

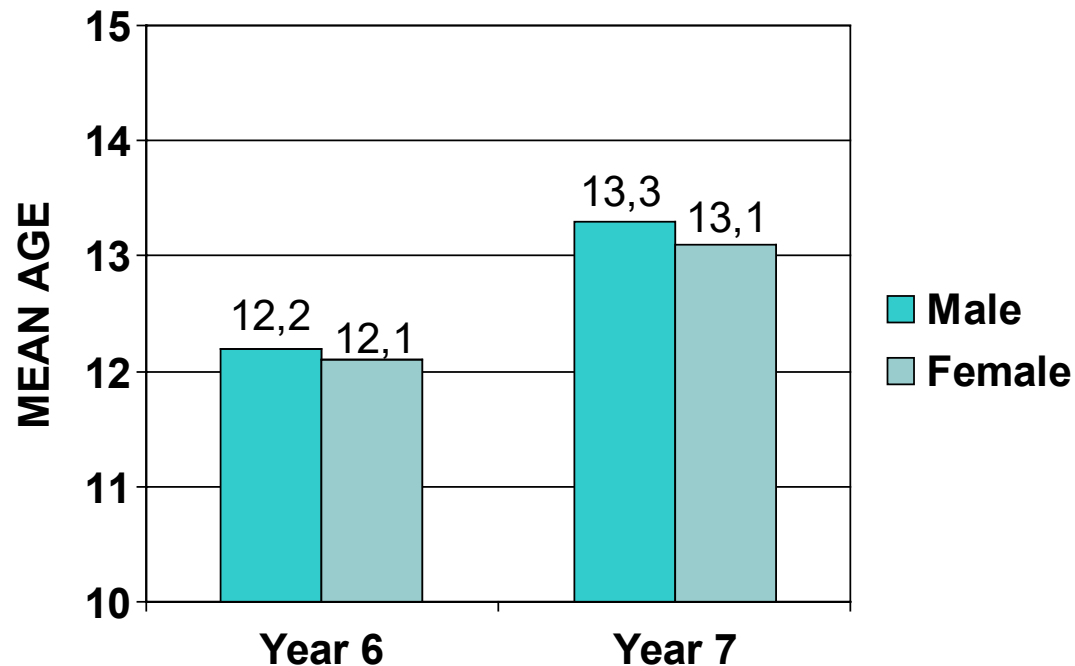

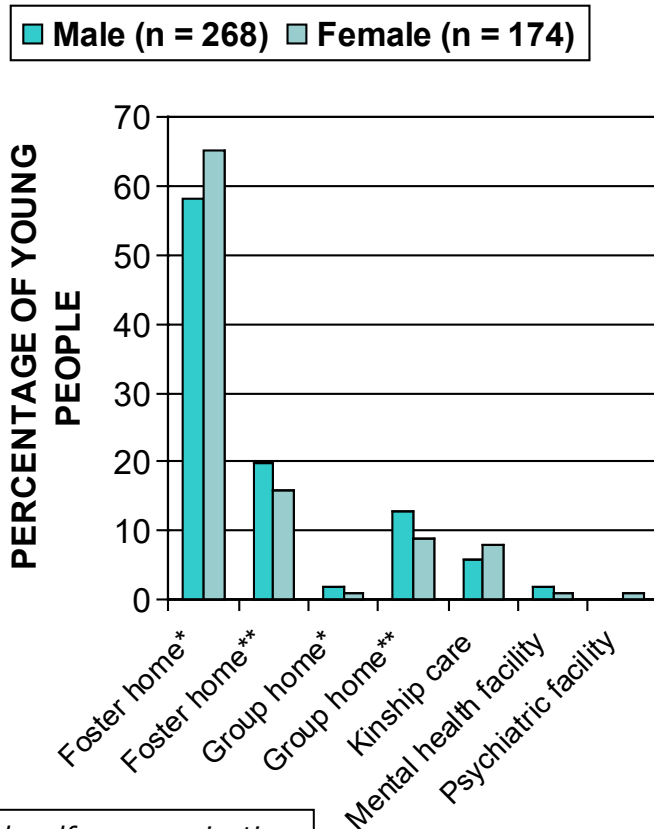
$N = 444$

- Female $n = 174$ (39%)

