To all staff,

This notification is to inform you that the outbreak of COVID-19 that was declared on April 1, 2022 at the Saskatoon Correctional Centre has been declared over by the Medical Health Officer.

An assessment of risk will be completed by SCC personnel and the Occupational Health and Safety Branch to determine next steps regarding the de-escalation of COVID-19 measures. Until that occurs, SCC will remain in the Phase 0 stage of the de-escalation of COVID-19 measures protocol. As we move forward, this assessment will be continually reviewed and adjusted as necessary. Should the decision be made to transition to Phase 1, further messaging will occur.

In summary, other than the outbreak being declared over, everything else from inmate assessment, isolation, PPE, masking, etc will remain as it is now.
