



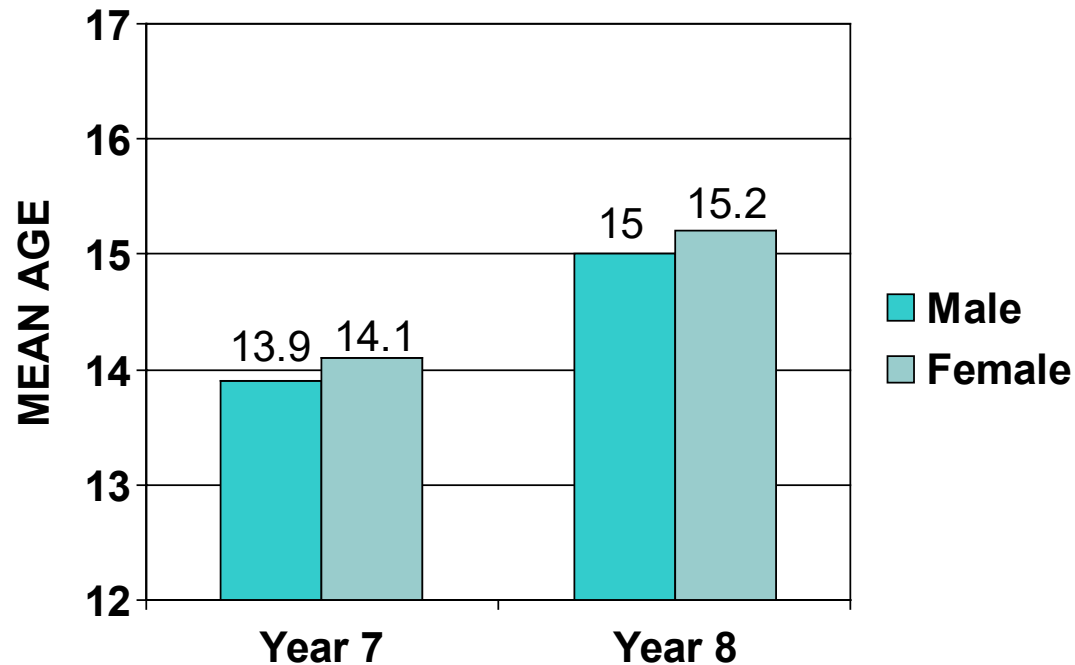

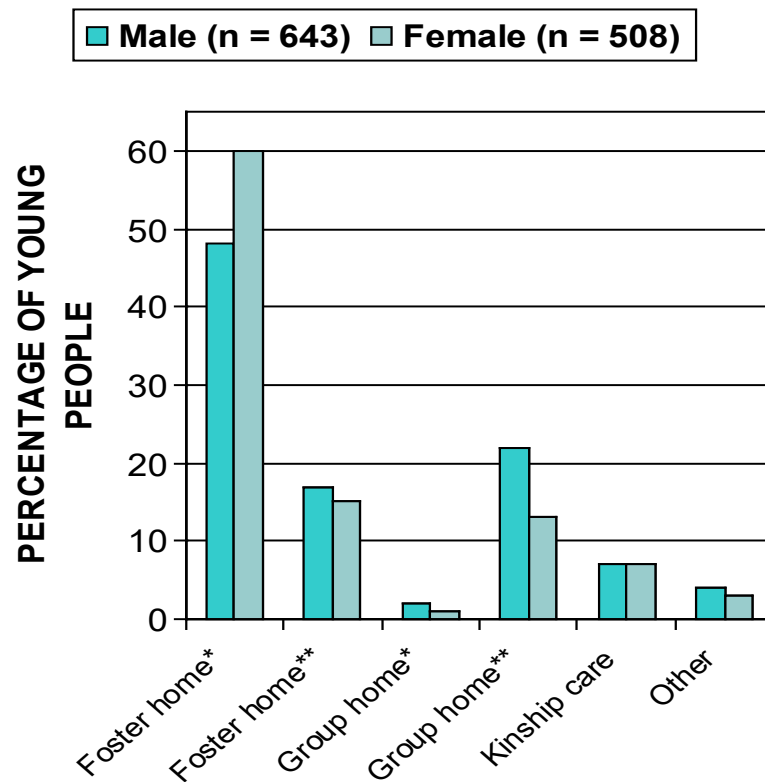
$N = 1160$

- Female $n = 513$ (44%)