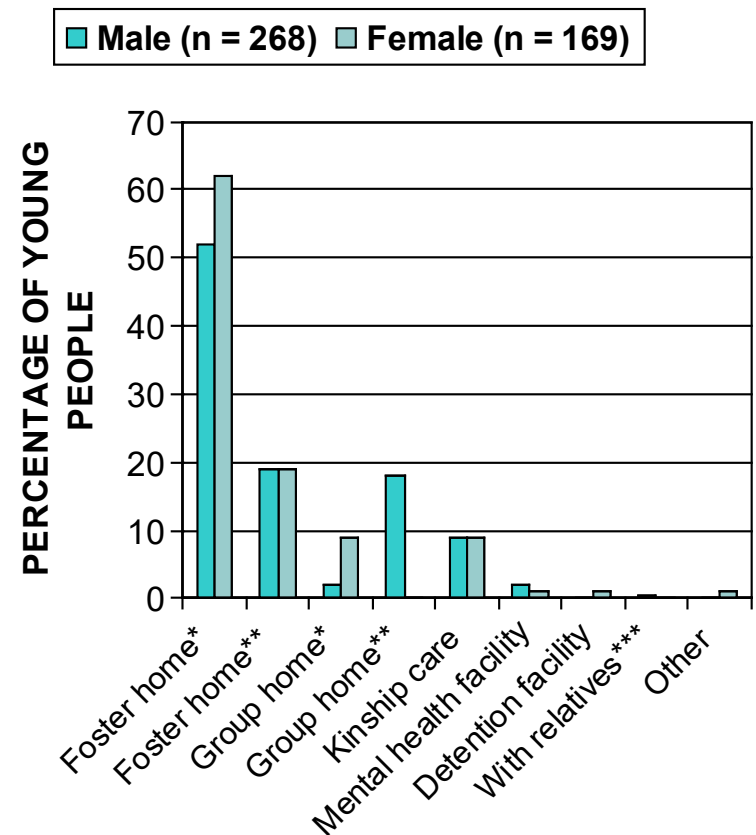


Placement Settings for Males and Females Aged 10-15 Yrs, OnLAC Yrs 6 & 7

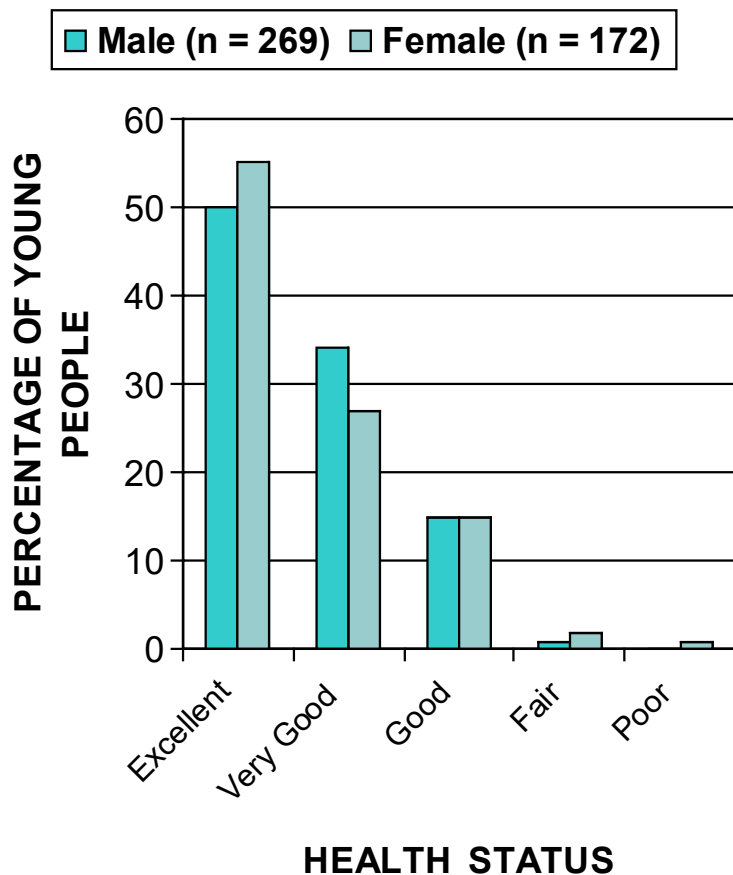

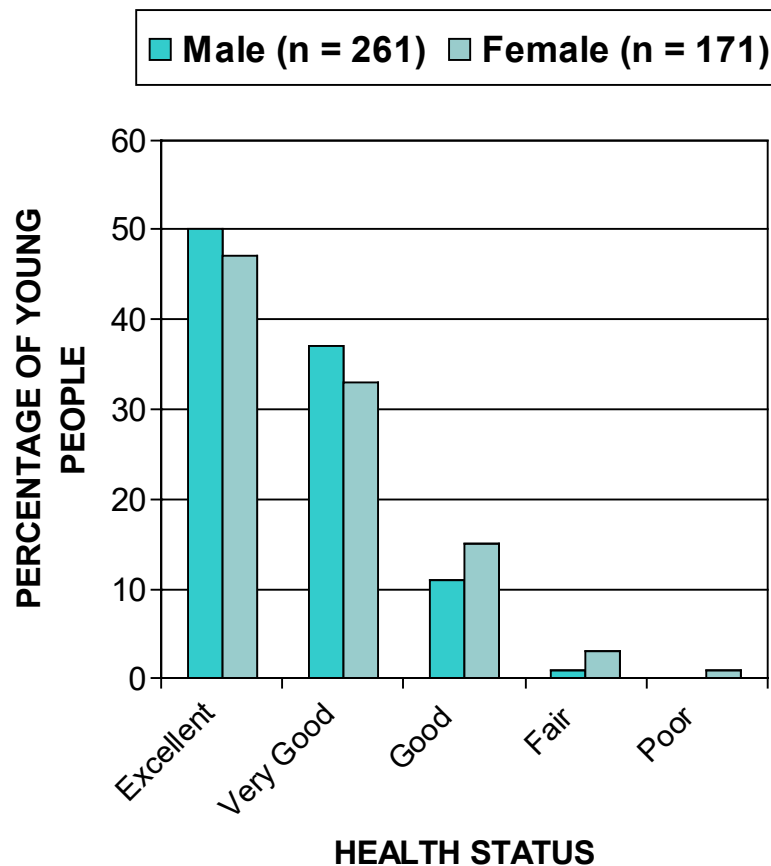

Health Status for Males and Females Aged 10-15 Yrs, OnLAC Yrs 6 & 7

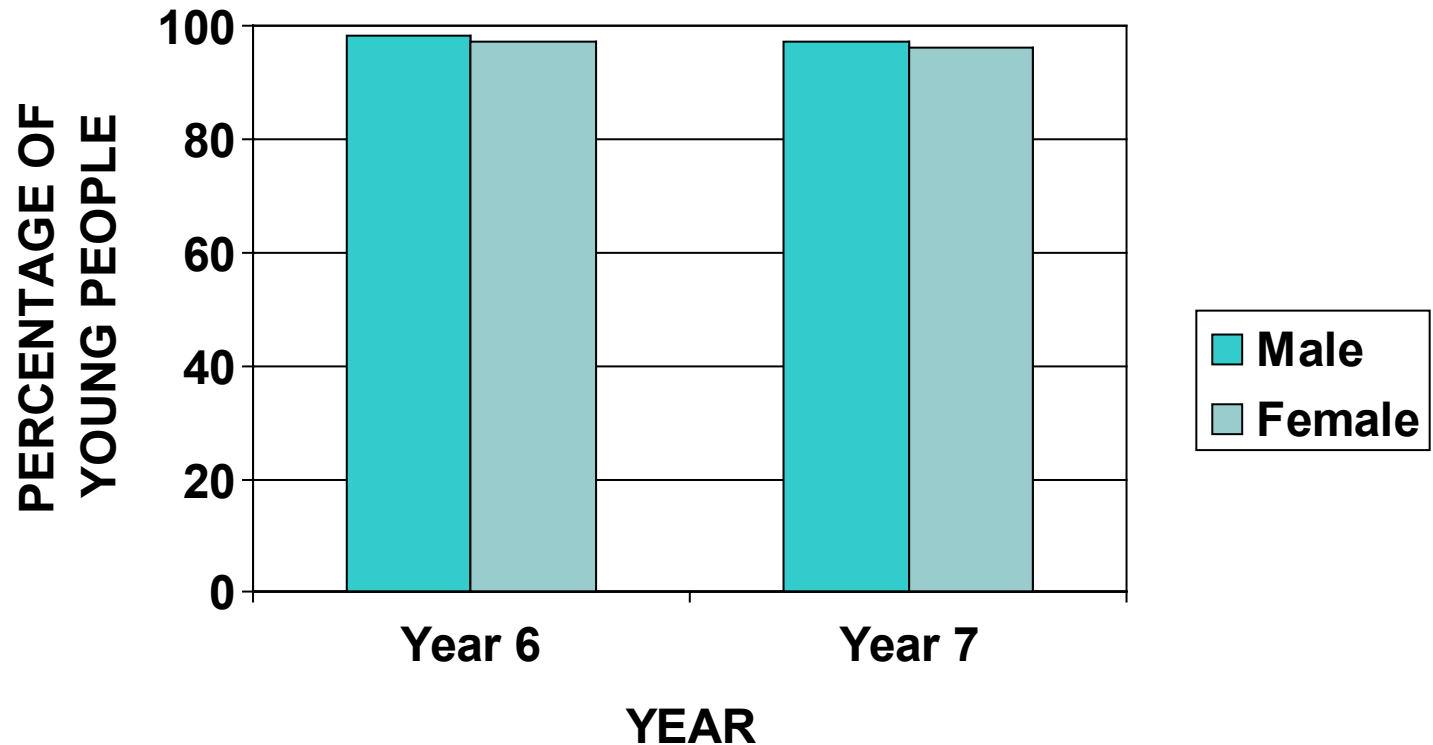

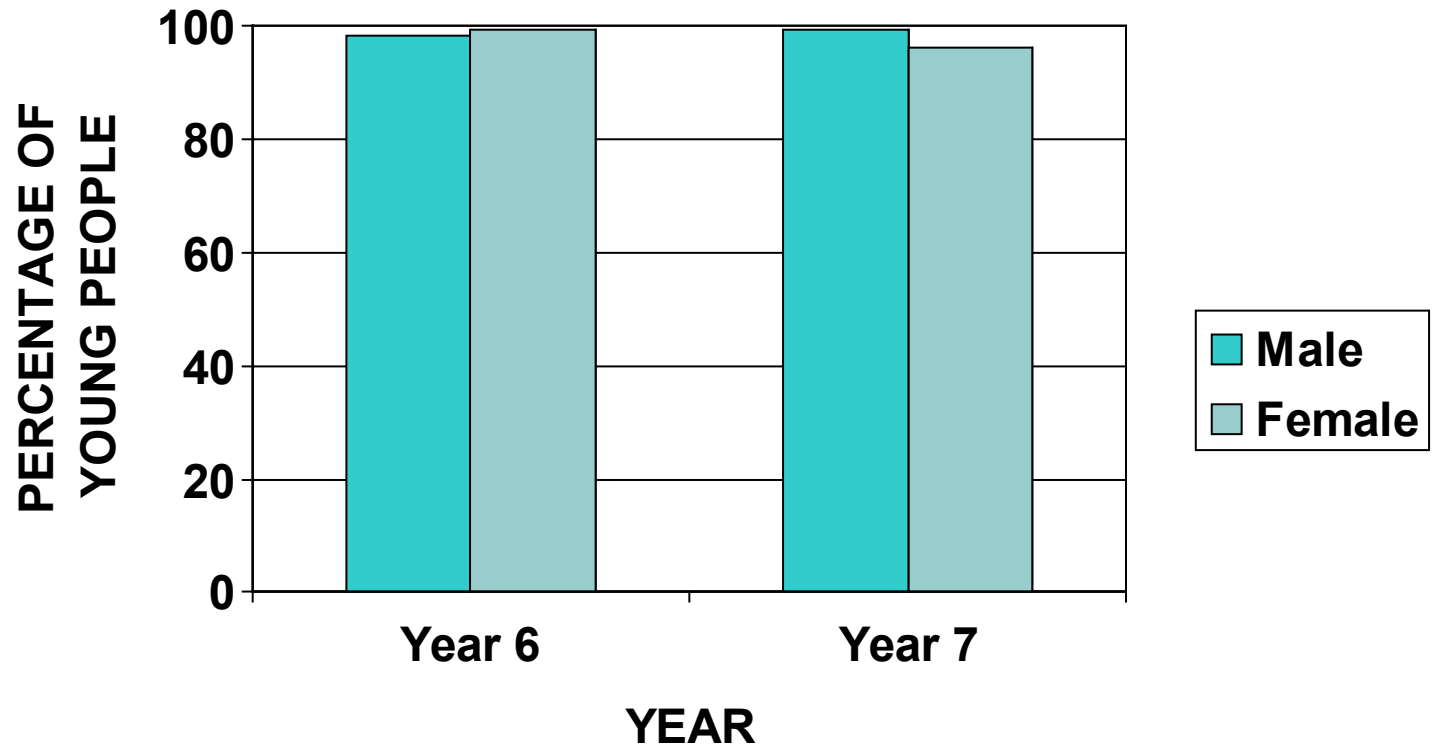


Young People Aged 10-15 Yrs Who Had Had a Medical Exam Within the Last Year, OnLAC Yrs 6 & 7



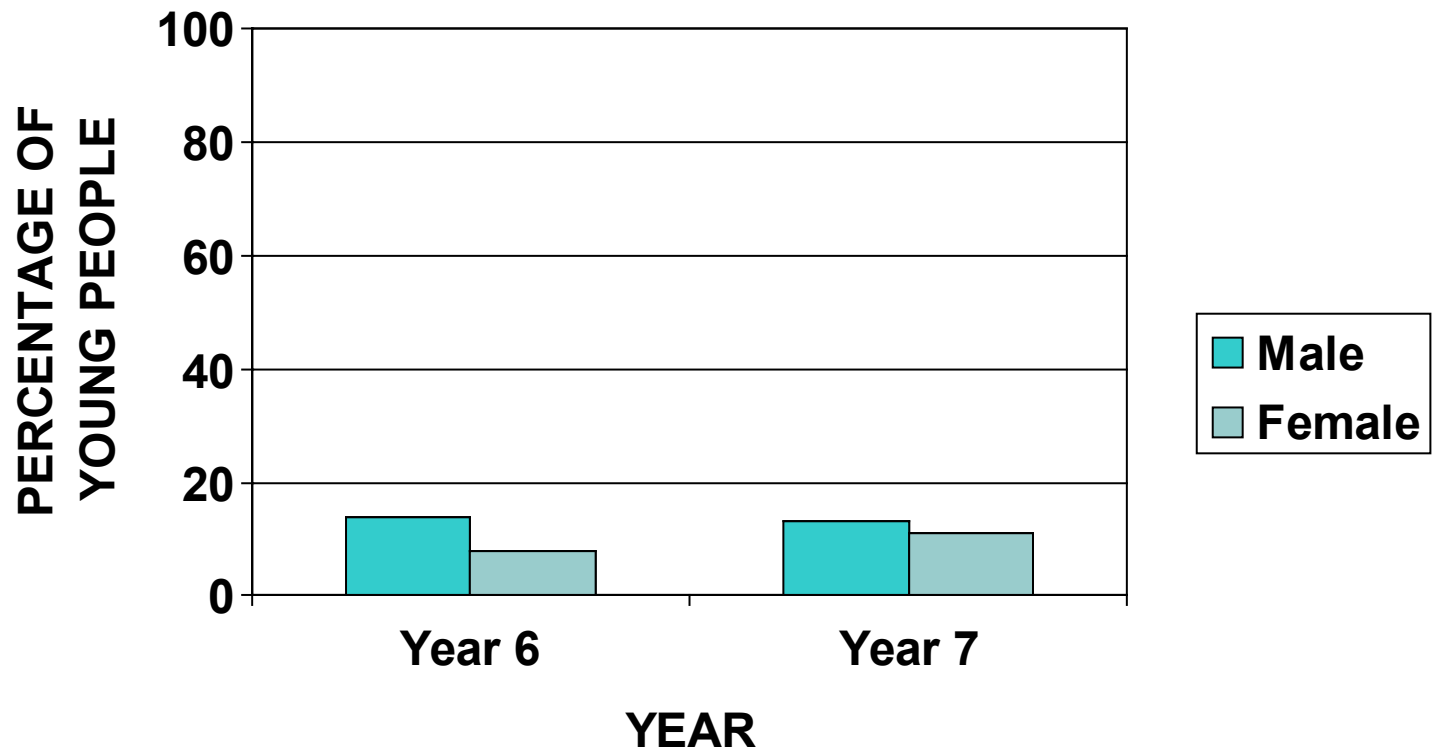

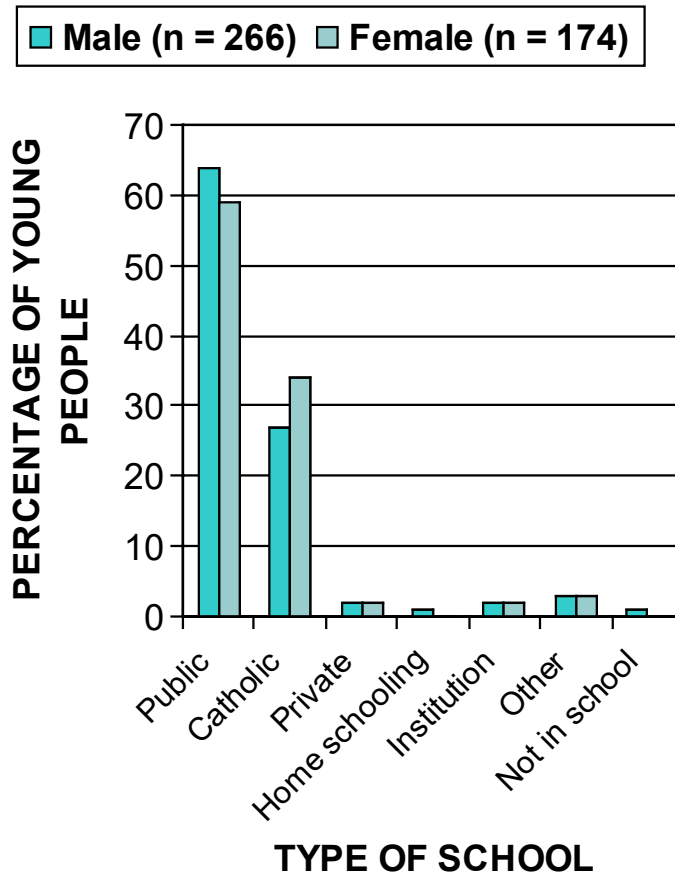
Young People Aged 10-15 Yrs Who Had a Health-Related Disability, OnLAC Yrs 6 & 7



