Re: Your Access Request under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act – Our Files: # 2021-045 and 062

On January 15, 2021, Manitoba Justice received your applications for access under *the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA) for the following:

FIPPA # 2021-045: *I am requesting statistical overviews on the number and length of lockdowns in your correctional institutions. January 2020 (WHO Disease Outbreak News) to March 1, 2020.*

FIPPA # 2021-62: *I am requesting statistical overviews on the number and length of lockdowns in your correctional institutions. March 1, 2020 to August 30, 2020.*

By letter dated February 16, 2021, we extended the time limit to respond to your access request and advised that we would respond on or before March 18, 2020.

One of the purposes of FIPPA is to allow any person a right of access to records in custody or under the control of a public body, subject to limited and specific exemptions, which are set out in the Act. Access is granted in full to the records. Responsive records follow below:
