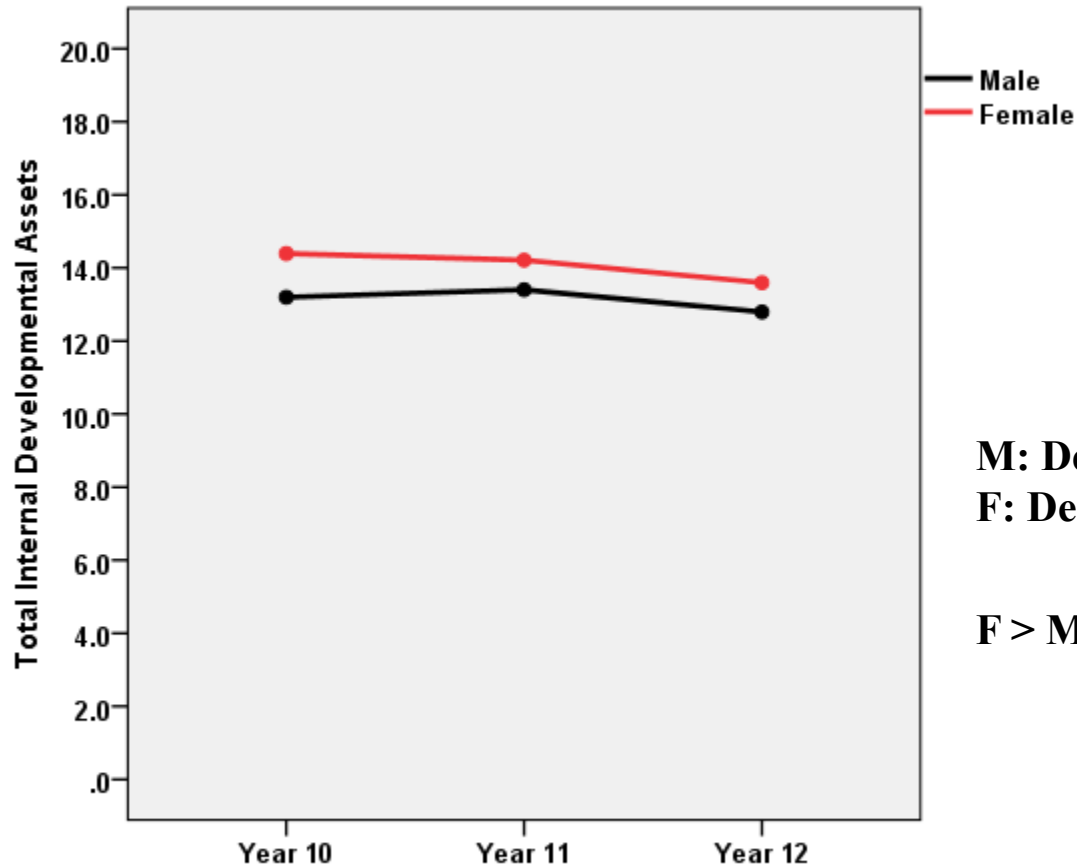

