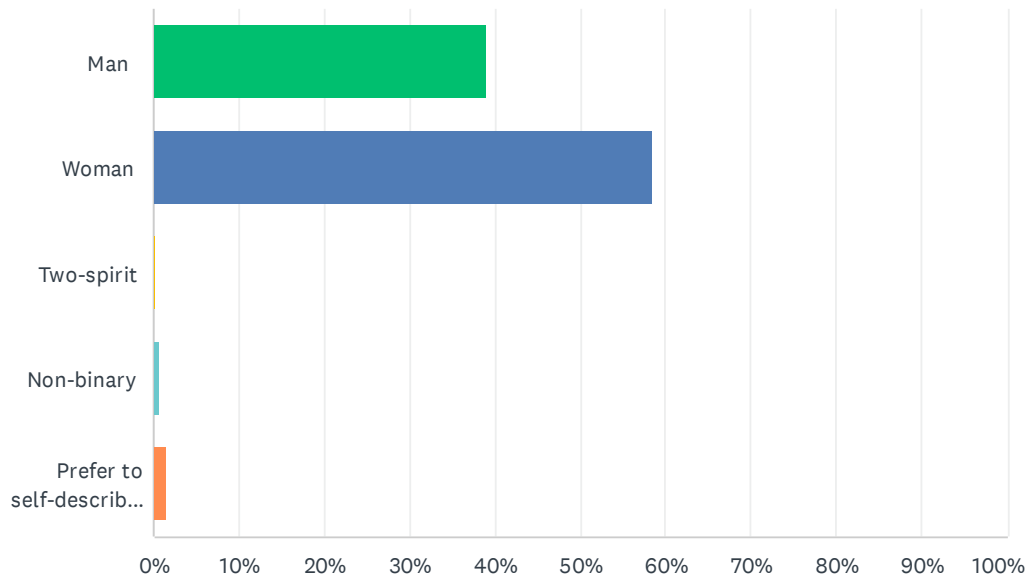

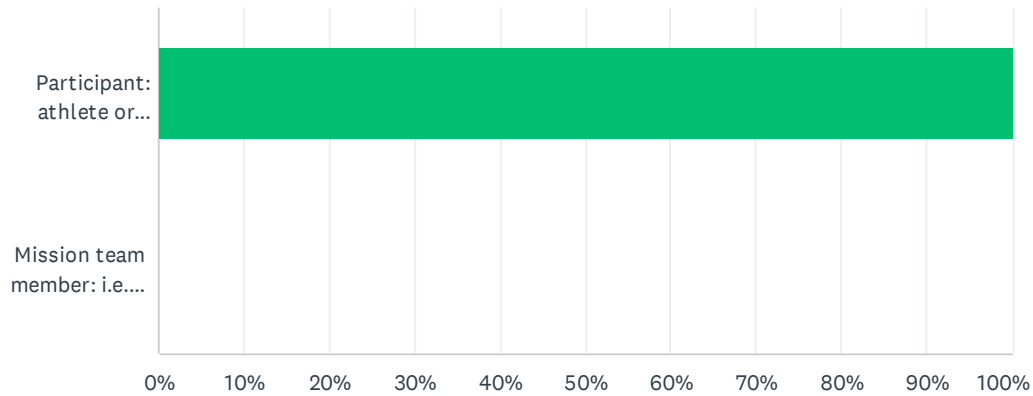

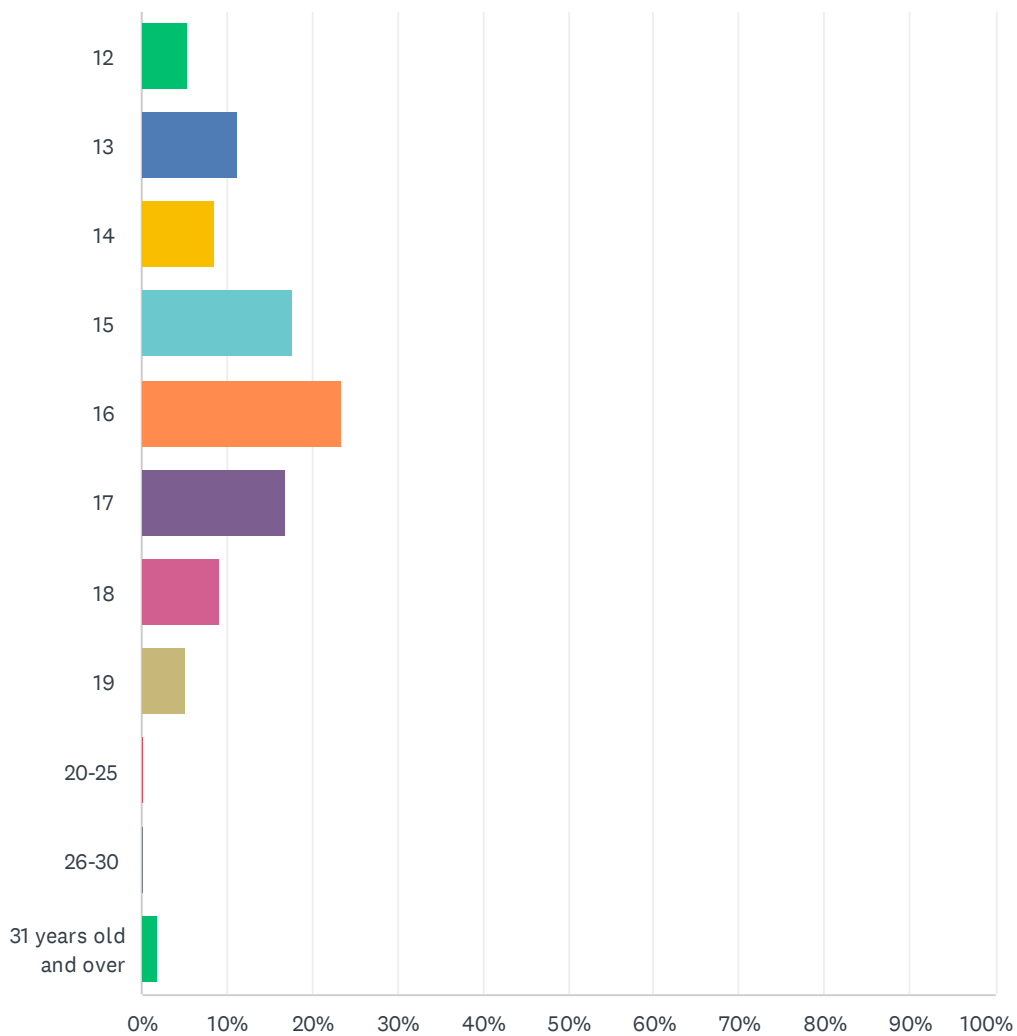

Q6 In what capacity are you participating in the AWG 2023

