I started my incarceration time of ²⁹⁽¹⁾ November 2020, I was first isolated for 14 days because of the COVID epidemic that is/was going around at the S.C.C. After the 4 weeks that I was in the D1 unit and screened 3 times for COVID, Testing ^{29(1), HIPA 27(1)} I was placed in Echo 2 dorm and was stated facts that the unit was cleaned thoroughly by the proper sanitizers and equipment for the Covid Virus.

December 14/20 in Echo unit I was cleaning around my bunk bed living space with a Book Shelf beside my bed, I had moved for the cleaning, underneath the shelf was a lot of garbage which consists of cards, paper, trash and a cigarette blatts that I perceived was not professionally dealt with. I had reported this and made a complaint to Pat Sommerville, and the complaint was dealt with from Rita Turnice A/ADSP Echo 2, The following weekend other inmates were transferred around. An inmate whom was transferred to Echo 2 unit had told guys in Echo 2 that he is/was recovering from COVID Virus, he had asked the guards of why he was not in the process of the recovery unit, since the guard had asked him if he would be a domestic on Echo 3 unit since he was previously. My concerns had risen to why a recovery person is with or on Echo 2 with the guys who tested negative 3 times and also if the room was at the maximum capacity, why would a overflow Bed mat to be used for a recovery inmate, which should be in the proper unit with the "Recovery" "Active" and "Negative" inmates in the S.C.C

In Conclusion; Inmates, including myself are not being dealt with properly or given the proper information regarding this Epidemic. Please Consider this a Step in the right direction for Everyone's Health and Safety. Thank you ²⁹⁽¹⁾

I have previously asked staff for basic necessities to clean the environment I live inside, whether it be for unlocked time or within my own cell I would normally do this daily and in consideration of the covid-19 outbreaks. I have done this more than usual and have never previously been denied such a small humanitarian right due to the staffs inconvenience. Canadians being governed by the Rule of Law pertains to all Canadian Individuals as well as any ones persons rights as a human. Inmates as myself and any government officials alike are to resolve disputes by a "peaceful" manner of discussion or negotiation if not by due process within a court. It also states within the Rule of law that no government officials are allowed to make up or change the rules without consulting anyone else. I'd like to be advised where exactly Pine Grove officials or policy has stated in writing that an inmate is not allowed the use of the spray bottle with the only form of sanitation inside the facility during an unlocked time and further more where it states that any correctional officer can change order of what we as humans have a right to be given to fit their own times and convenience. Considering all this I have written today because I was refused numerous times of my basic hygienic rights and my own right to voice my opinion yesterday on paper and now again today am locked for a day and refused yet again basic necessities due to the staffs unprofessional manner towards me as an inmate and the assumption that her