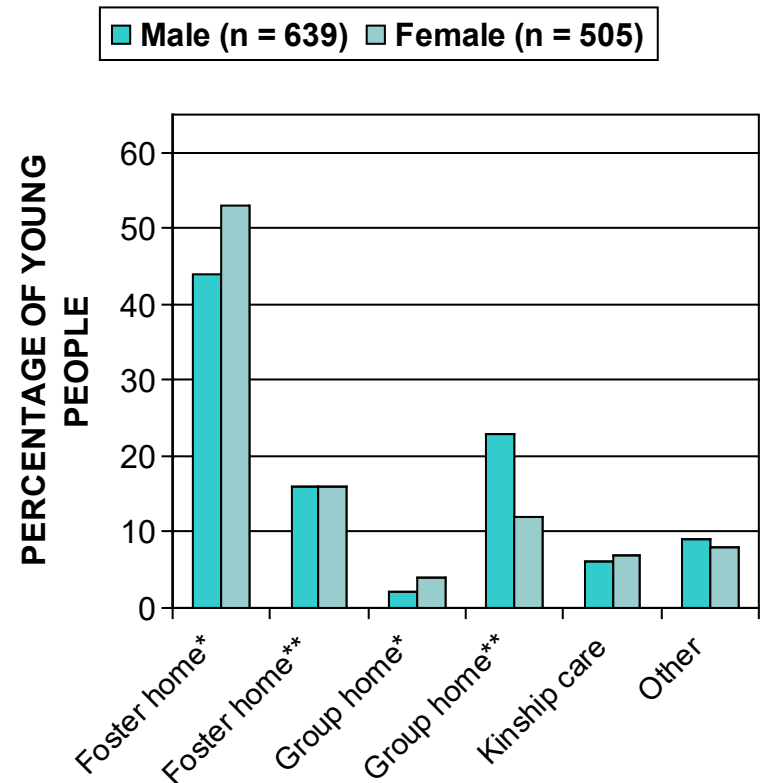


Placement Settings for Males and Females Aged 12-17 Yrs, OnLAC Yrs 7 & 8

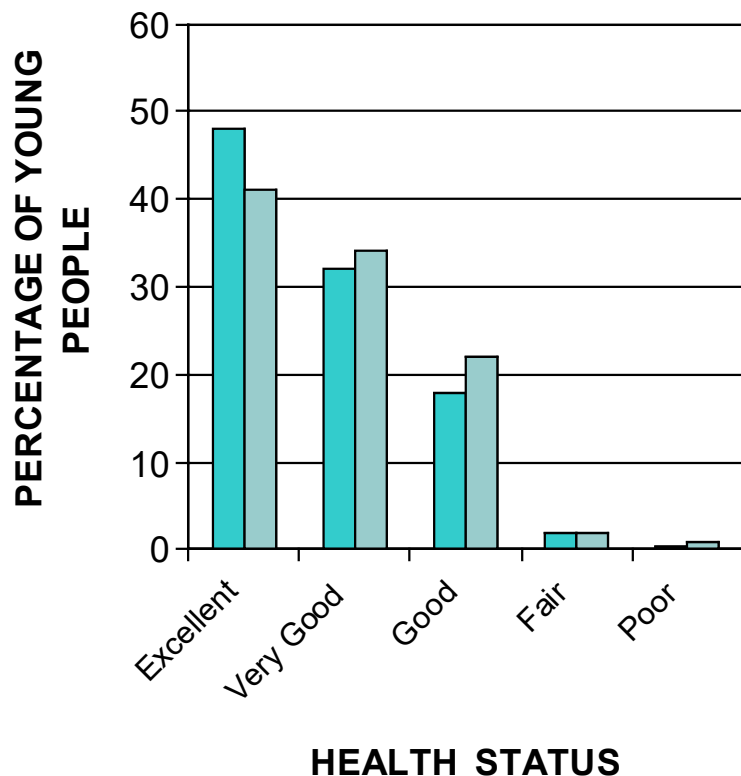

Health Status for Males and Females Aged 12-17 Yrs, OnLAC Yrs 7 & 8

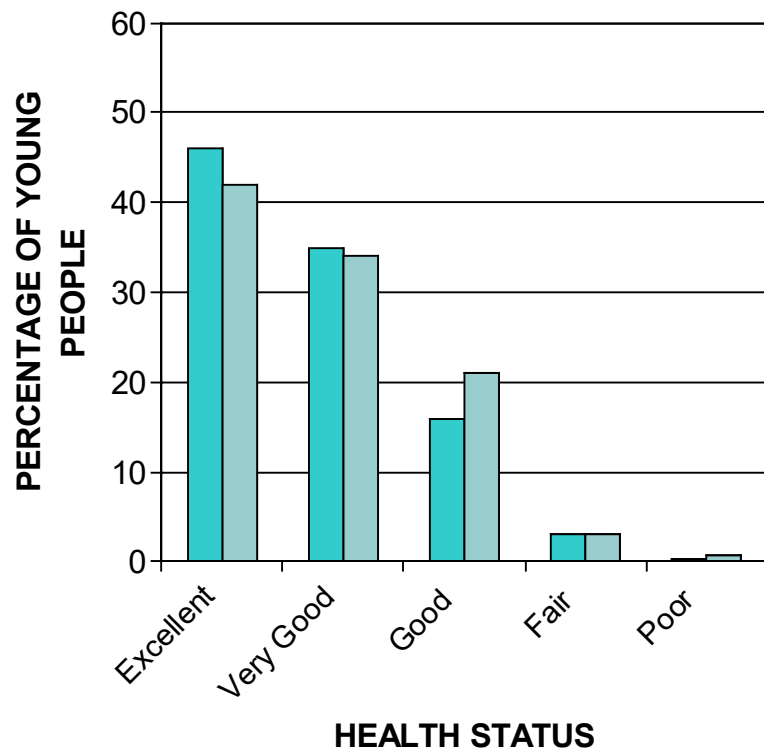

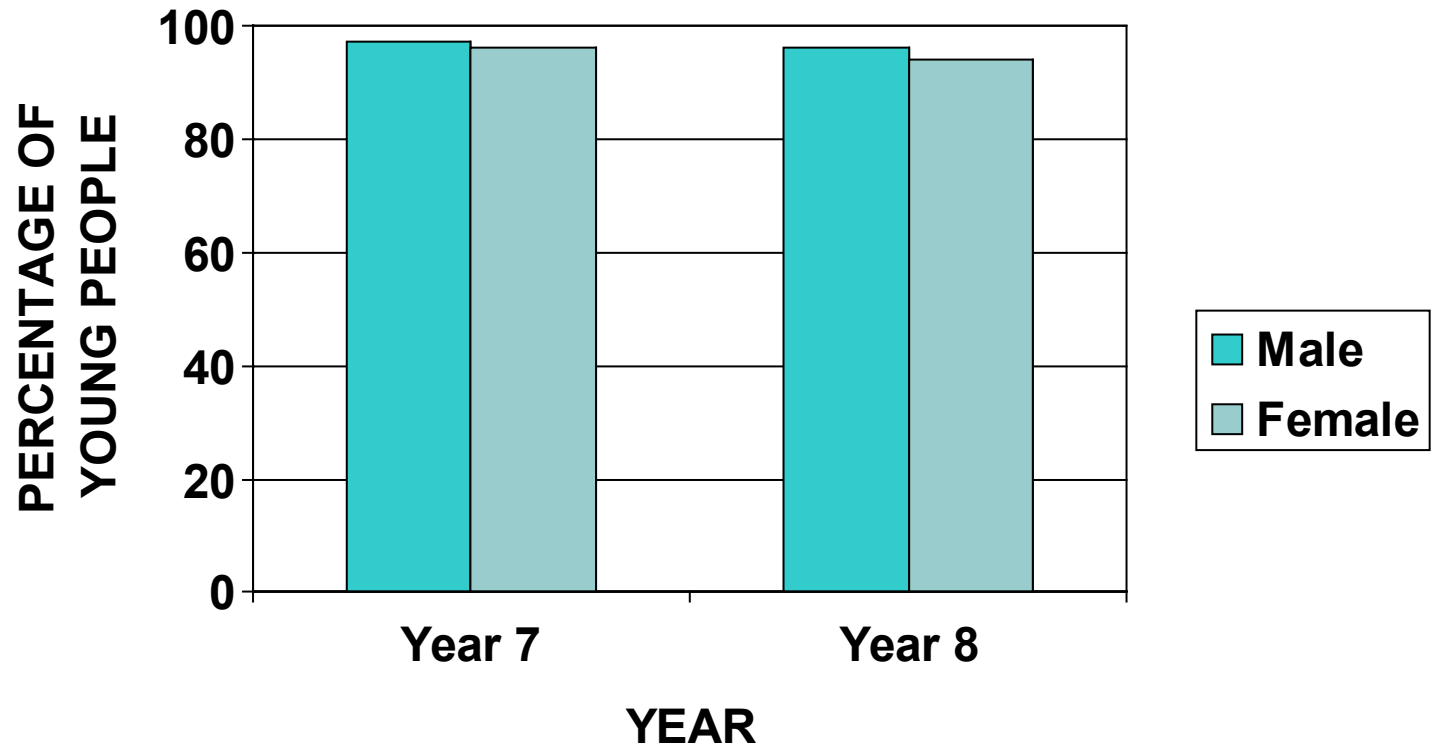

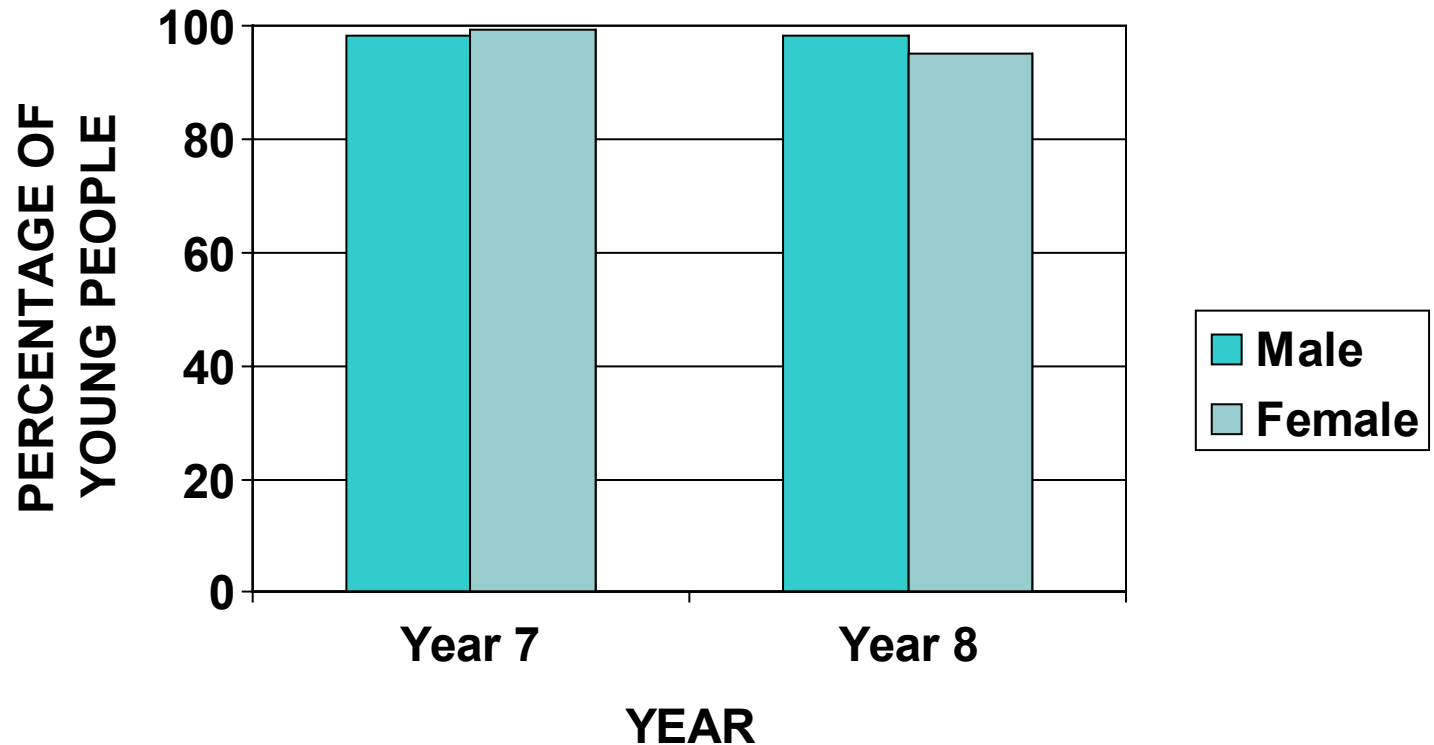


Young People Aged 12-17 Yrs Who Had Had a Medical Exam Within the Last Year, OnLAC Yrs 7 & 8

Year 8: Male ($n = 616$) & Female ($n = 499$)

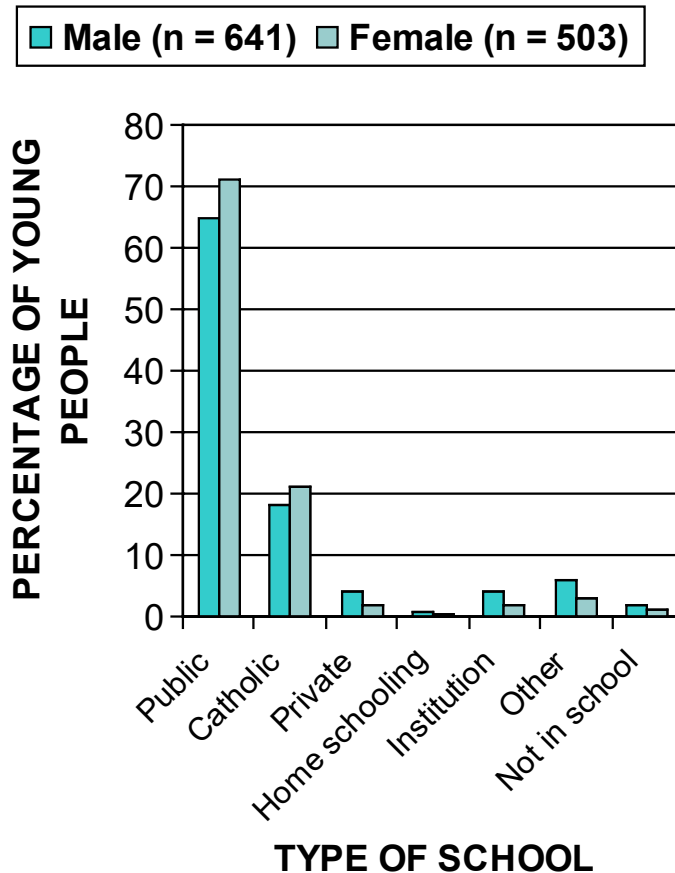
Young People Aged 12-17 Yrs Who Had Had a Dental Exam Within the Last Year, OnLAC Yrs 7 & 8