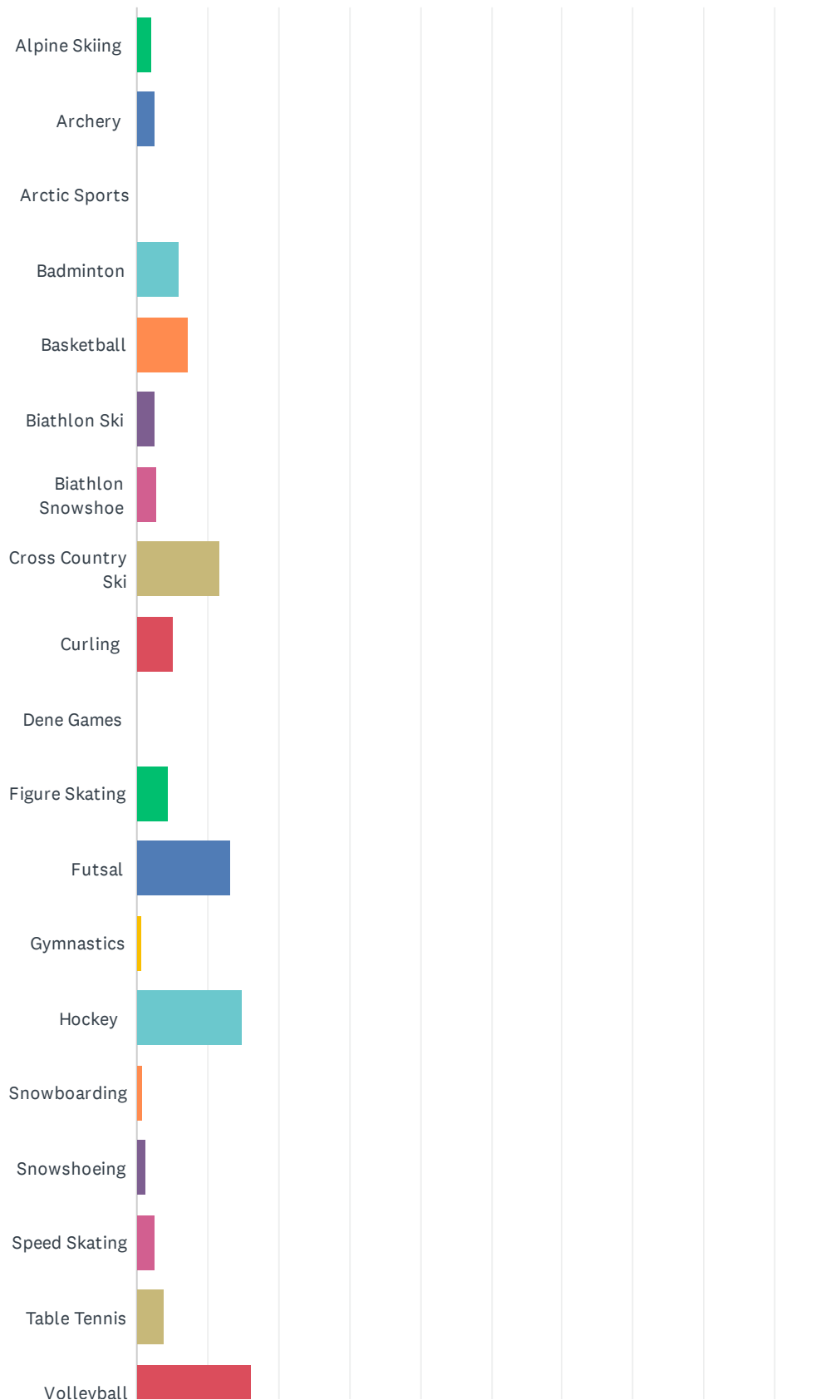

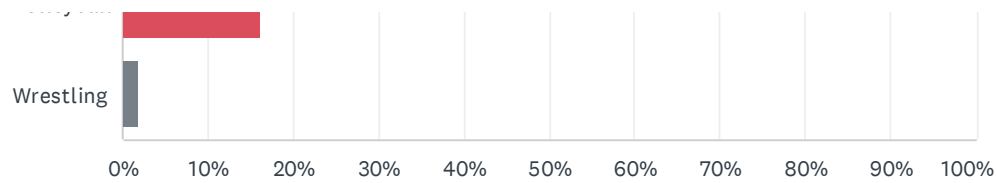

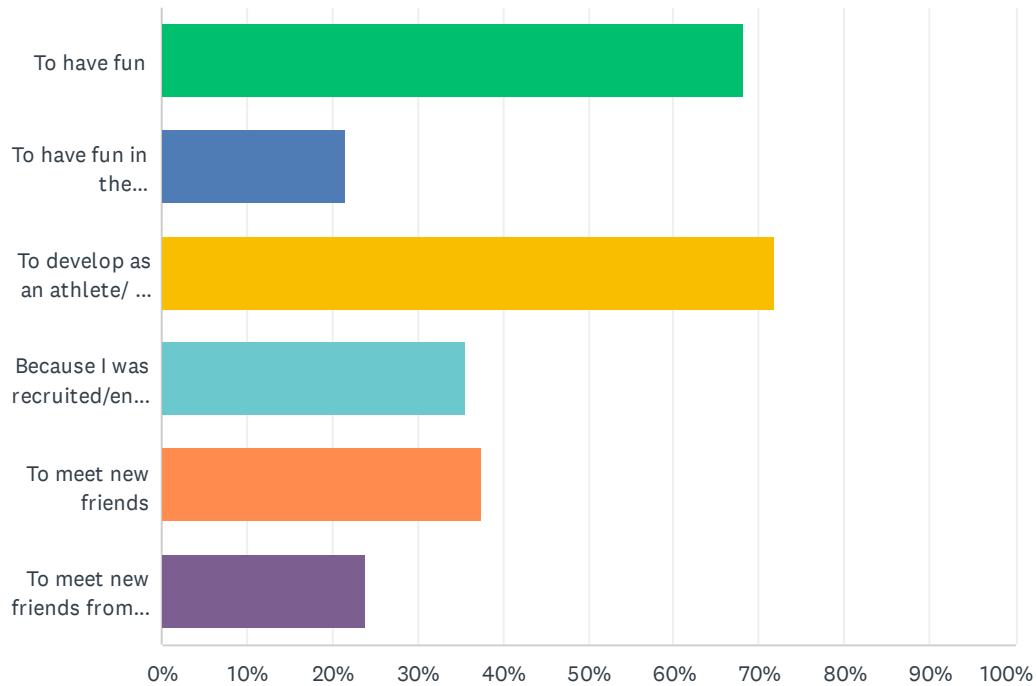

