The Health Library provides services and resources that support the policy, research and regulatory activities of Health Canada (HC) and the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC).

The Health Library is a member of the Federal Science Library (FSL), a partnership of seven federal science libraries that have joined together to establish a portal where you can search the print collections and repositories of all the libraries from a single place.

At PHAC there were specific librarians we would connect with, that would send files by reference manager or end note software. They would also assist with streamlining for broad topics (inclusion / exclusion criteria). May be an assumption that CSC as a federal dept. should be able to access this type of support.

The landing page (portal) provides a search function. It is an incredibly large data base, so key words are critical to conducting a successful search
