General Consumer products do not have the same regulatory process as health products reviewed by HC (pre and post market review)

I would not be able to comment on the claim. Not sure how or who would be a contact to research this product claim.

The recommendation gets back to what the evidence supports for IPC best practices for laundry in warm / hot water (60-90) regardless of the soap product. This is consistent advice from PHAC, WHO and CDC for communicable disease prevention (COVID and other microorganism).

I understand there are operational considerations. However, if the goal is best practices, then using warm/hot water is preferable regardless of the product.

Greg,

I became aware of a laundry detergent that kills COVID, Lysol laundry detergent. I am telling you because perhaps the cost of this detergent would be less than infrastructure changes or equipment purchases for hot water AND significantly less controversial and problematic for our labour partners.