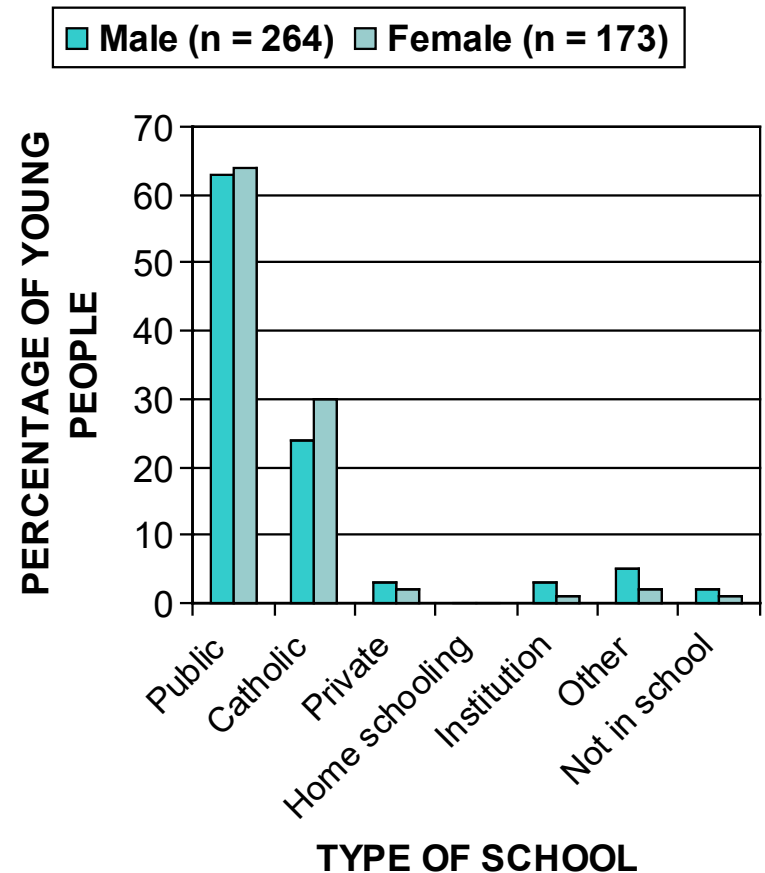

Types of School for Males and Females Aged 10-15 Yrs, OnLAC Yrs 6 & 7

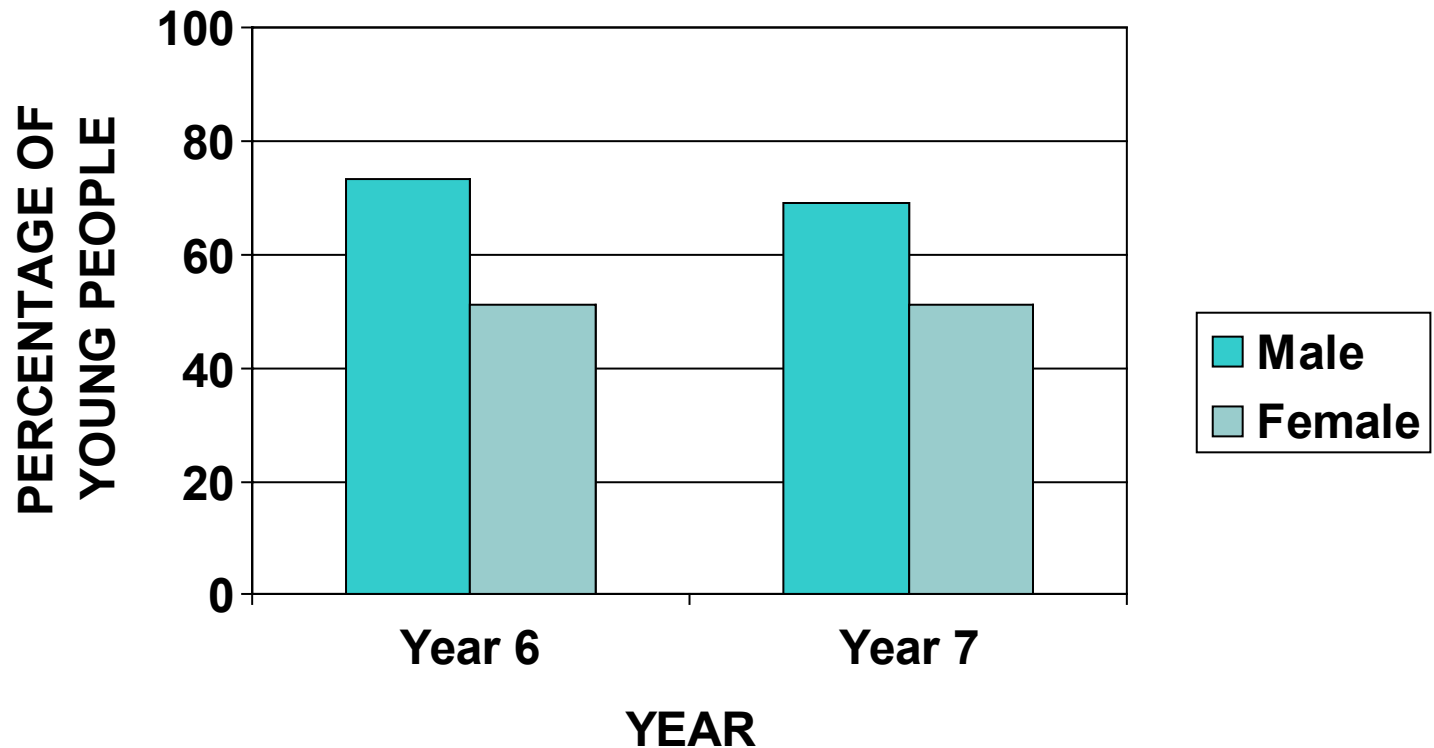

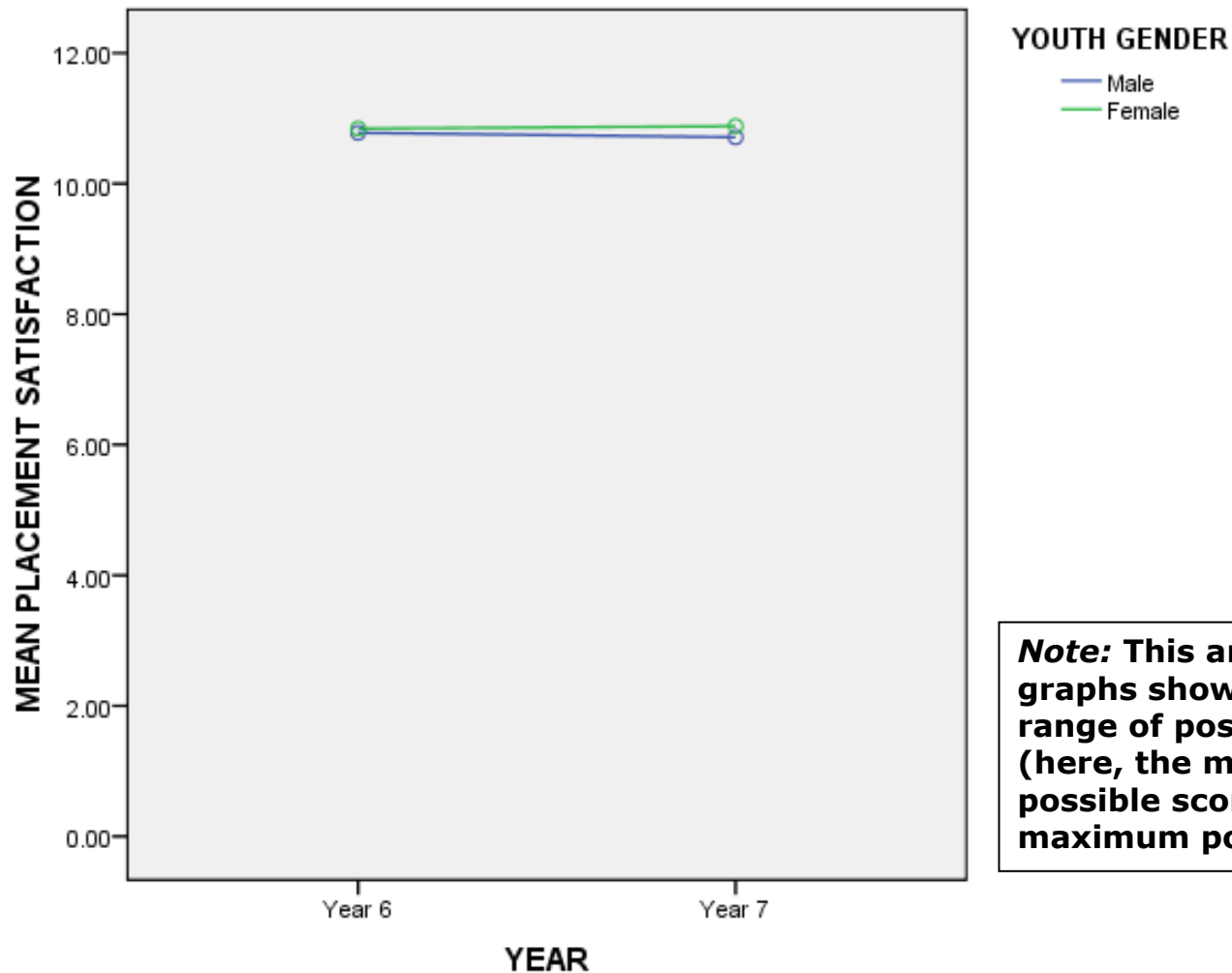


Young People Aged 10-15 Yrs Who Had an Education-Related Disability, OnLAC Yrs 6 & 7