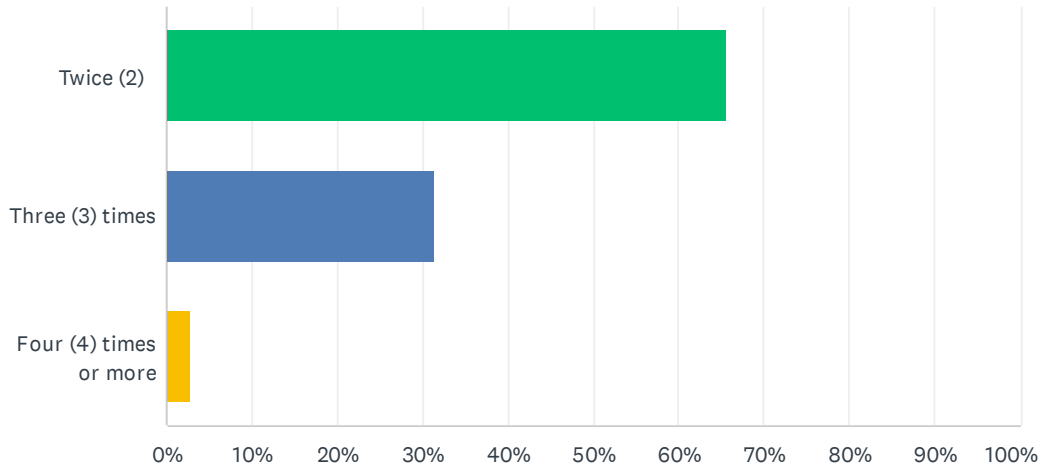

Q15 If it is not your first time at the AWG, how many times have you been at the Arctic Winter Games, including the 2023 AWG in Wood Buffalo?