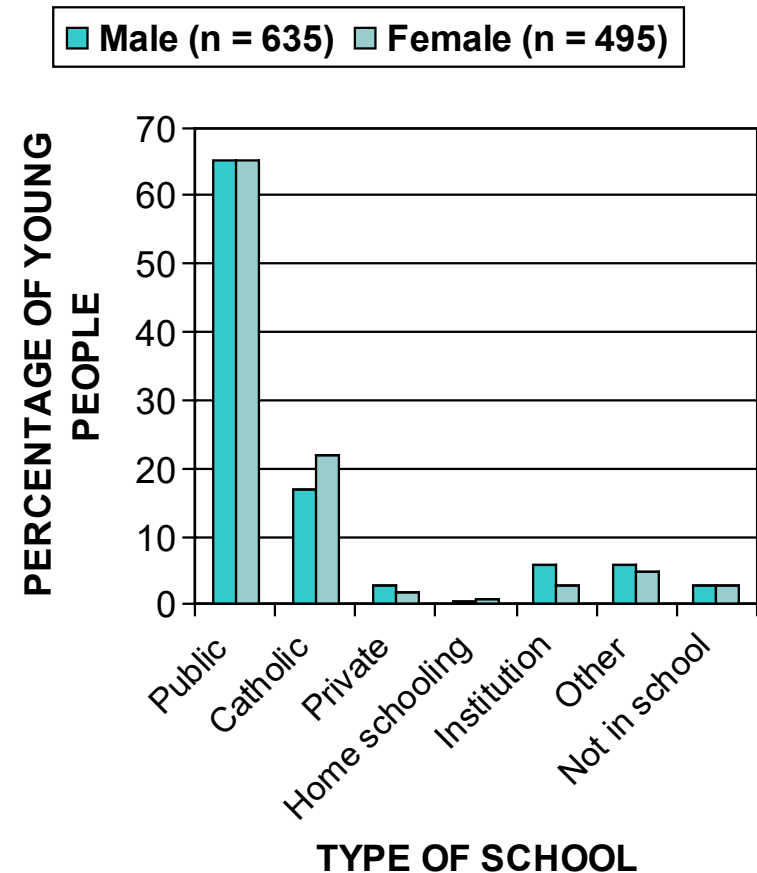

Types of School for Males and Females Aged 12-17 Yrs, OnLAC Yrs 7 & 8

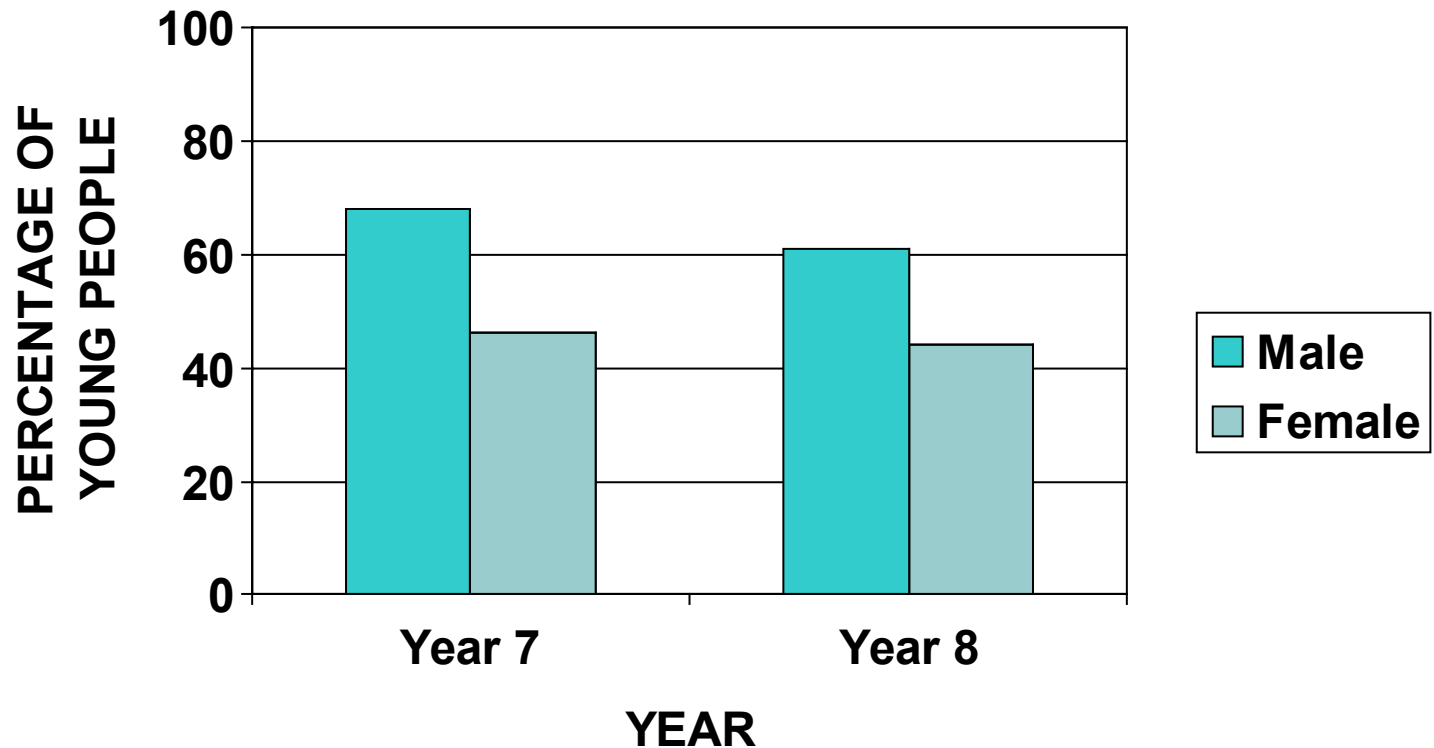

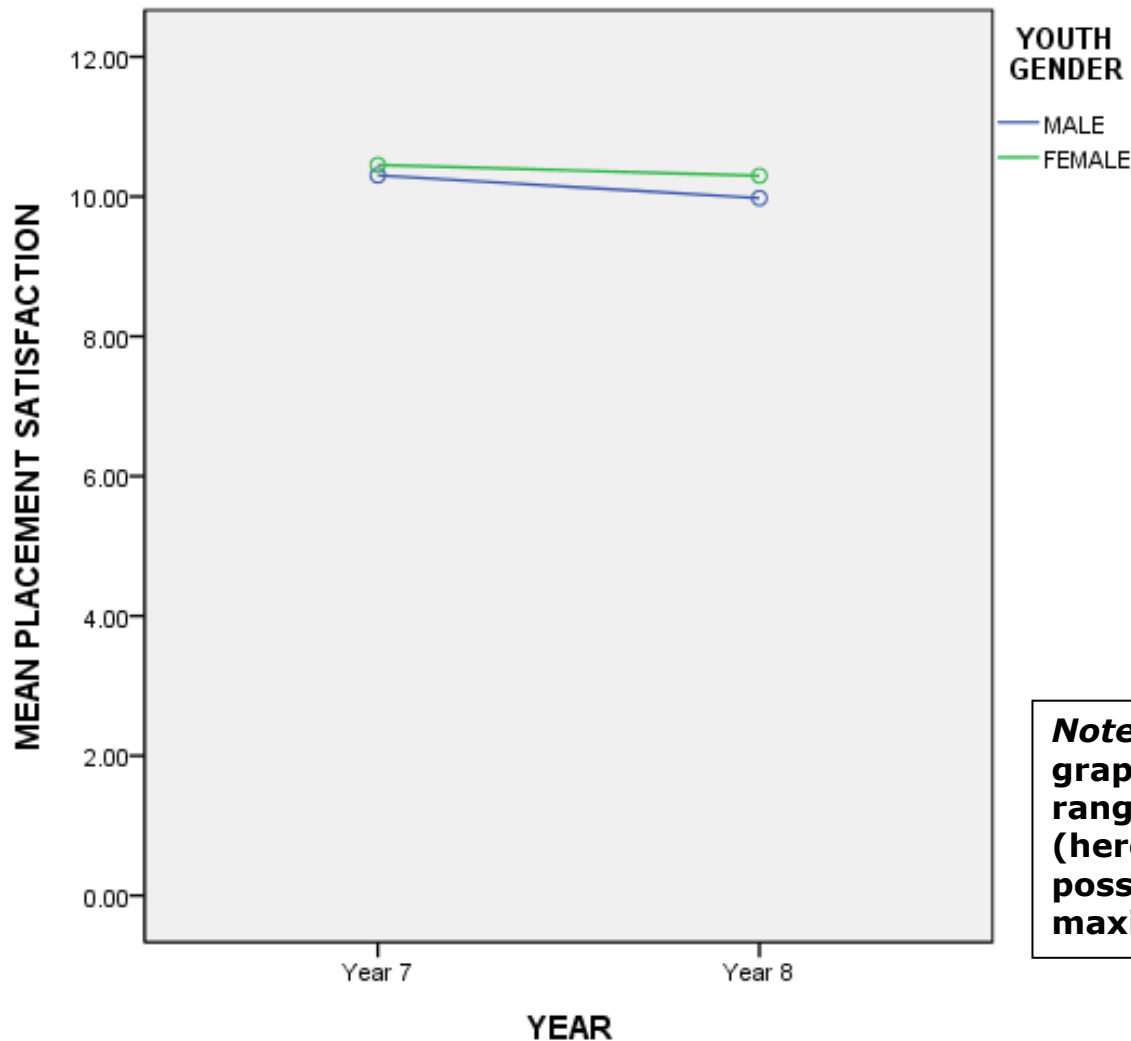


Young People Aged 12-17 Yrs Who Had an Education-Related Disability, OnLAC Yrs 7 & 8