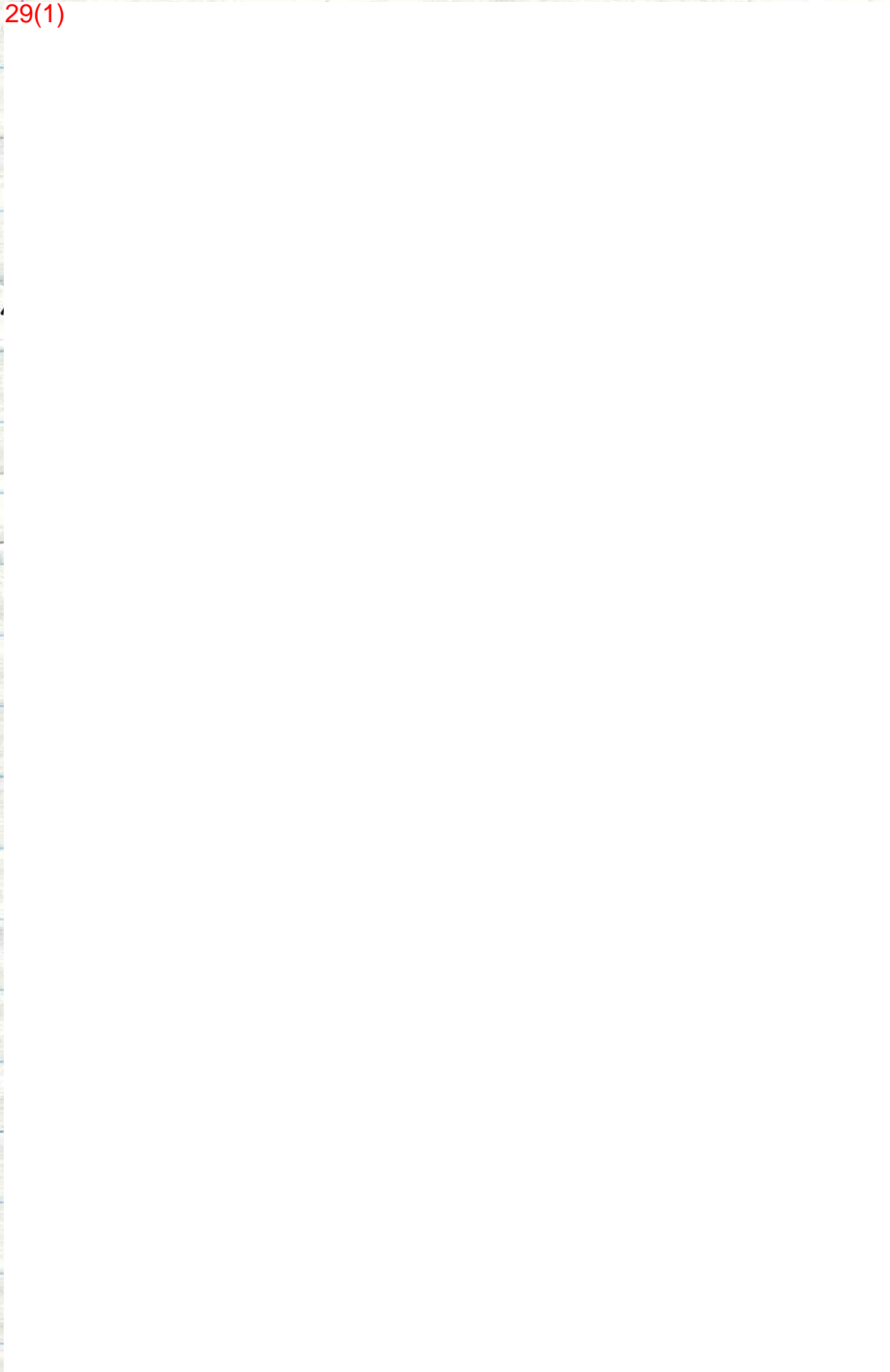

THERE SHOULDN'T BE AN ISSUE W/ US WORKING OUT TOGETHER, ALOT OF US INMATES LOOK FORWARD TO THAT 1 HOUR OF EXERCISE TIME. WE WORK HARD FROM 6:45-1PM THEN 3:45 UNTIL 6, WORKING OUT IS PRETTY MUCH ALL WE HAVE LEFT TO LOOK FORWARD TO, WE ALREADY LOST VISITING PRIVILEGES.

3) WE HAVE ALL BEEN HERE FOR ATLEAST A FEW WEEKS AND THERE HAS BEEN NO CASES. THE INMATES THAT DO GET THROUGH HERE SHOULD BE SCREENED PRIOR TO GETTING TO 3 SQUARE ALREADY. SO BASICALLY THE ONLY WAY IT CAN BE TRANSFERRED TO US WOULD BE THROUGH STAFF.