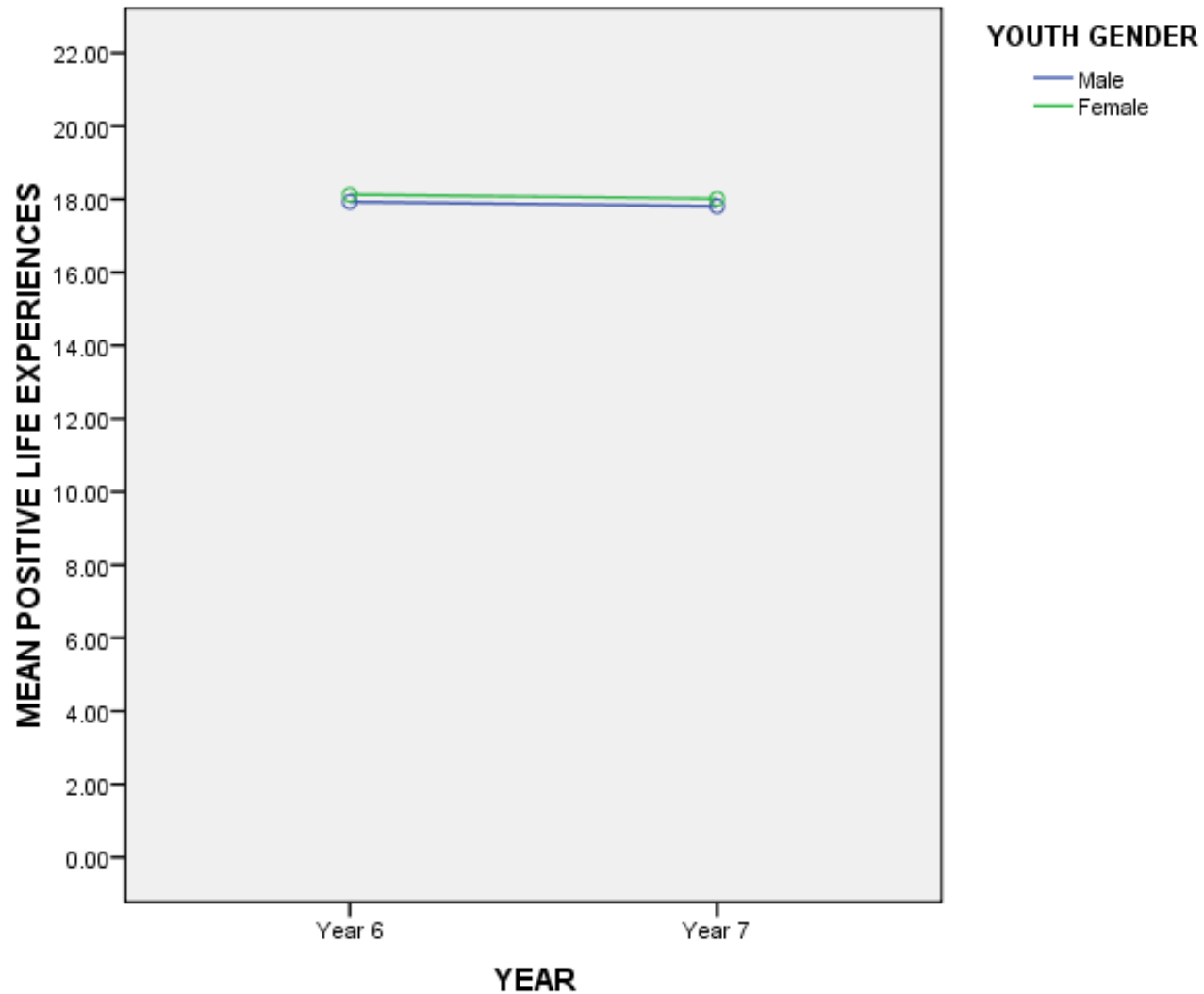

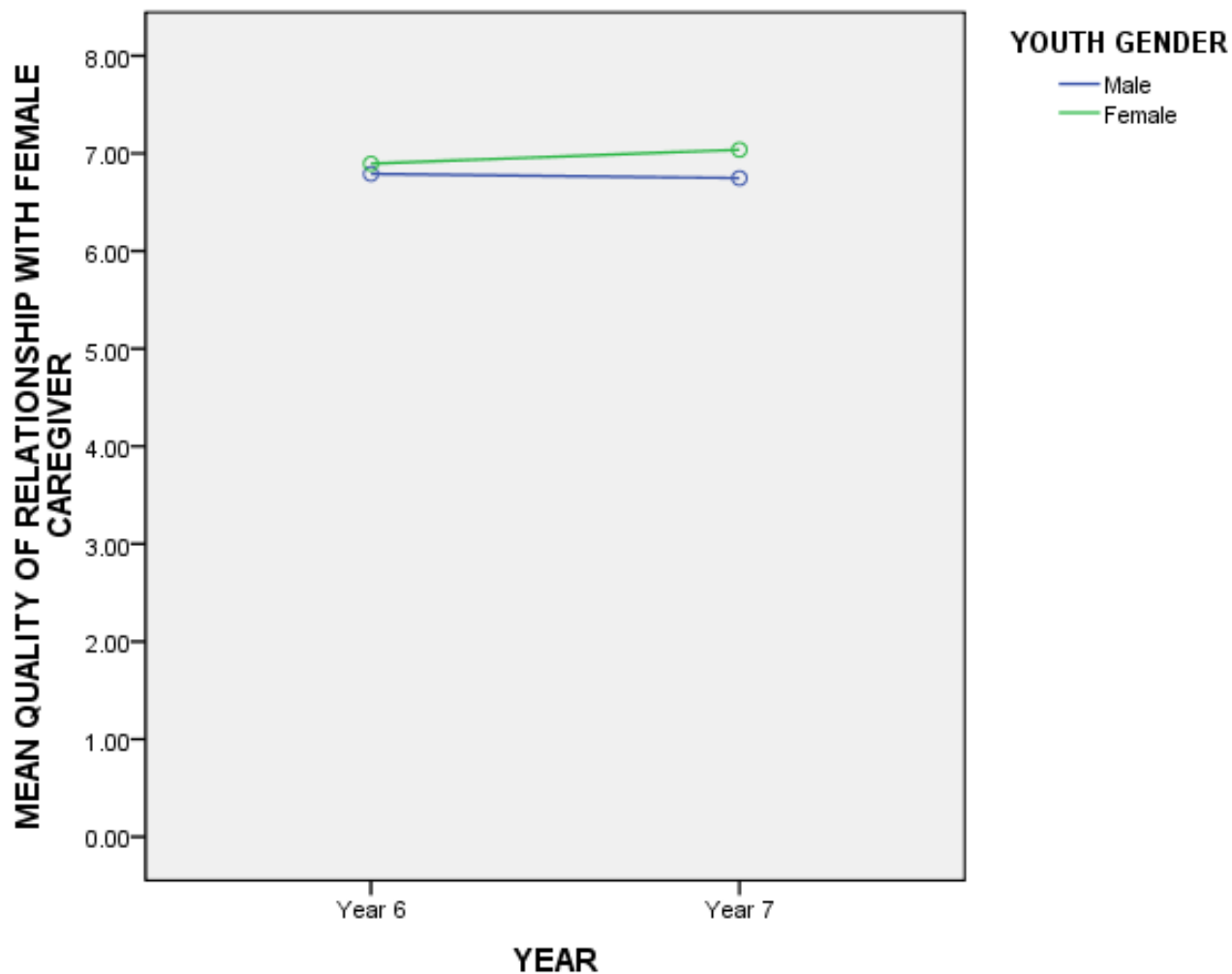

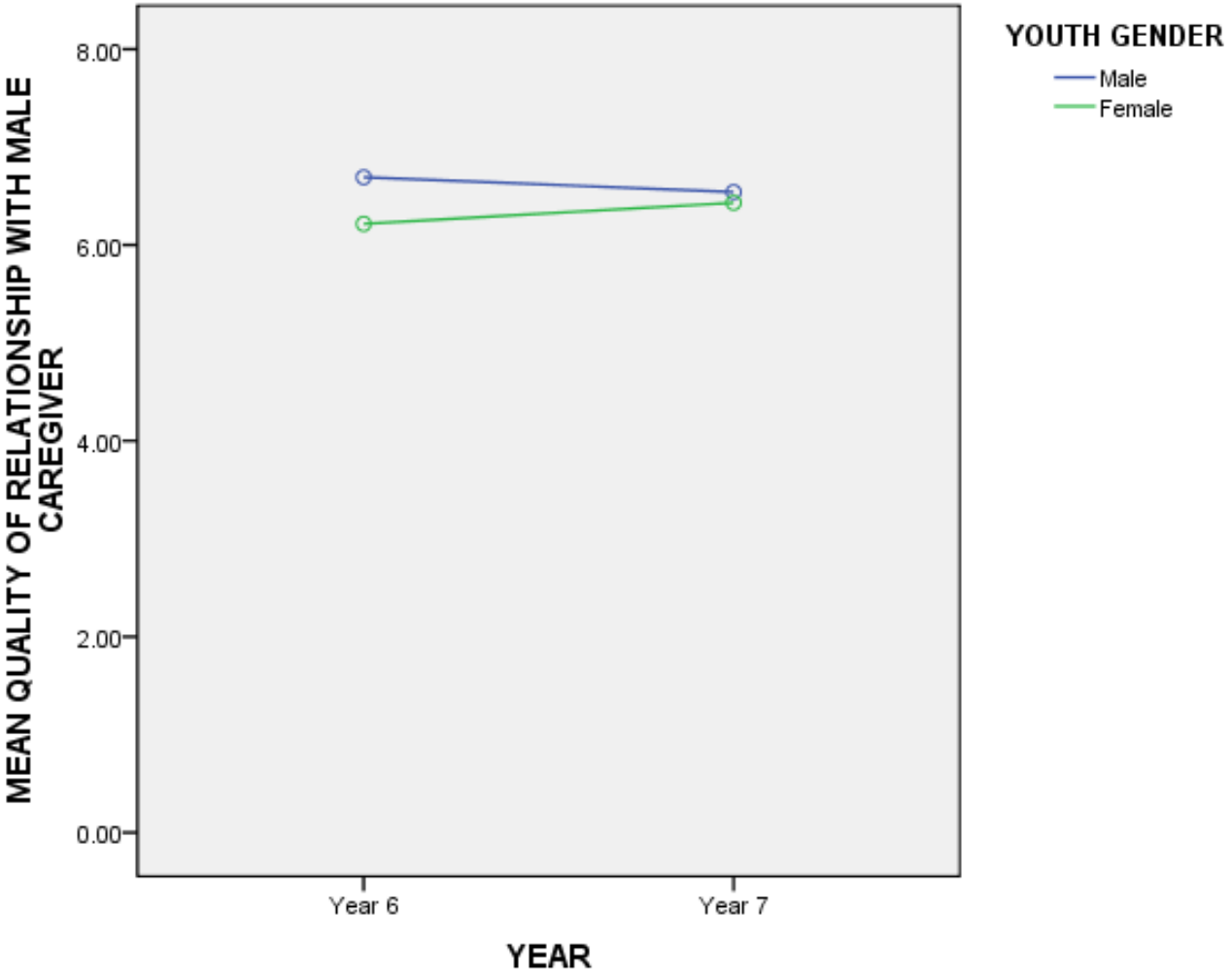

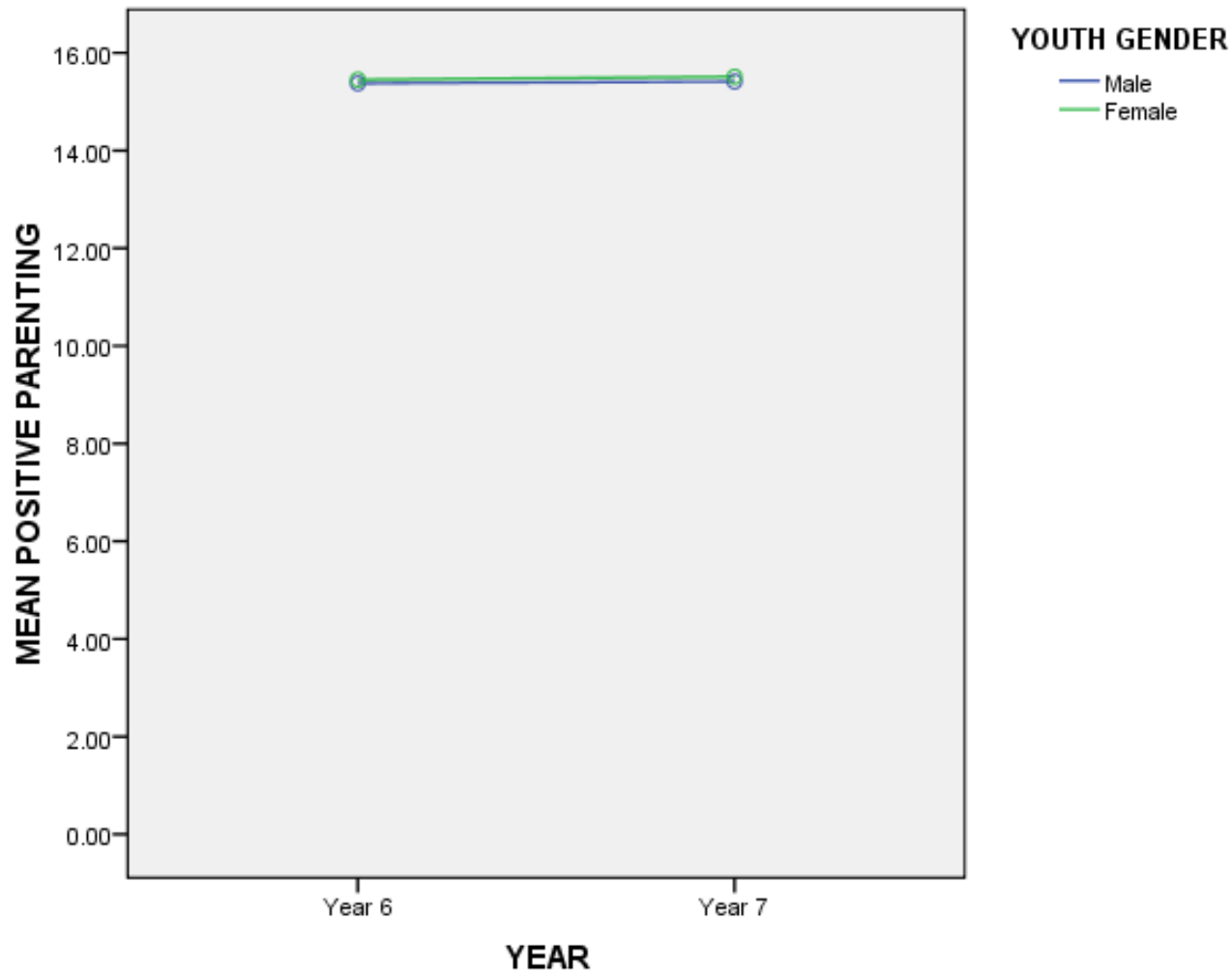

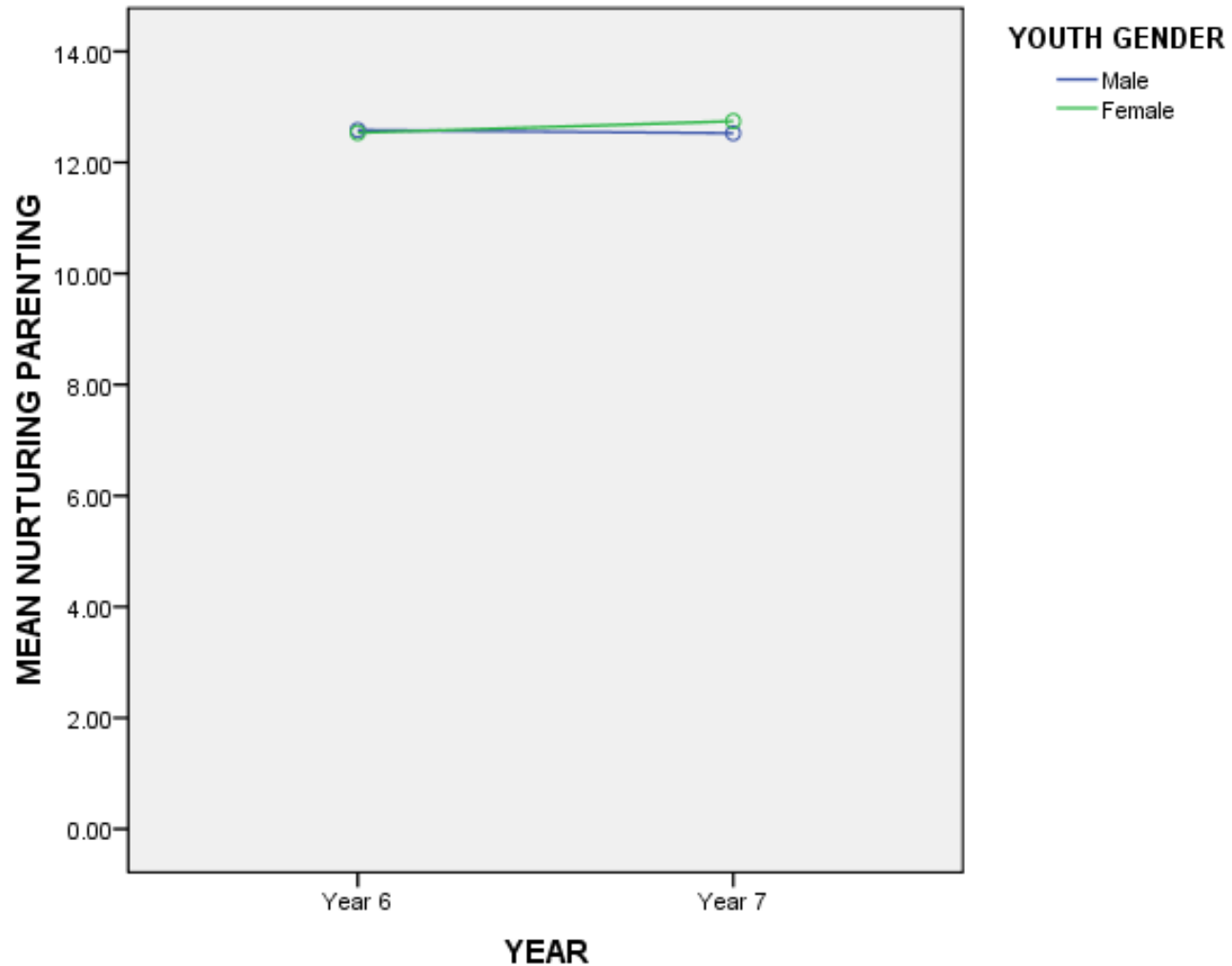