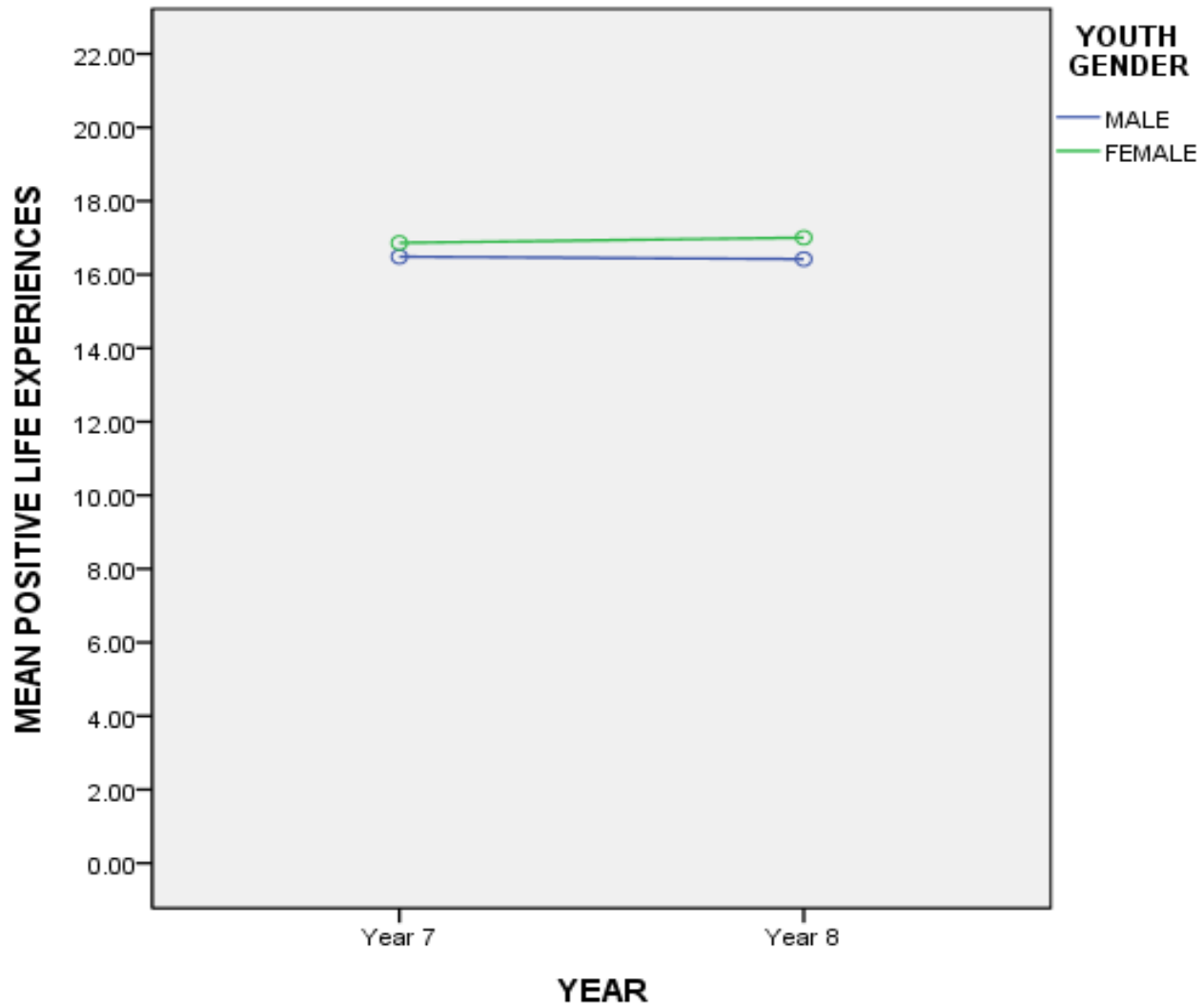

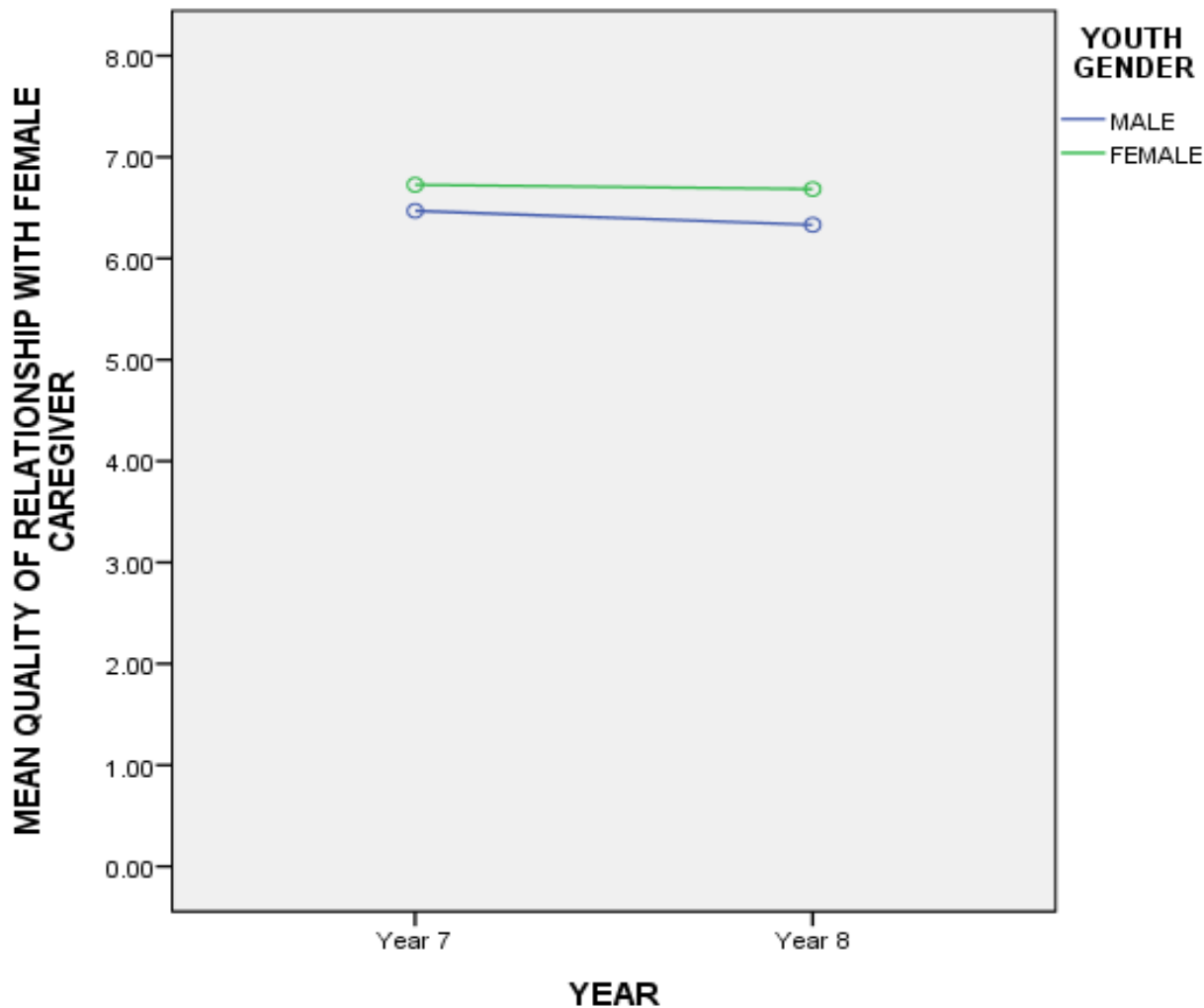

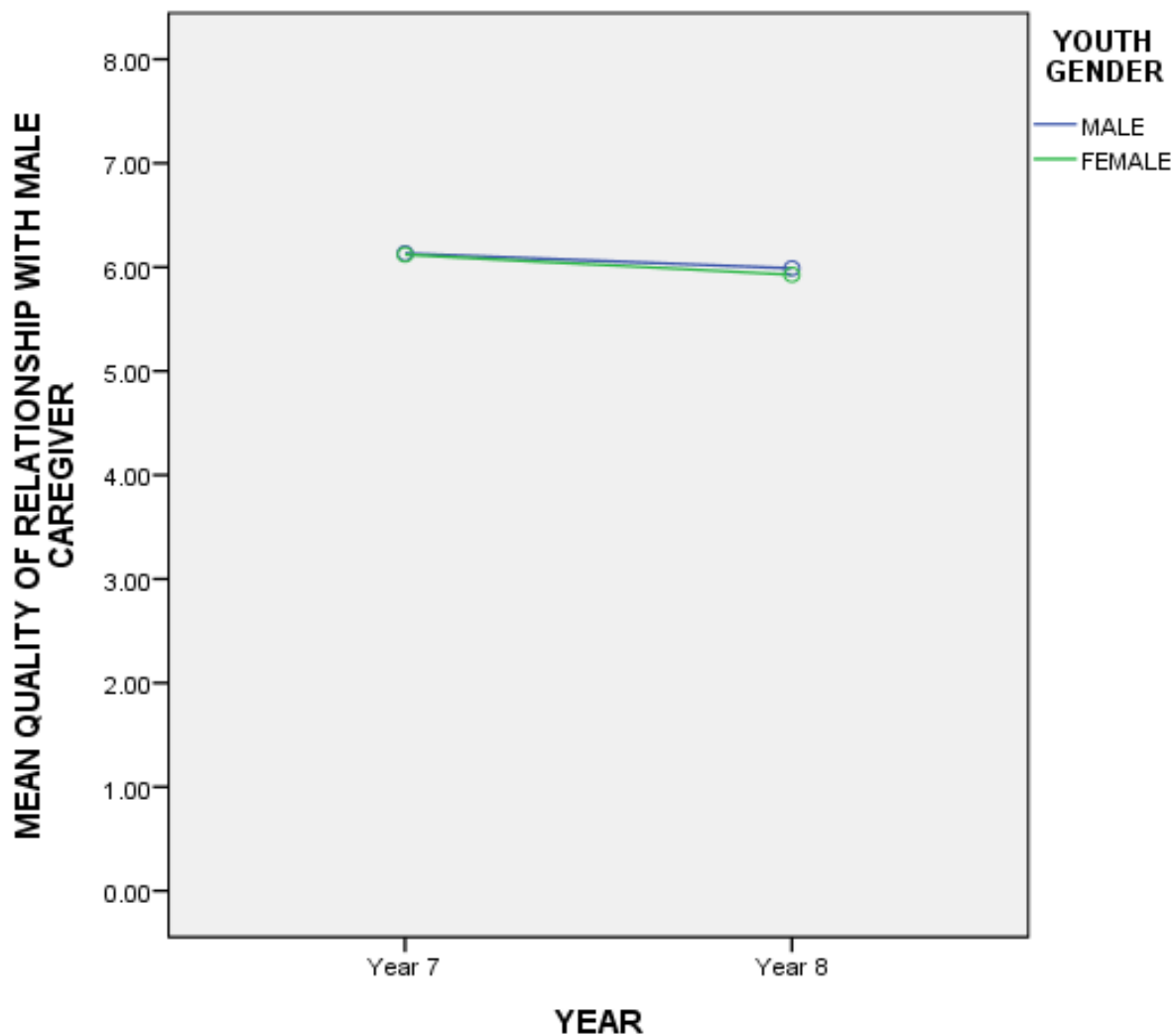

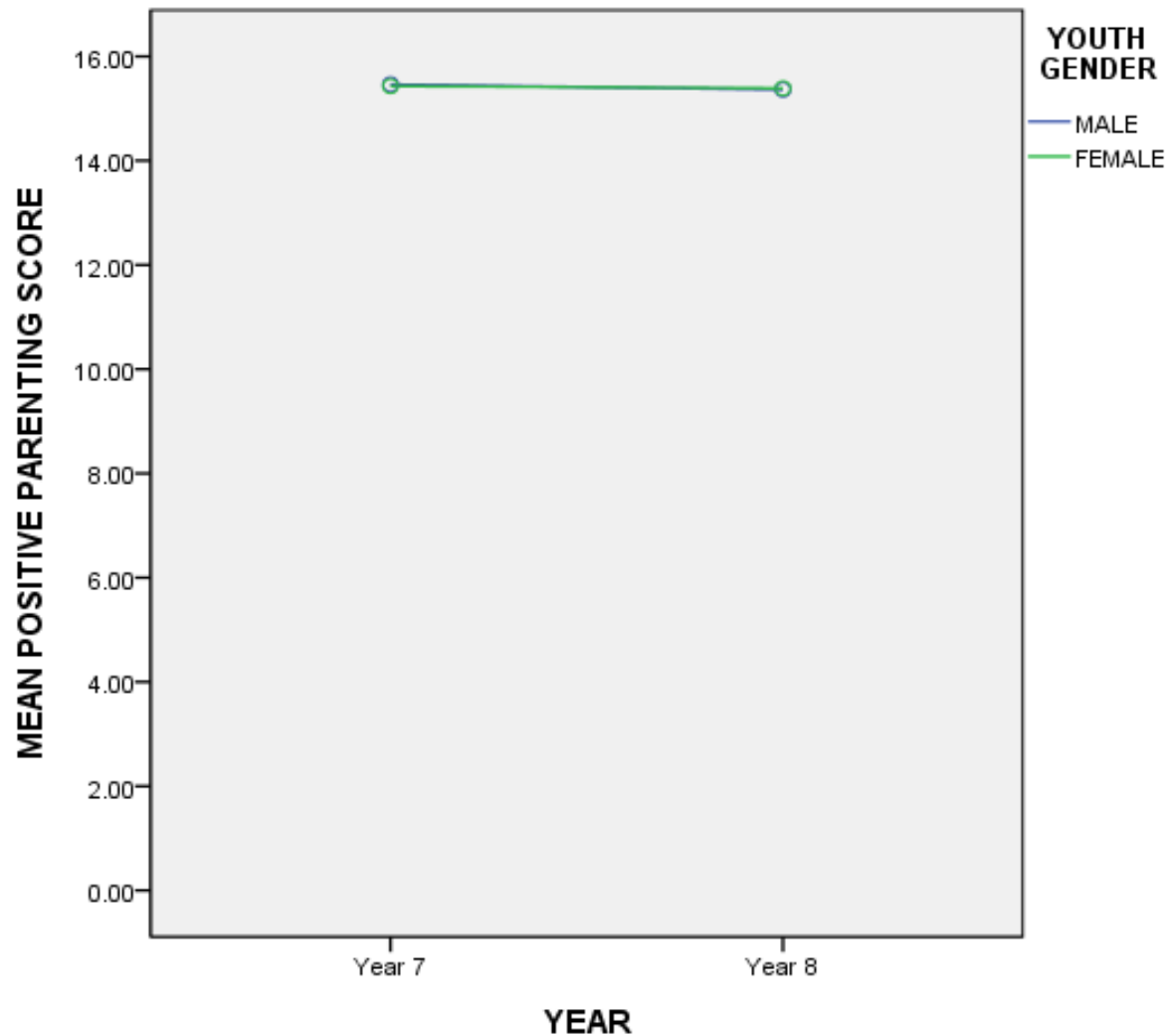

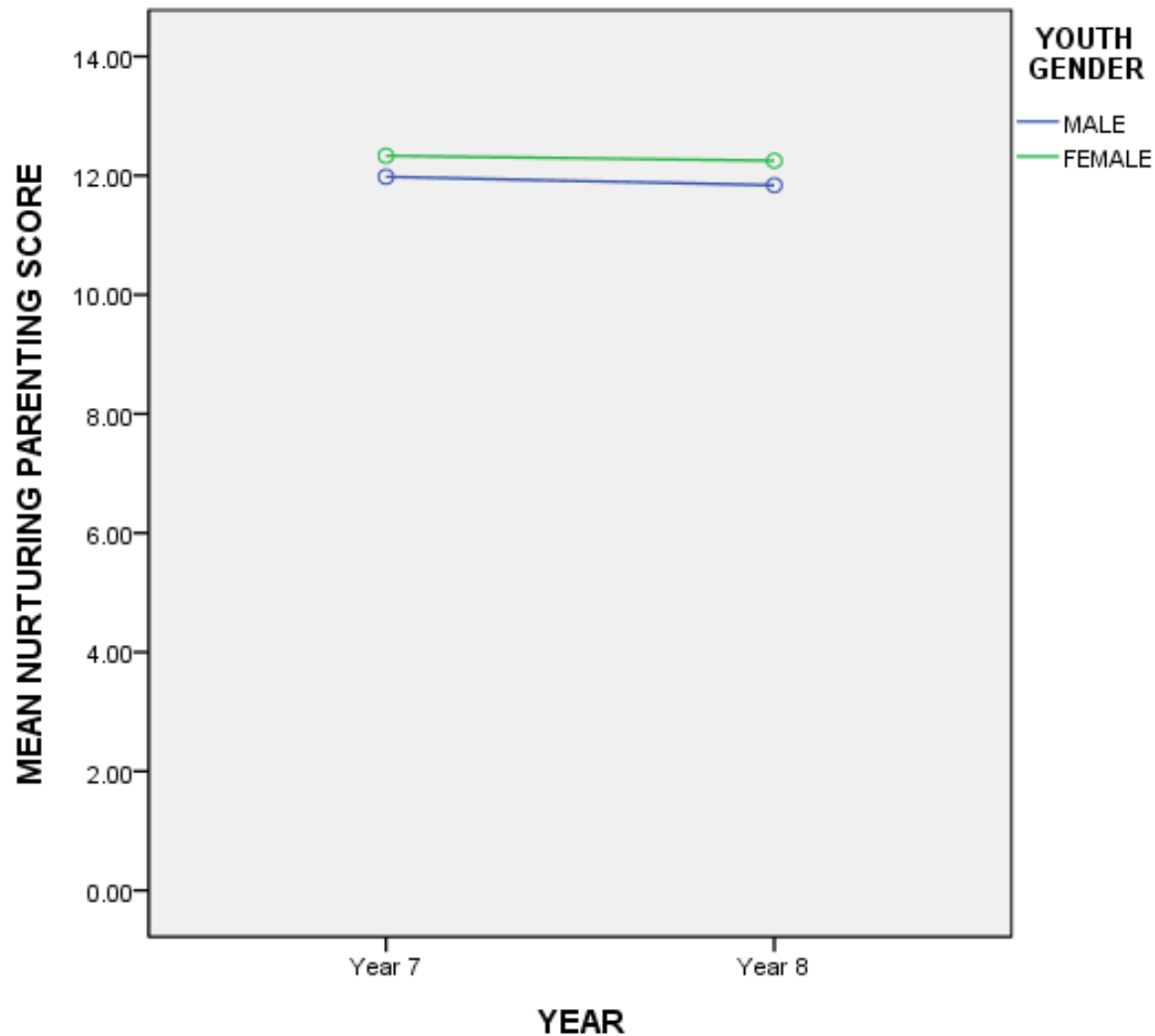

