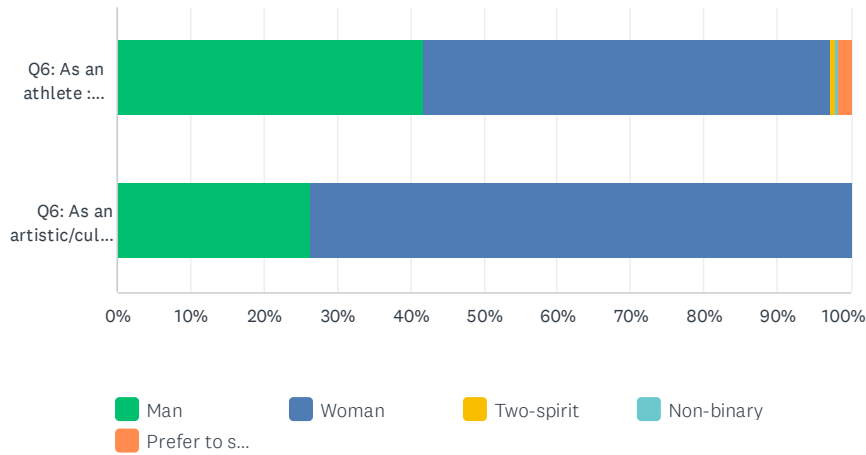

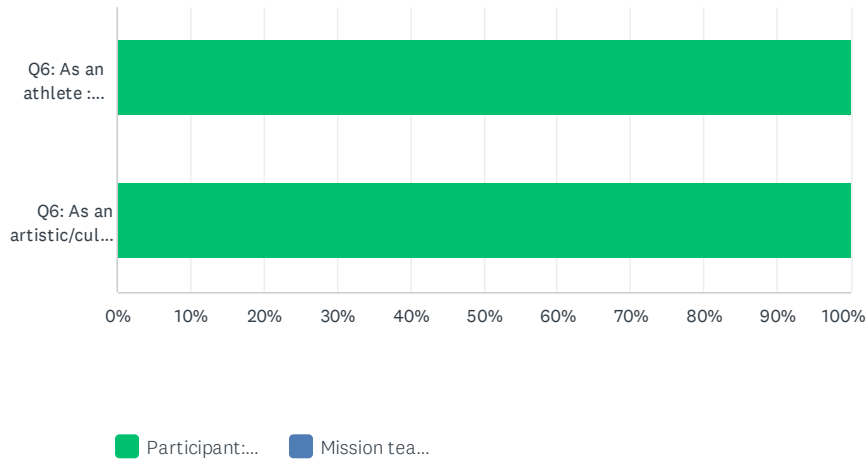

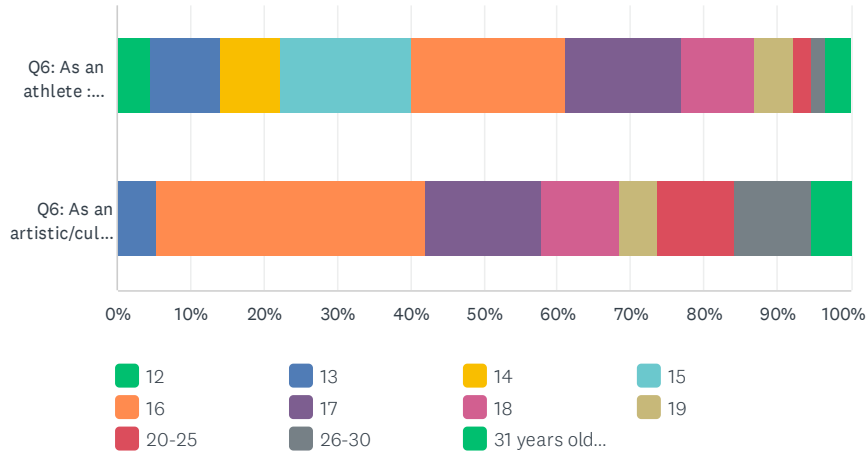

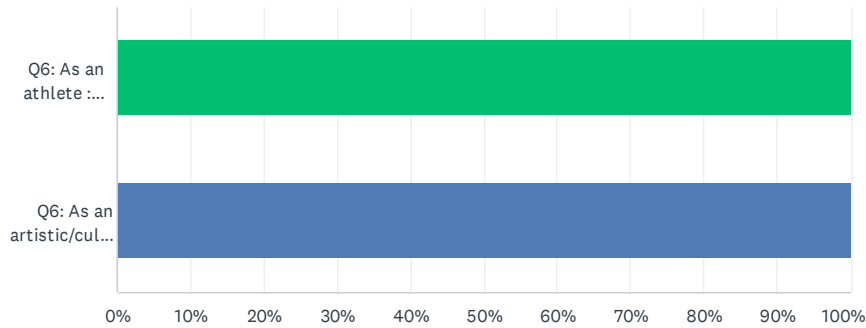

