Given the rapidly evolving situation, please let me know by **Friday, February 26th**.

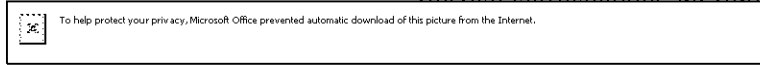

Given the trusted role of nurses play in vaccine administration and education, this is an important opportunity to build confidence within the public moving forward.

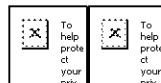