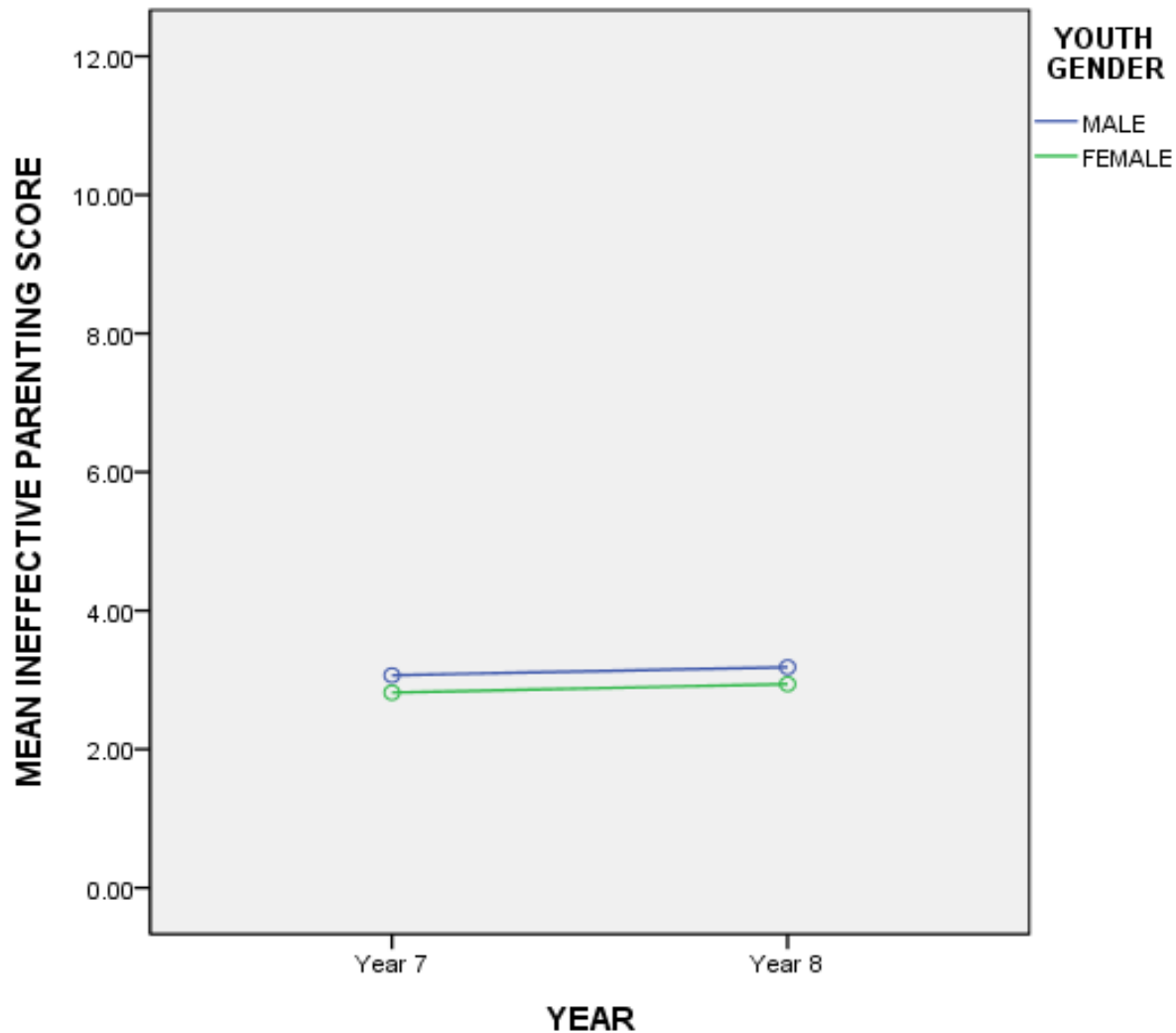

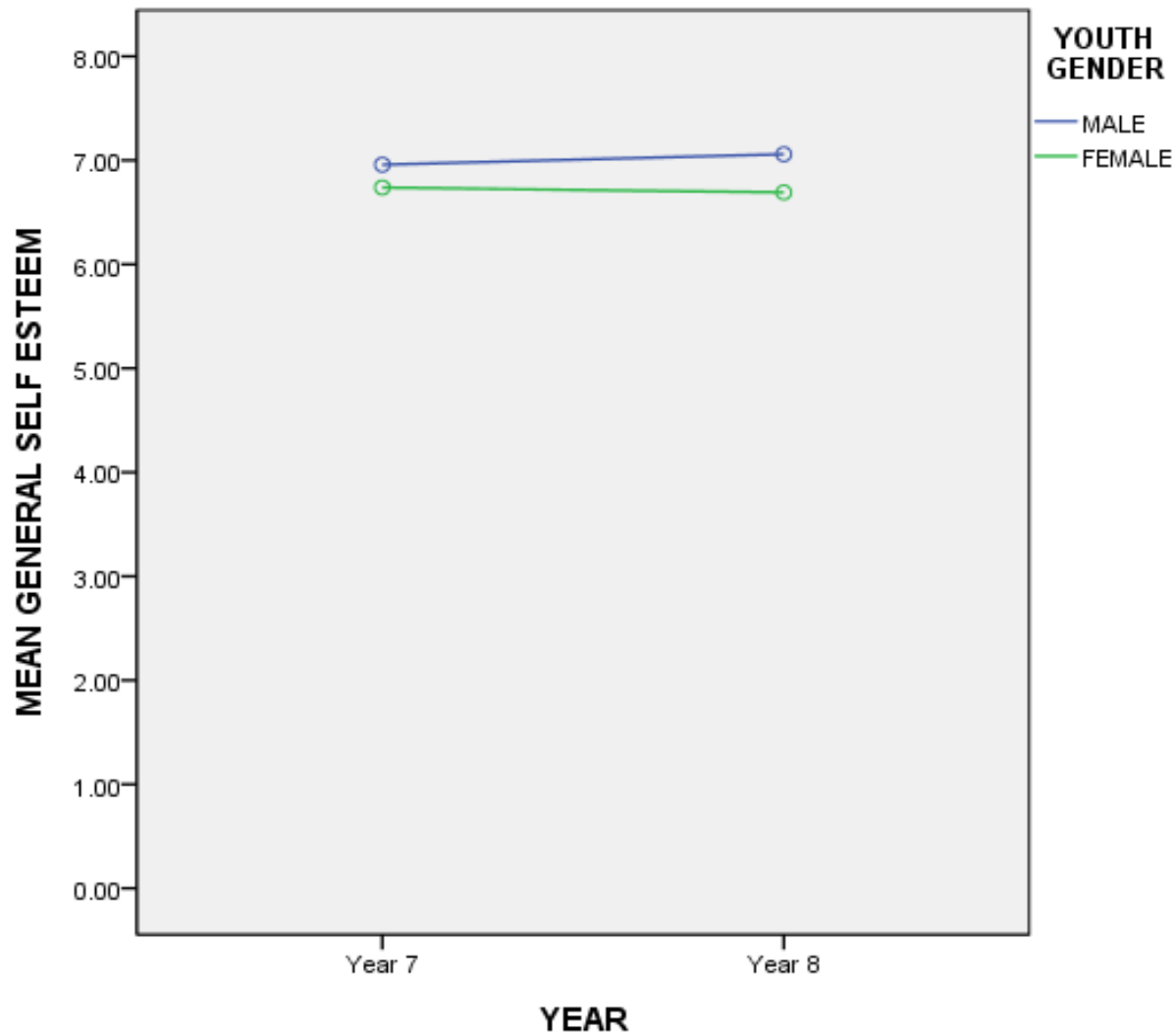

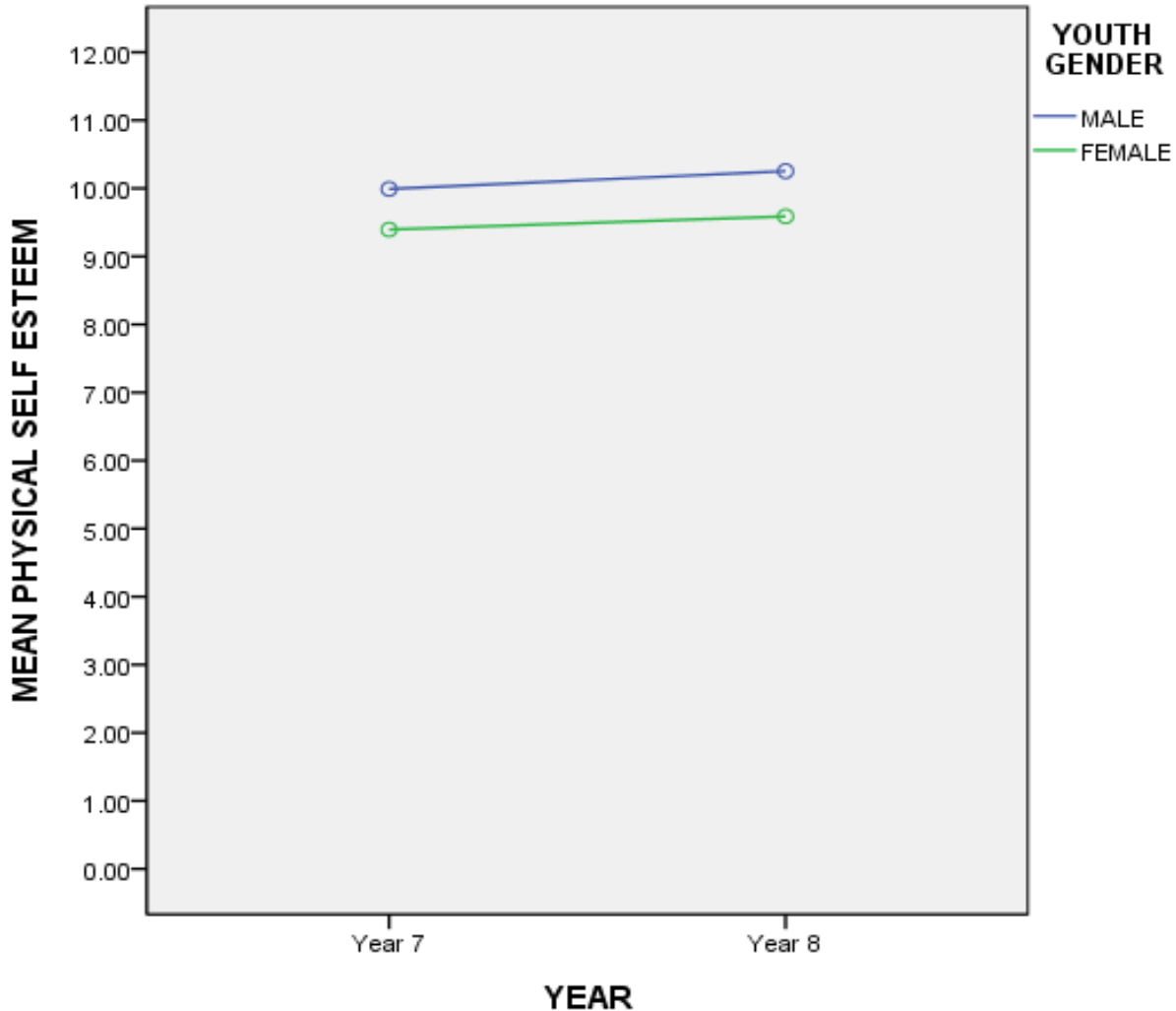

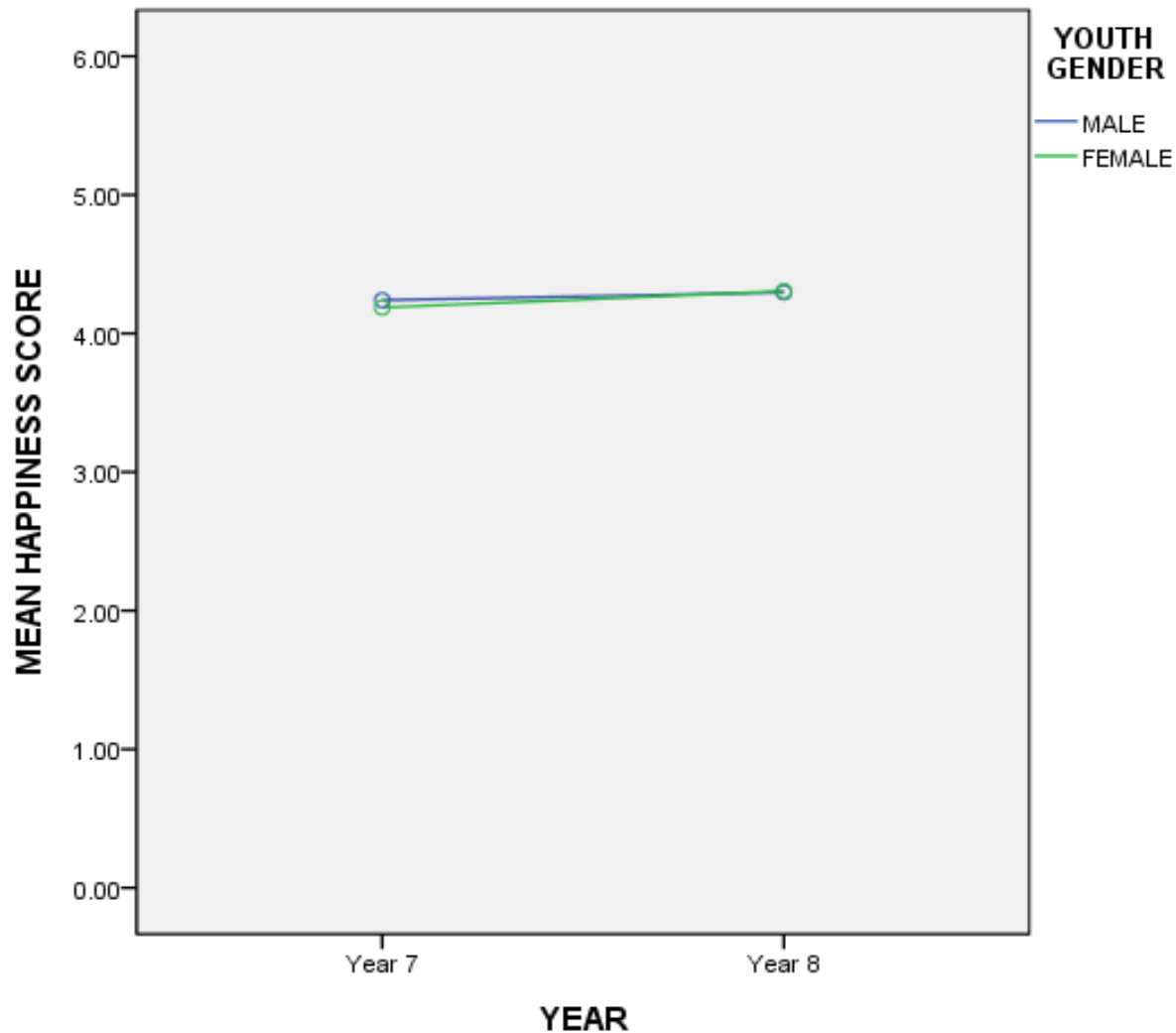

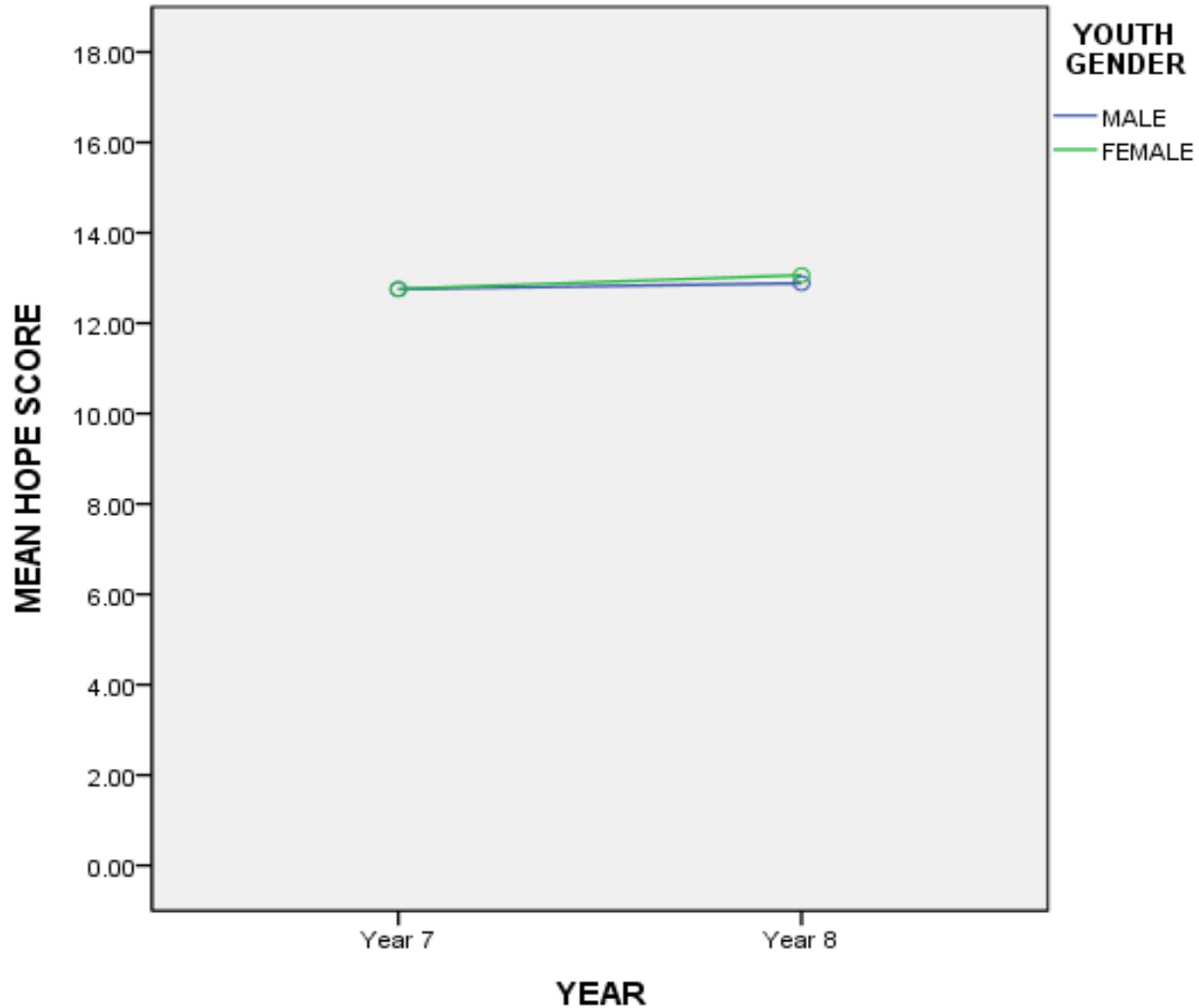