4) WE ALSO ARE THE ONE'S RISKING OUR HEALTH BY HANDLING THE DIRTY TRAYS FROM BREAKFAST, LUNCH AND DINNER. WE DON'T REALLY UNDERSTAND THE LOGIC BEHIND TAKING AWAY OUR REC EQUIPMENT. IF THE CORONAVIRUS IS PRESENT, THIS CONSTRAINED PROXIMITY AND PROLONGED PERIOD OF TIME TOGETHER, ALL BUT GUARANTEES THIS HIGHLY CONTAGIOUS DISEASE. ALTHOUGH WE HAVE SEEN SOME POPULATION REDUCTION RECENTLY, AS THE LAW COURTS HAVE BEEN RELEASING A NUMBER OF QUALIFYING INMATES ON BAIL CONDITIONS, THE TOTAL OVERALL EFFECT ON REDUCING THE PRISONS RESIDENTS IS RATHER LIMITED DUE TO THE RECENT ISSUES OF OVERCROWDING WITHIN THE SYSTEM. PRISONERS PROLONGED CONFINEMENT WITH ANOTHER INMATE, OR DOUBLE BUNKING AS IT IS KNOWN, BREAKS ALL SOCIAL DISTANCING BARRIERS THAT THE REST OF OUR COUNTRY RELIES UPON FOR PERSONAL SAFETY. VIRUS AT ITS MOST CRUCIAL POINT, HOWEVER THIS CURRENT COMBINATION OF CIRCUMSTANCES DOES NOT BY ANYWAY BELIEVE US FROM ACTING RESPONSIBLE AND TAKE OTHER PRECAUTIONS IN THE AREAS THAT WE ARE ABLE.

WE ALREADY KNOW THAT THROUGHOUT THE PROVINCIAL CORRECTIONS SYSTEM NEW INTAKE UNITS ARE BEING CREATED AND MAINTAINED TO RELIEVE ADDITIONAL INMATES FOR QUARANTINE PERIODS OF 14 DAYS. THIS MEASURED RESPONSE IS BOTH OBVIOUS AND APPROPRIATE TO STEM THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 WITHIN THE PROVINCE'S CORRECTIONALS. BUT, SINCE IT IS ALSO REASONABLE TO ADMIT THAT THE MAJORITY OF POSSIBLE CORONAVIRUS CASES WILL BE COMMUNICATED THROUGH THE PROLONGED PERIODS OF TIME INMATES SHARE WITH EACH OTHER INSIDE THEIR JAIL CELLS, A SUBSEQUENT LIST OF RISKY AREAS AND ACTIVITIES SHOULD BE PROVIDED. RECENTLY, ELECTIVE PROGRAMMING AND OTHER NON-ESSENTIAL MOVEMENTS WITHIN THE INSTITUTION HAVE BEEN REDUCED OR EVEN ENTIRELY ELIMINATED. THIS LEAVES ONLY ON UNIT ACTIVITIES, AREAS AND BEHAVIORS TO BE SCRUTINIZED.

WE UNDERSTAND THAT OUR EXERCISE FACILITY WAS LABELLED A HIGH-RISK ACTIVITY / AREA DUE TO THE MULTIPLE TOUCH / USE SURFACES, CLOSE PROXIMITY CONCERNS, AS WELL AS THE INCREASED RISK OF SALIVA DROPLET TRANSMISSION. SINCE THESE FACTORS MAKE UP THE CRITERIA ON WHICH THE DECISION WAS BASED TO RESTRICT OUR ACCESS TO THE WEIGHT ROOM, THE UNITS KITCHEN AREA MUST BE EXAMINED FIRST,

UNDER MY OWN CLOSE OBSERVATION I HAVE WITNESSED APPROXIMATELY $\frac{1}{3}$ (UP TO 24 INMATES) OF MY ENTIRE UNIT (72 INMATES AT FULL CAPACITY) USE THE GYM AREA ON A REGULAR BASIS THROUGHOUT THE DAY, (THIS ESTIMATION IS GIVEN ON THE HIGH SIDE).