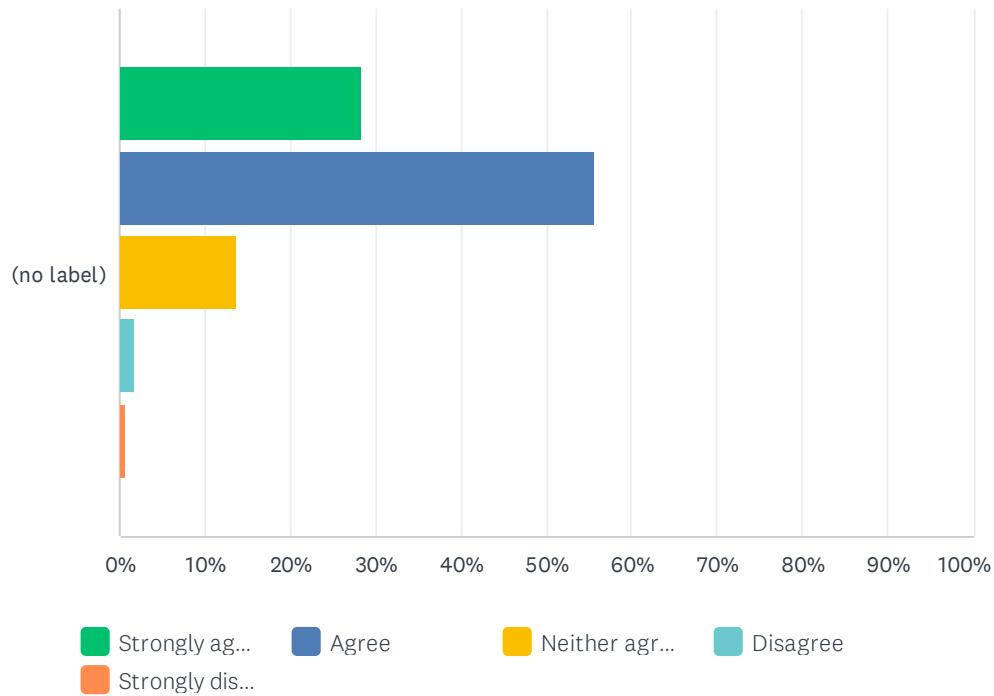

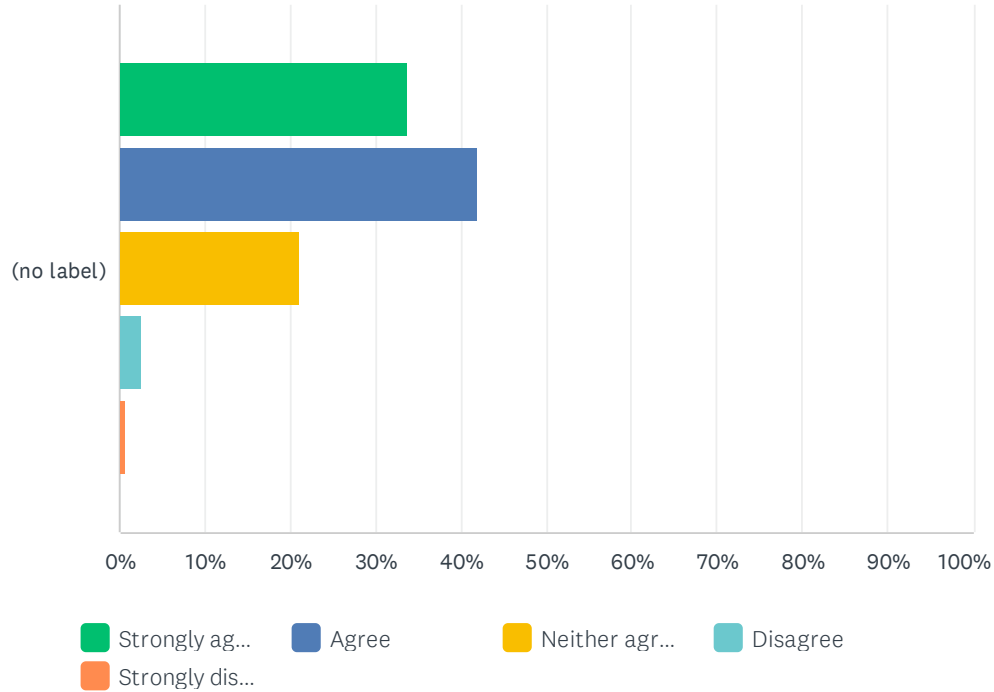

Q17 How strongly do you agree with the following statement: Participating in the AWG makes me feel that my home is the Arctic/North?