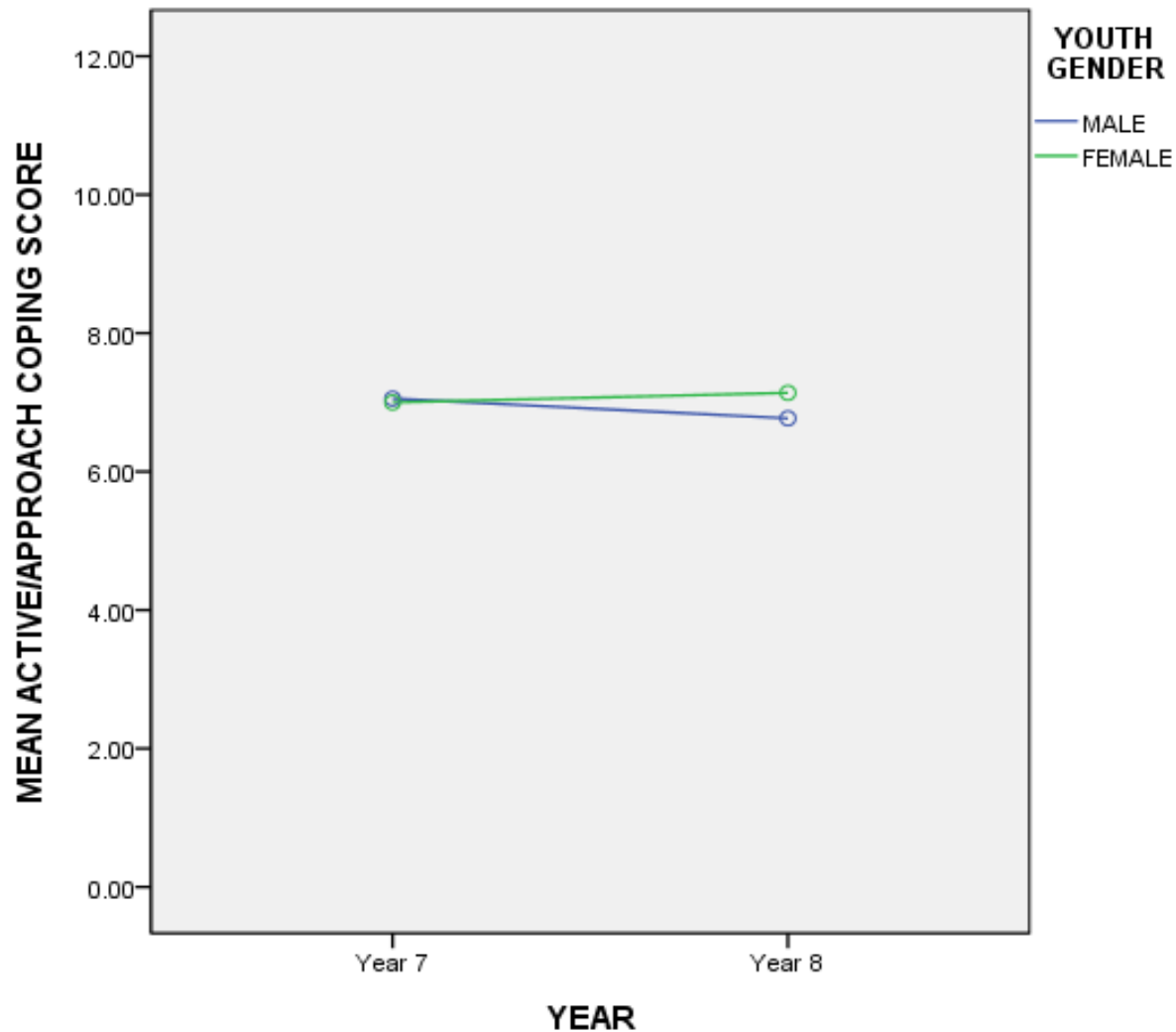

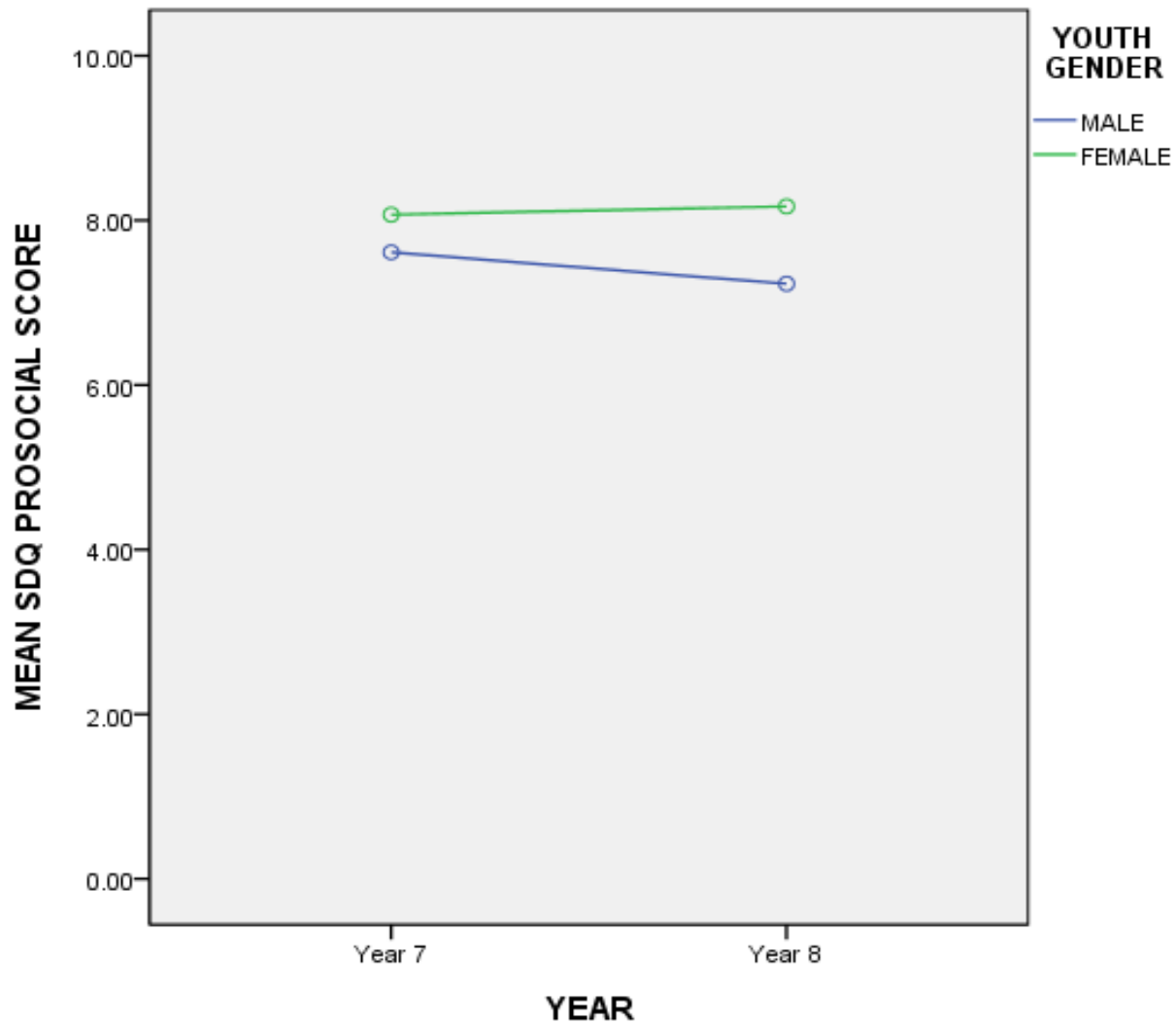
Mean Hope Score, for Males ($n = 546$) & Females ($n = 448$) Aged 12-17 Yrs, OnLAC Yrs 7 & 8