BUT IN CONTRAST TO THESE NUMBERS, I CAN ATTEST TO THE FACT THAT THE ENTIRE POPULATION OF THIS UNIT USES THE KITCHEN FACILITIES REPEATEDLY, EACH AND EVERY DAY, OUR UNITS KITCHEN AREA CONSISTS OF; 2 MICROWAVES, 2 TOASTERS, 10 FEET OF COUNTERTOP, MULTIPLE CUPBOARDS AND DRAWERS, AS WELL AS A TABLE AND 4 CHAIRS DIRECTLY ADJACENT TO THE KITCHEN. ALL OF THESE AMENITIES ARE CONFINED TO A SMALLER AREA THAN OUR EXERCISE ROOM. ALSO, EACH ONE OF THESE ABOVE STATED KITCHEN FEATURES ARE USED MULTIPLE TIMES BY THE ENTIRE UNITS POPULATION DURING THEIR ALLOTTED EXERCISE PERIODS. EVERY INMATE USES, TOUCHES, STANDS IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO ONE ANOTHER MANY TIMES MORE THAN WITHIN THE GYM AREA. THIS CURRENT USE OF THE KITCHEN AREA, BY SHEAR NUMBERS AND REPETITION, IS EXPONENTIALLY MORE HAZARDOUS THAN THE FRACTION OF INMATES WHO USE THE WEIGHT PIT. IN FACT, IF THE RESTRICTIVE ACTION TAKEN AGAINST THE WEIGHT ROOM IS BASED UPON THE INCREASED PROBABILITY OF DISEASE TRANSMISSION, THEN REMOVING ACCESS TO THE UNITS COMMON AREAS OF TABLES AND CHAIRS, MUST ALSO TAKE PRECEDENT OVER OUR WEIGHT PIT AS WELL.

EVEN WHEN INMATES ARE NOT PREPARING FOOD ON THE TABLES, THEY ARE CONGREGATING AT, WALKING BY TOUCHING OR SITTING AT AND PLAYING CARDS / BOARD GAMES UPON. AGAIN BY BOTH NUMBERS AND FREQUENCY, THE COMMON AREA RECEIVES DOUBLE THE USE COMPARED TO THE WIEGHT ROOM, SURELY WE WON'T SEE INSTITUTIONAL MAINTENANCE CREWS COMMING INTO THE LIVING UNITS AND EXTRACTING CEMENT TABLES OR REMOVING 200 POUND CHAIRS IN RESPONSE TO THIS CURRENT ISSUE? ALSO WE CANNOT NEGLECT THE FACT THAT 'DOUBLE BUNKING' GREATLY PRECEEDS AND TAKES PRECEDENT OVER THESE EXAMPLES. A FAIR AND LOGICAL EVALUATION WILL FIND THAT OUR JAIL CELLS, THEN KITCHEN AREA, FOLLOWED BY THE COMMON AREAS, WITH FINALLY THE EXERCISE FACILITY AT THE BOTTOM OF THE LIST, DEFINES A PRIORITIZED RISK ASSESSMENT OF THIS ISSUE.

TAKING ALL THIS INFORMATION INTO ACCOUNT WE STILL UNDERSTAND THE SEVERE IMPLICATIONS OF THIS CURRENT HEALTH CRISIS, AS WELL AS WHAT IS REQUIRED OF OUR COUNTRY TO ASSIST IN CONTAINING IT. WE COMPLETELY UNDERSTAND THAT THE DECISION TO CLOSE OUR EXERCISE FACILITY WAS DONE IN GOOD FAITH, NOT ONLY TO PROTECT THE PRISON POPULATION, BUT ALSO THE CORRECTIONAL STAFF AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC AS WELL.