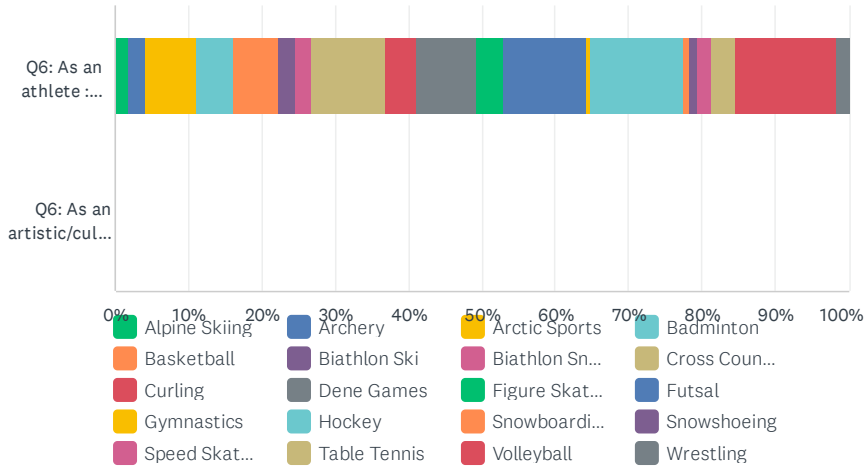

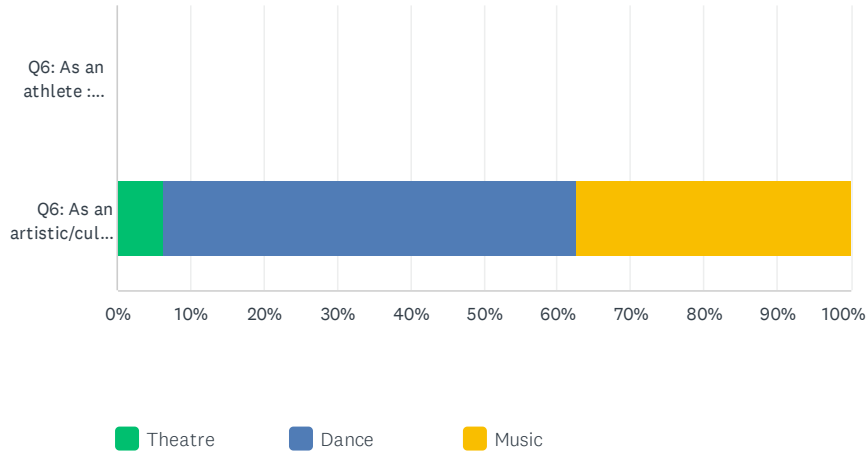

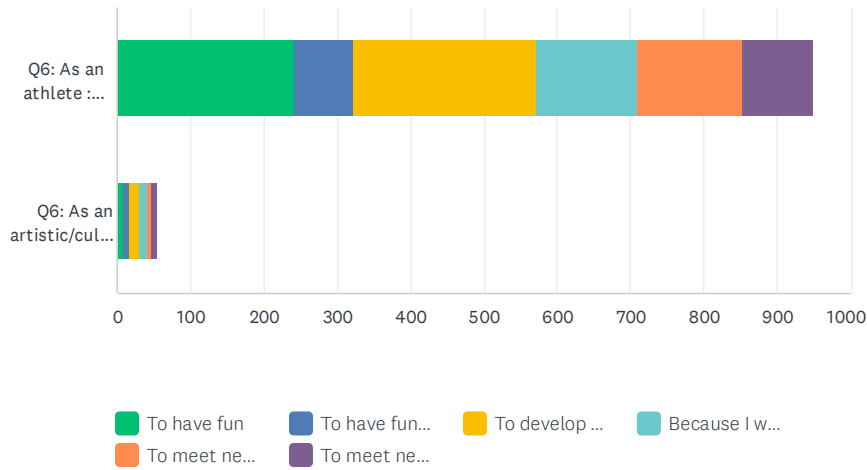

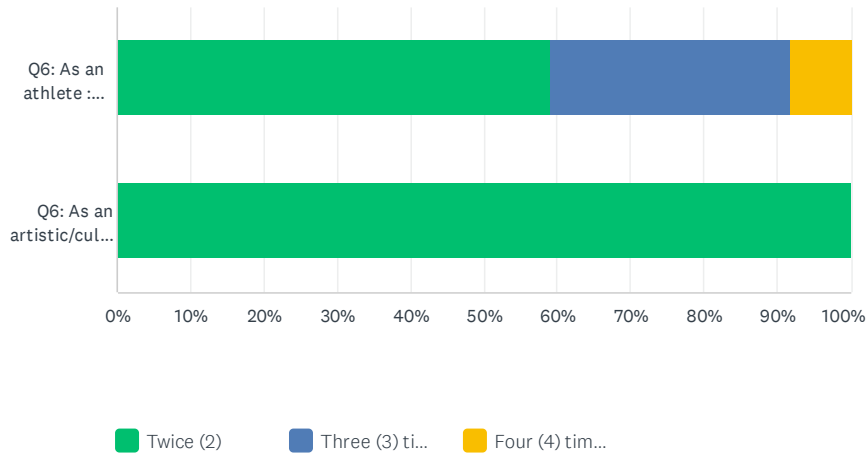

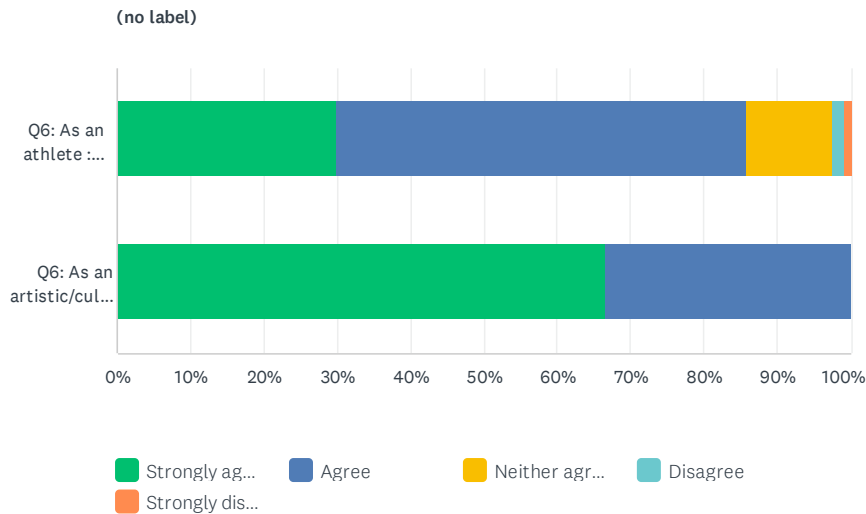