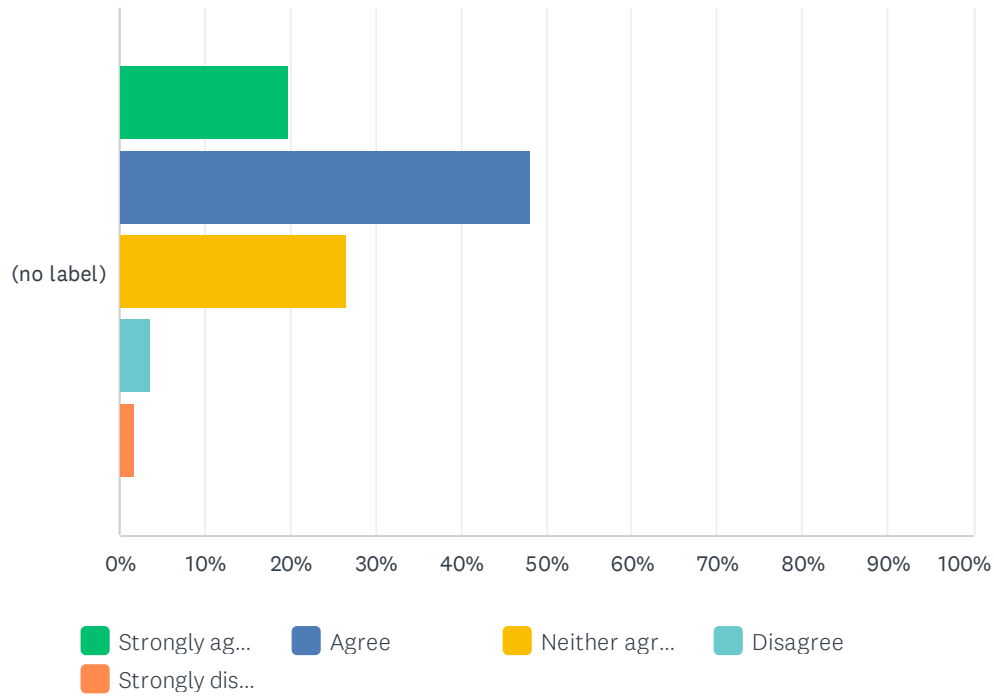

Q18 How strongly do you agree with the following statement: Participating in the AWG makes me understand how similar Arctic/Northern cultures are?

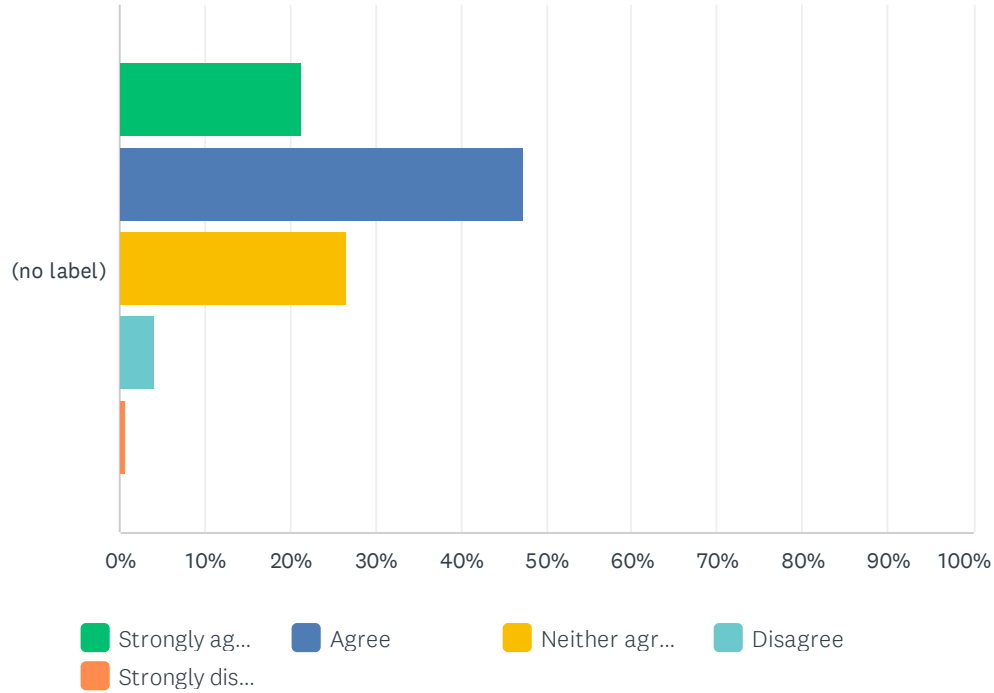

Q19 How strongly do you agree with the following statement: Participating in the AWG makes me understand how different Arctic/Northern cultures are?