HOWEVER, THESE CIRCUMSTANCES ARE NOT THE CASE WITHIN THE INSTITUTIONAL ENVIRONMENT. WE HARBOR AN ALMOST STATIC, AND HEALTHY, GENERAL POPULATION. INMATES WHO ARE LEAVING BECAUSE THEY HAVE BEEN GRANTED BAIL, OR GIVEN EARLY RELEASE, OBVIOUSLY POSE NO THREAT. NEW INMATES RECEIVED ONTO THE LIVING UNIT HAVE BEEN VETTED AND QUARANTINED FOR A MINIMUM OF 14 DAYS. INSTITUTIONAL STAFF FOLLOW SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES CAREFULLY AS WELL AS STAY COGNITIVE AND VIGILANT AGAINST VIRAL TRANSMISSION WHILE ON SHIFT. IF BY SOME CHANCE PROTECTIVE MEASURES FALL SHORT AND AN INMATE BECOMES ILL, HE IS IMMEDIATELY REMOVED FROM THE GENERAL POPULATION ENVIRONMENT AND SECLUDED INTO A QUARANTINED SETTING.

EACH OF OUR LIVING UNITS 3 TIERS ARE ISOLATED FROM INTERMINGLING. I CAN PERSONALLY ATTEST THAT FULL AND THOROUGH DISENFECTING/SANITIZING TAKES PLACE A MINIMUM OF 6 TIMES PER DAY, OR MORE, AS I LEAD THE COVID-19 CLEANING RESPONSE CREW ON MY UNIT. DEFINITELY, FROM A PUBLIC VIEWPOINT, CLOSING OUR EXERCISE FACILITY SEEMS LIKE A REASONABLE RESPONSE TO THIS COVID-19 OUTBREAK... BUT WE ARE NOT THE GENERAL PUBLIC. 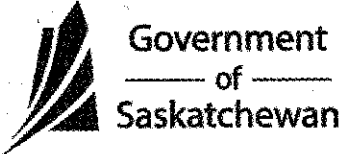

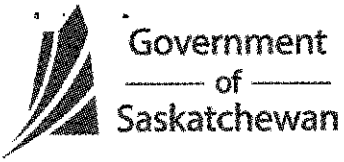

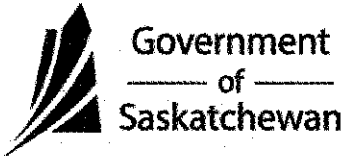

WE THE INMATES OF UNIT 4A13 REGINA PROVINCIAL CORRECTIONAL HAVE COME TOGETHER WITH QUESTIONS AND CONCERNS REGARDING THE STEPS AND MEASURES THIS FACILITY IS TAKING TO ADDRESS CERTAIN AREAS NOT INCLUDED WITHIN THE MEMO OF NOV 25/20 FROM DIRECTOR JULIEN HULSEK.

- 1) How healthy and safe is it for inmates to be wearing face masks on a continuing basis while confined
- 2) With the amount of germs and bacteria that is being circulated via the vent system. masks should be changed more than once a day
- 3) So why is it mandatory for inmates to wear masks on the range but allowed to take them off in their cells - same air circulating
- 4) Inmates with respiratory problems such as asthma or in need of inhalers or are claustrophobic are at risk of asphyxiation or other related health traumas.

Other inmates that come into distress are the elderly, diabetics, at risk individuals with other health problems.

SAYING MASKS MAKE THE HEALTH PROBLEMS

- 5) MASKS RESTRICT THE INTAKE OF OXYGEN AND THE RELEASING OF CARBON DIOXIDE WITHIN THE LUNGS. WHICH CAN LEAD TO OTHER LUNG RELATED SICKNESSES OR ILLNESS OR CANCER.
- 6) WE ALSO NOTICE THAT GUARDS DO NOT ALWAYS WEAR THEIR MASKS OR SANITIZE THEIR HANDS
- 7) WE NOTICE GUARDS COUGHING AND SNEEZING FREQUENTLY
- 8) WE NOTICE THAT GUARDS BRING IN OUTSIDE CONTAINERS ~~AND~~ THAT COULD CARRY THE VIRUS IS: COFFEE CUPS (TIM HORTONS, MCDONALDS ETC)