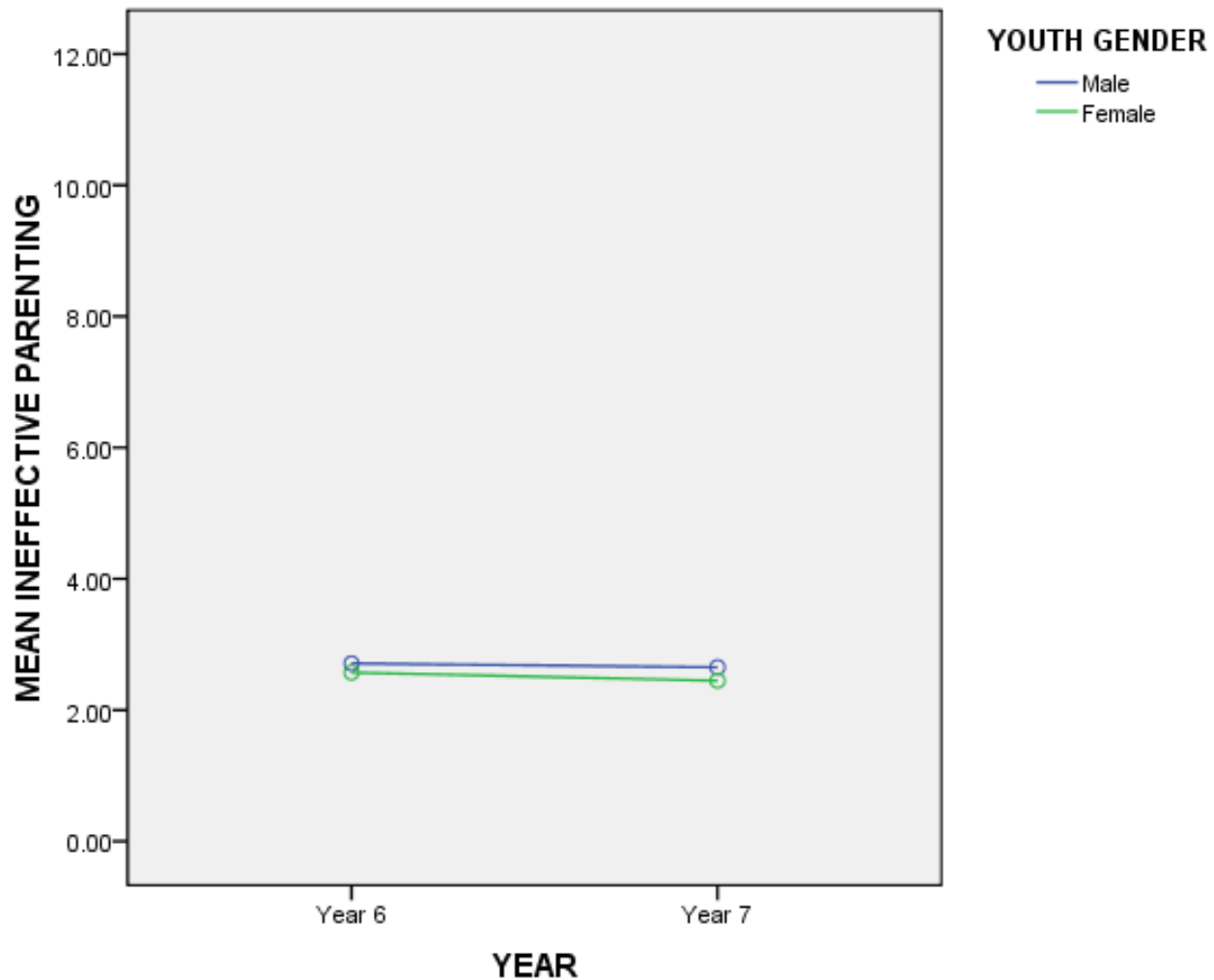

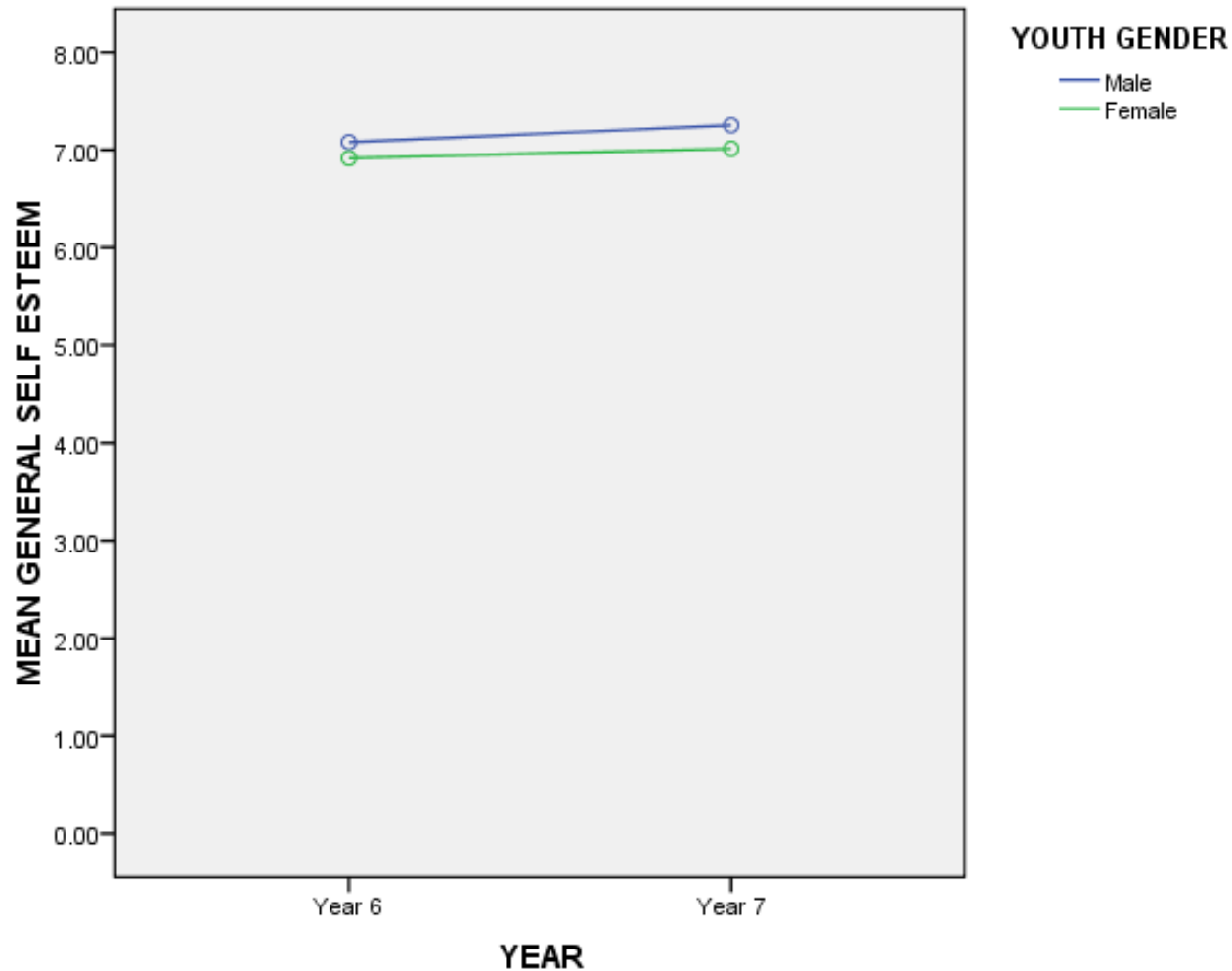

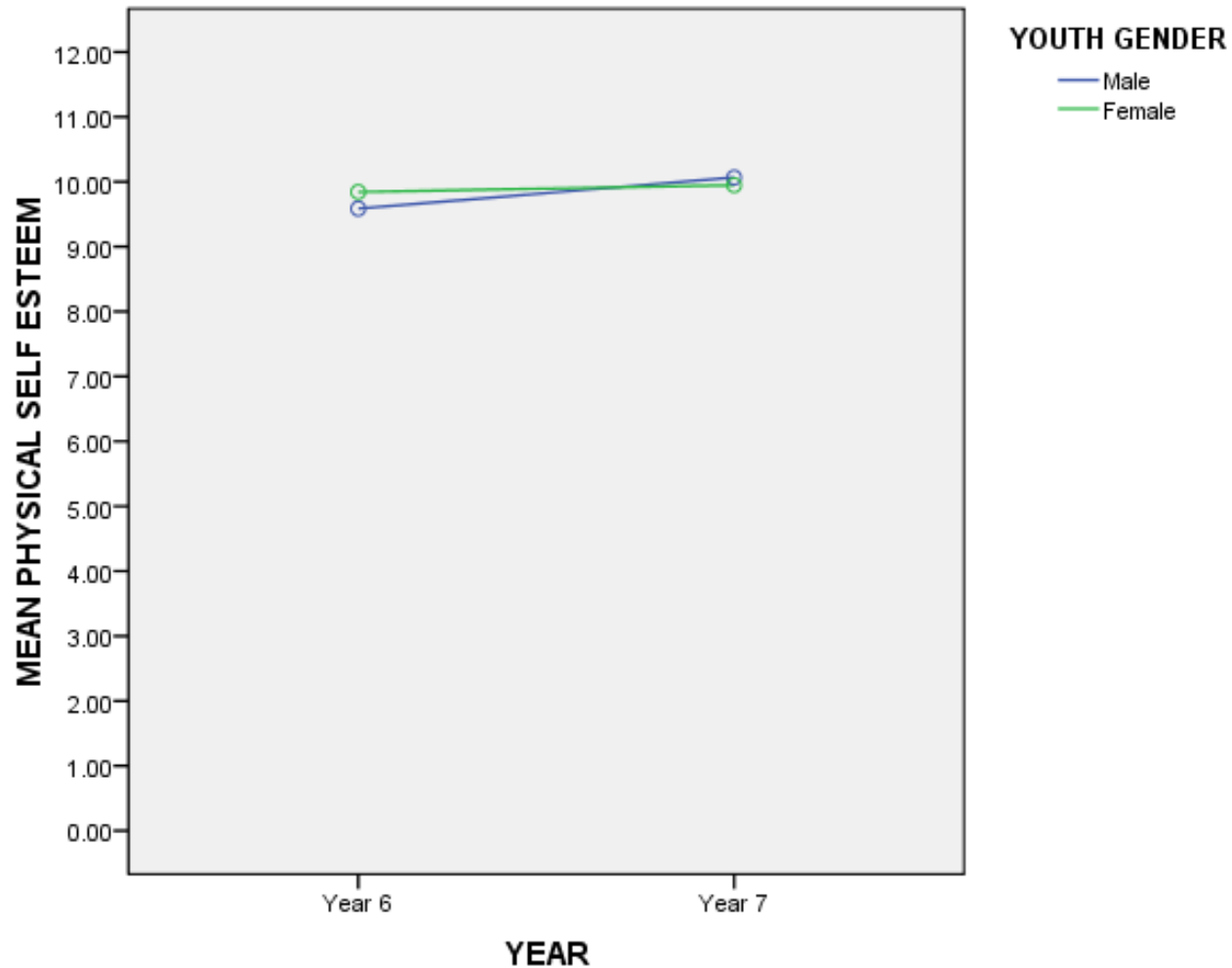

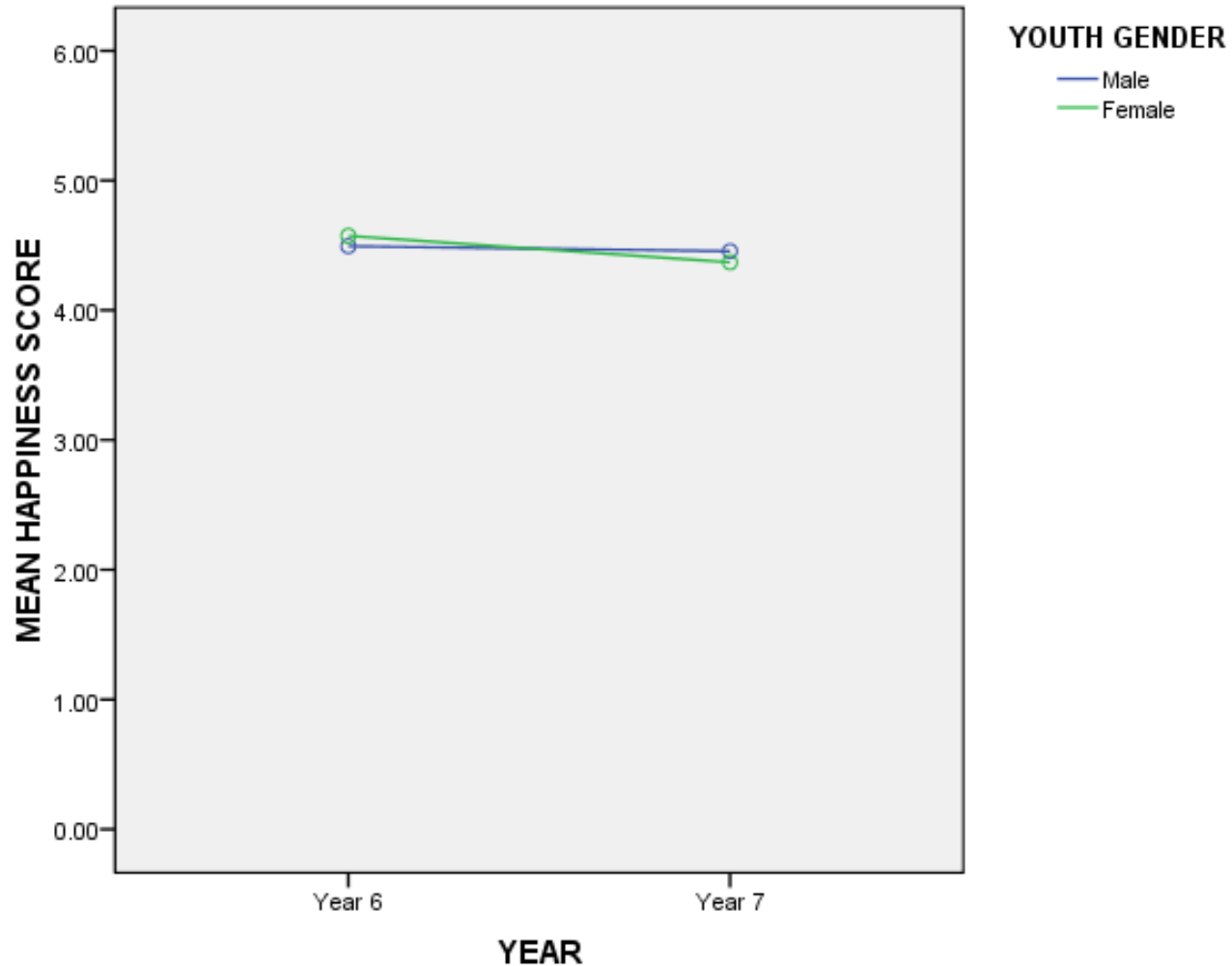

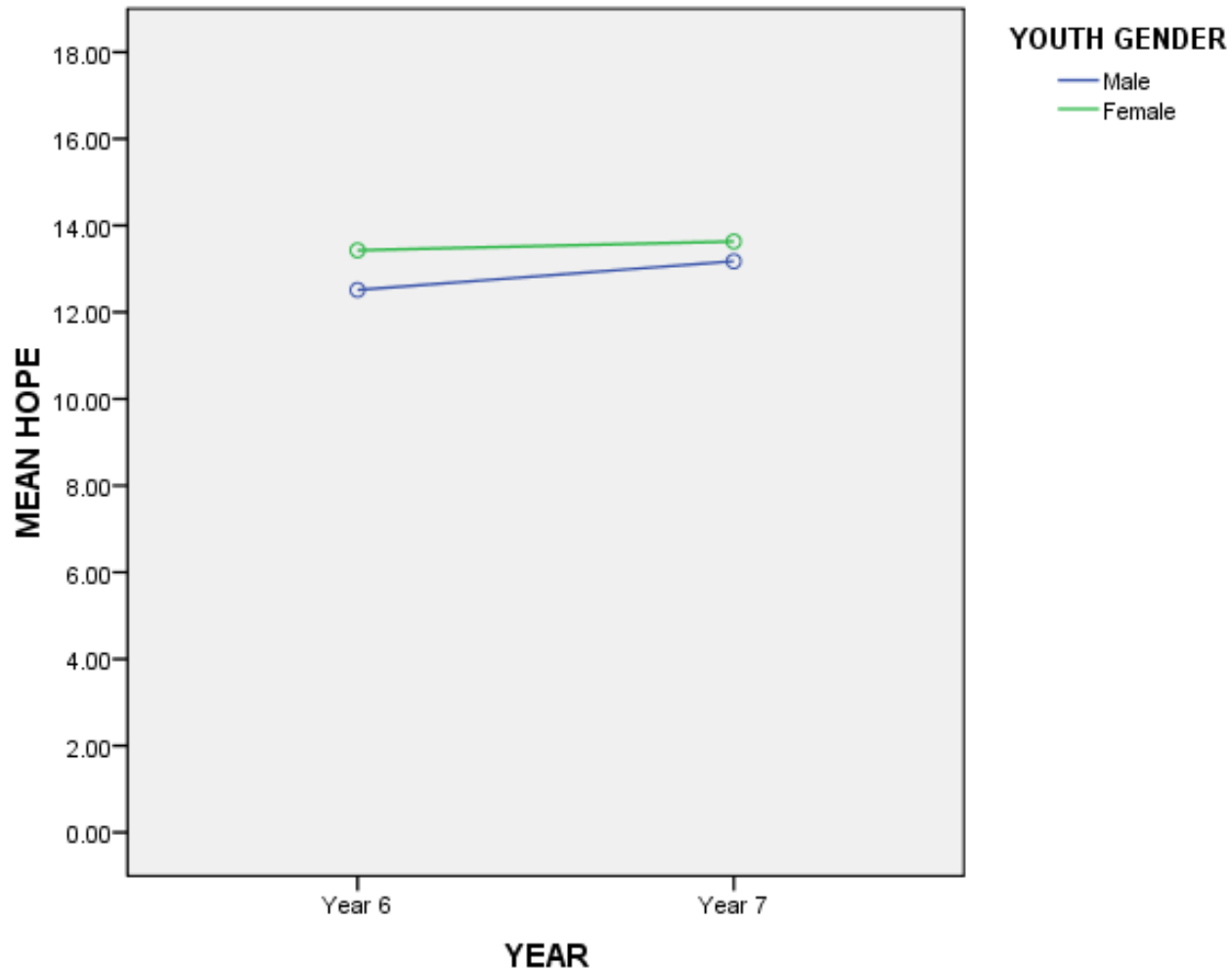