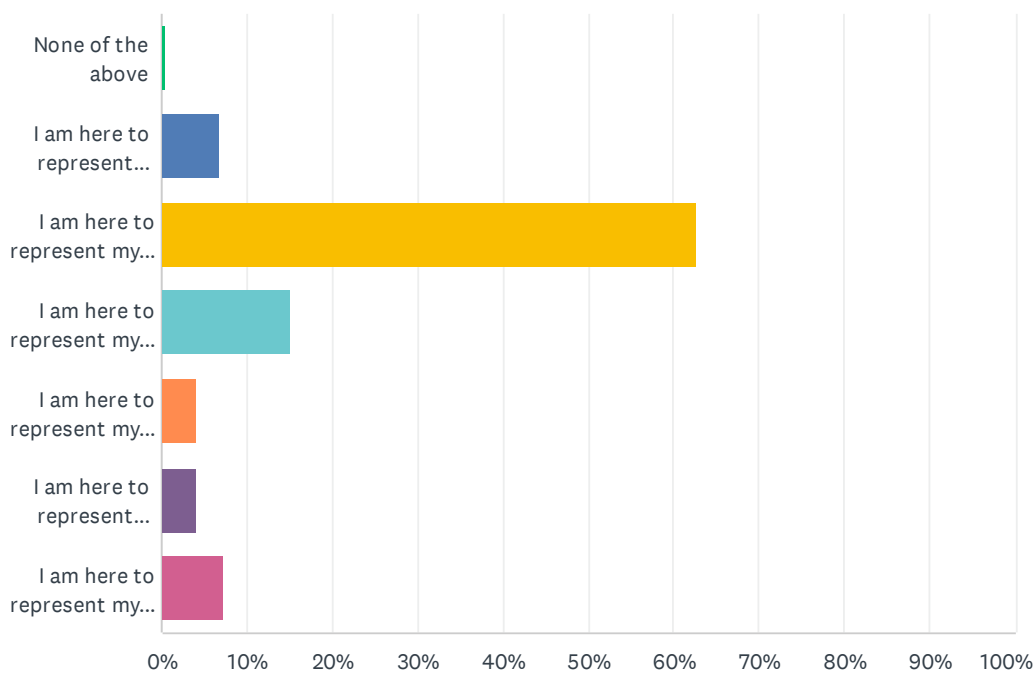

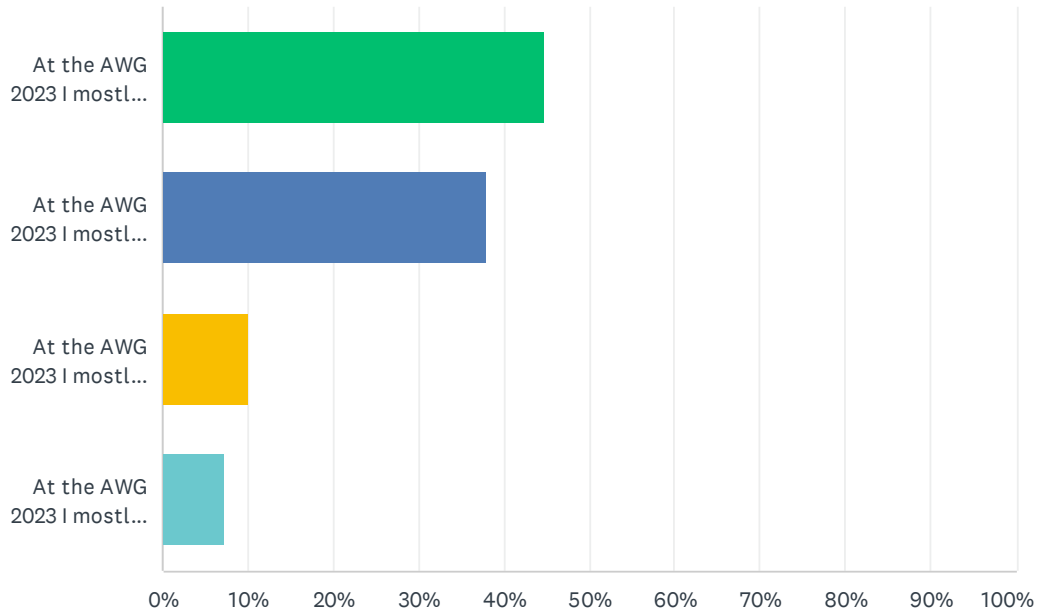

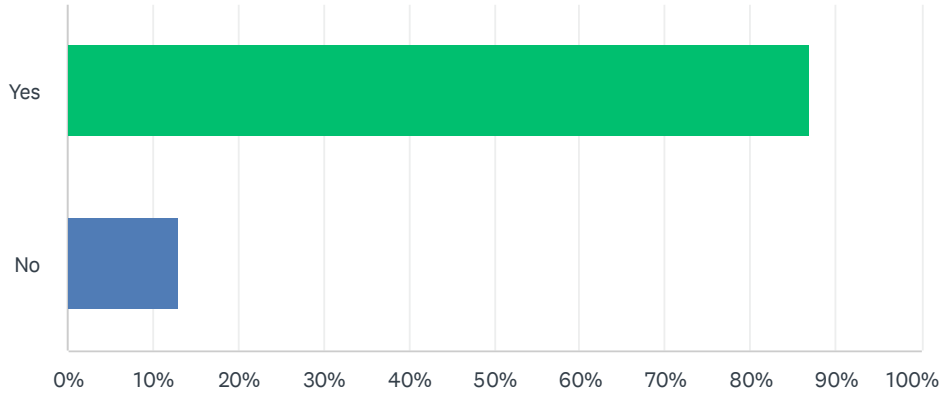

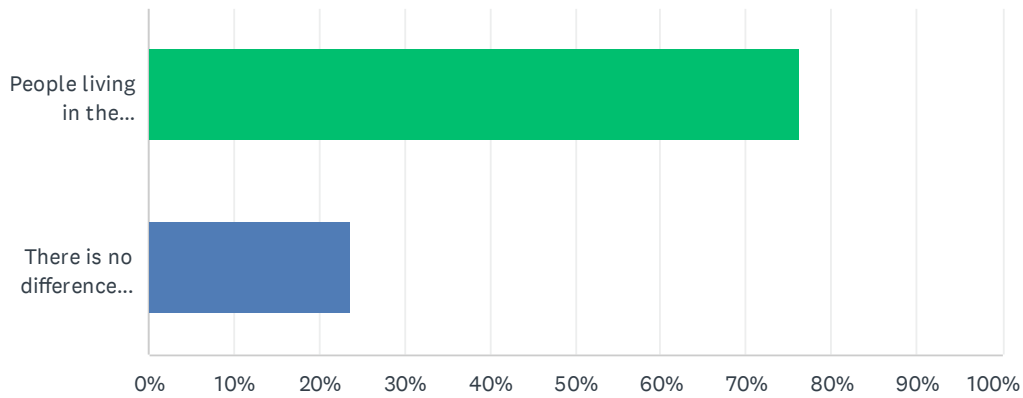

Q39 Which one of these statements do you mostly agree with?

