This letter is in response to your request submitted to the Ministry of the Solicitor General (the Ministry) under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act).

Your request is for access to the number of hunger strikes, protests, and refusal to stand for inmate counts involving inmates in correctional institutions for the time period covering October 1, 2020 to December 20, 2020. Please be advised that total access is granted to the available records. Please note that refusal to stand for inmate counts is not tracked and therefore no information is available.

Please note the ministry uses the term hunger strike to refer to inmates at a correctional facility refusing institutional meal service. For the purposes of data collection, a hunger strike does not preclude inmates from purchasing and/or consuming additional food items through an institution's canteen service when available.