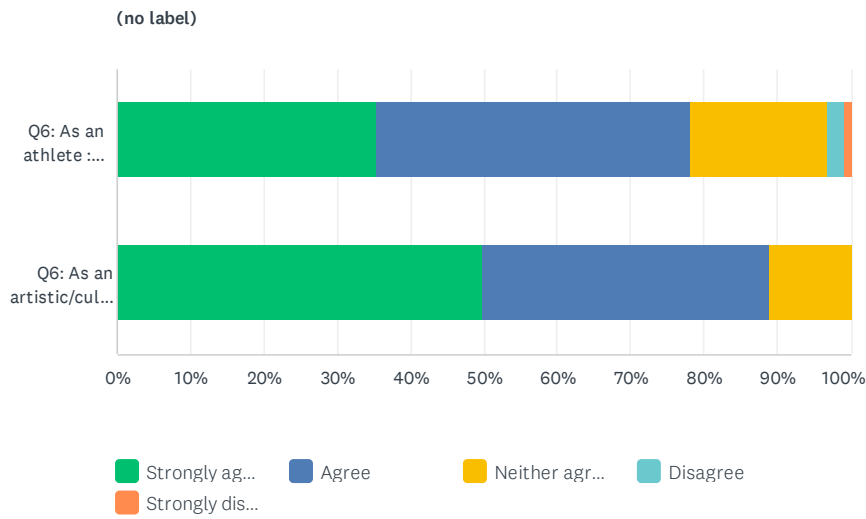

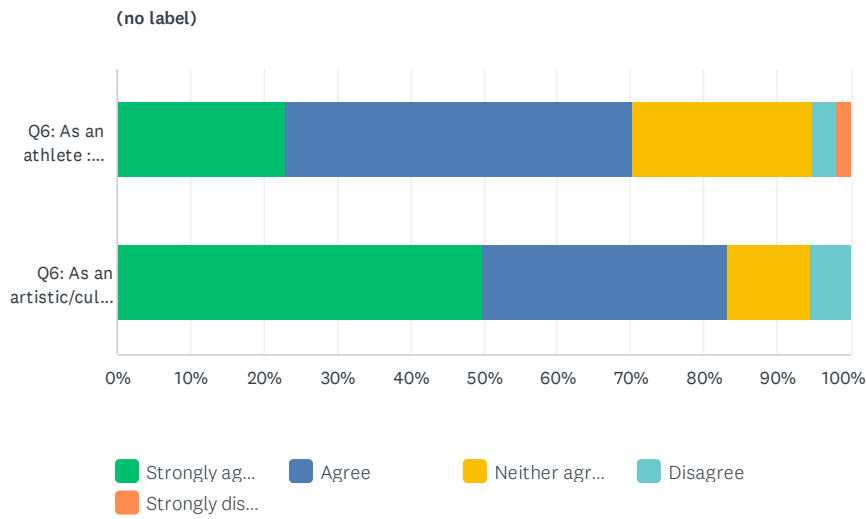

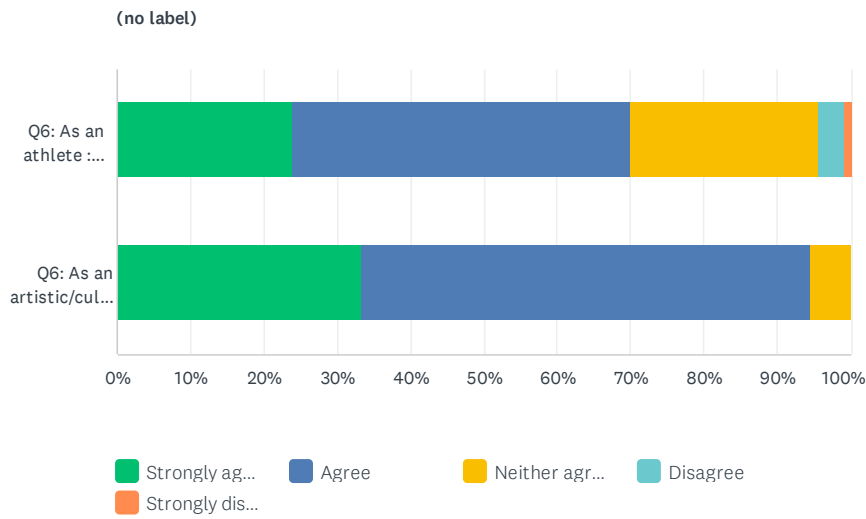

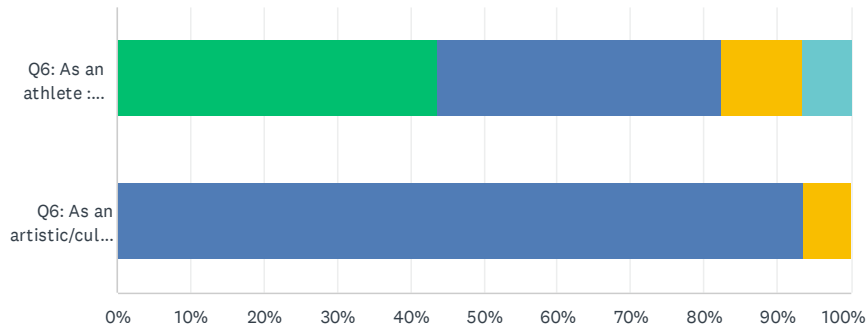

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### Q38 Do you think that Arctic/Northern peoples are more vulnerable to climate change and other environmental issues than other peoples in the world?

