Dr. Wong,

In follow up to your correspondence with Michael Martin, please see the information provided below.

Michael is currently away from the office but please feel free to let me know if you have other questions or concerns on this subject.

Covid-19 vaccination coverage as of February 22nd 2021

- CSC received 1,200 doses of Moderna vaccine, enough to vaccinate 600 individuals (~4.9% of the incarcerated population)
- Individuals were chosen based on the National Advisory Committee Stage 1 priorities, including older adults aged 70 and over and working down in 5 year age groups
- Overall, 4.7% of the population in CSC have received full vaccination for Covid-19, and another 0.1% have been partially vaccinated (awaiting a second dose).
- Among indigenous offenders in CSC, 2.1% have received full vaccination for Covid-19, and ██████████ has been partially vaccinated.
- Among offenders in CSC over 70 years of age, 79.6% have been fully vaccinated and 1.0% are awaiting a second dose
- Among indigenous offenders 70 years of age and older, 70.3% have been fully vaccinated and none are awaiting a second dose
- CSC anticipates another shipment of Moderna vaccine by mid April 2021 which will be in sufficient quantity to administer vaccine to the remaining offender population in CSC.

No Michael, it's absolutely not being used publicly.

It's for our internal understanding of the level of distinctions-based vaccine uptake thus far. I understand that CSC is offering vaccines to elderly and other most vulnerable inmates.

For First Nations reserves, the # of vaccine doses administered (over 44,000 doses) per on-reserve adult population was at 21% as of Feb 11. We're hoping for at least 75% First Nations on reserve population level uptake rate in the coming months. It would be great if you have the approx. #s and percentages.

As for the PCR testing, do you have Point-of-care tests on site or do you have to send them out to the lab for testing? We have been working with NML to deploy over 330 devices (with training and proficiency programs) in or near Indigenous communities to speed up the turnaround time and to facilitate Indigenous-led testing.
