Re: Custody, Supervision and Rehabilitation Services COVID-19 Pandemic Update

As of this morning, the total number of positive cases in the offender population is 21. What is encouraging is the facility has not had a new COVID positive case from a non-affected unit since about mid-November. This is due in part to your efforts in following masking and cleaning protocols. Please keep it up as it is important we all work together to contain this outbreak.

There are several units affected:

- Unit 3A, 3B, 3C, Unit 4A/B, Unit 1C, Unit 2C3, Unit 2D3

Mass testing will resume on Monday. This mass testing is super important as it will locate any further positive cases, so we can handle appropriately. Test results of the testing this past week continue to come in and the results are encouraging.


With the concern of the Delta variant, it is extremely important the offender population follow the protocols put in place throughout this pandemic. We want to minimize the spread and risk as much as possible. You, the inmate population, can assist by:

- Wearing your mask appropriately at all times when in common areas
- Cleaning and sanitizing common spaces and high touchpoint areas, including shared tables, bathrooms, and showers
- Frequently washing/sanitizing your hands, including before eating
- Taking advantage of the weekly vaccination clinics held at RCC

If you would like to be vaccinated or would like more information about vaccines, please ask your Unit staff, ADDP or Nurse. We will also have flu vaccines available shortly.

Just a heads up, we will be doing the Unit Christmas decorating contest again this year. Your Unit ADDP will be able to provide more details.