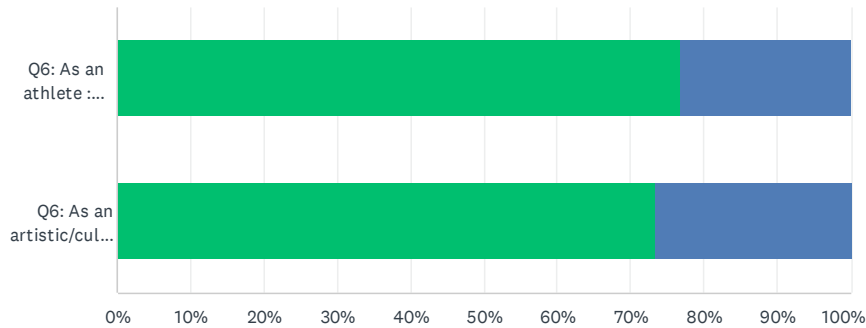

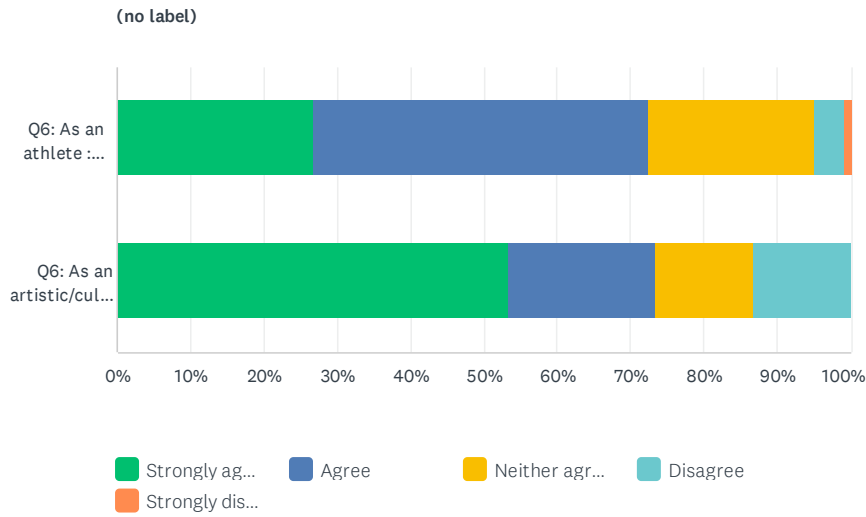

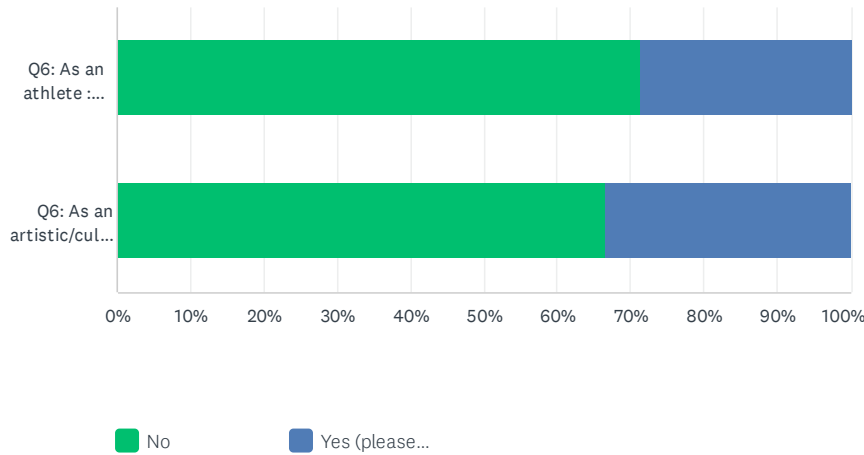