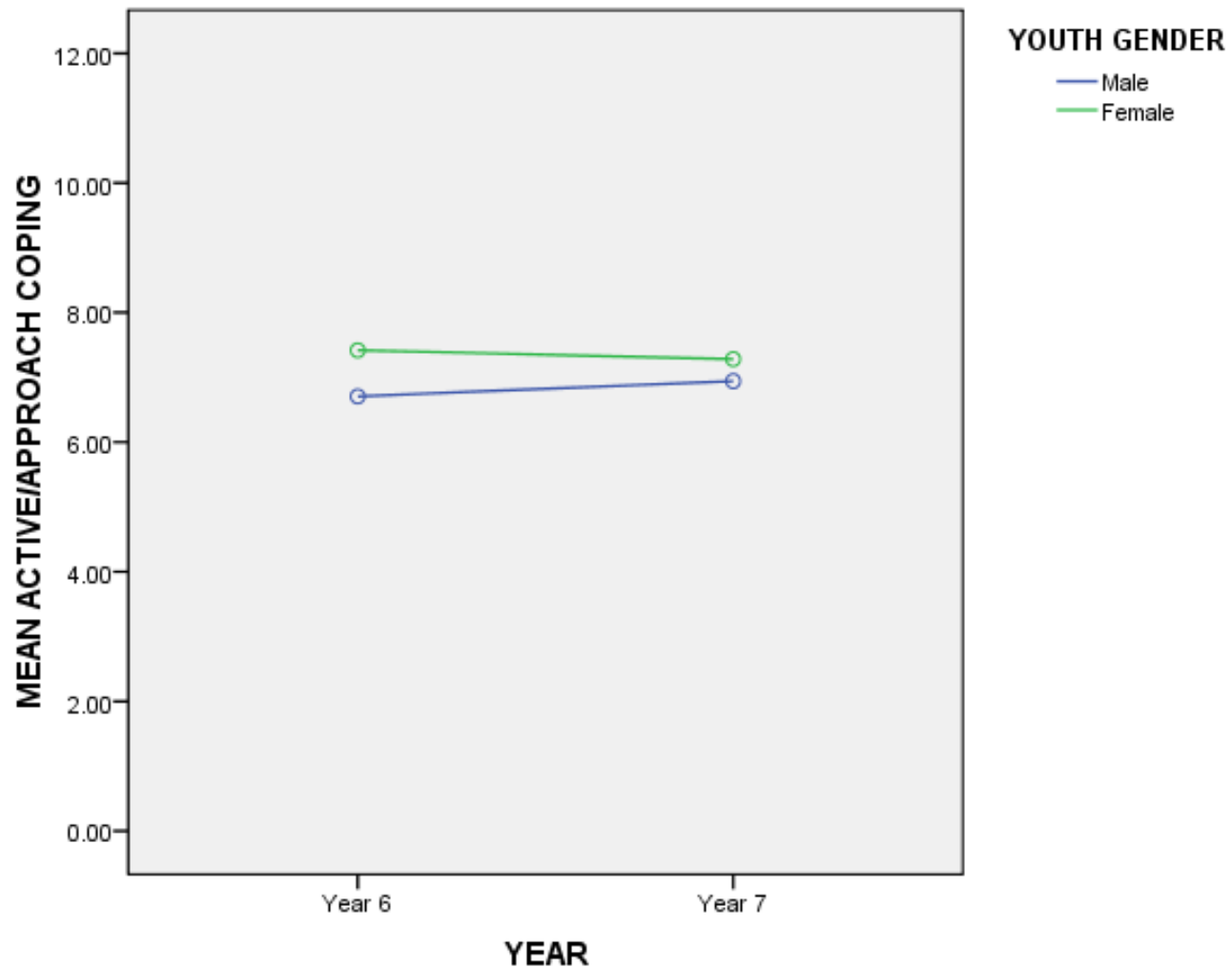

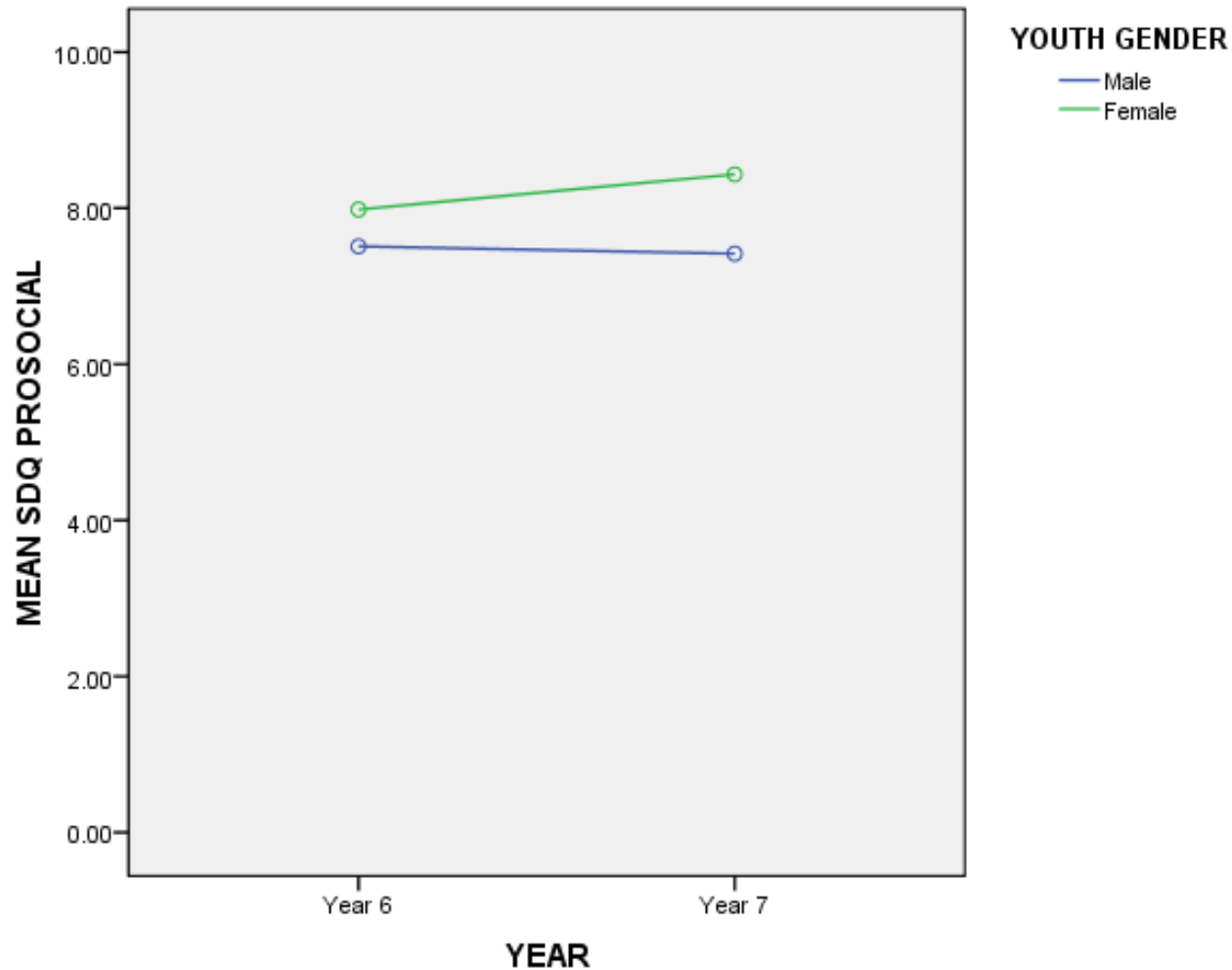
Mean Hope Score, for Males ($n = 154$) & Females ($n = 103$) Aged 10-15 Yrs, OnLAC Yrs 6 & 7