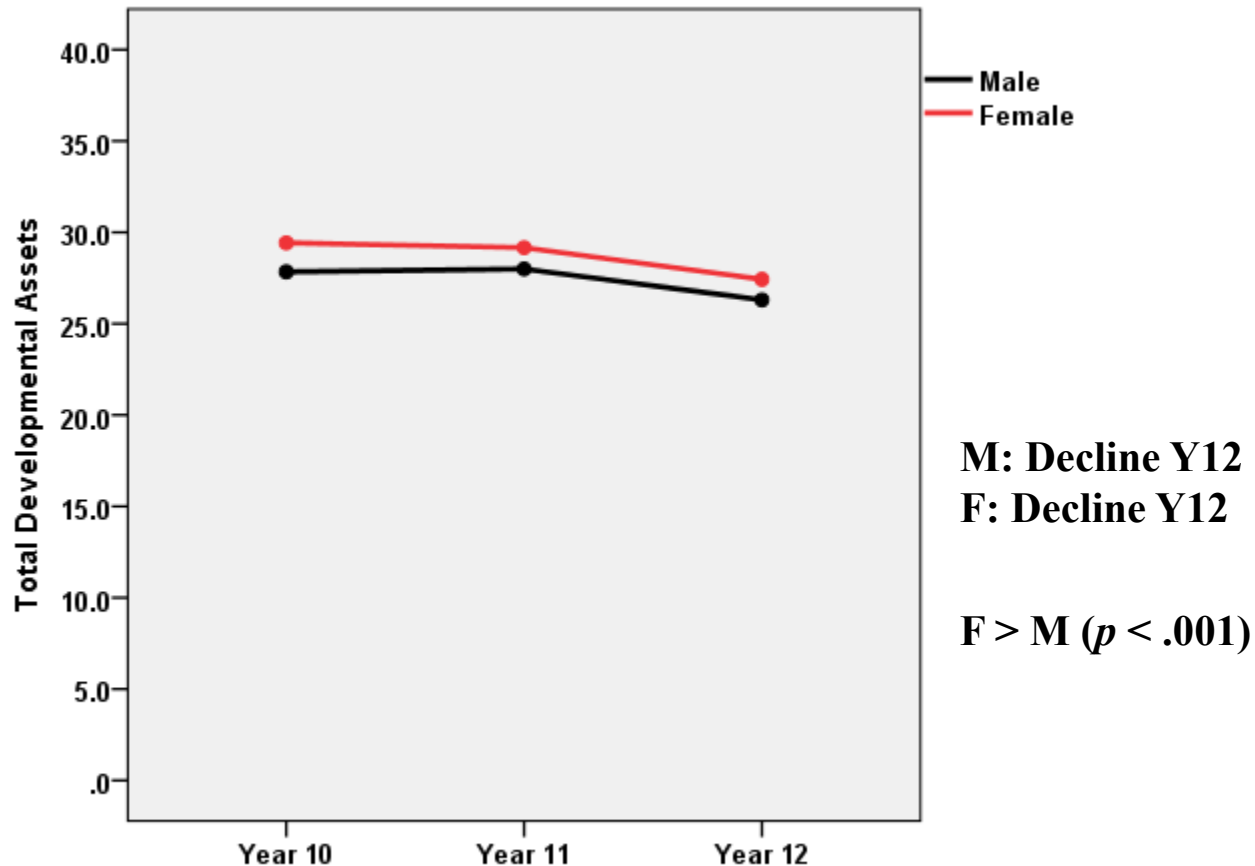

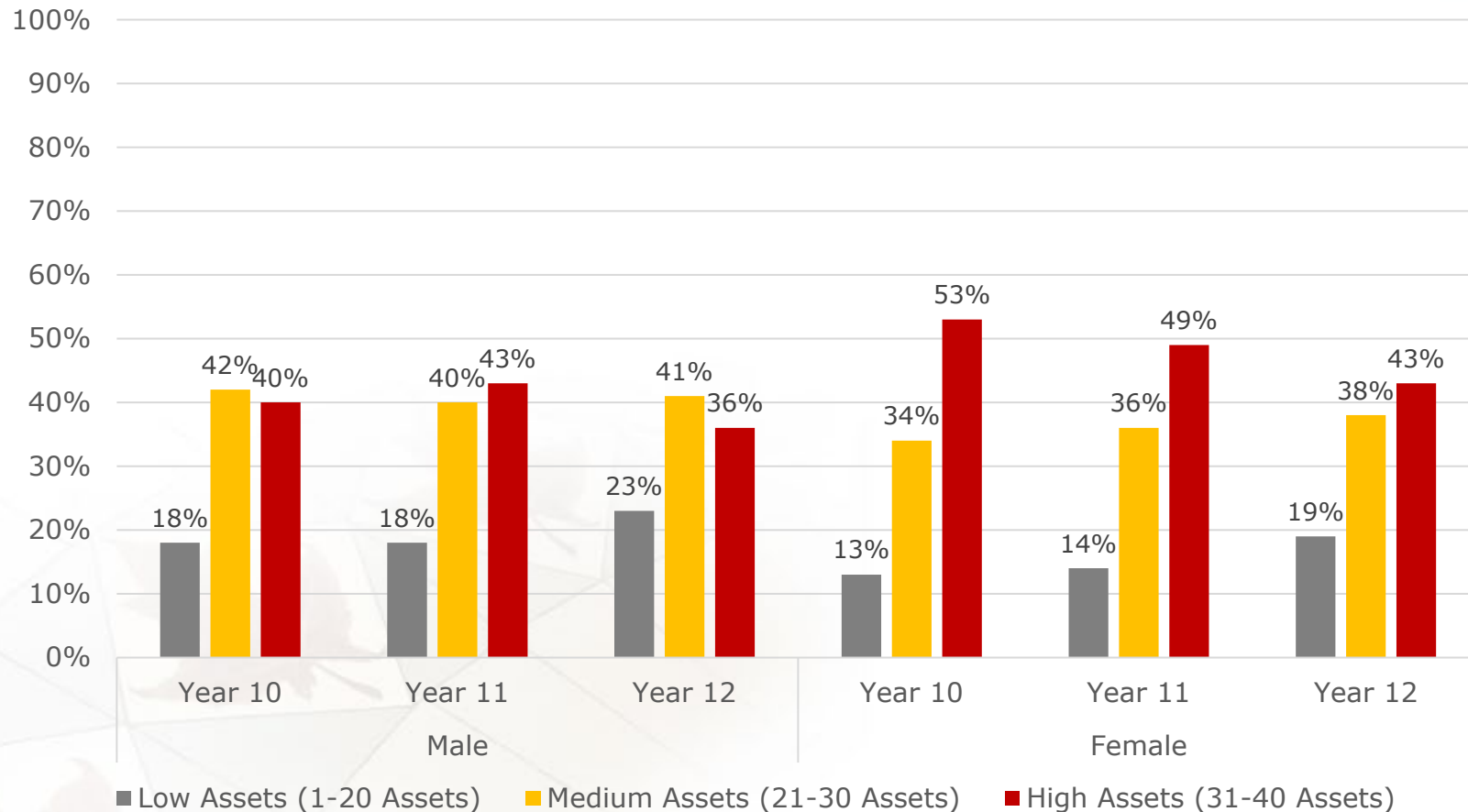