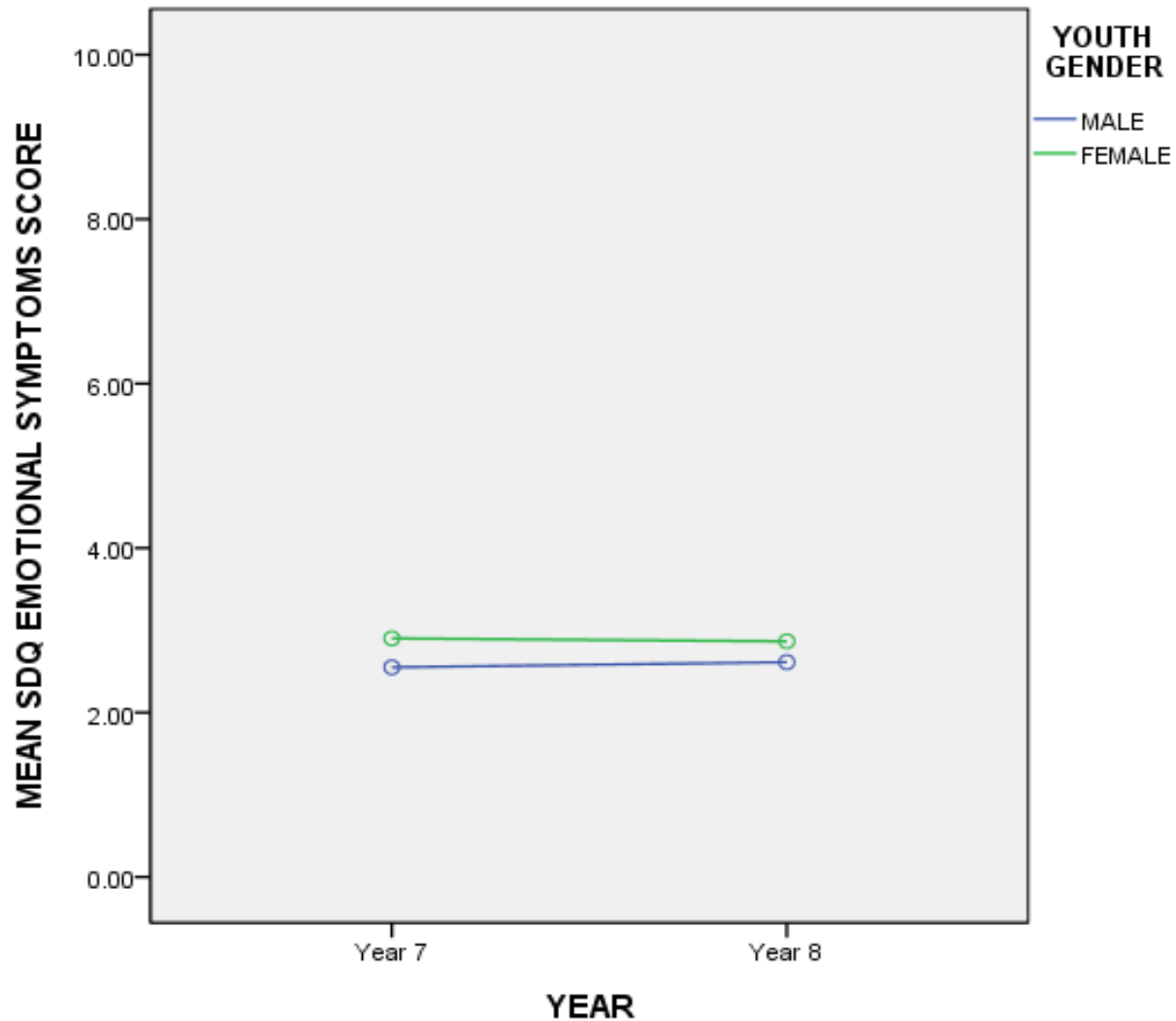

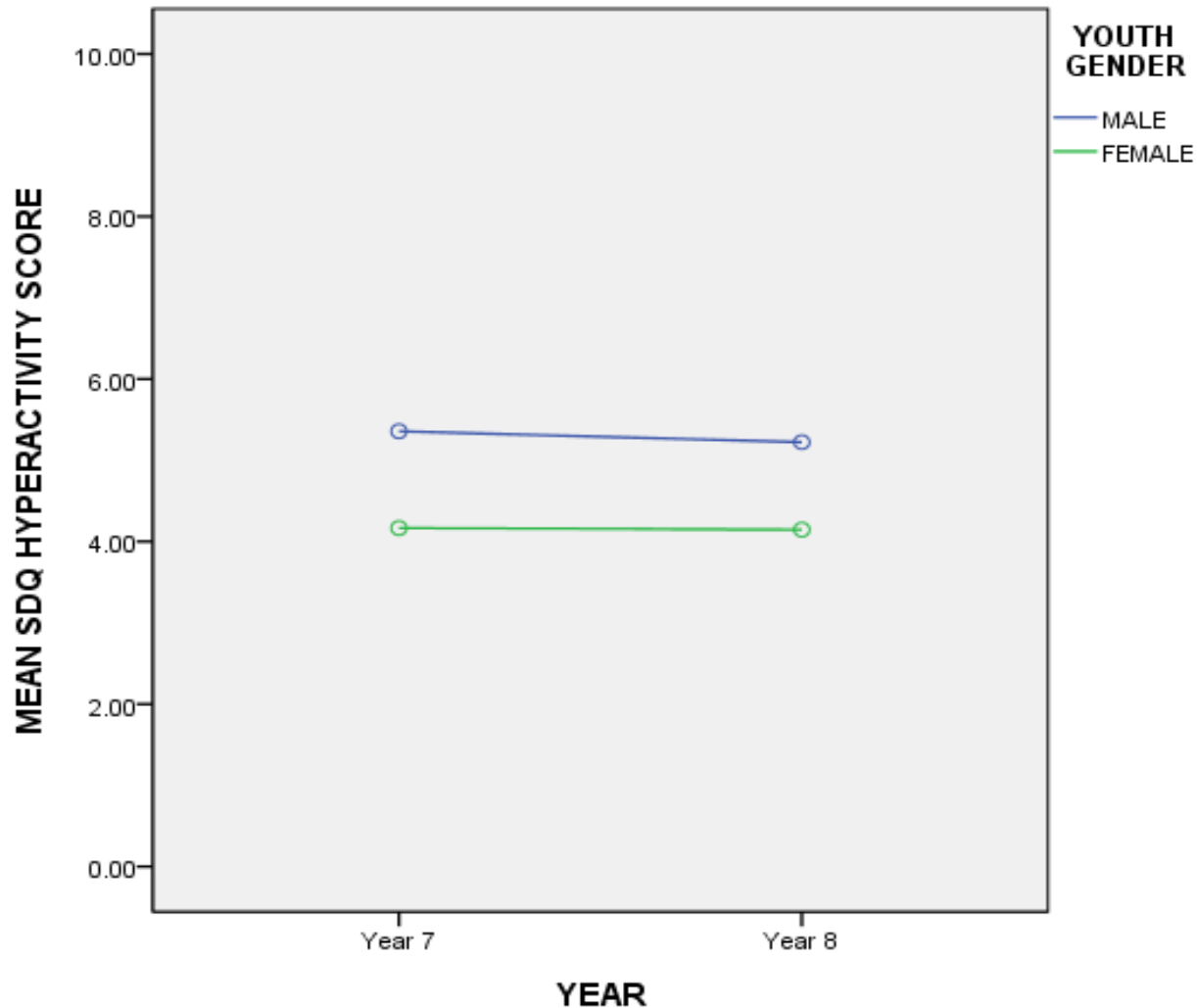

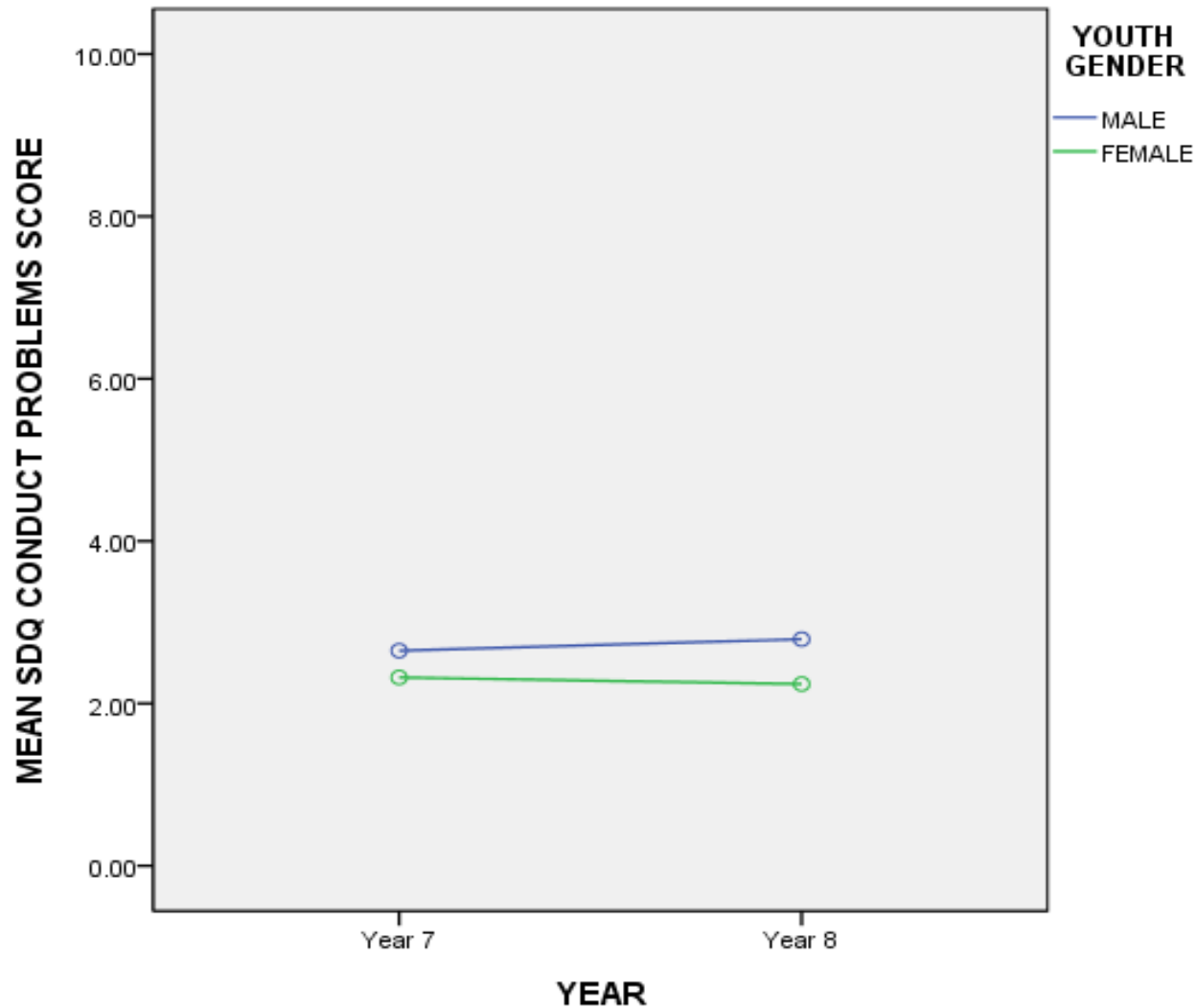