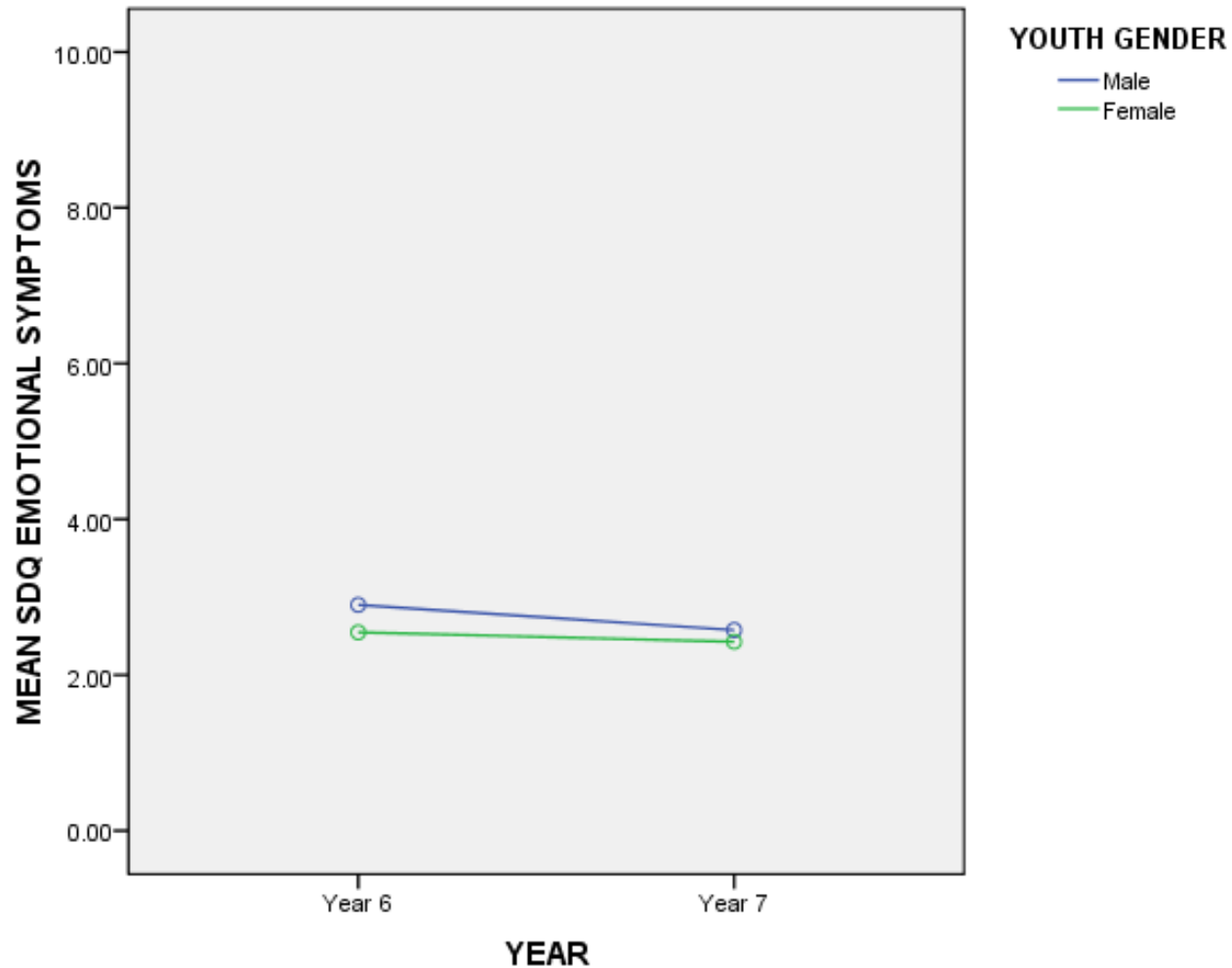

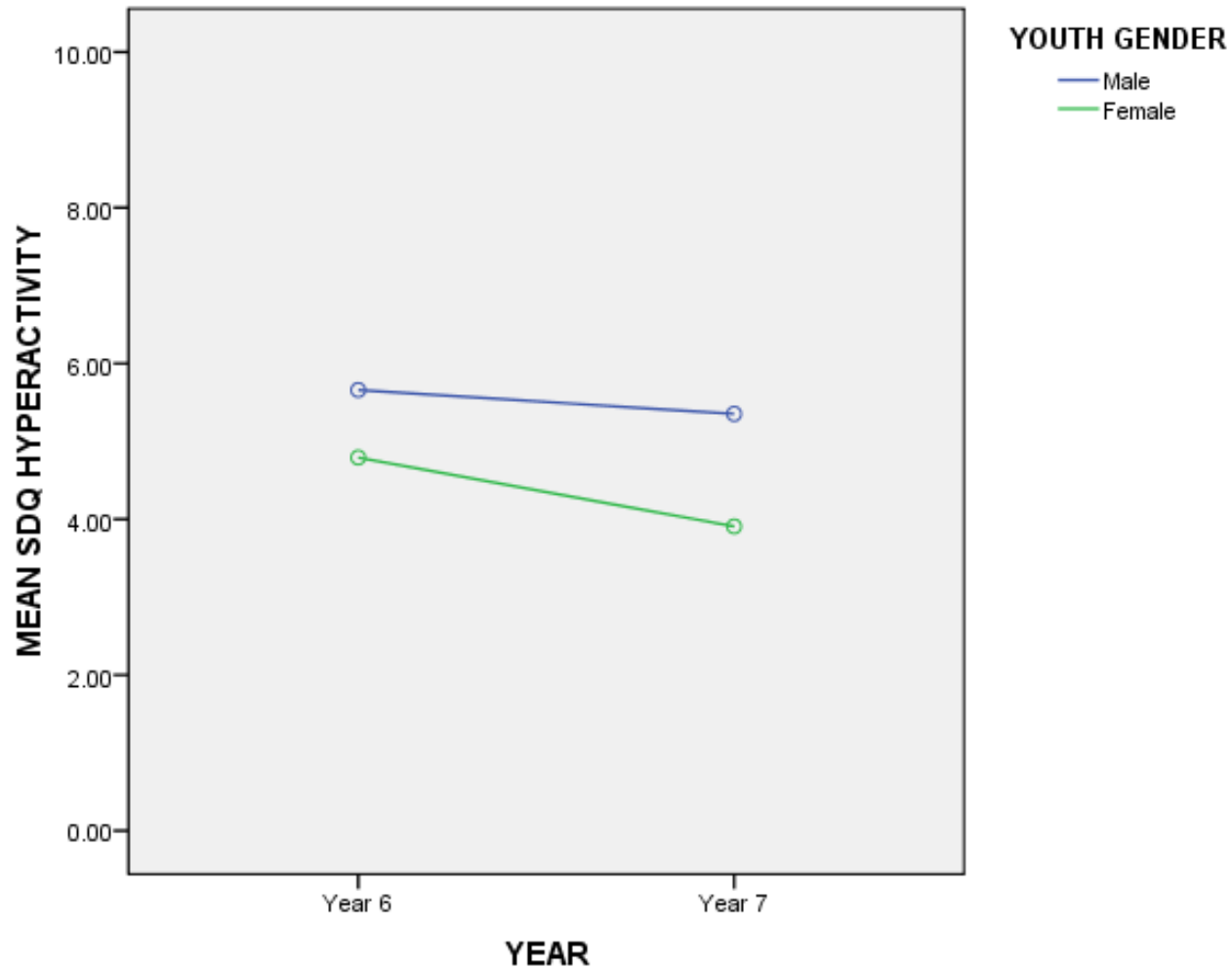

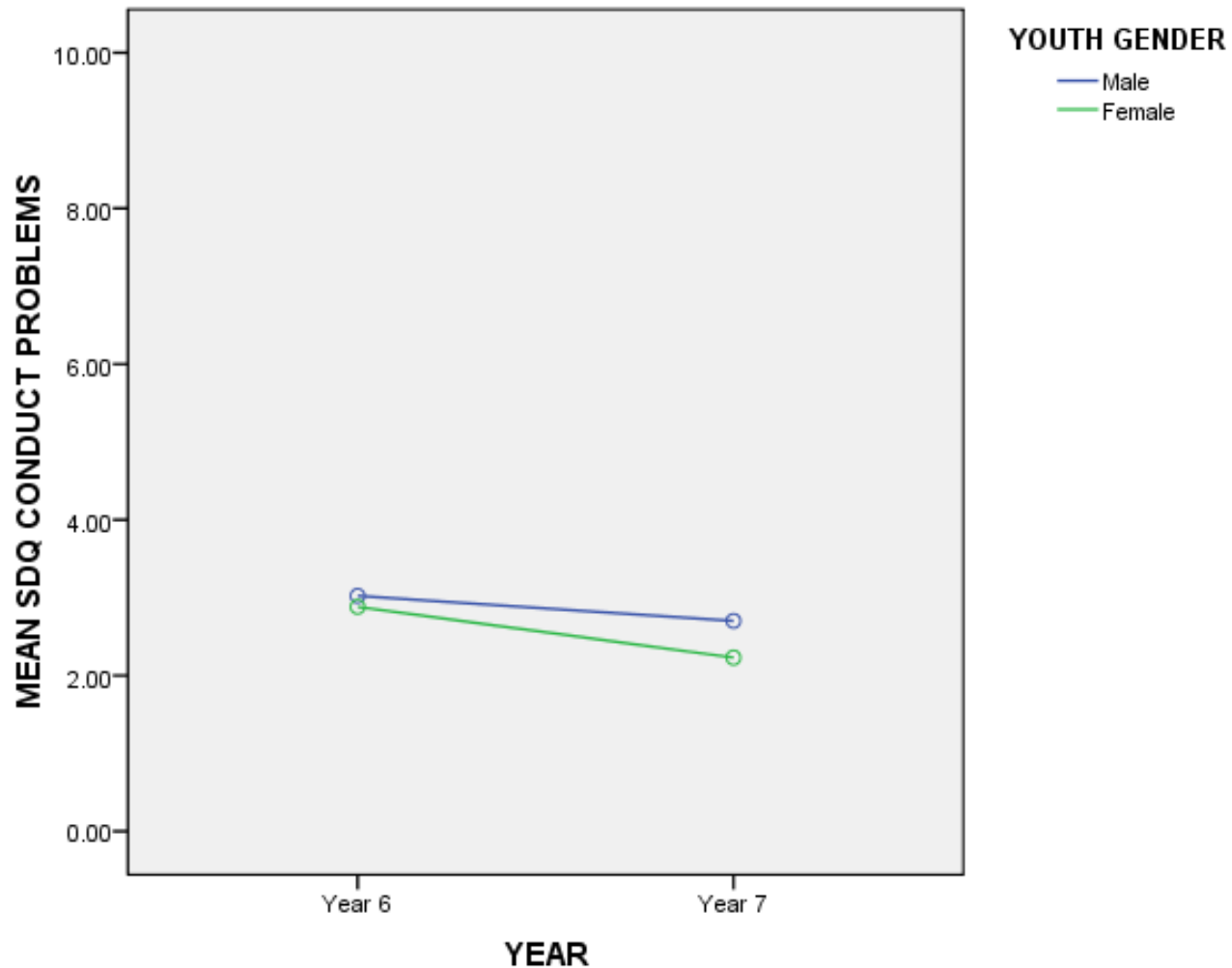