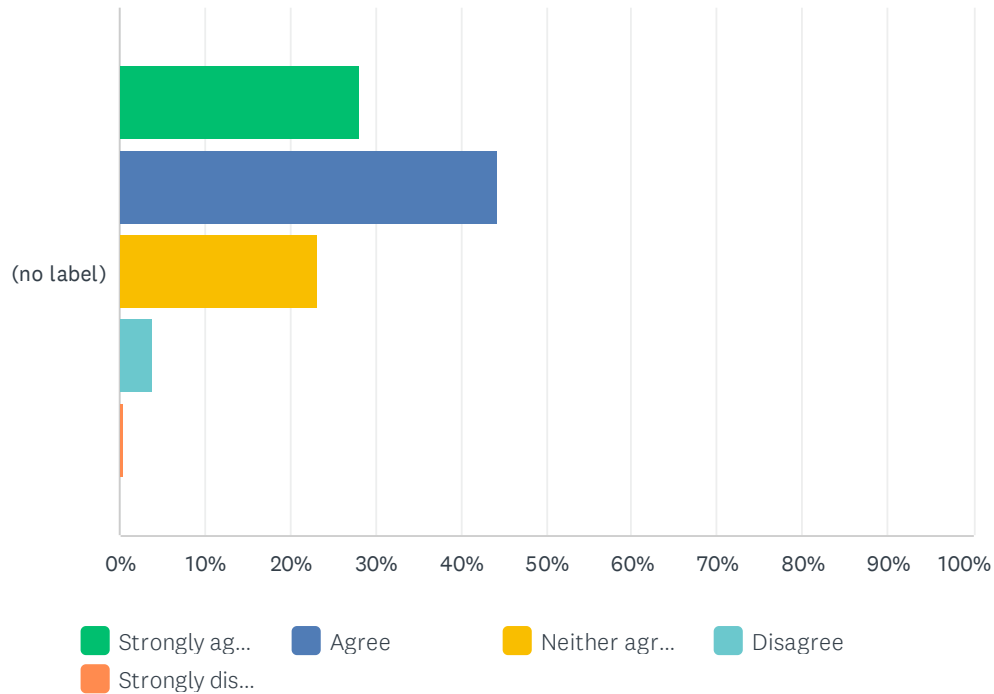

Q40 How strongly do you agree with the following statement: The AWG have a special responsibility to promote environmental protection of the Arctic/North?