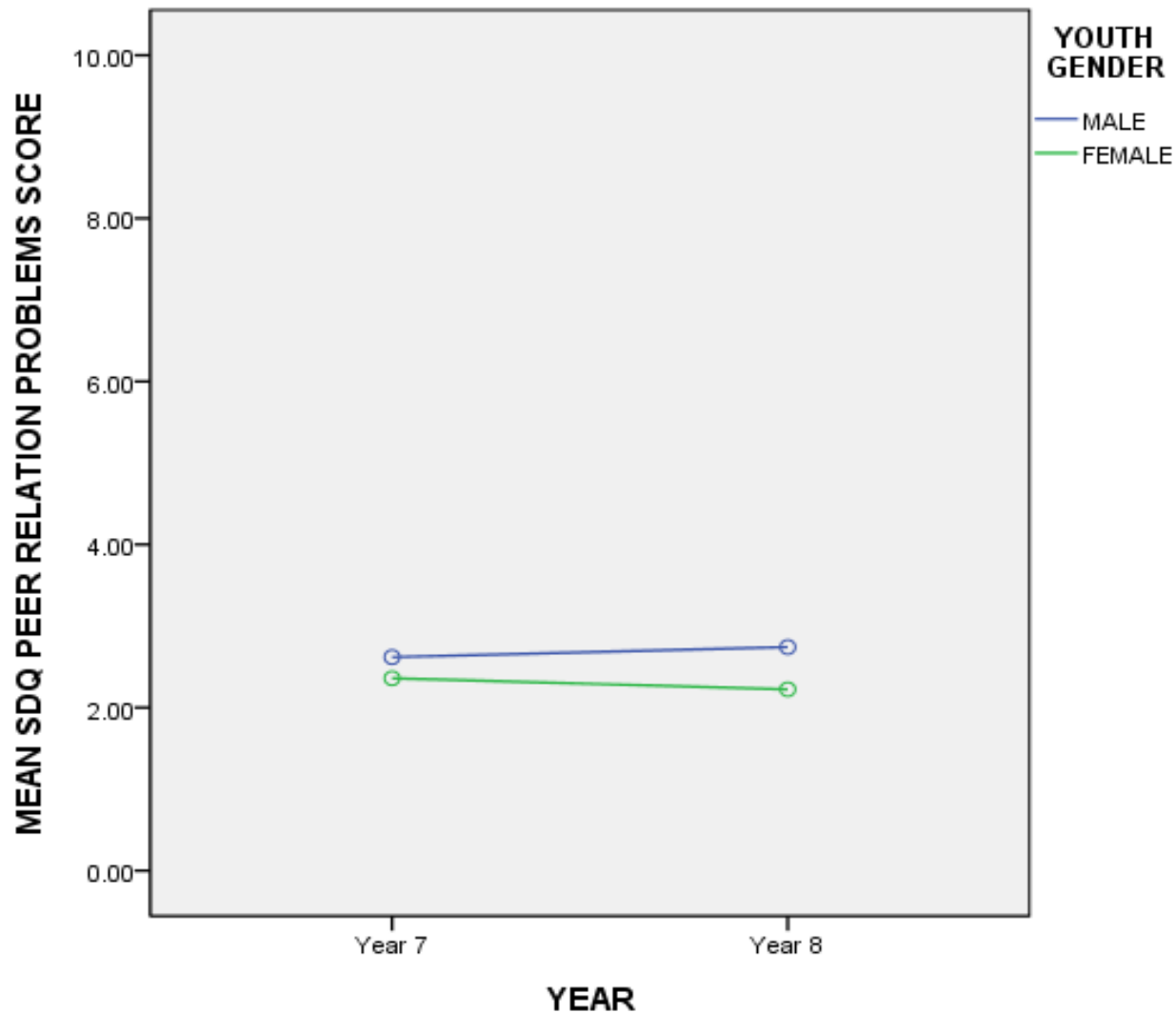

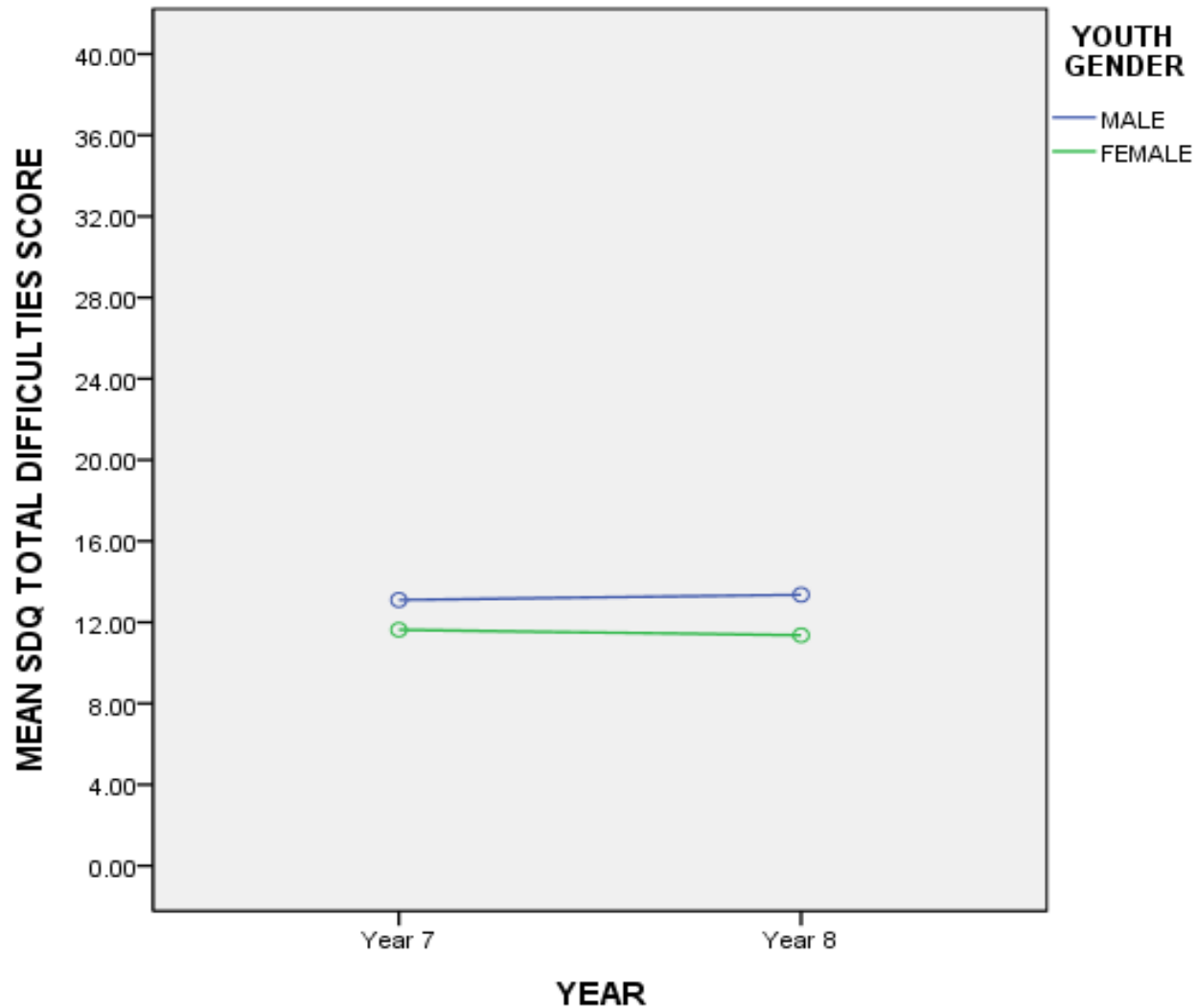

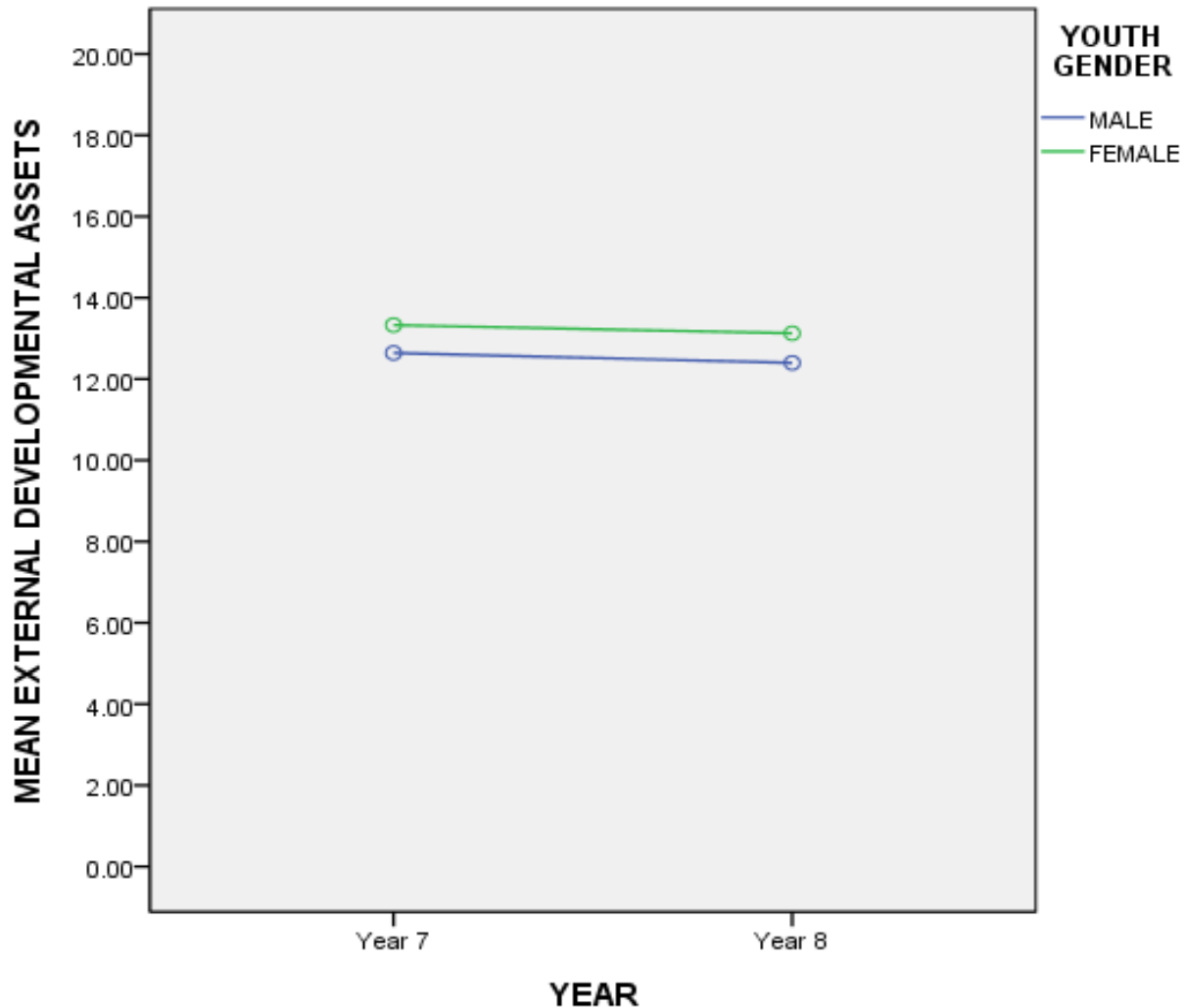

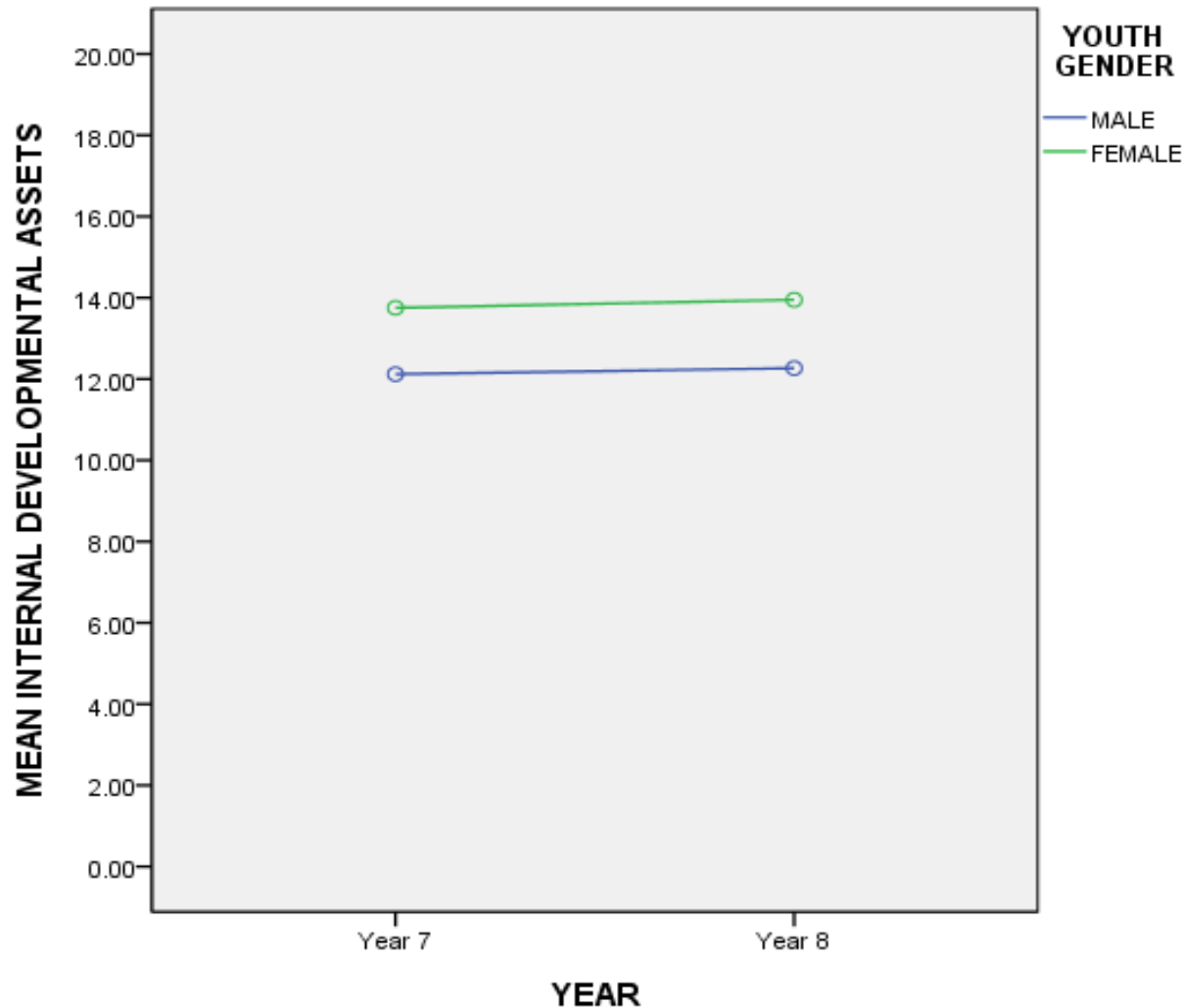