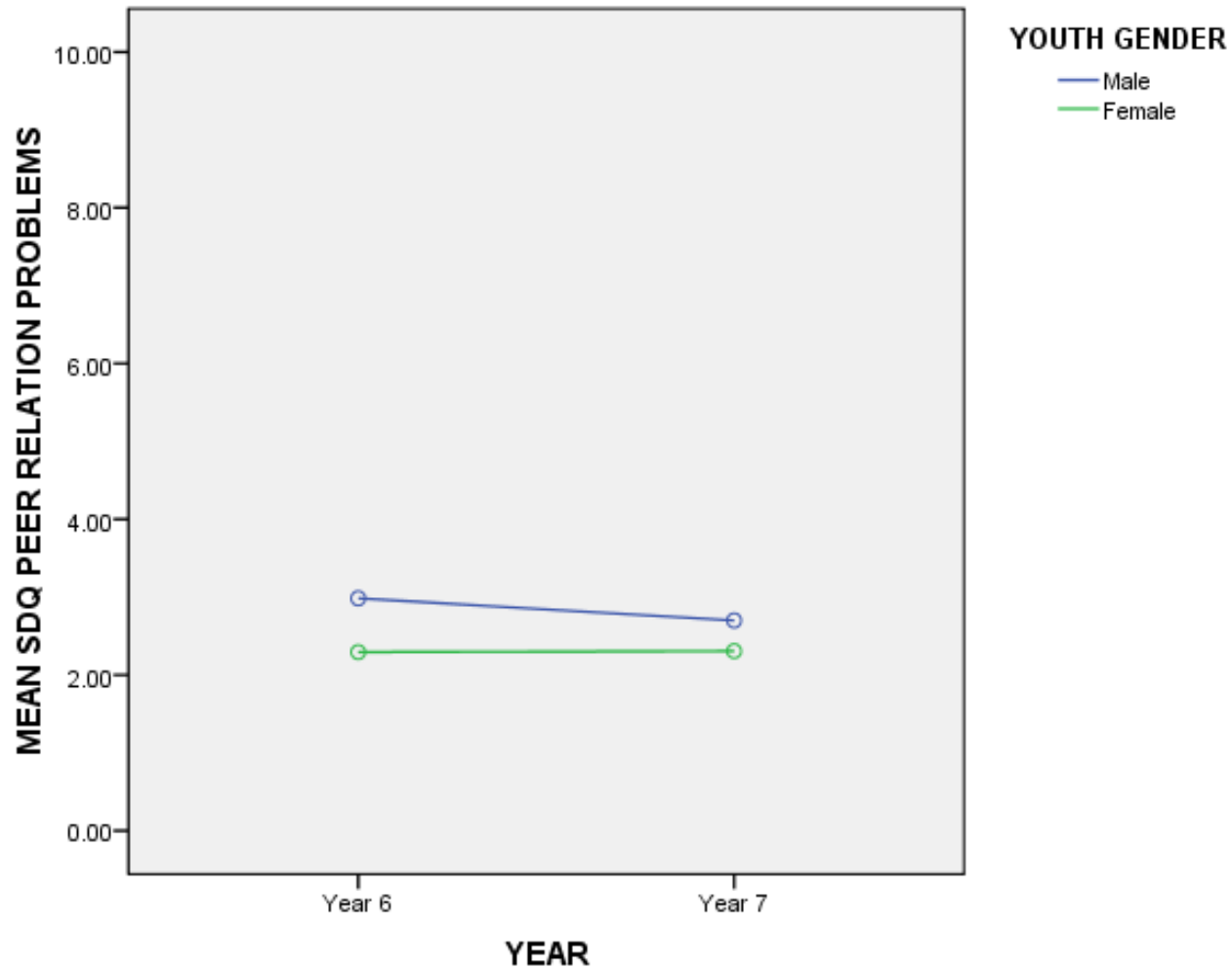

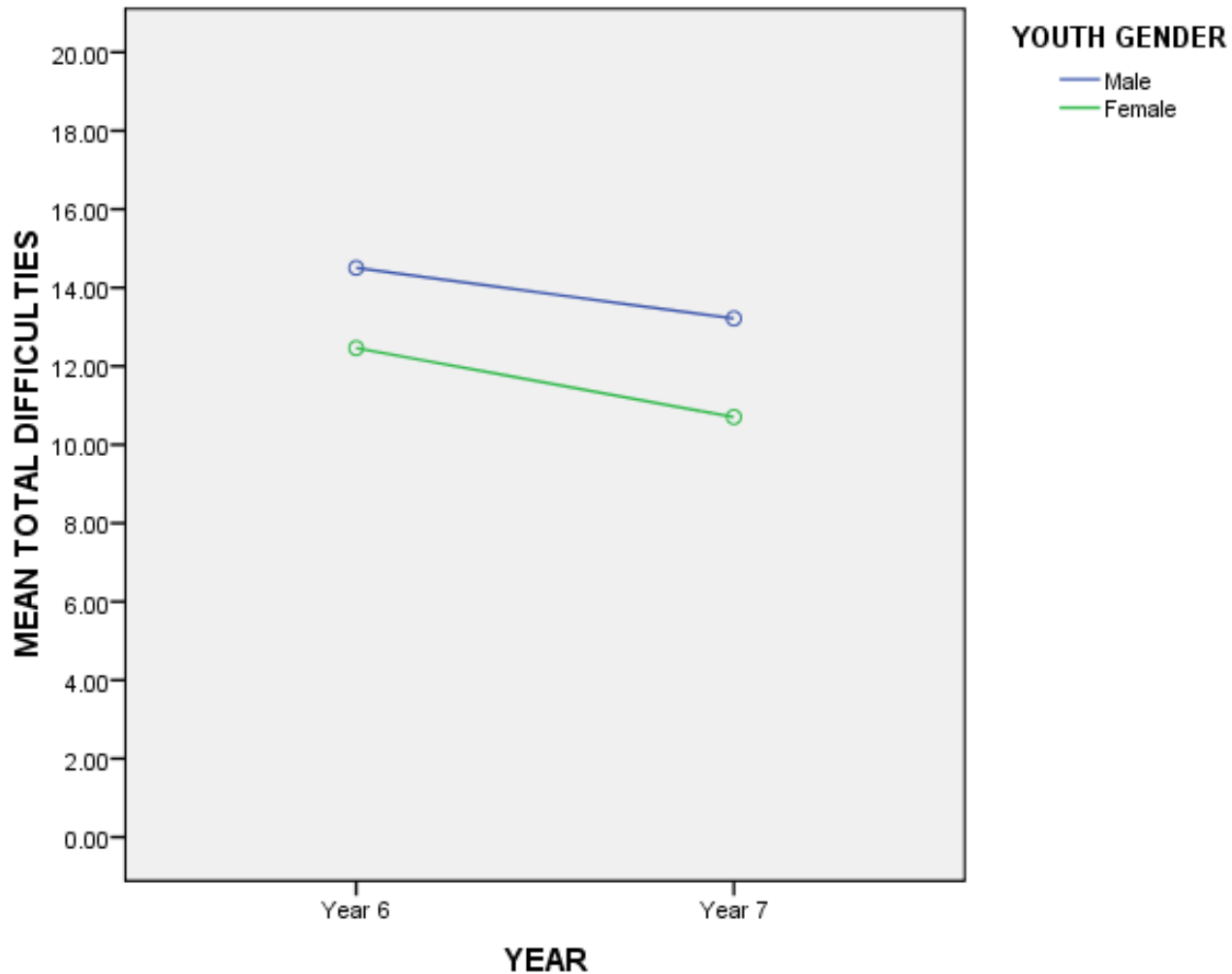

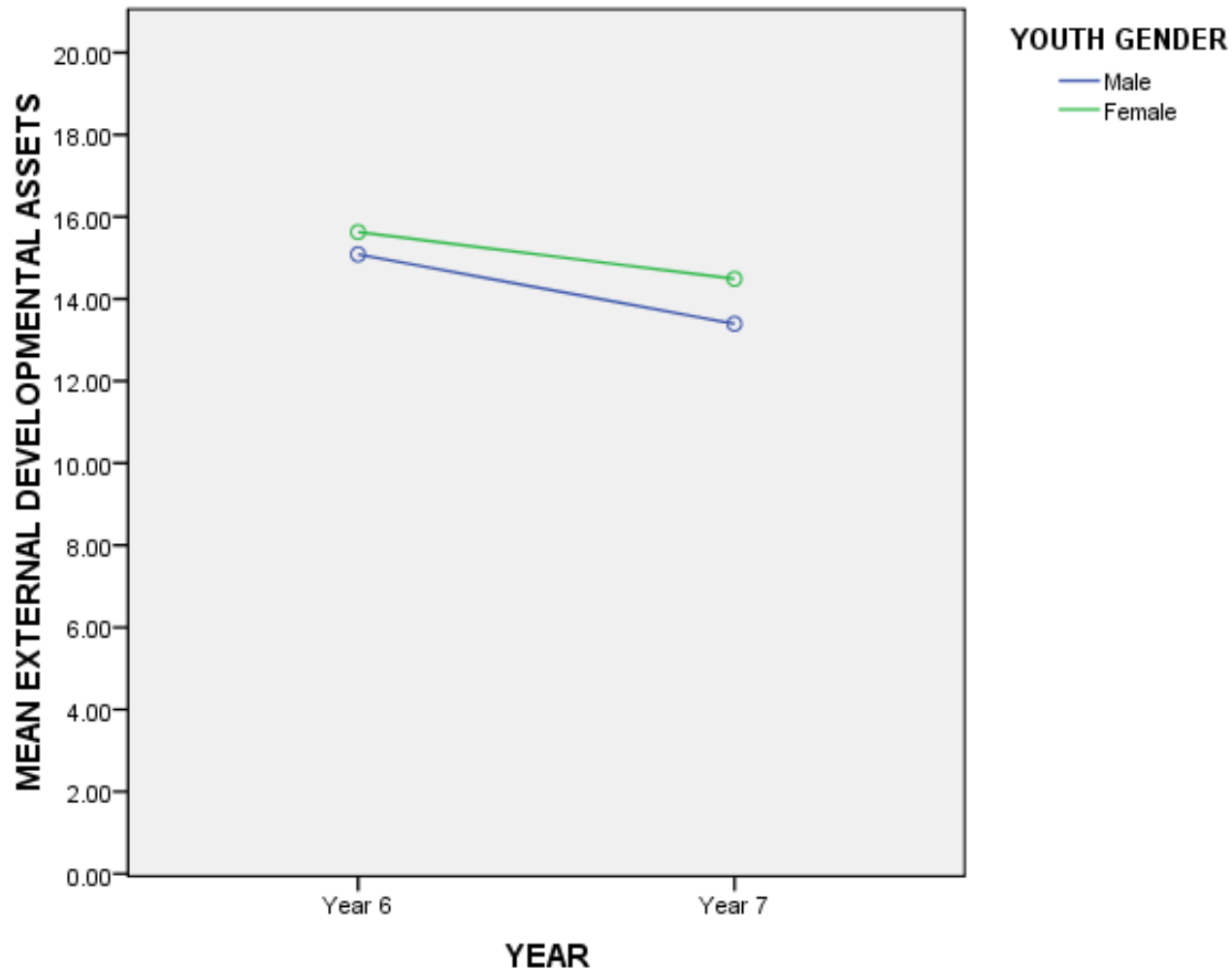

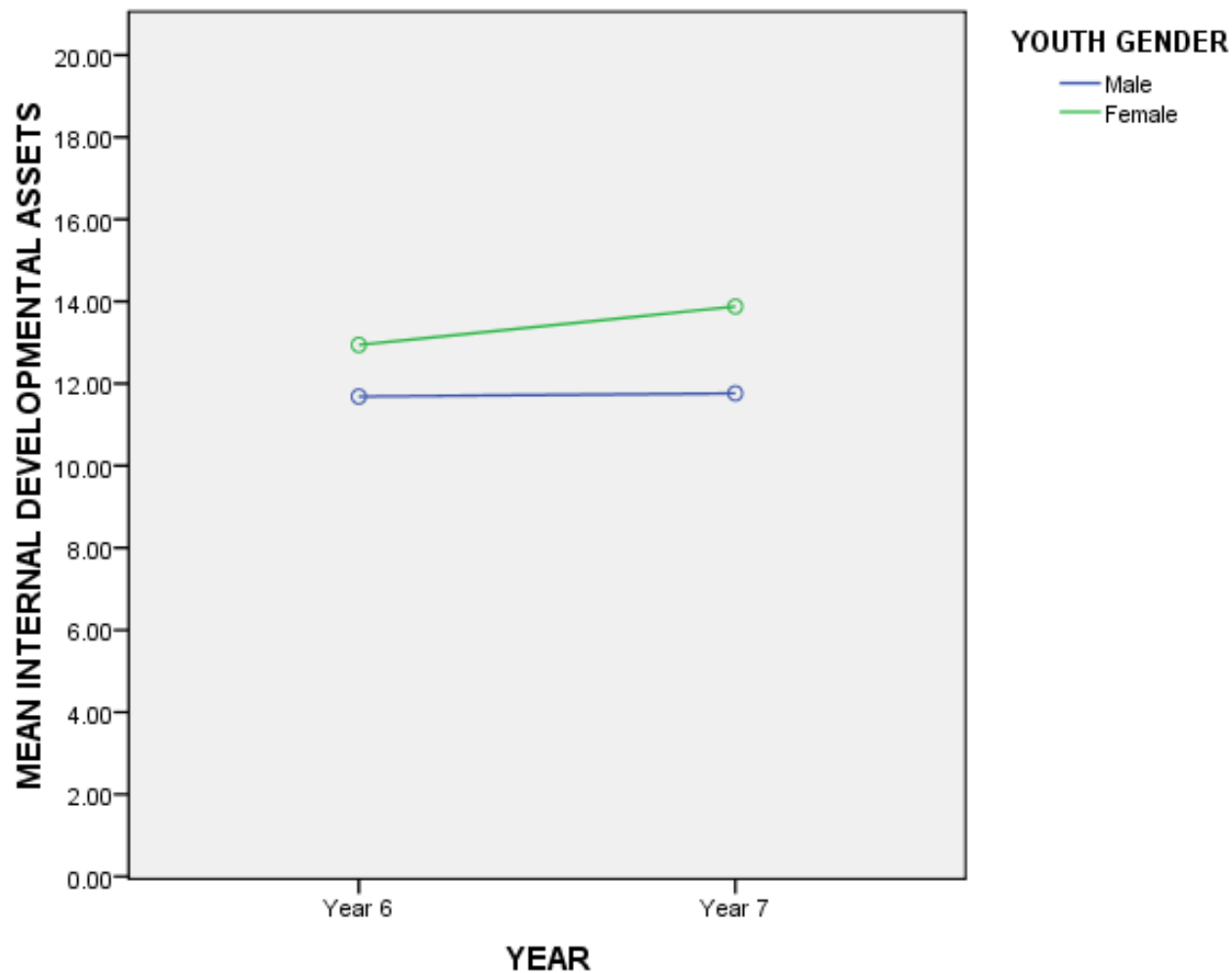