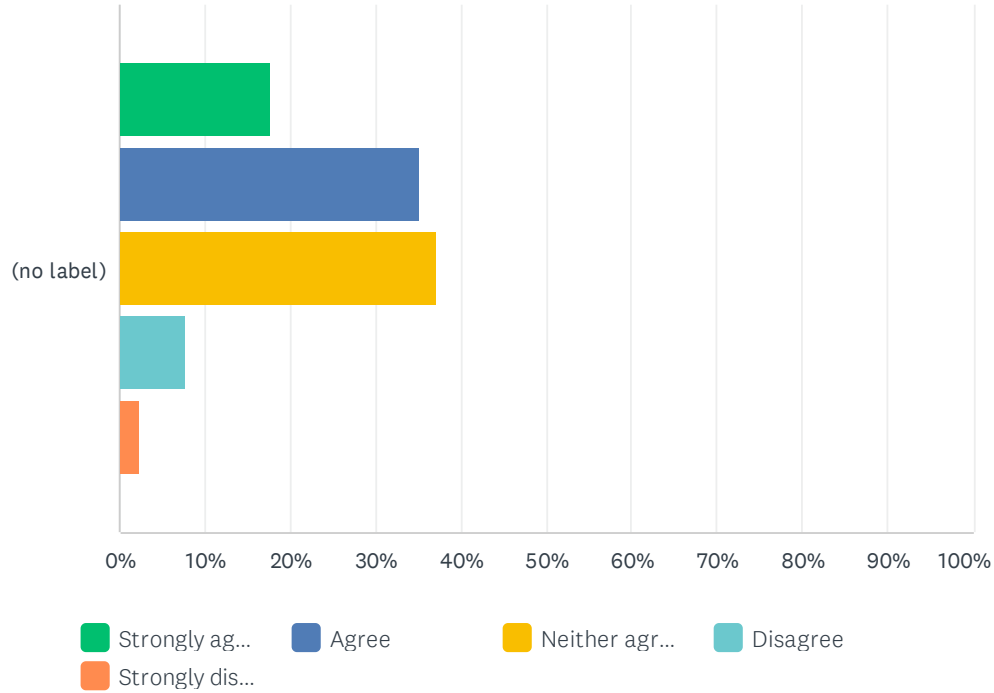

Q41 How strongly do you agree with the following statement: The AWG have a special responsibility to promote environmental protection to the world outside of the Arctic/North?

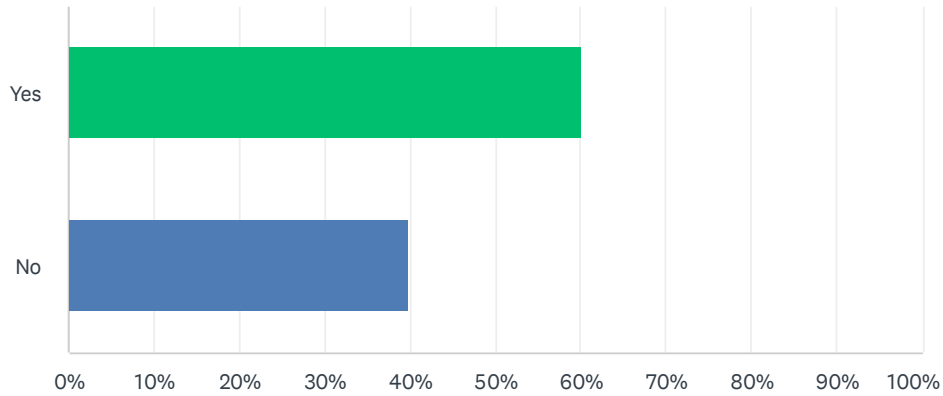

Q42 Do you think the AWG 2023 are a sustainable event that protects the environment?

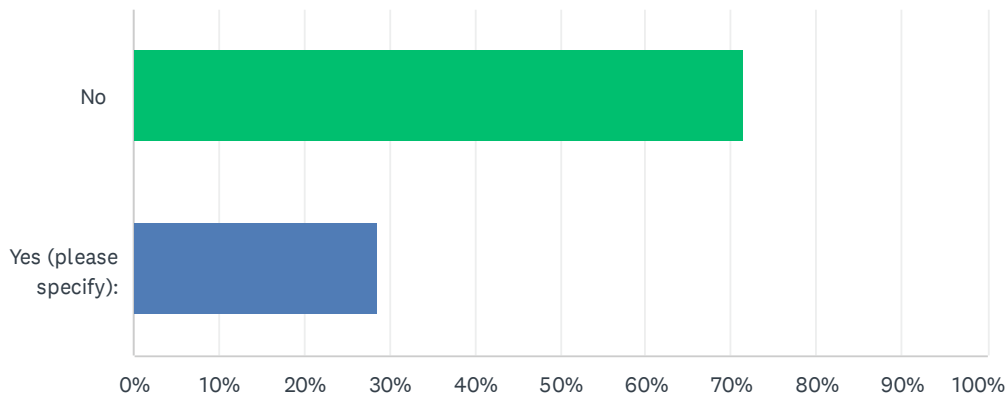
